Mr. J. HANDLEY telephonically contacted this office at 10:17 a.m., this date, and inquired if the Police Department had turned over all negatives of photographs taken of the crime scene. He further stated that in the event they have not been turned over, contact should be made in an effort to obtain same. If the Police Department does not desire to turn them over but will release them for a limited time, the Bureau should be advised.

Mr. HANDLEY stated there is some mixup as to where the bullet was recovered that came from the President's back. He stated the report indicates that a Secret Service Agent by the name of JOHNSON turned it over to the FBI, and the Bureau has information that JOHNSON obtained the bullet from Mrs. KENNEDY, who said she obtained it from the stretcher. The matter as to exact obtaining of the bullet and where it was recovered must be determined.

Mr. HANDLEY was advised that it was my recollection that Secret Service Agent JOHNSON carried the bullet from Dallas to Washington, D.C., and turned it over to an agent in Washington. He stated that was correct and contact would be made with Secret Service to determine JOHNSON's location for further inquiry.

Mr. HANDLEY stated they are in receipt of the photograph of OSWALD where he is holding a gun and papers and is wearing a sidearm. The Bureau is not exactly certain as to where this photograph was obtained during the search. It should be determined from which residence this photograph was obtained and the Bureau advised.

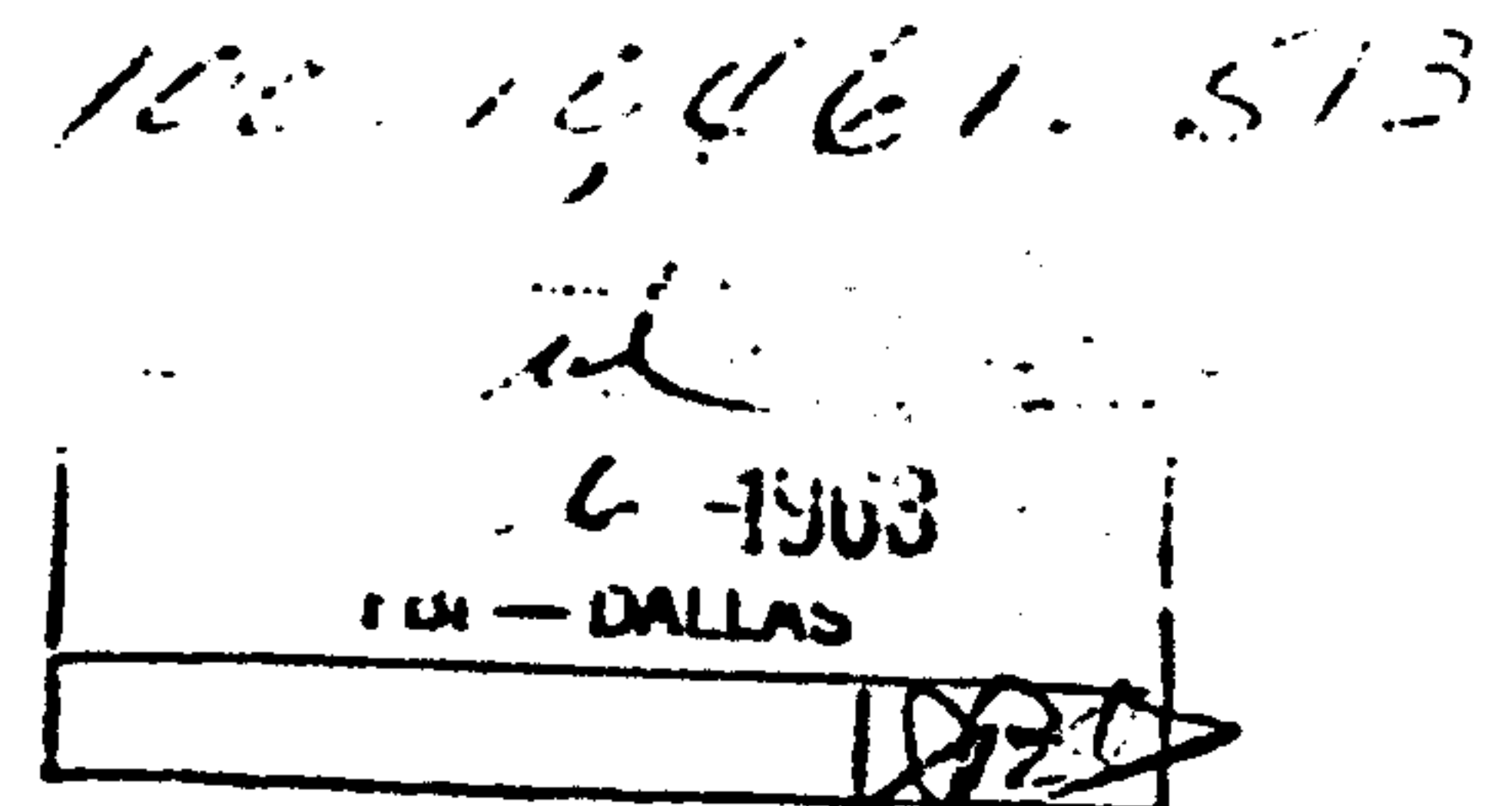

_____ furnished the following information to this office as being of possible pertinence to captioned investigation; if it conforms to a pattern of similar reported occurrences at other places:

Briefly, the circumstances as furnished third hand to _____ are as follows. Dr. RICHARD IRELAND, Pastor, University of Life Church, and one of his associates, ELIZABETH FRAZIER, have been holding closed-meeting seances at FRAZIER'S home, 724 E. Willetta, Phoenix. Apparently, through communication with the spirits of the dead and other powers, including extra-sensory perception, a reputation to forecast the future has been established by the IRELAND group.

