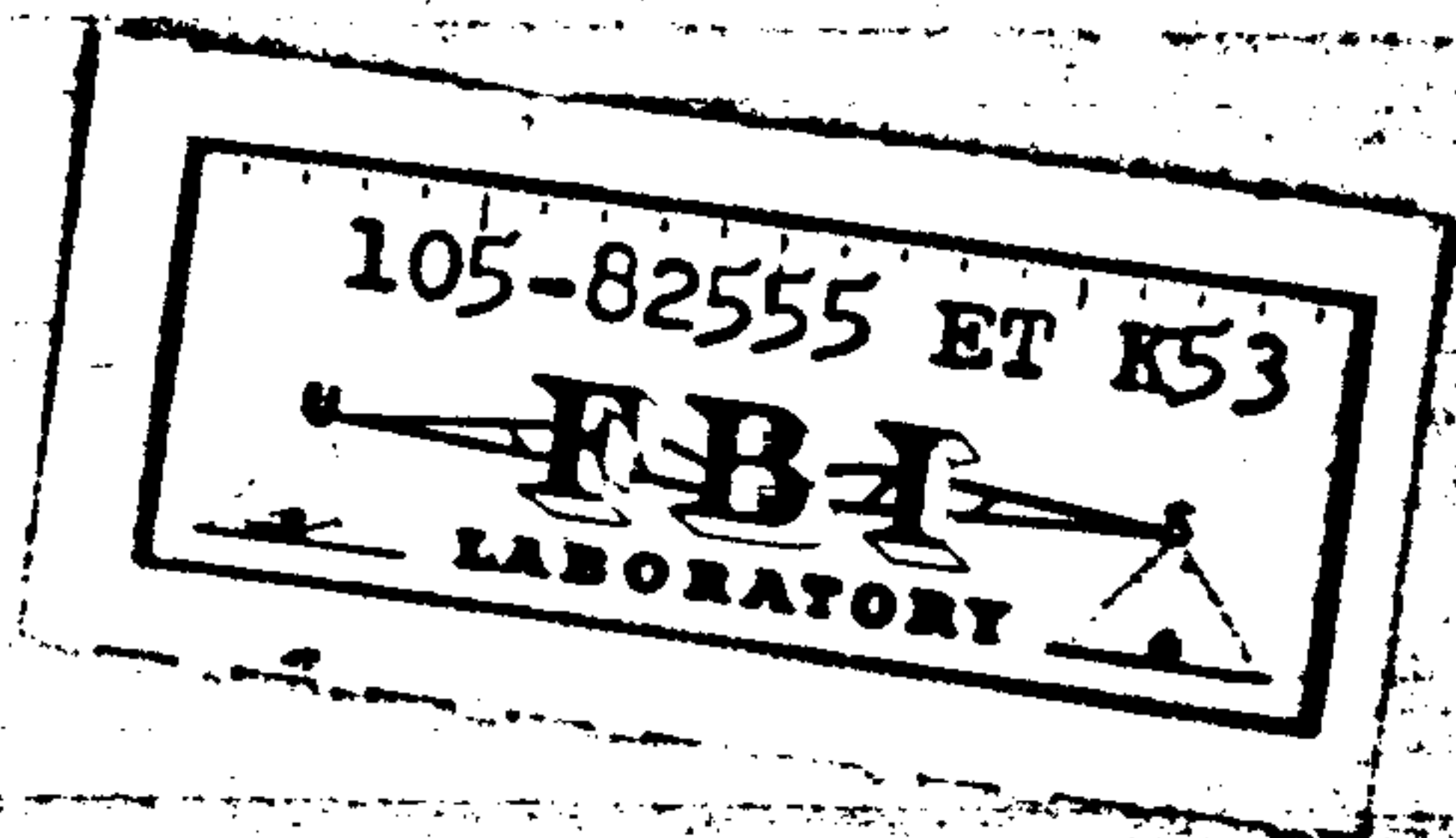

Police cars were passing me coming down toward the triple underpass and I walked up among many other people and this building was surrounded by police officers with guns and we were all watching them. I moved on up to the building across the street from the building that was surrounded and I ask one of the girls if there was a telephone that I could use and she said "Yes, there is one on the third floor of the building where I work". I walked through a passage to the elevator they were all getting on (freight elevator) and I got off on the third floor with all the other people and there was a lady using the pay telephone and I ask her if I could use it when she hung up and she said it was out of order and I tried to use it but with no success. I ask her how I can get out of this building and she said that there is an exit right there and then she said wait a minute here is the elevator now. I got on the elevator and returned to the ground floor and the colored man who ran the elevator said you are a stranger in this building and I was not suppose to let you up and he ran outside to an officer and said to the officer that he had just taken me up and down in the elevator and the officer said for me to identify myself and I presented him with a credit card and he said well we have to check out everything and took me to his superior and said for me to wait and we will check it out. I was then taken to the Sheriff's office and interrogated.

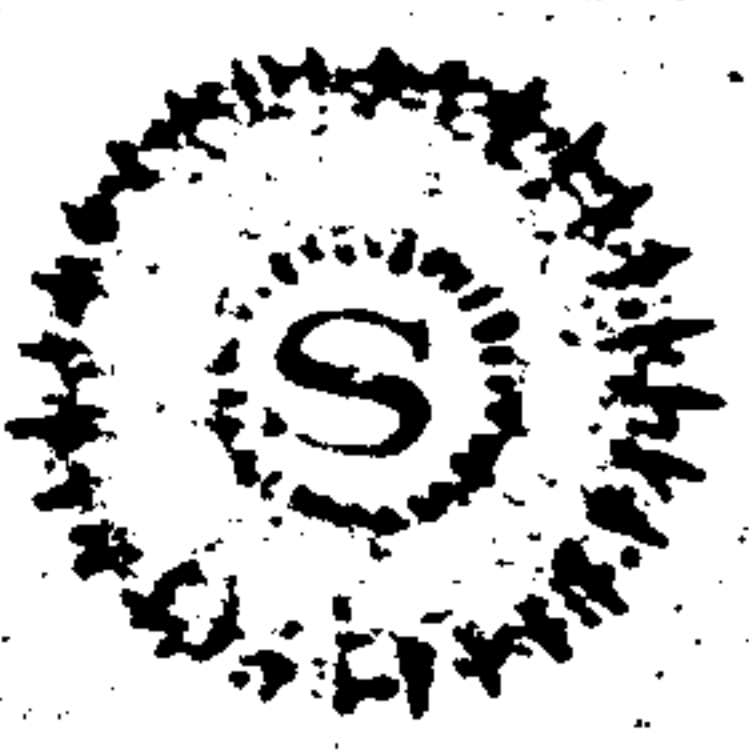

BEFORE ME, the undersigned, a Notary Public in and for said County, State of Texas, on this day personally appeared John W. Fain, to me well known, and who, after being by me duly sworn, deposes and states as follows:

