The quotation about which you inquired in your letter of December 11, 1964, is on a memorial placed in the Trade Mart where President John F. Kennedy was scheduled to speak on the day of his assassination.

The inscription reads, "When thou seest an eagle, thou seest a portion of genius. Lift up thy head."

The only other writing on the memorial plaque is, "Placed in memorial by the friends of John F. Kennedy who awaited his arrival at the Trade Mart November 22, 1963."
