LATIL, JR., who for many years has been known as Buddy Latil.

The March 1, 1960, issue of "The Daily Herald", a Biloxi-Gulfport, Mississippi daily newspaper, contained a photograph of Walter Anderson Bailey along with an article entitled "Rebirth of Klan in Mississippi told by Bailey". The article identified Bailey as a third generation Klansman with the title of "Grand Dragon of Mississippi." The article reported that Bailey announced the reorganization of the Ku Klux Klan in the state of Mississippi, under a charter issued by the State of Georgia, December 10, 1959.

On January 25, 1961, Robert Latil, Latil Motor Company, 325 Caillavet Street, Biloxi, Mississippi, advised that Walter A. Bailey purchased for cash from that company a new white 1961 Dodge Seneca on December 12, 1960.

On May 14, 1963, Walter A. Bailey, 412 West Beach, Biloxi, was interviewed by FBI Agents. At that time he exhibited a certificate carrying his name as Walter A. Bailey, Grand Dragon, which was dated 1960 and bore the name "Knights of the Ku Klux Klan". Bailey stated he obtained this certificate when affiliated with the Knights of the Ku Klux Klan at Atlanta, Georgia. He said that about two years prior to the date of interview, he took his group of Klansmen and the organization he headed in Mississippi, out of the Knights of the Ku Klux Klan and that his Mississippi Ku Klux Klan is now an independent organization with no allegiance to any other State but that he will cooperate with other Klan organizations. Bailey described the Ku Klux Klan as non-militant and strongly apposed to violence. He said the Ku Klux Klan stood for being, "pro-American", pro-Protestant", pro-white."

At the time of the interview Bailey exhibited a billy club of the type utilized by police officers which he said he used for protection in his apartment. He also exhibited a pen like object containing a 410 gauge gas cartridge, which could be triggered by use of a clip. He said this unit was kept at his residence for his wife's protection.





Enclosed for the Bureau are 8 copies of a letterhead memorandum pertaining to WALTER ANDERSON BAILLY together with appendices characterizing the Miss. Ku Klux Klan and the National Ku Klux Klan (Knight's of the Ku Klux Klan). Also enclosed is an informant evaluation sheet for each copy of the letterhead memorandum.

One copy each of the letterhead memorandum and its attachments are being furnished Dallas and WFO.

Inasmuch as the letterhead memorandum enclosed with referenced WFO airtel refers to a statement by BAILLY concerning Attorney General ROBERT KENNEDY that "Someone is going to kill him", it does not appear that this matter actually pertains to the assassination of Pres. JOHN F. KENNEDY. It is suggested that the Bureau may desire to disseminate copies of the letterhead memorandum to the Department.

Concerning the allegation in the letterhead memorandum submitted by WFO, that the person accused of shooting MEDGAR EVERS has been observed at Latil Motor Company in the past, investigation in this regard is being handled in the MEDGAR EVERS case.



The envelope, Q6, is a self-seal envelope manufactured by the U. S. Envelope Company, 31 Cypress, Springfield 2, Massachusetts. No watermarks or other identifying characteristics were found in the paper comprising Q7 to determine its source.

The ink writing on Q6 and Q7 was prepared with a ball-point pen.

The stamp on specimen Q6 was torn from a booklet.

