IDENTIFY CRIMINAL DETAILS, PROGRESS OF INVESTIGATION, ETC.

On November 24, 1963, at 6:30 P.M., Det. J. E. Leavelle delivered to Captain G. M. Doughty, a lead slug removed from the body of Lee Harvey Oswald at Parkland Hospital by Dr. Tom Shires. The slug was removed in the presence of Furse Aubrey Bue who placed the letter A on the base of the slug and gave it to Det. Leavelle.

On November 24, 1963, at 6:30 P.M., Captain J. W. Brits delivered to Capt. G. M. Doughty a Colt Cobra .38 Special revolver # 2744 LW attached to the gun in an envelope was the following:

- One .38 S&W Special live shell.
- Four .38 Special RUMBO live shells.
- One .38 Special RKT-UMC spent shell.

All of the above were released at 11:00 A.M., on December 30, 1963 by Sgt. [Name] to the [Name] on unit # [Name] D. W. Montgomery, to be taken to the [Name] for identification.