I am a retired Special Agent of the Federal Bureau of Investigation and reside at 12711 Pebblebrook, Houston, Texas.

I was formerly employed as a Special Agent of the Federal Bureau of Investigation from September 8, 1942, to October 29, 1962.

During the year 1962, I was assigned to the Dallas Division of the Federal Bureau of Investigation, and in connection with my work as a Special Agent I had occasion to interview Lee Harvey Oswald. This first interview occurred at Fort Worth, Texas, on or about June 26, 1962, and I was assisted in this interview by Special Agent B. Tom Carter.

Upon a second occasion I interviewed Lee Harvey Oswald on or about August 16, 1962, at Fort Worth, Texas, and upon this occasion was assisted by Special Agent Arnold J. Brown.

At no time during or in connection with the above interviews did I or either of the above named agents make any payment of any kind to Oswald for any information he furnished us or which he might furnish in the future. No effort was at any time made to recruit Lee Harvey Oswald's services in any capacity on behalf of the Federal Bureau of Investigation or any other Government agency. Furthermore, no suggestion, either express or implied, was ever made that Oswald might act as an informant or employee in any capacity for the Federal Bureau of Investigation or for any Government agency.

During these interviews, Lee Harvey Oswald exhibited an arrogant and hostile attitude, and in view of his uncooperative attitude I never felt that he could be trusted to furnish any reliable information.

