SUBJECT: Brutality of Ruby

An examination of the Jack Ruby investigative reports was made to determine the identity of persons who could testify regarding the brutality of Ruby; and persons who have first-hand knowledge of acts of brutality committed by Ruby. When Ruby couldn't meet the payroll and girls asked to be paid, he would get mad and beat them up; enjoyed taking advantage of girls and other employees by beating them when they had no recourse.

2. BIRCH, Mrs. Fannie - P. 189-190 -  
9100 Metz Drive  
Dallas, Texas - Forcibly ejected customers for no sound reason; once knocked customer down flight of stairs.

3. CALGROVE, Mrs. Paul - P. 87 -  
6829 Peerless, Apt. 3  
Houston, Texas - A stripper who was slapped by Ruby.

4. CALHOUN, Henry Red - P. 333 -  
4906 Linnet Lane  
Dallas, Texas - Was struck in mouth by Ruby; 16 stitches required.

5. DICKERSON, Willis D. - P. 334 -  
2442 Hawthorne St.  
Dallas, Texas - Was struck by Ruby in face and groin and in self-defense he bit Ruby's finger which was later amputated.

6. FARRARO, Frank - P. 89 -  
53 Farmerly Street  
New Haven, Connecticut - Was struck by Ruby 3 or 4 times with brass knuckles.
