

of 12 people in terms of various trips into the Dallas area and we also have an office functioning here in New York City, which is coordinating information which we receive from all over the country and from all over the world and we are desperately in need of these funds. I've not drawn one single penny from this committee. I dare say I've, I'm the major contributor to it from my, what were my meager savings and now are non-existent and I've almost personally, for a period of three months, kept the office going in terms of paying the rent, paying the phone bill, and paying the two staff members, and anyone who want to join with us in this inquiry, who wants to do what Professor Toynbee suggests all Americans should do and that is support an independent citizen's inquiry. I suggest that they make a contribution by sending, I'm glad you raised the question, by sending it to the Citizen's Committee of Inquiry at 156 5th Avenue, in New York City.

Randi

I suggest perhaps a better idea might be to come down to see your lecture at the Gramercy Arts Theater.

Mark Lane

Fine and those funds.

Randi

Let's put it that way because we really shouldn't be asking for donations.

Lane

That's great too. That's, well the "ques". I didn't raise the question of funds. As you know I'm just responding, and to those

who want to come to the lecture they're more than welcome and whatever funds are realized there, if we do break even or make money, those funds will be used in carrying forward this investigation, in sending more people like Florynce Kennedy and others into, the. Florynce Kennedy has agreed to go to the Dallas area. Well responsibility. just to raise airplane fare and, for four weeks that she has been willing to go to check out some most important leads, we've not had the funds to even pay for one round-trip ticket. So, those who want to support us by coming to the lecture. We need, we need all the assistance we can get.

Florynce Kennedy

Before we leave this question, there is somehow a suggestion of a sinister aspect to fund raising and perhaps even a sinister aspect to inquiry. Now we sit before our television sets and we see thousands, evidence of thousands of dollars having been spent to show us how the cleaner gets beneath the surface of the sink to get out the pot marks and we see evidence of people being interested in going to the moon, and we see evidence of people being concerned about when the green pea turns green and when the grass pokes up through the soil. We see evidence of people being concerned about faults in rocks, lava flows, matters of sea, earth, sky. We see all sorts of inquiries into behavior, birth rate, birth control, and all this sort of thing. I don't understand how a person just might not have a curiosity about an unresolved mystery.

Florynce Kennedy

Mystery books are sold by the millions. People read Ian Fleming's books and we haven't concern with any mystery. So that I don't understand how it is that somehow there may be assumed a sinister aspect to being concerned with the unraveling of any mystery on any level, physical, social, psychological, criminal or otherwise.

Randi

Florynce, thank you very much for that comment, but I see Sid is very anxious to make a comment. I'm going to ask you, Sid, if you would just hold off until I get one telegram read, which will clean up this little pile and there's more coming in all the time. Then we're going to take some phone calls. You've been very patient, Sid Siller and Joe Broder both, because, really, most of the commentary has been made by Mark and by Florynce and, I think, to a certain extent justly so. They have a tough job to make their point and that sort of thing and I, as we discussed during the coffee break, as I said to you, I really will give you more chance to get at them a little bit, but we do have some obligations to the folks at home and this telegram, particularly, has been sitting here for a while, waiting. We just haven't had a chance to get in with it. It's addressed to Randi, WOR, New York City. "The New York Times" said General Walker was shot at by a 306 rifle. Kennedy was shot by Carsano (phonetic) it is?

Male

Carsano (phonetic)

Randi

Carsano (phonetic), pardon me. By Carsano. Has 306 turned up? Why didn't

Randi

Oswald use 305 instead of inferior Carcano (phonetic)? Signed by Robert Brooks.

Male

Yeah, well, that's, if I may, that's an interesting point because when Walker was shot at back in April of '63, the Dallas police said that the bullet had been so fragmented they could not do a ballistics test on it in terms of determining the specific rifle but they did know that it was a 30 caliber bullet which is precisely the statement made by the listener, accurately. However, after the President was assassinated, about two months later, for the first time, the Dallas police said now they were able to do a ballistics test on it and first of all, they were wrong back in April when they said it was a 30 caliber. It was actually a 6.5 and their ballistics test showed that it came from Oswald's rifle. So, that was another one of those, of the fast switches which took place.

