T-1 futher reveals that SUBJECT has three tax lien cases filed against him at the present time. These tax leins are listed in the Recording Section of the County Clerk's office. The date of filing, log book number, page number and monetary amount are as follows: September 11, 1961, Volume 41, page 335, excise tax for \$50,993.00; March 16, 1962, volume 44, page 356, cabaret tax for \$3,876.00; January 4, 1963, volume 54, page 125, excise tax for \$24, 482.00.

The County Clerk's office, Recording Section, was checked by the reporting officer and the above information was verified.

SUBJECT was interviewed by Detective T.T. Wardlaw of the Intelligence Section on 14, February, 1964. SUBJECT stated he had been an employee of JACK RUBY aka RUBENSTEIN at the Silver Spur night club, 1717 S. Ervar St. in 1948 and worked for RUBY for approximately six to eight months. SUBJECT also stated he has seen RUBY about two or three times a year since his employment by Ruby. SUBJECT was asked if he knew LEE HARVEY OSWALD and if he did, was he aware of any connection between RUBY and OSWALD. SUBJECT'S reply was that he personally did not know OSWALD and he has no knowledge of an aquaintance between RUBY and OSWALD. SUBJECT also stated that although he was not a close friend of RUBY, he did not beleive RUBY was a communist or had been connected with any. SUBJECT told Detective WARDLAW that if he learned of any information that might be helpfull to the police, that he would contact officer WARDLAW. The interview was then terminated.
