The following is submitted for your information.

SUBJECT was involved in a disturbance on the street in the 500 Block of EIM ST. this date with BILLY NOWITH LOYELADY was LOVELADY is an emphoyee of the TEXAS SCHOOL BOOK DEPOSITORY. This disturbance resulted from an attempt by SUBJECT to photograph h.k. LOVELADY.

SUBJECT stated that he had been hired by one CLAY FELKNER of NEW YORK CITY to photograph MR. LOVELADY. MR. LOVELADY reportedly was standing on the sidewalk in front of the depository at the time of the assassination of FRESIDENT KENNEDY and was photographed at that time. SUBJECT stated that FELKNER that the photo taken at that time actually is a picture of LEE HARVEY CSWALD and not that of BILLY NOWLIN LOVELADY. A new photograph of LOVELADY is needed for comparison. SUBJECT had approached MR. LOVELADY prior to the disturbance and asked permission to take his photograph and ER. LOVELADY refused.

OFFICER'S COMMENTS: MRS. MARGUERITE OSWALD, mother of LEE
HARVEY OSWALD has made the same claim
as that of MR. FELKNUR, i.e. LEE HARVEY
OSWALD was standing on the sidewalk in
front of the depository and therefore
could not have shot the President.

SUBJECT denies knowing MAS. MARGUERITH OSWALD and further that he is not working for her.
