The following is submitted for your information.


My right knee has been bothering me for several weeks. This is the same knee that was stabbed by an ice pick on April 28, 1956.

Captain Solomon advised me to see Dr. Mattson, 630 No. Bishop, who is on the approved City Doctors list.

I went there on Tuesday, November 5, 1956. X-rays were taken and it was disclosed that there is approximately one-half inch of the tip from the ice pick embedded in my right knee cap.

Dr. Mattson made arrangements for me to enter Methodist Hospital on November 15, 1956 and to be operated on November 16, 1956.