THE REPORTING OFFICER HAS NURSE FEDELE GO INTO ROOM # 30 AND ASK IF MR. FRAZIER WAS THERE AND IF SO THERE WAS A TELEPHONE CALL OUT AT THE DESK.

11/22/63 - 5:35 PM CAPT. MCCARLEY AND THE REPORTING OFFICER BROUGHT FRAZIER TO THE IRVING POLICE DEPT. WHERE WE CONTACTED DET. ROSE AND ADVISED HIM THAT WE HAD FRAZIER IN CUSTODY.

DET. ROSE AND DET. R.S. STOVALL CAME TO THE IRVING POLICE DEPT. AND INTERVIEWED FRAZIER BRIEFLY AND THEN BOTH DETECTIVES AND THE REPORTING OFFICER WENT TO FRAZIER'S CAR WHICH WAS STILL PARKED AT THE PROFESSIONAL CENTER. NOTHING WAS FOUND IN THE VEHICLE.

DETS. ROSE AND STOVALL AND THE REPORTING OFFICER THEN WENT TO FRAZIER'S HOME. FRAZIER PRODUCED A 303 CAL. BRITISH ENFIELD RIFLE FROM THE CLOSET IN THE LIVING ROOM AND TURNED THE RIFLE OVER TO DET. ROSE ALONG WITH THE CLIP FOR THE RIFLE.

11/23/63 2:45 PM DALLAS HOMICIDE DETECTIVES ROSE AND STOVALL CONTACTED THE REPORTING OFFICER AT THE IRVING POLICE DEPT. AND REQUESTED THAT I ACCOMPANY THEM TO THE PAIN RESIDENCE AT 2515 W. 5TH ST. IN IRVING TO EXECUTE A SEARCH WARRANT IN AN ATTEMPT TO FIND ANY ADDITIONAL EVIDENCE CONNECTED WITH THE INVESTIGATION OF LEE HARVEY OSWALD.

ON ARRIVAL AT 2515 W. 5TH ST., WE TALKED WITH MR. AND MRS. PAIN, SHOWED THE SEARCH WARRANT. MR. AND MRS. PAIN BOTH LEFT THE HOUSE WHILE WE WERE THERE.

3:20 PM WHILE SEARCHING THROUGH A 24" X 12" X 12" CARD BOARD BOX ON THE FLOOR OF THE GARAGE, (EAST SIDE NEAR FRONT DOOR) THE REPORTING OFFICER FOUND A DULL BLACK SLEALED ENVELOPE.

THE REPORTING OFFICER CALLED DET. ROSE'S ATTENTION TO THE ENVELOPE AND THEN DET. ROSE OPENED THE ENVELOPE.

THE ENVELOPE CONTAINED SEVERAL PHOTOGRAPHS. ONE OF THE PHOTOGRAPHS WAS A PICTURE OF LEE HARVEY OSWALD STANDING WITH A RIFLE HELD IN HIS HANDS. THE HANDLE OF A PISTOL WAS VISIBLE AT OSWALD'S RIGHT HIP. ALSO VISIBLE IN THE PICTURE WAS WHAT APPEARED TO BE STAIRS STEPPS ON OSWALD'S RIGHT. THE RIFLE IN THE PICTURE APPEARED TO BE EQUIPED WITH A TELESCOPIC SIGHT. IN SEARCHING THE BOX, THE REPORTING OFFICER ALSO FOUND A SMALL BLUE DRAW STRING BAG WHICH CONTAINED A "SHARP SHOOTER'S MEDAL". NUMEROUS BOOKS, WERE FOUND IN THE SUSPECT'S PROPERTY IN THE GARAGE. THE BOOKS WERE WRITTEN IN RUSSIAN. 18" OR 20" PEKE WHITE COTTON SAW CORP. PENCIL STUB TIE TO ONE END WAS LOCATED BY REPORTING OFFICER. DET. ROSE AND STOVALL PUT THE PICTURES, BOOKS, MEDALS AND VARIOUS OTHER ARTICLES IN A BLUE SUIT CASE AND TOOK IT TO DALLAS.