Randi

Well, we are in a position now where we're going to start to take phone calls in a matter of a few minutes. One more, one more wire. Phil Mc Kelly (phonetic) just came in shaking his head at the wire wondering if he can figure it out. Oh boy...well, I'll read it but it doesn't make very much sense. Forgive me, I'm reading a telegram. I don't want the panel to look at me as if I'm a nut and please don't send me any nutty letters saying why did you read

Randi

that telegram, but here it is. How can I win? It's signed by Flower, whoever Flower is. Thanks a whole load. Please let's all be happy, period. Enough controversy, period. The heck with all nonsense of our crazy world, let us live in foolishness, including the telegram situation, period. Much better sleeping pills. Well, I don't know who we'd recommend take the sleeping pills, but I could make a recommendation. Anyway---

Florynce Kennedy

It's a light note.

Randi

Yeah. It's a light note, I guess. I really can't figure it out, Florynce. Maybe we'll look at it over afterwards and uh, well I don't know figure out, maybe, we can use it for wallpaper. Yeah, well, thank you anyway, Flower, whoever you may be. I am going to give the telephone number now and, in about five minutes from now, I'm going to grab everybody by the throat here and stop them talking from whatever they are talking about. Sid, I'm going to give you five minutes to expound a little bit there and I'm going to ask that no one interrupt Sid for about five minutes, after I give the telephone numbers, so the folks at home can write it down and be prepared to call in in five minutes. The telephone number we're using this morning is Long Acre 4-2292, Long Acre 4-2292. We will begin picking up the phone in about five minutes. Sid, you've got such a mass of papers there. How about five minutes. Give us five minutes of Sid Siller.

Sid Siller

The one thing I want to go to before we lose it is that Mr. Lane mentioned the fact just a few moments ago, that there was a very prominent New York liberal and he didn't mention his name, that pretty well was convinced - pretty well convinced Mr. Lane that Oswald was not guilty. Is that your present position, Mr. Lane?

Mark Lane

Is what, you're asking...

Sid Siller

Is that Oswald is not guilty?

Mark Lane

Well you're a lawyer, you're a lawyer, so, you should know what I mean when I said at the outset of the program that I ...

Sid Siller

No, I'm referring to this specific remark. You-You made a statement.

Mark Lane

You don't want (unintelligible). Look, you can only ask a question. You can't answer it for me. I have the question; if you'd like to give me the opportunity to answer it. I'll be happy to. That is that my position is very simply this, and I've said this at least twice before on the program, that I've seen the evidence in the case. There is not evidence here which would show in any respect that Oswald either assassinated the President, wounded Governor Connally, or killed Officer Tippit. Now in the absence of a case against him, I have to presume that the man is innocent.

Mark Lane

Now you may say to me, do you know that he is innocent, which is really the question. I don't know if you're innocent, sir, because I don't know where you were on November 22nd... (unintelligible)...excuse me; I presume you had ab- I am sure you had absolutely nothing to do with the assassination of the President. I'm sure no one in this room did, but I couldn't swear that that's true about anyone in this room nor about Lee Harvey Oswald because I didn't see anyone, including Mr. Oswald, and no one in this room on November 22nd. All I can say is I look at the evidence. There is no case against Oswald just as there would be no case against anyone in this room and that's enough for me to conclude and you're a lawyer, too, sir, it's enough, it must be enough for you to conclude that there is no case against him that you presume, therefore, he's innocent. If they can develop an overwhelming case against him, then you have to give consideration to the overwhelming case, but I'd like to see it. Where is it?

Sid Siller

All right. Now with respect to this statement that you have made here tonight before us, I would like to ask you whether or not subsequent to a reply to Judge Warren's statement following your public testimony in July, whether or not you said that you did not claim Oswald was entirely out of the assassination picture, but only that he was not the sole assassin.

