- Q2** Accompanying one-page typewritten letter beginning "To Madam (Widow), Tippit Dallas, Texas, U.S.A." and ending "For the Gang, Thomas, William Evershire."

**Result of examination:**

The typewriting on Q1 and Q2 was not identified with any of the material in the Anonymous Letter File. Appropriate photographs will be added to this file.

The typewriting on Q1 and Q2 was prepared on a machine equipped with a foreign style of type spaced ten letters per inch. The foreign style of type is known as Ransmeyer and is manufactured in West Germany and the manufacturer is alleged to be the world's largest, exclusive manufacturer of typewriter type. The manufacturer supplies several American typewriter companies in addition to the major European typewriter companies. Some of the machines using this particular style of type are: Woodstock, Antares, Halda, Olivetti, Orga, Remington, R. C. Allen, Smith-Corona.

The physical characteristics of the paper of Q1 and Q2 have been recorded for future reference. No watermarks, indented writings, or other significant features were noted which would indicate the source of the paper used.

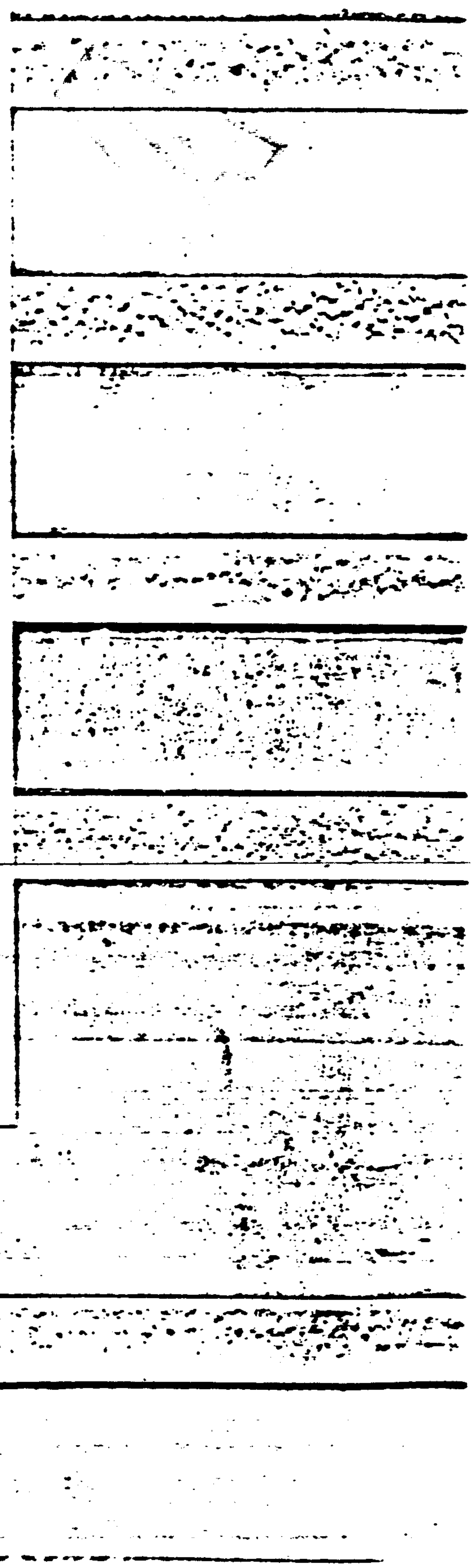

CALLS FROM WELL-MEANING CITIZENS, QUOTE CRACK POTS AND DRUNKS UNQUOTE, PUBLIC OFFICIALS, ETC. MOORE STATES GEORGE CARTER, POLICE REPORTER, QUOTE DALLAS TIMES HERALD UNQUOTE EXHIBITED TO HIM ON JANUARY TWO FOUR LAST AN ADVANCE COPY OF THE MARCH ISSUE OF SAGA WHICH MOORE TERMED QUOTE CRACK POT MAGAZINE UNQUOTE. STATED HE SCANNED ARTICLE HURRIEDLY BUT DID NOT READ IN DETAIL, DID READ QUOTATION ATTRIBUTED TO HIM BY TURNER WHO REPRESENTED HE, TURNER, WAS SITTING BY DESK OF MOORE WHEN A PARTICULAR TELEPHONE CALL WAS RECEIVED.

MOORE STATED HE BELIEVES HE RECALLS THE TELEPHONE CALL TO WHICH TURNER IS APPARENTLY REFERRING, WHICH CALL WAS RECEIVED AT A TIME OF DAY OR NIGHT NOT RECALLED BY MOORE. HE BELIEVED CALL CAME FROM TENNESSEE OR KENTUCKY, RECALLS INDIVIDUAL WAS APPARENTLY DRUNK AND SPECULATED HE MAY WELL HAVE ON COMPLETION OF CALL MADE REMARK THAT THE CALLER STATED THE POLICE HAD THE WRONG MAN AND THAT HE WOULD CALL BACK LATER TO TELL POLICE WHO THE RIGHT MAN WAS, REFERRING TO THE ASSASSIN OF PRESIDENT KENNEDY. HE HAS NO RECOLLECTION OF EVER HAVING SEEN TURNER,

ON BASIS OF PHOTOGRAPH WHICH ACCOMPANIES SAGA ARTICLE BUT STATED THERE WERE SCORES OF NEWSPAPER, RADIO AND TELEVISION REPORTERS, FBI AND SECRET SERVICE AGENTS AND OTHERS, MANY NOT PERSONALLY KNOWN TO HIM, IN AND OUT OF THE AREA WHERE HE WAS WORKING ON NOVEMBER TWENTY-TWO, LAST AND HE CANNOT STATE DEFINITELY HE DID NOT SEE TURNER. MOORE STATED HE DID NOT WORK ON SATURDAY OR SUNDAY, NOVEMBER TWENTY-THREE OR TWENTY-FOUR LAST, AND ACCORDINGLY IF TURNER DID OVERHEAR HIS TELEPHONE CALL AS REFERRED TO ABOVE, IT WOULD HAVE HAD TO HAVE BEEN ON NOVEMBER TWENTY-TWO.

