Pursuant to the instructions of Captain W.P. Gammaway an investigation was conducted regarding SUBJECT and the following report is submitted. This investigation is revelent to the Jack Ruby trial.

Confidential informant T-1 reports that SUBJECT was born July 25, 1923. Place of birth is not known. SUBJECT has maintained residence at 4637 San Jacinto for the past fourteen (14) years. The telephone number at this location is TA-4-0202. T-1 states that SUBJECT served in the United States Army from February 16, 1943 to November 7, 1945, and was discharged as a Sergeant. T-1 reports that SUBJECT is employed as a musician at the Cattleman's Steak Mouse, 2007 Live Oak, six (6) nights each week, with the G.R. Hovatny Orchestra. This orchastra lists the business address of 711 North Oak Cliff Blvd. Prior to joining the Novatny group, SUBJECT played with the Roland Drayer Orchestra. T-1 states that in addition to playing with the aforementioned crehestra SUBJECT maintaines Karl's Piano Service, 1637 San Jacinto. T-1 states that according to their records SUBJECT'S father E.C. Wahrmund also lives at 4637 San Jacinto along with SUBJECT.

The indices of the Dallas Police Department Special Service Buress were searched regarding SUBJECT with negative results.

The indices of the Fallas Police Department Records Bureau were searched regarding SURJECT with negative results.

The indices of the Delias Police Department Identification Bureau were searched regarding SUBJECT with the following results. Records of the Identification Bureau reveal that on April 30, 1951 a Mrs. Eurt A. Wahrmund, W/F was sentenced to the Texas Department of Corrections for a period of two (2) years for the offense of Forgery under the number of 125805. At this time Mrs. Vahrmund was fifty-two (52) years of age. Her date of birth being April 15, 1901, at Fredericksburg, Texas. Records reveal that Mrs. Kurt A. Wahrmund was married to one Kurt A. Wahrmund whose address is listed as 1637 Sen Jacinto, the same as SUBJECT.
