RELEVANT DETAILS, PROGRESS OF INVESTIGATION, ETC

On November 24, 1963, at 6:30 P.M., Det. J. R. Leavelle delivered to Captain G. M. Dougherty, a lead slug removed from the body of Lee Harvey Oswald at Parkland Hospital by Dr. Tom Shires. The slug was removed in the presence of Nurse Aubrey Due who placed the letter A on the base of the slug and gave it to Det. Leavelle.

On November 24, 1963, at 7:00 P.M., Captain J. W. Tritts delivered to Capt. G. M. Dougherty a Colt Cobra .38 Special revolver # 2744 LW attached to the gun in an envelope was the following:

- One .38 Special live shell.
Four .38 Special 2 WMC live shells.
One .38 Special REM-UMC spent hull.

All of the above were released at 11:00 A.M., on December 30, 1963 by Det. J. R. Leavelle to Mr. L. C. Johnson and Det. W. D. Montgomery, to be taken to the FBI Lab in Austin for examination.
