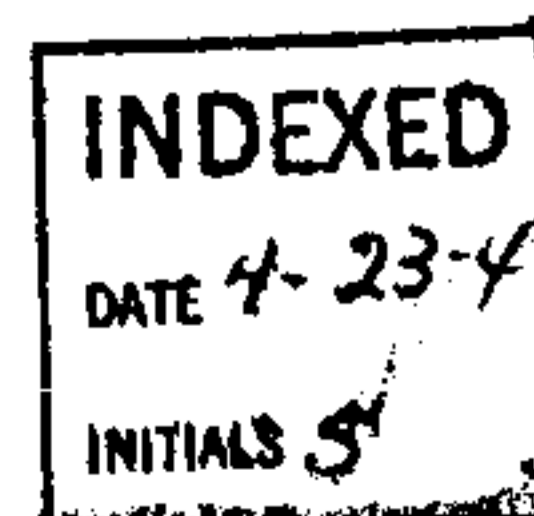

San Bernadino, California
Had fist fight with Ruby in 1953. Ruby arrested and put in jail.
 3. ANDERSON, Bernard - P. 55 -
5000 W. University Blvd.
Dallas, Texas
Has heard from other employees that Ruby was quick tempered.
 4. ANDERSON, John Harold - P. 82 -
2409 Atkinson Street
Irving, Texas
Ruby is a man of quick temper and explosive volatile personality who is quick to become angry because of trivial matter.
 5. BARRAGAN, James C. - P. 254 -
The Town Pump
5021 W. Lovers Lane
Dallas, Texas
Suggests possible liquor violations at Ruby's club.