Mark Lane

Well, I've just given you my positions exactly the same as the one you are raising. I said this, that the evidence proves conclusively, thus I want to make it plain, the evidence proves conclusively that more than one person was involved in the assassination of President Kennedy. That, there

is no question about. Therefore, the government's theory that Oswald is the lone assassin is pure nonsense and it's nonsense which they recognize themselves to be inaccurate in terms of Oswald's. I know that Oswald was not the lone assassin. In terms of whether Oswald was in any way involved, I just said the same thing that you just quoted, that is, I see no evidence that he was in any way involved. If there is an overwhelming case which they don't have contrary to all the evidence they have thus far, but if an overwhelming case should be presented, I'd be happy to examine it and look at it, but I see no evidence against Oswald at all tending to show that he was involved in the assassination.

Sid Siller

But isn't that entirely different than your statement replying that Judge Warren...

Mark Lane

What is my statement?

Sid Siller

With respect to the fact that you do think that Oswald was in the case and involved in "the assass."

Mark Lane

I never said he was in the case and you didn't quote me as saying that. You found that nowhere. I have never said that Oswald was involved in the assassination.

Sid Siller

Well, do you deny that statement having been made by you?

Mark Lane

What Statement?

Sid Siller

Is that your reply?

Mark Lane

What? Quote it again.

Sid Siller

Lane does not claim Oswald was entirely out of the assassination picture, but only that he was not the sole assassin.



Mark Lane

Well, I don't know what language it is best to try and communicate in. All I can do is tell you that is precisely my position. Now, I have no proof that he is innocent, just as I have no proof that you are innocent, but I have proof that more than one person was involved in the assassination. So I would say this about you if they asked me if I knew whether or not you were the assassin. I would say if the theory is that this gentleman did it alone, I know that's not true, 'cause the evidence proves that more than one person was involved. In terms of a case against this gentleman here, I see no evidence whatsoever to indicate that he was involved in the assassination.

Sid Siller

Well, apparently you're missing the point, Mr. Lane and you're weaseling--you are weaseling...

Mark Lane

I resent that use of that word.

Sid Siller

Well, that's what it is, because if you're... if you reply to Judge Warren in a public statement, which is a quote...I have here a photostatic quote--.

Mark Lane

You're not quoting.

Sid Siller

Oh yes, and I'll show it to anyone who wants to look at it.

Mark Lane

Let me see it right now. Where is it, where is it?

Sid Siller

Right here.

Mark Lane

There's no quote marks around that. You know that this is a photostat of the paper, the "National Guardian".

Sid Siller

...which is a paper supporting your, uh stand on this issue.

Mark Lane

It is not supporting my stand. It is not supporting any stand. It is presenting some of the facts as they can do. But it is not a quote in any event. It is really unfair of you to tell this listening audience that you've read a quote when it's a statement by an, not by...uh.

Male

Well, is this a false statement then? You did not make, do you, do you deny that you made this statement?

Mark Lane

If you will just listen. I don't understand, if we're trying in the same language or not. This is the...

Male

We're trying in the very same language...

Mark Lane

Well...

Mark Lane

This is exactly the point I've made from the outset, that the case against Oswald as a lone assassin is a phony because the facts show that more than one person was involved. In terms of proof that Oswald was involved, there is no proof that I've seen at all that indicates that Oswald was involved, but I cannot prove that he is innocent and I can't prove you're innocent. I presume that you had nothing to do with it. I presume Oswald had nothing to do with it and that's exactly the point which the "Guardian" in that one sentence is summing up.

Sid Siller

Now, well... I read it entirely different than you.

Mark Lane

Well, that's your problem. I can't...

Sid Siller

The point here, Mr. Lane, is very simply this: is Oswald guilty or is he not guilty.

Florynce Kennedy

Who can answer that?

Sid Siller

Wait. If there were other conspirators with Mr. Oswald, that's something else. You've investigated the case probably better than the FBI has. You've sent out, you've sent out 12 experts to Dallas.

Florynce Kennedy

They've sent hundreds.

Male

They have 700 there, sir.

Sid Siller

That's all right.

Mark Lane

I think it's true. We did a better job but they had more personnel. (unintelligible).

Sid Siller

One of the things that has arisen in the case other than Oswald.