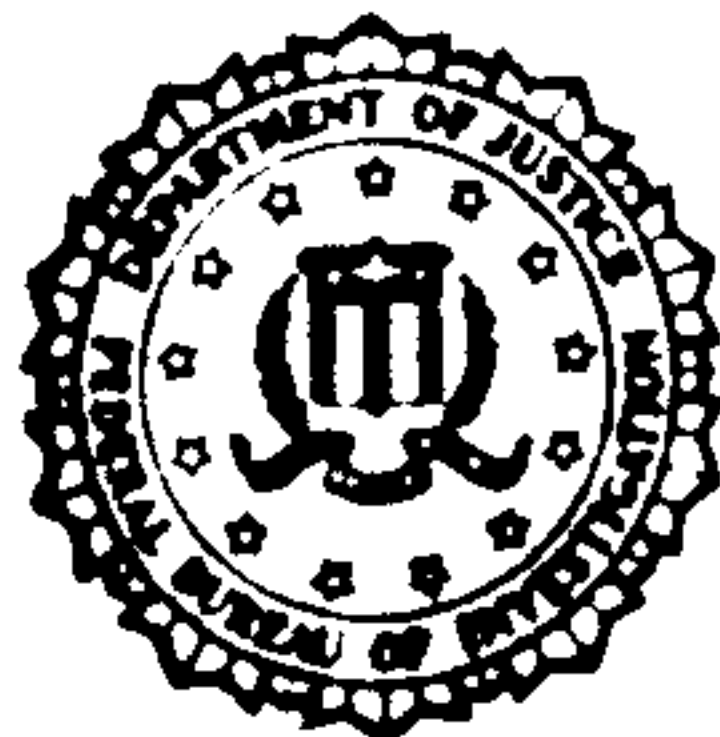

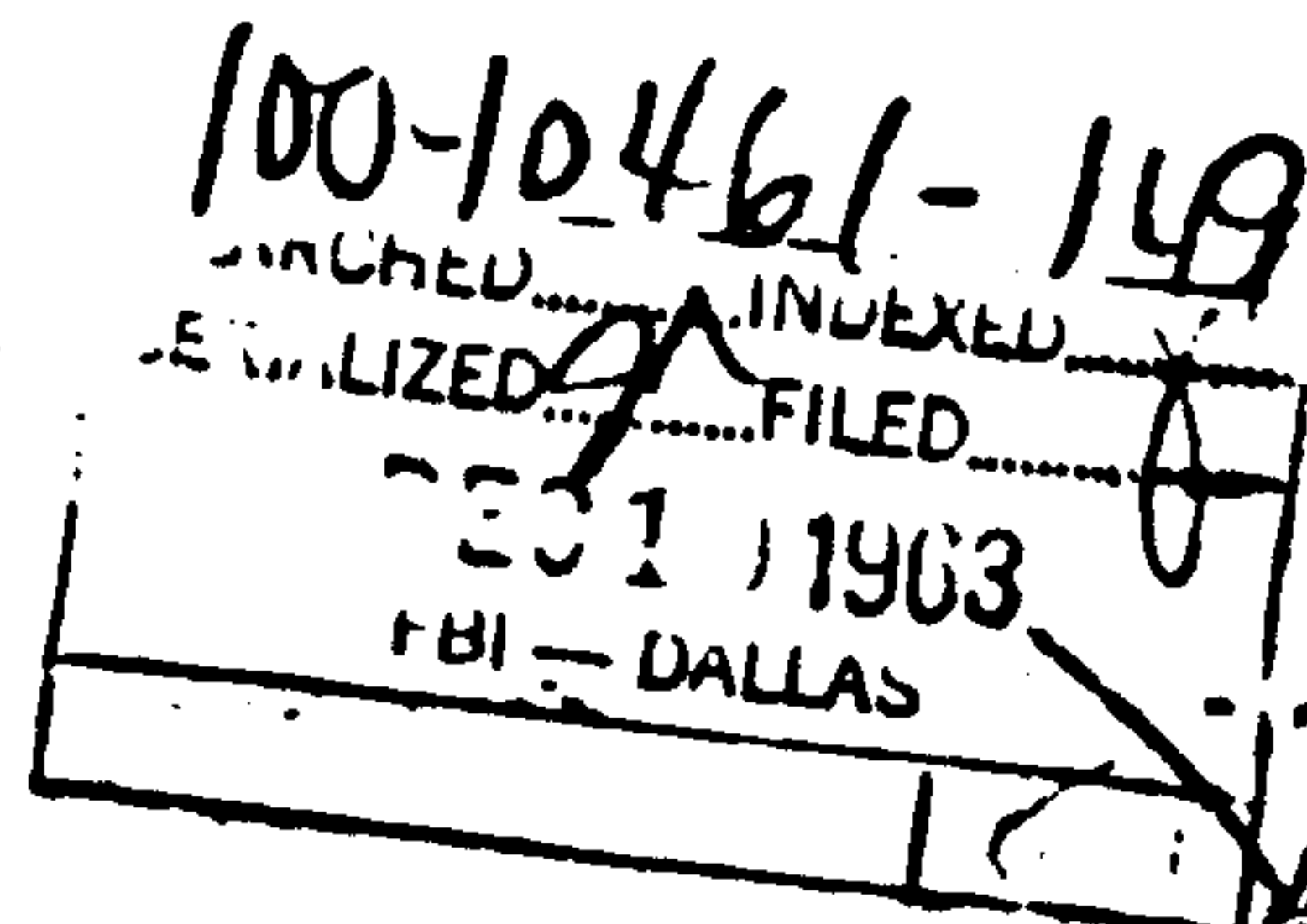

Re memoranda to SAC from RICHARD T. RABIDEAU dated 12/18 and 19/63 regarding telephone calls received by RABIDEAU from Mrs. MARGUERITE OSWALD complaining of obscene letters received by herself.