11/23/63 5:30 PM THE REPORTING OFFICER RETURNED TO 2515 W. 5TH ST. WITH THE DALLAS OFFICERS, AT WHICH TIME MICHAEL PAIN RETURNED TO DALLAS WITH THE OFFICERS:

WHILE RIDING WITH PAIN IN THE POLICE CAR, PAIN STATED THAT HE HAD ATTENDED JOHN BIRCHE SOCIETY MEETINGS AND THAT HE FELT SIMPATHY FOR SOME OF OSWALD'S POLITICAL VIEWS.

11/24/63 11:15 AM THE REPORTING OFFICER HEARD ON TELEVISION THAT LEE HARVEY OSWALD HAD BEEN SHOT.

CONTACTED DET. PROFFER AND HE ADVISED THAT HE HAD JUST HEARD OF THE INCIDENT. WE AGREED THAT WE SHOULD BOTH GET IN SERVICE IMMEDIATELY.

11/24/63 11:40 AM THE REPORTING OFFICER AND DET. PROFFER HEARD THE IRVING POLICE DISPATCHER DIRECT PATROL UNITS TO 2515 W. 5TH ST., IRVING, TEXAS.

THE REPORTING OFFICER AND DET. PROFFER WENT TO 2515 W 5TH ST. AND MET WITH PATROL SGT. JAMES JOHNSON.

AT THIS TIME, THE PAIN RESIDENCE AT 2515 W. 5TH ST. WAS GETTING A GREAT DEAL OF ATTENTION FROM MOTORIST WHO WERE PASSING BACK AND FORTH IN FRONT OF THE RESIDENCE.

IT WAS DECIDED TO STATION A SQUAD CAR AT THE INTERSECTIONS OF 5TH ST. AND WESTBROOK DR. AND 5TH ST. AND LILAC LN. ALL TRAFFIC WITH THE EXCEPTION OF THOSE PEOPLE WHO LIVED IN THE CLOSED AREA WAS DIVERTED.

WHILE STATIONED AT 5TH ST. AND WESTBROOK DR., RESERVE SGT. PHILLIP STOPPED A RED 1963 CHEV. IMPALA. THE VEHICLE WAS BEING DRIVE BY AN EARL DEWAYNE MILES 2502 HELMET ST. IRVING, TEXAS. SGT. PHILLIPS CONFISCATED A 30 CAL. BOLT ACTION RIFLE, EQUIPED WITH A 4 X 32 MONOSCOPE TELESCOPIC SIGHT MOUNTED. EARL DEWAYNE MILES WAS RELEASED AT THAT TIME AND TOLD THAT HE COULD PICK THE GUN UP LATER AT THE IRVING POLICE STATION. DET. PROFFER WAS CALLED TO THE INTERSECTION WHILE MILES WAS STILL AT THE LOCATION. IT WAS THEN THAT DET. PROFFER CONFISCATED THE RIFLE, GIVING IT TO SGT. JOHN SON FOR SAFE KEEPING.

AT THIS POINT, THE REPORTING OFFICER WENT TO THE PAIN RESIDENCE AT 2515 W. 5TH ST. AND ADVISED MRS. PAIN, THAT WITH HER PERMISSION, WE WOULD LIKE TO STATION TWO OFFICERS IN HER HOME. MRS. PAIN READILY AGREED TO THIS.

OFFICERS JOHN RICHARDS AND RESERVE OFFICER CLYDE DORMAN WERE STATION IN THE HOUSE WITH MRS. PAIN. MR. DON JANSON, REPORTER FOR THE NEW YORK TIMES AND HIS FEMALE COMPANION WERE AT THAT TIME VISITING WITH MRS. PAIN.

11/24/63 AT APPROXIMATELY 12:15 PM THE POLICE DISPATCHER ADVISED THAT A SECRET SERVICE UNIT WAS ENROUTE WITH MRS. OSWALD AND HER MOTHER-IN-LAW TO 2515 W. 5TH ST.

THE REPORTING OFFICER CONTACTED CHIEF WIRASNIK AND ADVISED HIM OF THE SITUATION ON 5TH ST. AND HE DIRECTED ME TO HAVE THE SECRET SERVICE UNIT DIVERTED TO HIS HOME SO THAT HE COULD TALK WITH THEM.

PATROLMAN FRED VAUGHN INTERCEPTED THE SECRET SERVICE UNIT AND TOOK THE VEHICLE DIRECTLY TO THE CHIEF'S HOME.

