Dear Representative Preyer:

The papers indicate that there is much skepticism about the report of the Mouse Assassinations Committee which indicates that organized crime may have played a role in the death of President Kennedy.

I want to share with you a fragment of information which came to me shortly after the assassination. It is probably worth nothing, but I have carried it in mind all these years.

At the time of the event, I was a health education consultant with the Public Health Service, working in Bethesda. One of my associates, and I cannot now remember the name or the face, told me that either she, or a friend, was in Boston shortly after the Dallas affair. The individual was in a beauty shop in Doston. Her operator told her that on the morning of Nov. 22, 1963 the wife of a known or suspected mob figure in the area came to the shop for services. The womah was agitated and in a hurry. As she swept out of the shop almost breathlessly she said: "President Kennedy is going to be killed!"

At the time of the assassination, no one was talking or reading about organized crime involvement. This little scrap of information was different from anything

else which came to my attention. That is obviously the reason why it stuck in my mind.

Let me assure you that this is all I know and I couldn't be of further assistance. Also, know that I have no morbid curiosity nor am I accustomed to dashing off letters to Congressmen or newspapers. I hold a very responsible position in State Government.

You deserve credit for your service on the Committee.