Male

There's the quotes are marked here on this statement. You had underlined this statement, Sid. It says Lane does not claim Oswald was entirely out of the assassination picture, but only that he was not the sole assassin and there are quote marks around not the sole assassin. (unintelligible)  
That's all right--

Sid Siller

...but that doesn't exculpate Oswald from killing Kennedy.

Mark Lane

Nor does it exculpate you from killing Kennedy because I have no proof that you were not involved.

Sid Siller

Well, don't you understand (unintelligible).

Mark Lane

Now let's get legal evidence, plain ordinary, plain facts : : :

Florynce Kennedy

But are we going to talk about the facts?

Sid Siller

The fact of the matter is that if there were other assassins, there has been no other names brought into the picture.

Florynce Kennedy

That's what we're complaining about... (unintelligible).

Sid Siller

What ideas do you have on the subject?

Mark Lane

I don't, I don't, you see reference was made before to speculation and conjection. What ideas I have. I don't get involved in speculation and conjection. (unintelligible).

Mark Lane

If Oswald didn't do it who did it? I can't give you that answer. All I can tell you is this. We've investigated this case quite thoroughly. It's been rather difficult because the FBI, the Secret Service, and Dallas police have ordered witnesses not to talk with us, but we have been able to turn up a great deal of information indicating that the case against Oswald is not a valid one, not an accurate one, and does not stand up whatsoever.

Sid Siller

That's entirely different than your statement in the "Guardian".

Mark Lane

Well, then I'm afraid that...

Sir Siller

Mark Lane

He's not the sole assassin.

I think you're not the sole, I know you're not the sole assassin, because I know that more than one person was involved...

(unintelligible)

Mark Lane

Yes. Of course. Well, I know that I'm not because I know what I was doing the 22nd, but in terms of anyone other than myself or someone that I saw, then I know that no one could be the sole assassin because the evidence shows that more than one was involved. But turns of the case against Oswald, there's no proof that he was at all involved in the assassination. Now I don't know how to make it any plainer. I just don't know. I think that everyone who is listening in the audience understands this position quite clearly. I'm sorry that you don't seem to grasp it.

(Commercial)

Randi

Gentlemen, I think, and Florynce, pardon me, that it is time first of all to tell the folks who we have here this morning, in case they tuned in late, and immediately after that, I'm going to take phone calls. Now, Joe Broder is with us. He's a Connecticut attorney who's joined us for the program this morning. Joe, I have promised the folks at home that they can send us telephone messages and we will answer those messages for a short period of time. Then, I'm going to turn the microphone over to you and let you present a few facts that you have sketched out for us. Florynce Kennedy is with us. She's the lady barrister of New York City, who's Chairman of the Women's Division of

the Federal Bar Association, Sid Giller, barrister of New York City, who's been kind enough to join us for these 5½ hours, and Mark Lane, Chairman of the Citizen's Committee of Inquiry. We are now going to take the phone calls and the number again in case you didn't get it the first time is Long Acre 4-2292, and that light has been lit for quite some time now. Someone's very patiently waiting on the other end so I'll take this call and we'll see who that may be. Hello, this is Randi speaking. (Pause) No, we don't need your name, ma'am. (Pause) What's your question. Yes. (Pause) What's your question. Yes. (Pause) Yes. (Pause) What's your question. Yes. (Pause). Lady says she didn't see it on television. Yes. (Pause) Yes. (Pause) Right. Now, what's your question that you want to know about now? (Pause) I tell you we have to get a question from you ma'am because the other folks on the other end can't hear your conversation and it's going to be pretty dull for them if we don't get a question from you. Did you have a question you wanted to ask one of the panel. Yes. (Pause) Yes. (Pause) I see. All right, suppose I give him that question then. Right. Thank you very much. Lady had a lot of comments. She was going to tell me half the story of her life before we finally got the question out of her. I think I can almost answer the lady's question. She wanted to know, first of all, I'll let you answer it, but I think I pretty well have the answer and perhaps a lot of our listeners do. If you determine to your satisfaction that Oswald is not the murderer are you interested in finding out who is?

Mark Lane

Randi

This is to me?

Well, would you like to answer that?