Allegedly, on the night before the late President JOHN F. KENNEDY was assassinated, IRELAND during a seance, saw the U. S. flag, freshly turned dirt as though about a grave, and stated something "very drastic" was going to happen to the President. The attention of the Phoenix PD has been drawn to this group because six to ten elderly widows and widowers have become convinced of IRELAND'S supernatural powers, especially in light of the assassination. At least one widow is trying to sell her home, automobile,

RICHARD Z. HALL, 13305 Flagstone Lane (AD9-3313), Dallas, Texas, stated he has known GROVER CLEVELAND GILLETTE, 5315 Marnette Street for many years and CLEVELAND recently married a girl named MARGARET. He said GILLETTE attended Texas Tech graduating in 1949, later attended Texas University where he got his Masters Degree and is presently an independent Certified Public Accountant with offices on Turtle Creek Boulevard. He stated his wife, VIRGINIA ANN HALL was interviewed by SA JOSEPH M. MYERS on November 23, 1963 regarding LEE HARVEY and MARINA OSWALD and at that time GILLETTE was present and he, GILLETTE, kept urging Mrs. HALL to not furnish any information to SA MYERS. HALL said he does not know why GILLETTE urged Mrs. HALL to not furnish information, but pointed out GILLETTE has read CARL MARX and other Communist writers and is very "left wing" in his views.

Mrs. MARGARET HURLEY, Retail Merchants Credit Association, Dallas, Texas, advised SA LOGAN on December 6, 1963, that a review of her records under the name of CARL BOTTENGER and CARL WIESMEER failed to reveal any identifiable information concerning these names.

Miss JUDY HAHN, Clerk, Records Section, Dallas Police Department, Dallas, Texas, advised that a search of her records under the names CARL BOTTENGER and CARL WIESMEER failed to reveal any identifiable information concerning these two individuals.

Dallas indices negative.

