Sir,

We submit the following for your information concerning the above
prisoner.

At 5:10 P.M. this date we arrested this man in the 5100 block
Singleton for D&D. We had three prisoners already in the car
all for D&D. Two of these were handcuffed and the third man
who was not handcuffed was behaving himself.

Upon placing J. Barney Hanson in the rear of the squad car, he
jumped on Sam Richard Curbow (the prisoner that did not have
handcuffs on). Curbow scratched Hanson on left side of nose before
we got them separated. Hanson was given first aid at Police
Emergency and placed in jail for D&D agg.