A SHORT TIME LATER, OFFICER RICHARDS CAME OUT OF THE PAIN RESIDENCE AND ADVISED THAT THE CHIEF HAD CALLED AND REQUESTED THAT CLOTHING FOR THE OSWALD CHILDREN AND OTHER PERSONAL EFFECTS BE BROUGHT TO HIS RESIDENCE.

*7-11-63*  
THE REPORTING OFFICER AND DETECTIVE PROFFER TOOK A SMALL BROWN SUIT CASE AND A PLASTIC CLOTHES HAMPER FULL OF CLOTHING FROM 2515 W. 5TH ST. TO CHIEF WIRASNIK'S RESIDENCE.

AT THIS POINT, CHIEF WIRASNIK ORDERED THE AREA AROUND 2515 W. 5TH ST. CLEARED OF POLICE OFFICERS.

ON ARRIVAL AT THE CHIEF'S RESIDENCE, THE TWO SECRET SERVICE AGENTS WHO HAD BROUGHT MRS. LEE HARVEY OSWALD, HER TWO CHILDREN AND OSWALD'S MOTHER TO IRVING, ADVISED THAT THE OSWALDS INSISTED ON GOING TO PARKLAND HOSPITAL TO SEE THE BODY OF LEE HARVEY OSWALD.

THE TWO SECRET SERVICE AGENTS, CHARLES KUNKLE AND MICHAEL HOWARD REQUESTED OF THE CHIEF THAT DETS. PROFFER AND THE REPORTING OFFICER ESCORT THEM TO PARKLAND HOSPITAL AND ASSIST THEM IN GETTING IN THE HOSPITAL.

WHILE ENROUTE TO PARKLAND HOSPITAL, THE S.S. AGENTS AND THE OSWALD FAMILY IN THEIR CAR AND THE REPORTING OFFICER AND DET. PROFFER IN OUR VEHICLE, THE S.S. UNIT, # 432, RECEIVED INSTRUCTION FROM THEIR COMMANDER TO TAKE THE FAMILY ANYWHERE THAT THEY MIGHT WANT TO GO.

WE ARRIVED AT PARKLAND HOSPITAL AND FOUND THAT THE DALLAS POLICE HAD CLOSED OFF ALL OF THE REAR HOSPITAL AREA TO ANY BUT POLICE AND NEWS REPORTERS.

ON GOING INTO THE HOSPITAL, DET. PROFFER AND THE REPORTING OFFICER STAYED WITH THE S.S. AGENTS, GOING TO THE HOSPITAL WITH THEM AND THE FAMILY.

DR. ROSE, DALLAS COUNTY MEDICAL EXAMINER MET WITH THE OSWALDS, AND THROUGH PETER GREGORY, ENGLISH SPEAKING RUSSIAN INTERPRETER, EXPLAINED THAT THEY COULD VIEW THE BODY FOR A SHORT WHILE AND THEN THEY WOULD HAVE TO MAKE ARRANGEMENTS FOR THE BURIAL.

THE REPORTING OFFICER, DET. PROFFER, A DALLAS POLICE OFFICER, S.S. AGENTS KUNKLE AND HOWARD, DR. ROSE, MRS. OSWALD, OSWALDS MOTHER AND THE INTERPRETER WENT TO A ROOM AND WAS ADMITTED, WHERE WE ALL VIEWED THE BODY OF LEE HARVEY OSWALD.

AFTER MRS. OSWALD, (MOTHER OF BEE HARVEY OSWALD) HAD LOOKED AT THE BODY OF HER SON, SHE TURNED TO ALL OF US WHO WERE IN THE ROOM AND SAID, "AS THE MOTHER OF THIS BOY, I WOULD LIKE TO MAKE A STATEMENT. I THINK THAT NOW THE TRUTH SHOULD BE KNOWN. BEFORE MRS. OSWALD WAS ABLE TO CONTINUE, THE FAMILY WAS ESCORTED FROM THE ROOM, TAKEN OUT THE EMERGENCY EXIT OF THE HOSPITAL AND BACK IN A DOOR TO THE HOSPITAL BEHIND THE DALLAS COUNTY CRIME LAB.