It should be noted that no further investigation is being conducted to locate either CARL BOTTENGER or CARL WIESMEER in view of the source of the information. This information is being set forth in this letter inasmuch as it may prove necessary to search the names in the Bureau indices. 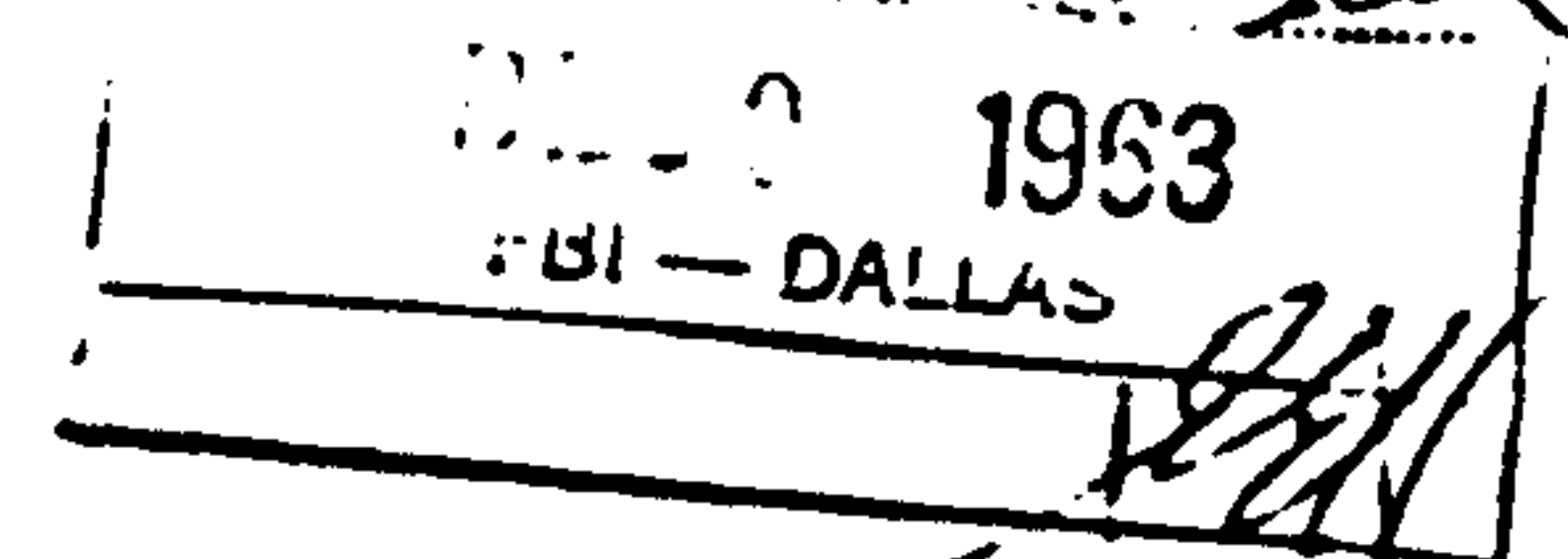

McDOWELL, Division Manager, American Society of Composers, Authors, and Publishers (ASCAP), 1700 Tower Petroleum Building, Dallas, advised he had been manager since 1943, and no one by the name of LEE has ever been associated with his office. He stated he recalled one VINCENT LEE (Oriental descent) was formerly District Manager for AGVA (American Guild of Varieties Artists). He stated that LEE formerly worked Texas and Oklahoma for the above organization and possibly Louisiana. He stated the last time he heard from VINCENT LEE he was in El Paso about five years ago and was working as a booker of shows in Juarez, Mexico. Mr. McDOWELL said he did not recall the middle initial of VINCENT LEE. He described VINCENT LEE as W, M, 5'9", slightly pudgy, dark hair, wore black horn-rimmed glasses, Oriental descent, and had a Caucasian wife.

At 3:51 p.m., 12/9/63, an individual who gave his name as JIM THOMPSON, but who refused to give his residence address and stated he was talking from a pay telephone, advised he had noticed in The Dallas Morning News on 10/23/63, an ad stating "BETTY PAIGE is terrific". He said this advertisement appeared in Section I, Page 9, and appeared to be an ad which cost \$20 to \$30. The word "terrific" was in italics and the ad had a black border around it. He said this did not say "watch this space" as most promotional advertising does say.

In two or three days after the ad appeared, he called The Dallas Morning News and was told by a secretary that Ken Ray Ford Co., in Dallas had run the ad. The secretary who gave him this information at the newspaper office stated she did not know what the ad meant.

In a few days his sister came to his residence and noticed the ad which he had torn out of the newspaper. Out of curiosity, she called The Dallas Morning News and was advised by the person talking that they did not know anything about this ad or who had placed it. Later THOMPSON said he called KEN GRANTHAM, Sales Manager of The Dallas Morning News, who vehemently denied knowing anything about the ad, but finally stated that the ad had been placed by ZEKE EVANS who was formerly employed by that newspaper. He said that EVANS was not now employed by the newspaper, but is employed by the Friendly Chevrolet Company on Lemmon Avenue in Dallas. GRANTHAM also claimed that he likewise did not know what the ad meant.

