Dear Representative Preyer:

The papers indicate that there is much skepticism about the report of the House Assassinations Committee which indicates that organized crime may have played a role in the death of President Kennedy.

I want to share with you a fragment of information which came to me shortly after the assassination. It is probably worth nothing, but I have carried it in mind all these years.

At the time of the event, I was a health education consultant with the Public Health Service, working in Bethesda. One of my associates, and I cannot now remember the name or the face, told me that either she, or a friend, was in Boston shortly after the Dallas affair. The individual was in a beauty shop in Boston. Her operator told her that on the morning of Nov. 22, 1963 the wife of a known or suspected mob figure in the area came to the shop for services. The woman was agitated and in a hurry. As she swept out of the shop almost breathlessly she said: "President Kennedy is going to be killed!"

At the time of the assassination, no one was talking or reading about organized crime involvement. This little scrap of information was different from anything

else which came to my attention. That is obviously the reason why it stuck in my mind.

Let me assure you that this is all I know and I couldn't be of further assistance. Also, know that I have no morbid curiosity nor am I accustomed to dashing off letters to Congressmen or newspapers. I hold a very responsible position in State Government.

You deserve credit for your service on the Committee.

7C+7D Memo of Walter J. Sheridan, 11-26-63, to Howard Willens indicates [redacted] of Chicago had received information from a representative of CIA that Rubenstein had been seen with Cas Alex. Alex is a prominent Chicago racketeer, associate of all of the major Chicago rackets figures. (FBI #4244200)

In the same memo it is indicated that Dusty Miller had been contacted about 11-16-63 by Rubenstein, at which time Rubenstein told Miller he had been in contact with a mutual friend, Robert Barney Baker, and asked Miller's assistance in settling a dispute with AGVA. FBI report 7-13-54 subject [redacted] DJ File [redacted] furnished the information that an article in the Chicago American, 11-16-53 contained the information that Teamsters health and welfare funds are administered by trustees, the union representatives being James R. Hoffa, Floyd Webb of Joplin, Missouri, and N. W. Miller of Dallas, Texas. Murray W. Miller (Dusty) of Dallas, Texas is listed as Director of the Teamsters Southern Conference. One Dusty Miller of Florida is also listed as connected with the Southern Conference of Teamsters and an associate of [redacted] (Florida) in FBI summaries 9-16-60 on [redacted] 7C 7C

Robert Barney Baker, mentioned in Sheridan's memo as having recently been contacted by Rubenstein is listed in FBI summaries on various hoodlums as an associate of:

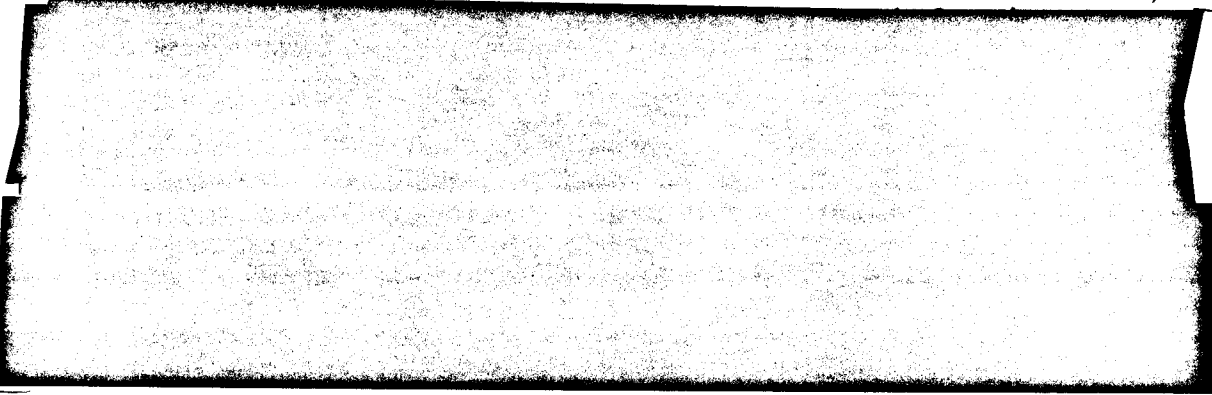

The information on this form reflects that Ruby solely owns the Vegas Club, 3508 Oaklawn, Dallas and is Vice President of S & R, Inc., which owns the Carousel Club, 1312-1/2 Commerce Street, Dallas. Ralph Paul is President of S & R, Inc., and Sam D. Ruby is also listed as an officer.