WELCOME EUGENE BARNETT, TRAFFIC OFFICER, DALLAS POLICE

DEPARTMENT, ADVISED WAS ASSIGNED TO SECURITY DETAIL AT TEN AM, NOVEMBER TWENTY-TWO LAST, STATIONED AT HOUSTON AND ELMS STREETS, NEAR TEXAS SCHOOL BOOK DEPOSITORY BUILDING. HIS SPECIFIC INSTRUCTIONS WERE TO OBSERVE CROWDS OF PEOPLE FOR ANY DEMONSTRATORS OR PERSONS WHO MIGHT APPEAR BENT ON MAKING TROUBLE, AND AS MOTOR-CADE APPROACHED HIS POSITION HE WAS TO STOP ALL TRAFFIC MOVING WEST ON ELM STREET, A ONE WAY STREET, UNTIL THE MOTOR-CADE HAD PASSED.

HE STATED WHEN FIRST SHOT WAS FIRED HE WAS BEWILDERED AS TO POINT FROM WHICH SHOT CAME DUE TO THE QUOTE ECHOS UNQUOTE BUT AS FURTHER SHOTS SOUNDED HE CONCEIVED IN OWN MIND SHOTS MUST HAVE COME FROM TOP OF TEXAS SCHOOL BOOK DEPOSITORY BUILDING. ACCORDINGLY, WITHOUT INSTRUCTION FROM ANYONE, HE RACED TO REAR OF THIS BUILDING TO DETERMINE WHETHER THERE WAS A FIRE ESCAPE OR REAR EXIT, HAVING PREVIOUSLY NOTED A FIRE ESCAPE ON THE EAST SIDE OF THE BUILDING. NOTING NO FIRE ESCAPE AT REAR, HE RETURNED TO FRONT OF BUILDING AND WAS SHORTLY ASSIGNED TO PREVENT ENTRANCE OF ANY PERSONS INTO FRONT DOOR OF THIS BUILDING. HE REMAINED AT THIS POST UNTIL THREE PM.

JIM POPPLEWELL, 2825 Donald, telephone BR 8-9926, employed as a jailer, Dallas Police Department, advised he was assigned on November 23, 1963 to watch OSWALD's cell. He explained that OSWALD was being held in isolation and a guard was maintained outside his cell.

POPPLEWELL advised that he took OSWALD to a phone in the jail to make a long distance call to his attorney, authority to make said call having been given by Captain J. W. FRITZ. OSWALD got the telephone operator to obtain the number of the attorney and then stated he would not be able to remember it and asked POPPLEWELL to get him paper and pencil to write the number down on. POPPLEWELL stated he tore off a small piece of paper from the side of a telephone contact slip and after getting an OK, he furnished said piece of paper and pencil to OSWALD in order for him to write the phone number down. Thereafter OSWALD attempted to call the phone number but was unable to get the call through to the attorney.

POPPLEWELL advised that he later took OSWALD to the phone again and OSWALD made two or three other calls or attempts, however it is not known if these calls were completed or who OSWALD might have called, as no record was kept of the numbers called.

POPPLEWELL recalled that on November 23, 1963, OSWALD was wearing a T-shirt, pants, and shoes, and OSWALD asked if there was any kind of jail clothes available that he could put on. POPPLEWELL stated he explained to OSWALD that the City Jail did not furnish any. POPPLEWELL added that as a matter of policy no change of clothes could be made by OSWALD without the authority of Captain J. W. FRITZ.

FRITZ, Homicide and Robbery, Dallas Police Department, was interviewed concerning a certain telephone number found on a piece of paper about 1½ x 2" in the right hand side pocket of the trousers of LEE HARVEY OSWALD, which trousers have been maintained in the Dallas Police Department Crime Laboratory (Parkland Hospital) as evidence in the pending murder case in the name JACK LEON RUBY.

Captain FRITZ stated that OSWALD was completely searched after his arrest November 22, 1963 and was allowed to keep nothing. Subsequently on November 22, 1963, OSWALD wanted to call Attorney JOHN ABT in New York City but did not have his phone number. Captain FRITZ stated he advised OSWALD he could make a collect call from the jail and explained to OSWALD how to give the operator the name of the person he wanted without having the number, and ABT, being a prominent attorney in New York, the operator would locate him and furnish OSWALD with the phone number. FRITZ stated that as a matter of course the operator would want to know the number the call was being made from and the same would be RI 8-9711, which is the Dallas Police Department number and appears on the dial of the phone in the jail.

FRITZ stated on the morning of November 23, 1963, he asked OSWALD if he had made his call and OSWALD advised he had been allowed to make a call but had been unable to contact Attorney ABT.

FRITZ stated it would be within the policy of the jail where a long distance call was made to allow the prisoner pencil and paper to write the number down on.

He acquired citizenship by decree of the court on 4/14/43, at Camp Hale, Colorado, Affidavit of Registration number E-962292, Court Docket number 547967. The record further revealed that ZERK was a textile engineer. The date of his last registry was 4/22/48, as a Democrat.

Records of the Los Angeles Retail Merchants Credit Association, Los Angeles, California, as caused to be checked 1/28/64, by IC GERALD A. BOSWELL, revealed that KARL ZERK had been on file since 9/26/55. His employment was listed as
