Any statements I made to the effect that Lee Harvey Oswald was not the person who shot Kennedy were merely expressions of my opinions. PRC

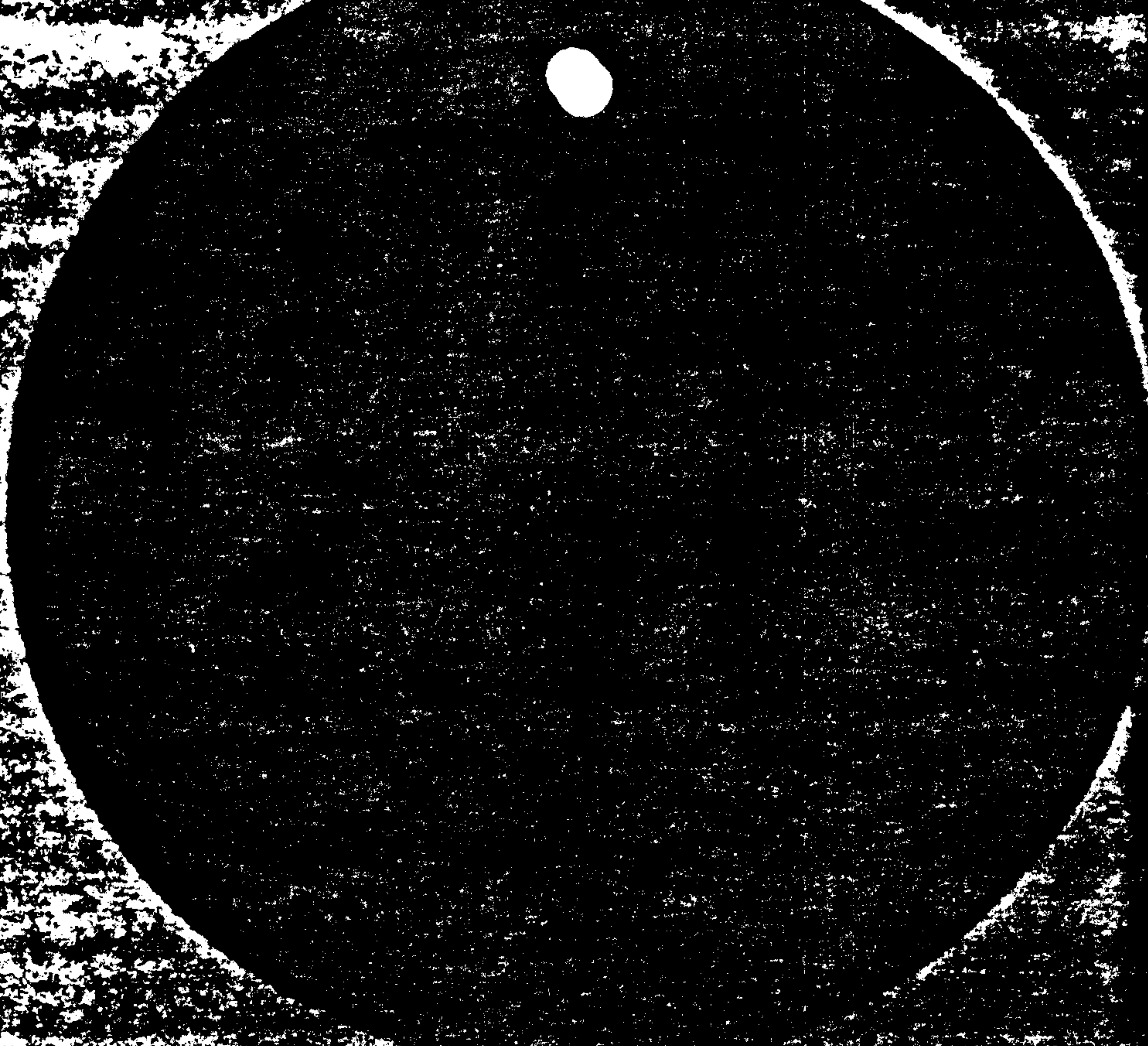

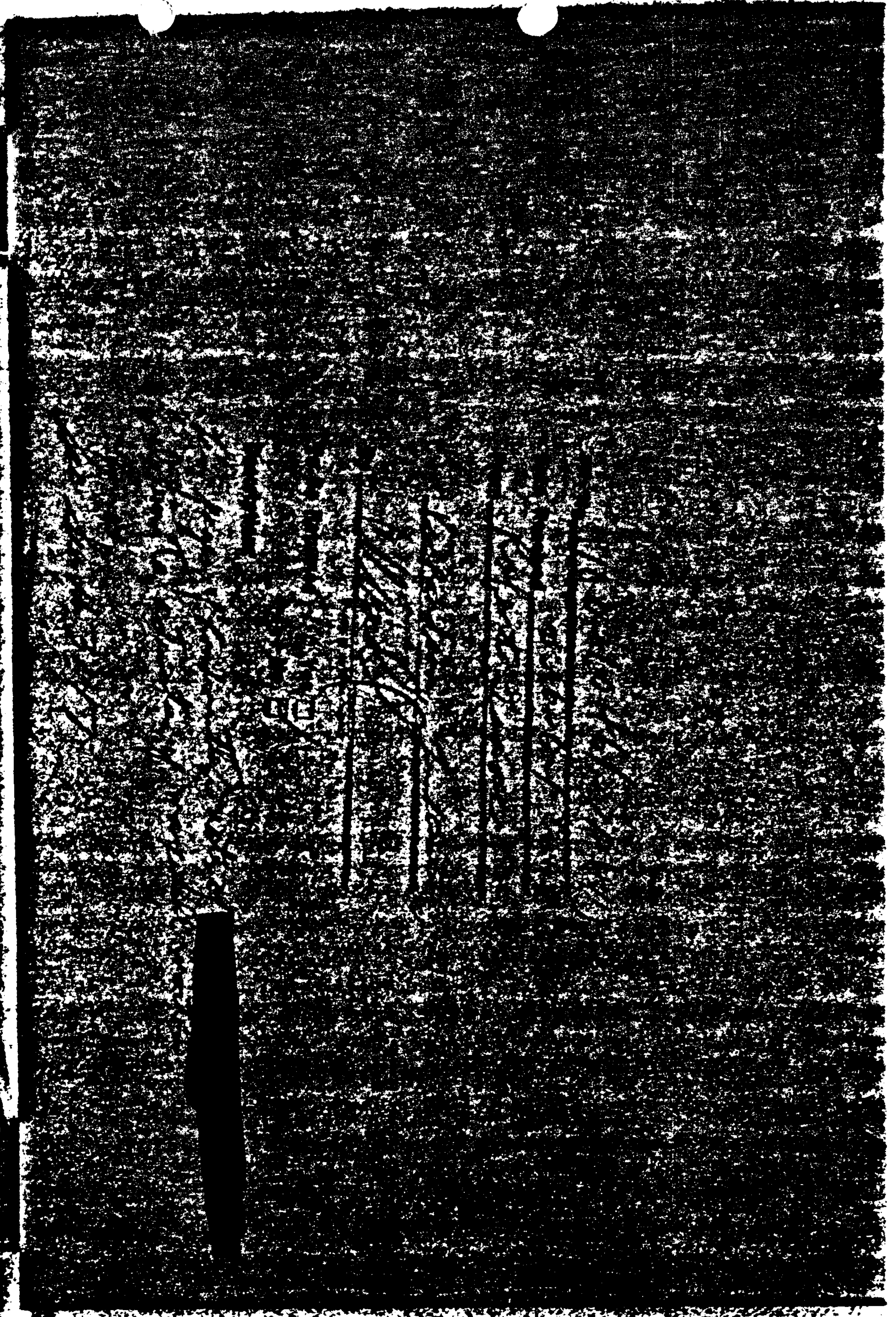

Flight Official 'Believes' He Spotted Oswald

DALLAS (UPI) — A charter flight service executive said Friday that a man resembling accused assassin Lee Harvey Oswald inquired last summer about a flight to a small island 170 miles off the Cuban coast.

The Dallas Times Herald said the executive, who wished to remain unidentified, said two persons were with the man whose "profile looked just like Oswald's..." He wanted to fly to Camahal, a Mexican-owned island.

"They wanted to charter a plane with pilot to fly five passengers," he said. "I got the impression they wanted to go in September or October. No deal was made at the time. They said they would check back."

The executive said the FBI had talked earlier with him on the matter.
