Summary of Case: Jack Ruby: broke from the crowd of news reporters and individuals who had gathered was being escorted in a waiting squad car for delivery to the County Jail. He stood from a distance of not more than 2 blocks, the bullet hitting Oswald in the left side, about 100 yards from him, lodging just under the shirt on the right side.