At 11:55 a.m., 12/19/63, Mr. W. C. McMORTIE, Office Superintendent, U. S. Post Office Inspector's Office, Fort Worth, Texas, was advised of the telephone calls from Mrs. OSWALD as set out in referenced memoranda. Mr. McMORTIE said Mrs. OSWALD had called his, McMORTIE's, office a day or two ago regarding the letters and during the a.m. of 12/19/63, Postal Inspector STEPHENS has sent two inspectors to interview Mrs. OSWALD. He said Mrs. OSWALD was interviewed during the morning of 12/19/63 at which time she turned over several letters which in McMORTIE's unofficial opinion are objectionable but are not unmailable. He stated the matter is receiving appropriate attention by his office.

NEVER OBTAINED ANY MEMBERS BUT SAYS HE HAD MANY SYMPATHIZERS. SUBJECT ASSOCIATED WITH MEMBERS OF AMERICAN NAZI PARTY, PAREN. ANP, ENPAREN, SAN FRANCISCO, AND STATES AIMS OF THIS ORGANIZATION SIMILAR TO HIS. SUBJECT REFUSED TO FURNISH NAMES OF ANY ASSOCIATES.

Letter from Pavel Golovachov, 11 Zahorova Street, Apt. 72, Minsk, USSR, to Marina Oswald, c/o Mrs. Ruth Paine, 2515 W. 5th St., Irving, Texas. Letter is dated September 29, 1963 at Minsk.

Sender sends greetings to Marina and family, and wishes she has a son. He then writes of his own examinations and studies.

Sender states he learned it is difficult to a degree to obtain work in the U. S. Sender does not think Oswald's request to return to the Soviet Union will be denied if he appeals to the Embassy. However, Oswald will be reminded he cannot easily change continents (countries). Sender suggests Marina select Minsk if she has a choice.

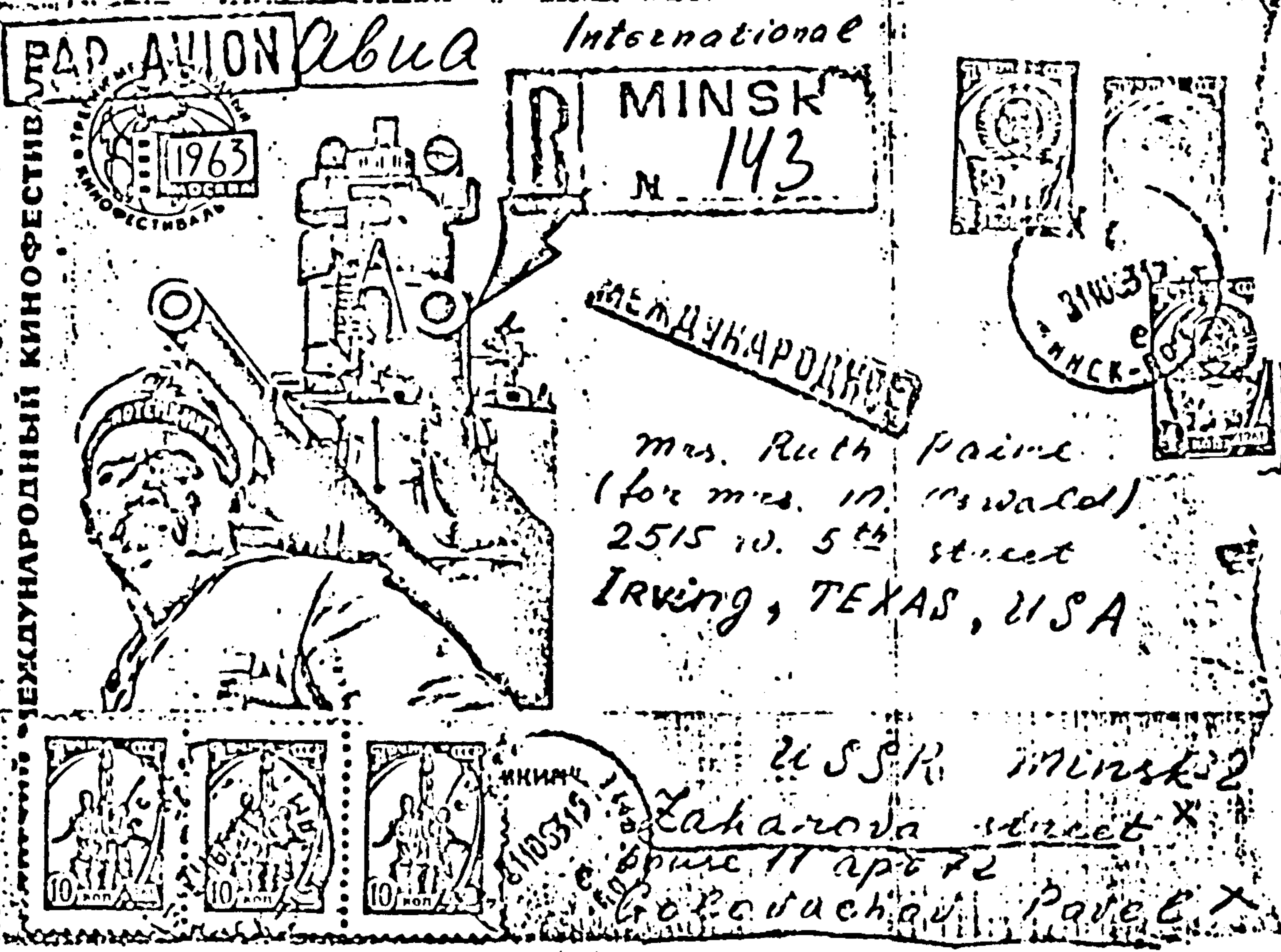
Sender tells Marina not to worry and to encourage Lee. Sender after quoting from Soviet literature a quotation indicating that Lee is not as important as he made out, tells her not to be angry with sender. He tells her to return to the Soviet Union with the family as there is work for everyone. Sender will meet the Oswalds when they arrive in the Soviet Union.