Mark Lane

Yes. I'm deeply interested in finding out who is the man or group of men who assassinated President Kennedy, but I do think that task is far beyond my capabilities particularly with our little Citizens Committee. It requires an investigation obviously by police authorities with all the capabilities that they have and, hopefully, as soon as it is determined publicly that Oswald could not have been the lone assassin these agencies will begin to seriously investigate the case and find out the answer to who was involved.

Randi

Right. I have an idea you know. That was a good brief answer and I think in order to get as many phone calls in as we can, let's keep, the questions will be directed, I'm sure, to Mr. Lane, pretty well, so let's keep the answers if we can, Mark, I know it's difficult in some cases because it involves more than a minute's worth of discussion in order to make yourself clear, but let's try to keep the answers down to a minute and I'll ask the folks when they call in to keep their questions down as briefly as possible. While you were answering that question, a young gentleman called in and he wanted me to ask you this question. Due to suppression of evidence that you claim has been practiced in this case, do you think it possible, and this may be rather unfair to make you make a statement like this, but it has been called in, do you think it is possible that perhaps President Kennedy was, the murder of President Kennedy was accomplished from, he said, inside the White House and I don't know exactly what he means from that, but would you like to comment on that?

Mark Lane



I don't have any theories or conjecture at all in terms of who actually assassinated the President and so I'd rather stay entirely out of the area of guessing as to what took place. I think our job is to get as much factual information as we can and to report it back as accurately as we can and stay entirely out of the area of speculation.

Florynce Kennedy

I would like to say, however, that although if necessary to stay out of conjecture for the average person, I think that in the interest of considering the likelihood, it is necessary for any thinking person to recognize that even in fiction the person who commits an assassin, assassination rather, is generally someone who will benefit unless, as Randi suggested earlier on, it is a person who is just a sort of headline grabber or a scene stealer. So, it is necessary to consider motivation when you talk about solving a mystery case and when you think of the possibility there are any number of areas in which a person would be motivated to kill the President and I think these things must be considered.

Randi

Well, a gentleman called in, a lady, pardon me, called in and said that you gave a lecture at Town Hall, apparently previously, did you?

Mark Lane

There were a number of speakers. I was one of them.

Randi

I see. This is before the Ruby trial?

Mark Lane

Before the Ruby trial.

Randi

Yes. She said that she had listened to that talk that you gave at Town Hall and she said that you had commented there was some evidence concerning Tippit that you felt that you could not discuss until after the Ruby trial. Do you recall that?

Mark Lane

Yes.



Randi

Would you like to discuss that? She would like to know what that evidence was.

Mark Lane

There was a meeting, I have information from a person who was at the next table and witnessed the meeting, which took place in Dallas in the Carousel Night Club, the night club owned and operated by Jack Ruby at the time. Present at this meeting were three persons. One was Officer Tippit. The second was Bernard. Officer Tippit, of course, is the man who was shot to death the same day the President was assassinated. The second person was Bernard Weissman (phonetic), the person who placed the full page ad in the "Dallas Morning News" on the day of the assassination. The ad was enclosed in a black mourning border and in essence called Kennedy a Communist, pro-Communist, and the third person, whose name I cannot at this point reveal. Now I think it is only fair to say that Mr. Weissman, who did go to Dallas to place the ad and become active in the extreme right wing there, he said this. He's told me this, he told me that he received \$1,500 for that rather sharp attack on President Kennedy in the advertisement and told me the funds came from the extreme right wing in Dallas. He also says that he was not present at the meeting. Mr. Weissman denies being present, but we have a statement from a gentleman who says that it was Weissman, Tippit, and a third person. I've given the name of the third person to the Warren Commission . . . (unintelligible)

Male

Well, previously there had been some evidence submitted to show that the Governor and the President were both shot in the back . . . (unintelligible)

Male

. . . person thinking of the Commission and that the Federal Bureau of Investigation . . . (unintelligible)

Subsequently, an agent of the NYO attempted to contact SCHREIBER at the above address, which is a hotel, but SCHREIBER had moved without leaving a forwarding address.

