Offices Van Cleave & McElroy arrived at the scene of the shooting at 10:30 AM. The complaint was reported. The compl. stated that he was sitting at the table in the living room of his home at 1000 E. Ross St. when he was shot. He was sitting at the table when a bullet of unknown caliber, steel jacket, hit him in the chest, passing through the ribs, leaving the frame of the window and going into the wall above the compl.'s head. The compl. lodged in some paper in the next room. He said that he did not see the person who shot him, but he thought it was some sort of firework. He was sitting at the table when he was shot. He went upstairs to his bedroom to get a pistol. He said that he had a pistol, but he would have committed this offense. The police searched the grounds at the rear of the house and the alley, with negative results. He also interviewed Robert Murray, 11111 R. L. Moore LA 6-7741 who was at the scene upon our arrival. This subject is a business associate and aide to the complainant. Mr. Murray stated that on Monday, April 6th about 9:00 AM he drove up the alley behind the compl.'s house and noticed two A/M-BOD sitting in a 1967 Ford dark purple or brown, parked in front of the complainant's house. Mr. Murray also stated that he observed these two men get out of the car and walk around the compl.'s house. He said that he was not disturbed about the incident. Mr. Murray also stated that he had the license plates on the 1967 Ford. Patrol squad 10, 1010, was called to the scene at 10:30 AM.