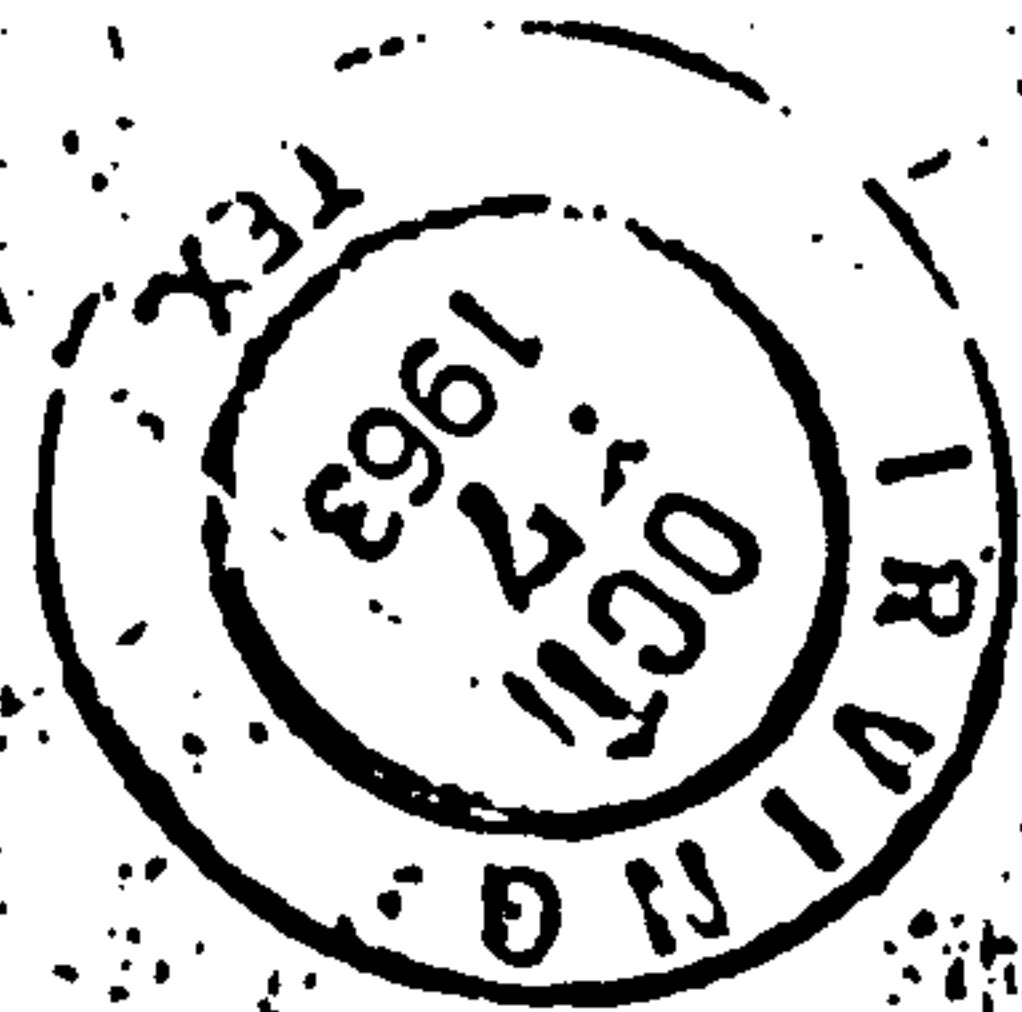

