

U.S.S. CONSTITUTION ("OLD IRONSIDES")

Navy Yard, Boston, Mass.
Was launched Oct. 21, 1797, under her first commander, Captain Samuel Nicholson. In 1798 she helped clear the West Indies as well as our own coastline of French privateers, and bombarded the forts at Tripoli in 1803 to 1805. During the War of 1812 she won a succession of victories over the British Fleet. It was Oliver Wendell Holmes's poem "Old Ironsides" which prompted the people to raise money for the preservation of this ship in 1833.
