Turlington stated that he had heard several people say that Subject is a homosexual, but did not know of his own knowledge of any homosexual activities of Ruby.

Turlington also stated that Ruby was a good employer and was easy to work for. Turlington stated that Subject's sister Eva had called him after Subject killed Oswald and asked if he would come to Dallas during the trial, that he might be able to help Subject.

OFFICERS COMMENTS: Turlington was interviewed in Warkshock, Texas, February 4, 1964, by the undersigned officers. An effort is being made to locate Manning (fmr) and Cecil Hamilton, mentioned in this report.