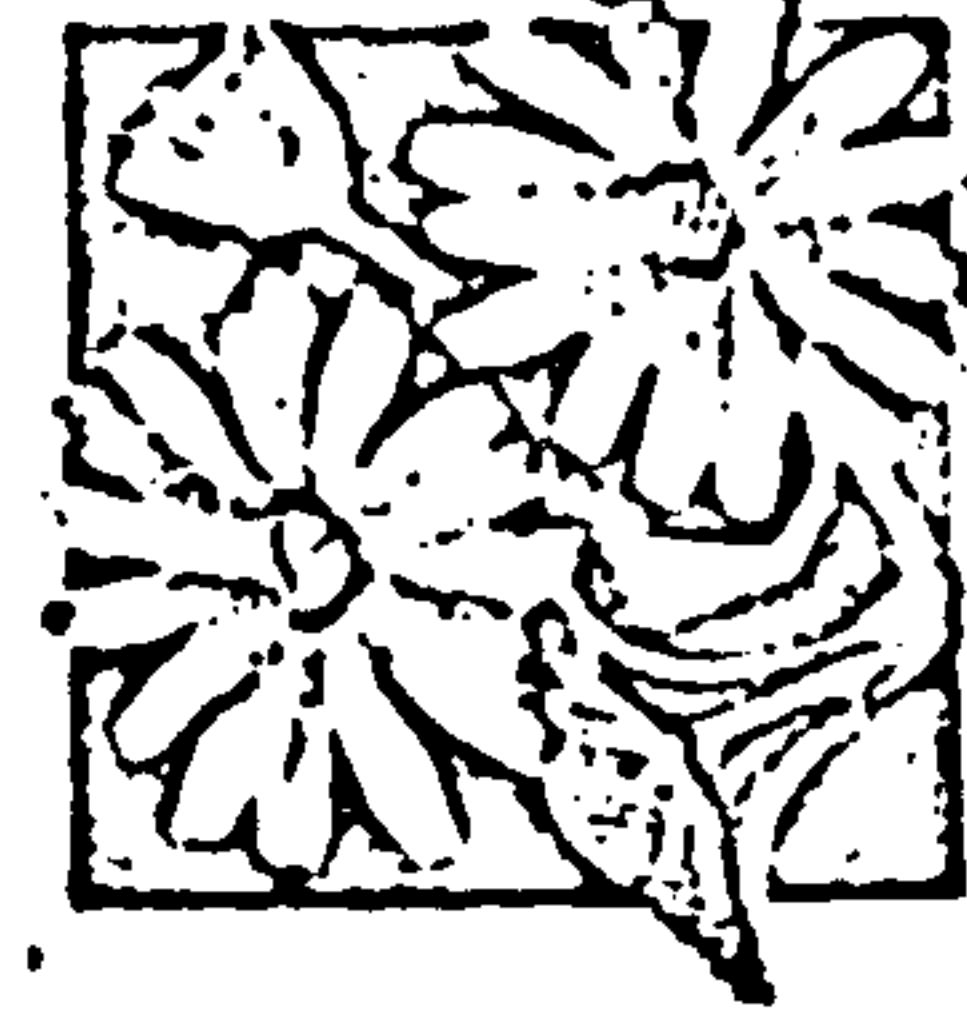