THOMPSON stated he made a telephone call to the Friendly Chevrolet Company and he was advised that ZEKE EVANS worked there and that EVANS was in his 30's.

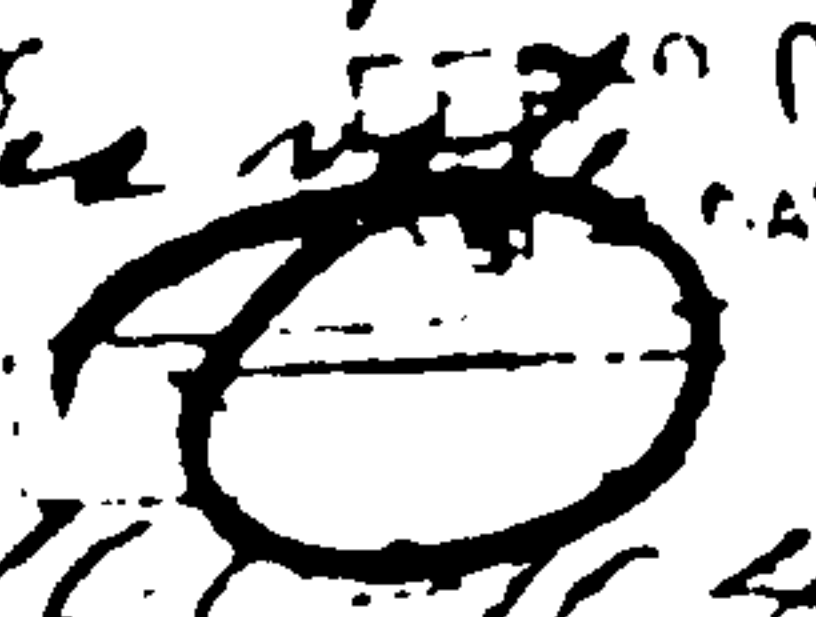
Madam:

