Long Distance Call From <u>Mr. Emery Richard Whetstine</u>, 7 E. Harrison, Ainsworth, Iowa

To-

At 1:20 A.M., Mr. Whetstine called this office and talked with Officer O. L. Rodgers regarding the assassination of President John F. Kennedy.

Mr. Whetstine spoke as if he were intoxicated, and seemed to be well educated.

He stated he saw the person that fired the shots that killed <u>Mr. Kennedy</u>, and that it was not <u>Mr. Oswald</u>. Mr. Whetstine stated it was <u>Franklin</u> <u>Folley</u>, who is the <u>drummer</u> in <u>Frank Sanatra</u>'s band, currently playing in Las Vagas. He stated that <u>Mr. Folley</u> was standing directly in front of him (in park across street from the Texas School Book Depository). Mr. Whetstine states he has three empty rile cartridges from the rile Mr. Folley used. Mr. Whetstine gave Officer Rodgers the phone number 646-6507, Welman, Iowa. This call was traced by telephone company and this is the correct number he was calling from.
