At 1:20 A.M., Mr. Whetstine called this office and talked with Officer O. L. Rodgers regarding the assassination of President John F. Kennedy.

Mr. Whetstine spoke as if he were intoxicated, and seemed to be well educated.

He stated he saw the person that fired the shots that killed Mr. Kennedy, and that it was not Mr. Cound. Mr. Whetstine stated it was Franklin Folley, who is the drummer in Frank Sanatra's band, currently playing in Las Vagas. He stated that Mr. Folley was standing directly in front of him (in park across street from the Texas School Book Depository). Mr. Whetstine states he has three empty rifle cartridges from the rifle Mr. Folley used. Mr. Whetstine gave Officer Rodgers the phone number $\partial 46-6507$, Welman, lowa. This call was traced by temphone company and this is the correct number he was calling from.