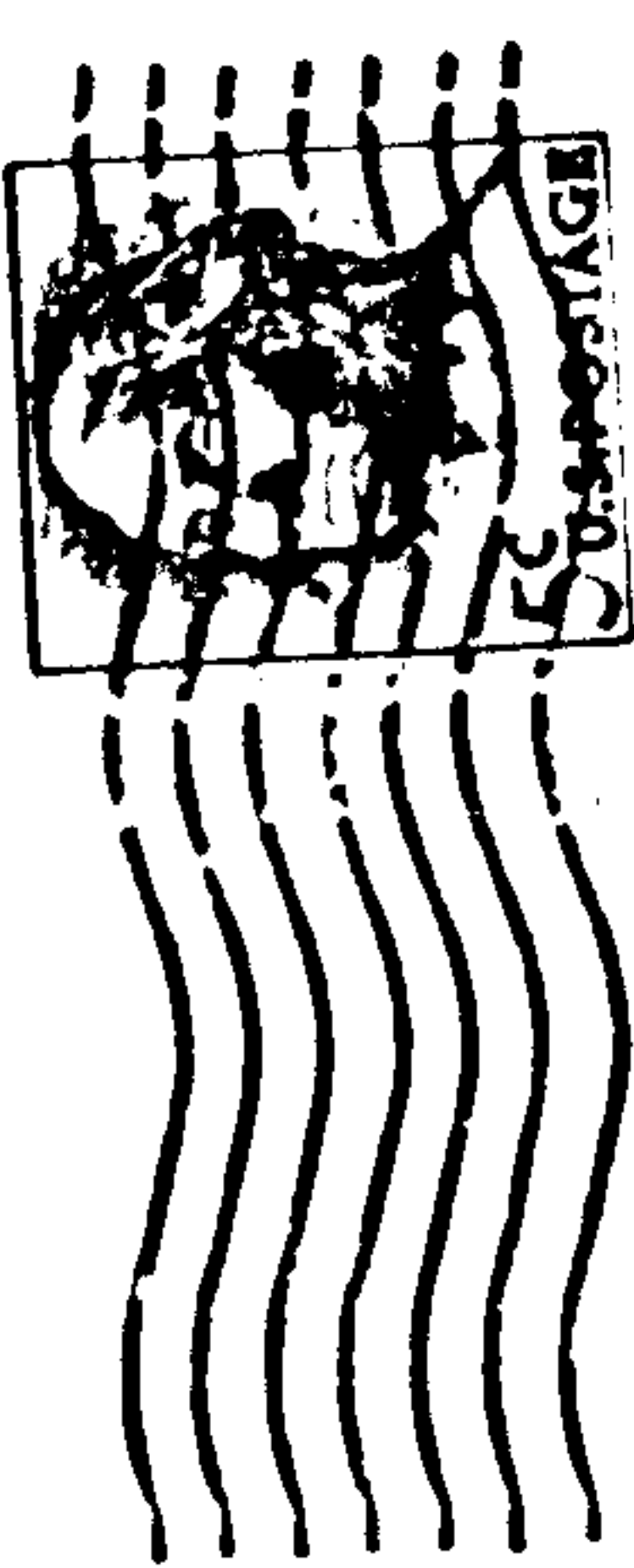

FLETCHER THOMPSON, Supervisor, Seat of Government, telephonically advised that a brief is being prepared for the Director in contemplation of his possible testifying before Committee. The following items are needed from the Police Department:

1. The Police Department file on the investigation of the attempted assassination of General WALKER should be thoroughly reviewed and all facets of their investigation prepared. In line with this, there should be obtained a definite statement as to whether OSWALD had been developed as a suspect.
2. In addition, it should be determined if the Police Department developed any suspects.

This information must be obtained 12/7/63 and furnished to the Bureau by teletype.

With reference to question as to whether any Agents were present in the basement of the City Hall at the time OSWALD was killed on 11/24/63, the following is set forth:

On 11/24/63 following SAC conference with all Agents, wherein instructions were given by SAC for all Agents to stay out of possible line of fire during PD transfer of OSWALD, SA JAMES W. BOOKHOUT proceeded to the Homicide and Robbery Bureau, Dallas PD, for coverage of previously assigned lead to be present on PD interviews of OSWALD and to maintain liaison with Homicide and Robbery Bureau.

After arriving at the Homicide and Robbery Bureau, it was ascertained that OSWALD was being interviewed by Captain J. W. FRITZ in the presence of Inspector HARRY HOLMES, P.O., PORREST SORRELS, Secret Service and others. This interview was being conducted in Captain FRITZ's office; all available seating space in said office was occupied, and therefore, Agent took seat outside office at glass panel where he could view OSWALD and hear questions and answers. OSWALD made no pertinent admissions during this interview which terminated about 11 a.m. During this time, Chief CURRY and Assistant Chief STEVENSON came to the Homicide and Robbery Bureau and appeared to be anxious for the interview to terminate. Upon termination of the interview,

they conferred with Captain FRITZ. About 11:15 a.m., OSWALD left the Homicide and Robbery Bureau en route to basement of City Hall, accompanied by the following officers: Lt. RICHARD E. SWAIN, Capt. J. W. FRITZ, JAMES R. LEAVELLE, L. C. GRAVES, LESLIE D. MONTGOMERY.

Lt. T. L. BAKER and SA BOOKHOUT were the only officers who remained at the Homicide and Robbery Bureau. SA BOOKHOUT turned up the PD dispatcher's radio unit for monitoring of same. Shortly thereafter, the dispatcher made a call for all homicide officers to report to the City Hall basement. Lt. BAKER immediately telephoned the dispatcher and asked what was going on and was advised OSWALD had been shot.

SA BOOKHOUT thereafter proceeded to the basement of the City Hall where it was ascertained immediately that OSWALD had been shot by an individual, reportedly named JACK RUBY. RUBY reportedly had already been taken to the fifth floor jail, and OSWALD had been taken into the jail office in the basement to await arrival of an ambulance. In just a few seconds the ambulance arrived, and as OSWALD was carried from the jail office to the ambulance on a stretcher, it was noted he had a powder burn bullet hole in his left side.

SA BOOKHOUT immediately returned to the Homicide and Robbery Bureau and phoned the office and was advised by the switchboard that SA BARRETT had already reported the shooting.

As reflected above, SA BOOKHOUT was not in the basement at the time OSWALD was killed, however, since he was in the basement following the killing and may have been observed by some officer who might later assume Agent had been in basement all the time, the above is being made a matter of record at this time.
