SUBJECT: DONALD ROY TABON (6)

Sir:

Pursuant to instructions of Captain W. P. Gannaway, the SUBJECT investigation was conducted and the following report submitted.

Confidential Informant T-1 reported that the SUBJECT, a white male, d o b, 10-23-1923 has been known to the source since October of 1952. At one time he reported that he had attended Oxford University in England and that he was a graduate of that institution. This could not be verified. The source reported that the SUBJECT has a very bad credit rating, owing more than twenty past due accounts that range back over the past ten years. T-1 stated that the SUBJECT first began using his name spelled as DON RAY TABON and that in 1956 he began spelling the name as DONALD ROY TABONE in many transactions, adding an 'E' to the name.

The source stated that the SUBJECT'S employment record was very bad, that in the past ten years he had been associated with eight different companies;

- 1954 - Revlon Products as a salesman
- 1955 - Schwade Bros. of Denver, Colo. as a salesman
- 1956 - Synthetic Plastic Sales Co. as a salesman
- 1959 - Crown Mfg. Co. as a salesman
- 1960 - Lenel Co. as a salesman
- 1960 - Gloff Glass Co. as a salesman
- 1961 - SORG Glass Co. as a salesman
- 1962 - Robert Fulton Show Case Co. as a salesman

The source reported that it was known that this is not a complete list of the companies the SUBJECT has been employed by, but that there was no record made of others.

Confidential Informant T-2 reported that there had been two inquiries made on the SUBJECT, both of them in 1959 with one