On 9/10/64, M. KAIN, Manager, Hotel Milburn, 243 West 76th Street, New York City, advised SA JOHN JAMES O'FLAHERTY that hotel records reflect that CARL SCHREIBER registered at the hotel on 8/21/64, and presently occupies room 117. A previous address for SCHREIBER was indicated as Box 800, Los Alamos, N.M. KAIN stated he does not know SCHREIBER personally and could only advise that SCHREIBER is about 48 years of age. He was unable to furnish any additional descriptive data or employment concerning SCHREIBER.

In an effort to determine if CARL SCHREIBER referred to in New York file 105-0-10581 may possibly be identical with CARL SCHREIBER referred to in retel, the following inquiry was conducted:

On 9/10/64, SIMON GWERN, Manager, Hotel Dexter House, 345 West 86th Street, New York City, advised SA JOHN JAMES O'FLAHERTY that CARL SCHREIBER, white, male, 45-50 years of age, approximately 5'10", stocky build, although not presently at the Hotel Dexter, has in the past, periodically resided there on numerous occasions. GWERN stated that a 1961 registration card reflected a previous address as Box 206, Alamogordo, N.M.

GWERN remarked that he personally knows SCHREIBER and stated that SCHREIBER is a World War II disabled veteran who receives disability checks from the Government. He stated that SCHREIBER was a captain and pilot in the United States Air Force and as a result of a head injury received in combat, he has a metal plate in his head. GWERN advised that whenever SCHREIBER's head injury causes pain, SCHREIBER begins to excess and quite often, while in an intoxicated condition, has a propensity of making numerous phone calls. On a few occasions, while in this condition, SCHREIBER placed long distance telephone calls to his brother, whose name is unknown, who resides in New Mexico and reportedly occupies some political position in that area. GWERN remarked that on one occasion, while apparently intoxicated, SCHREIBER placed a call through the hotel switchboard to New York

Governor ROCKEFELLER.

CWERN added that SCHREIBER is an attorney and reportedly was a candidate, on one occasion, for the office of District Attorney somewhere in the New Mexico area. He further stated that on one occasion SCHREIBER displayed to him a letter which SCHREIBER stated was a letter indicating that consideration was being given to appointing SCHREIBER as Commissioner of the New York State Thruway. CWERN was of the opinion that due to SCHREIBER's disability he never received the appointment.

In view of the above, it would appear that the CARL SCHREIBER referred to by CWERN is probably identical with the CARL SCHREIBER who contacted the New York Office on 3/1/63, from the Hotel Dexter House and also identical with the CARL SCHREIBER referred to in retel.

JARNIGAN, PRESENTLY TEACHING LAW AT UNIVERSITY OF CALIFORNIA, BERKELEY, CALIFORNIA, ADVISED THAT HE IS WAITING A BOOK BY JACK BRY. JARNIGAN WAS RECENTLY IN DALLAS INTERVIEWING VARIOUS WITNESSES.

APPROXIMATELY TWO WEEKS AGO HE WAS REFERRED TO AN ATTORNEY NAMED PAREN FNU JARNIGAN END PAREN, PHONETIC, WHO INFORMED HIM THAT HE, JARNIGAN, HAD PERSONALLY OBSERVED OSWALD AND RUBY PLOTTING TO KILL THE PRESIDENT, GOVERNOR CONNELLY, AND BOBBY KENNEDY. JARNIGAN CLAIMS HE REPORTED THIS TO THE DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC SAFETY, STATE OF TEXAS THREE WEEKS PRIOR TO THE ASSASSINATION.

KAPLAN TALKED TO DISTRICT ATTORNEY HENRY WADE AND WADE TOLD HIM JARNIGAN TOLD WADE THE SAME STORY. JARNIGAN ALSO TOLD KAPLAN THAT HE HAD BEEN INTERVIEWED BY THE FBI.

KAPLAN STATED THAT HE DOES NOT BELIEVE JARNIGAN, BUT CANNOT UNDERSTANT WHY JARNIGAN NOT CALLED AS WITNESS, AND FEELS WE SHOULD KNOW THAT JARNIGAN IS STILL SPREADING THE ABOVE STORY.