ON ARRIVING AT THE LOCATION WHERE THE OSWALD FAMILY WAS TO STAY, WE WERE MET BY TARRANT COUNTY FIRE MARSHALL MASON LANGFORD, TARRANT COUNTY SHERIFF LON EVANS AND ARLINGTON DETECTIVE BOB PARSONS.

11/24/63 5:15 PM WAS THE LAST TIME THAT THE REPORTING OFFICER HAD CONTACT WITH ANY MEMBER OF THE OSWALD FAMILY.

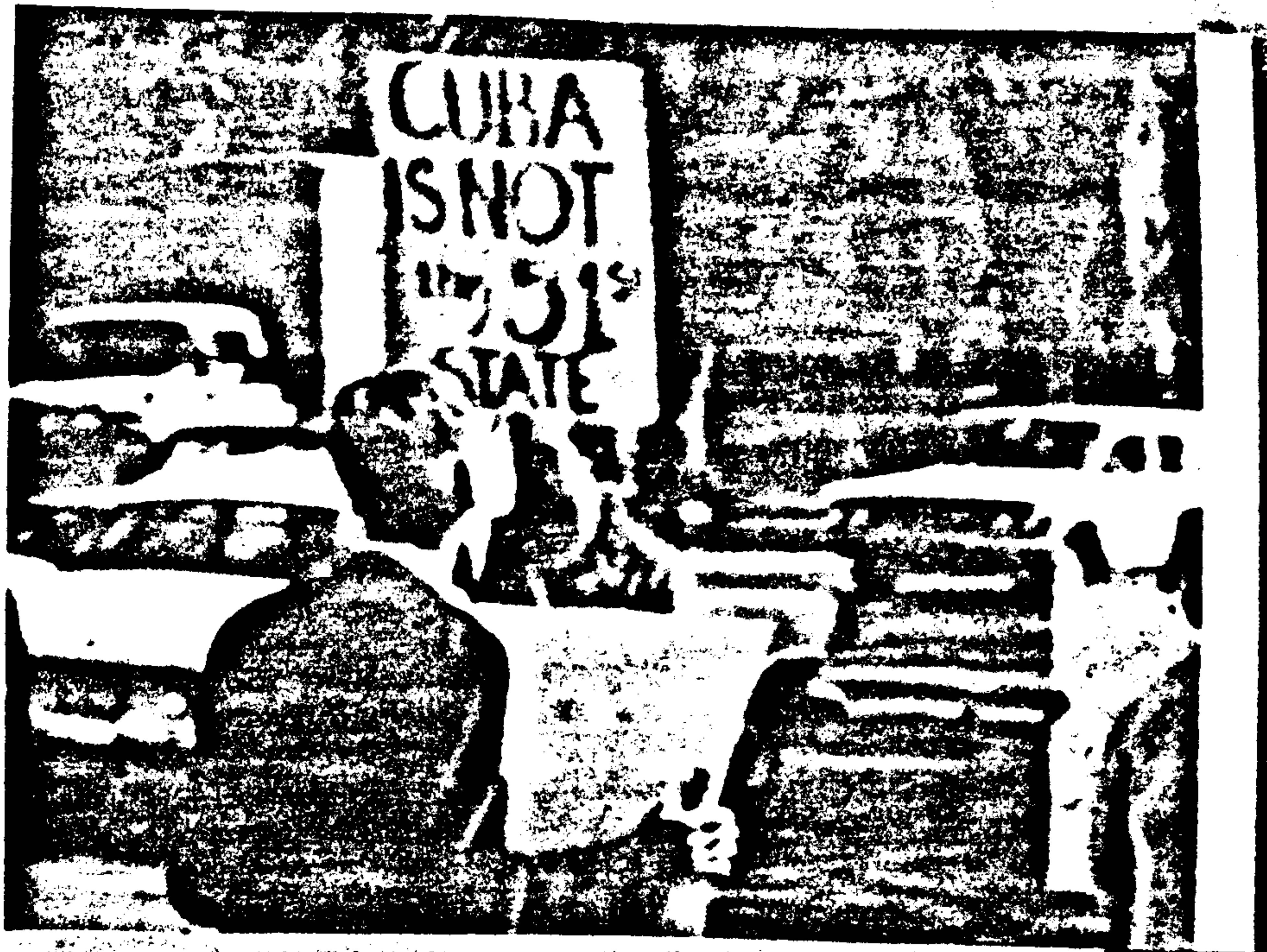

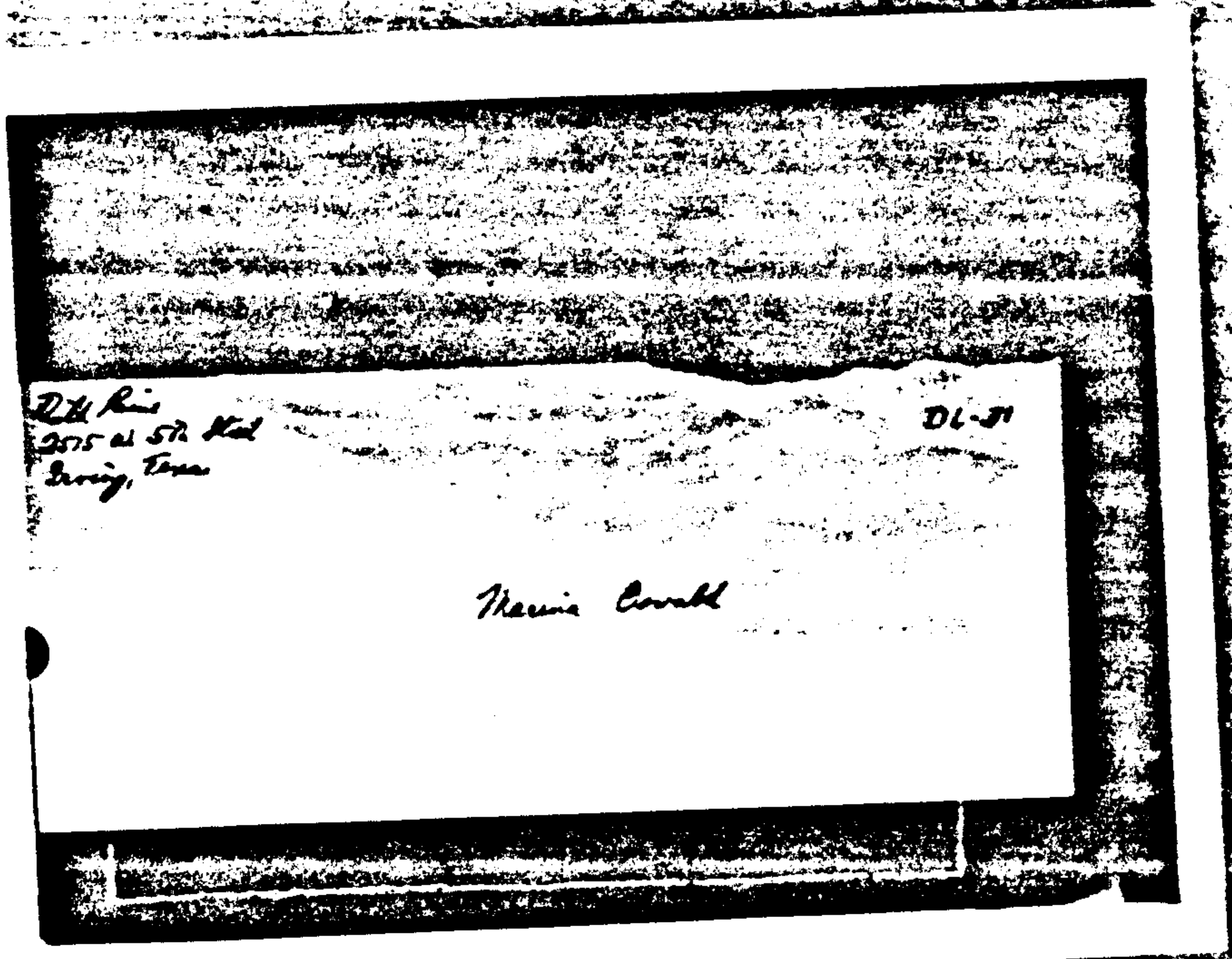