Reference is made to Bureau airtel to Dallas 10/14/64 requesting that Dallas revise the report of SA ROBERT P. GEMBERLING dated 10/8/64 deleting those portions therein which had previously been furnished via letterhead memoranda.

On 10/16/64, Supervisor RICHARD D. ROGGE was telephonically contacted. It was pointed out to Mr. ROGGE that the reason information previously submitted by letterhead memoranda had been included in the report was for the purpose of having in one place as much information concerning a particular phase or aspect of the case as possible. It was pointed out that this was invaluable in researching the files for data in connection with inquiries or requests made. It was further pointed out that previous reports had contained information which had been submitted via letterhead memoranda and that the reason for including such information in a report in the OSWALD case, which had been in letterhead memoranda, was to a great extent due to the fact that the letterhead memoranda had been submitted under the Assassination caption.

It was also pointed out that all of the index cards made from this report had been filed and would necessarily have to be removed in the event the report was revised.

Later on 10/16/64, Supervisor ROGGE advised that it would be permissible to resubmit the report in its present form but that all future reports should contain no information which had been previously submitted via letterhead memoranda and that Dallas should insure that the contents of the report of 10/8/64, where it contained information previously submitted in letterhead memoranda, contained no errors whatsoever.

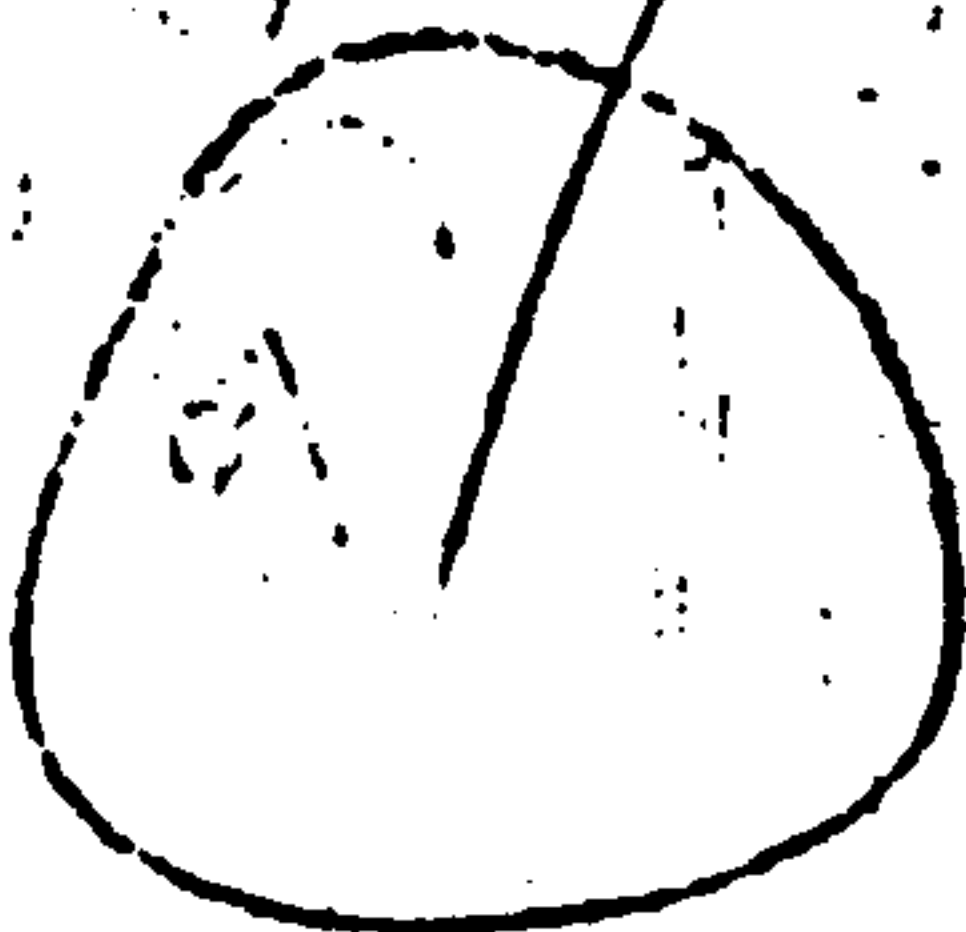

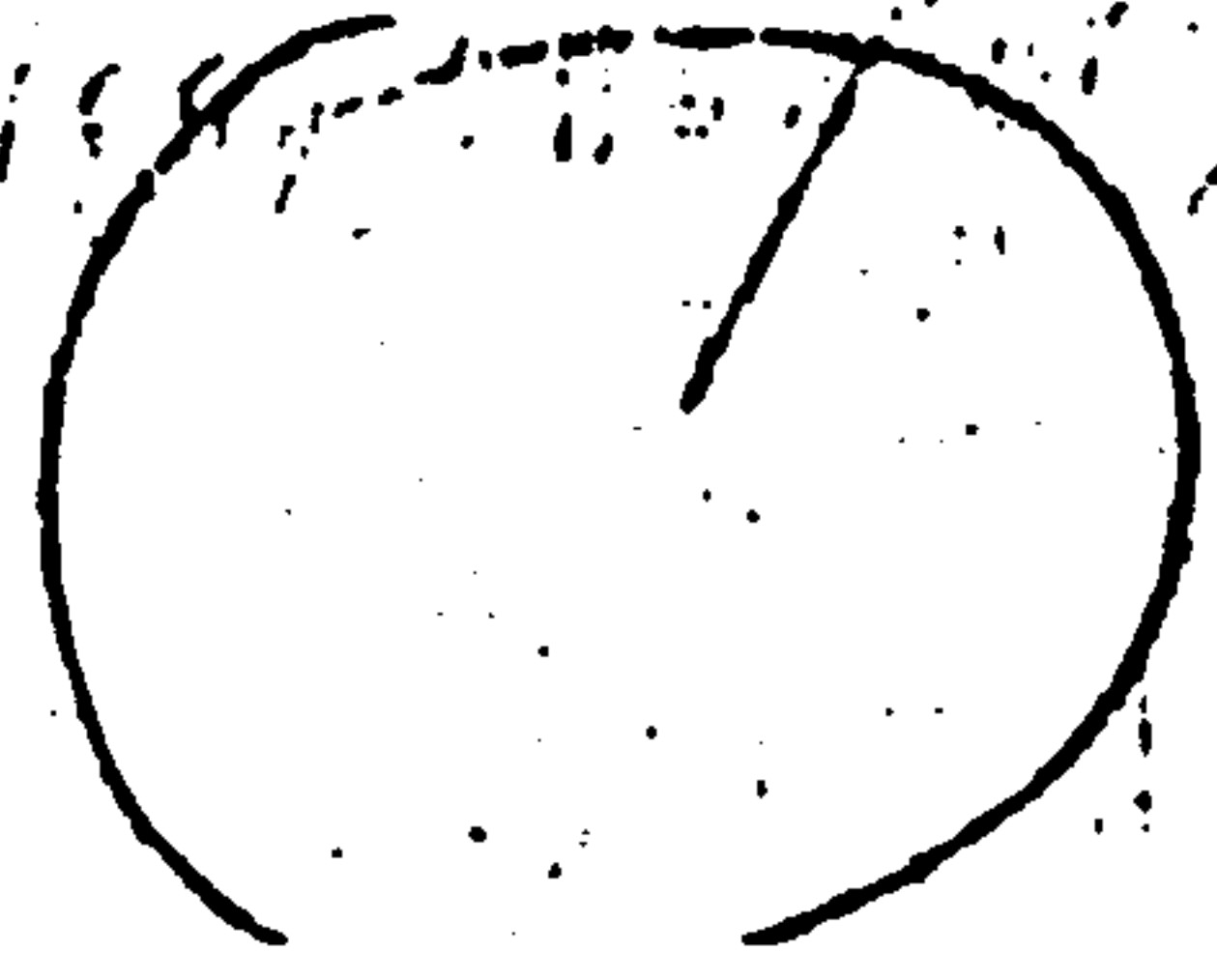
