on may 27 1963 I requested permission from the FCC headquarters at 399 Bowling New York 3, N.Y. to try to form a local branch in New Orleans. I received a caution but nevertheless proceeded from V.T. Lee attorney director of FCC. I then wrote & layouts and had printed public literature for the setting up of a local FCC. I hired persons to distribute literature. I then organized persons who display receptive attitudes toward Cuba to distribute pamphlets. I sought responses from their numerous contacts of which there are many here in New Orleans, I infiltrated the Cuban Student Directorate and then harassed them with information I gained including having the N.O. city attorney general call them in & put a restraining order pending a hearing on some so-called bonds for invasion they were setting in the New Orleans area. I caused the formation of a small, active, FCC organization of members and sympathizers. where before there was none.

On Aug. 21st I was arrested by these anti-communists and was arrested for "causing a disturbance" I was interrogated by intelligence section of New Orleans Sheriff's Dept and held overnight being held out the next morning by relatives I publicly was filed 10th charges against the three colors were dropped by the judge.

On Aug 26 I organized a fair new F.P.C.C. demonstration in front of the International Trade Mart in New Orleans. This demonstration was filmed by W.D.S.U. TV and shown on the 6:00 news.

### ВОДЯНАЯ БАНЯ

Кулинарная обработка требует иногда варки продукта на водяной бане или на пару.

Для устройства водяной бани нужны две кастрюли, одна меньше другой, чтобы меньшую можно было вставить внутрь большой, на ее дно, на две цепочки или на две проволоки.

В маленькую кастрюлю кладут продукты, которые надо сварить. Между стенками обеих кастрюль наливают воду с таким расчетом, чтобы вода не доходила до края меньшей кастрюли сантиметром на пять. Затем обе кастрюли закрывают крышками и ставят на огонь. По мере выпаривания воду нужно доливать. Так варят продукты до готовности.

Чаще всего на такой водяной бане варят кашу и всякого рода тушеные блюда.

### ОФОРМЛЕНИЕ ПРАЗДНИЧНЫХ БЛЮД

Каждой хозяйке хочется, чтобы ее праздничный стол выглядел красиво. Сервировка стола во многом зависит от умения и вкуса хозяйки.

Самое лучшее украшение стола — умело приготовленные кушанья. Постарайтесь сделать их не только вкусными, но и привлекательными на вид. Начнем с такой распространенной закуски, как сельдь. Очищенную и нарезанную сельдь укладывают на селедочницу или тарелку так, чтобы она имела вид целой рыбы. К голове сельди можно приложить «усышки» из зеленого или репчатого лука, а вокруг разложить ломтики вареного картофеля, свеклы, огурцов.

Хорошие украшения для многих кушаний получаются из сливочного масла. Проще всего сделать из него «своздочки». Для этого возьмите не очень твердый брикет масла и, придерживая левой рукой его нижнюю часть, завернутую в бумагу, ножом, который вы держите в правой руке, соскребите 12—15 раз верх брикета по направлению к себе. На ножке образуется веерообразная масса. Снимите ее с ножа и соедините пальцами концы. Край готовой «своздочки» слегка покрасьте красным перцем.

При помощи чайной ложки, которую время от времени следует опускать в горячую воду, можно сделать из масла «срозочки» или «срозочки». Придайте маслу форму усеченного конуса, затем начните делать «лепестки»: вдавите ложку в середину конуса и, наклонив ее от центра к себе, выньте из масла. Основная поверхность лепестка придет маслу форму лепестка. Чтобы получить «срозочку», в промежутках между лепестками второго ряда, но чуть ниже, сделайте второй и третий ряды. Цветами из масла хорошо украсить икру, шампет и другие кушанья.

Для украшения винегрета подходит вырезанные из вареной моркови или свеклы звездочки, кружочки и красиво уложенные ломтики огурца. Готовая салат, хозяйка думает о том, как его украсить сверху, и обычно отбирает для этого самые красивые огурчики, самые вкусные кружочки нарезанного яйца, ровные ломтики мяса, отставляет одну — две ложки зеленого горошка. Уложив салат пирамидой или куче (это будет зависеть от форм посуды), полейте его майонезом или сметаной, тогда украшения будут резче выделяться. По краям посуды с салатом разложите зеленый горошек и огурцы, нарезанные кусочками или в виде веера, подрезав тонко огурец поперек почти до самого края, который закрепляет дольки, чтобы они не разошлись.

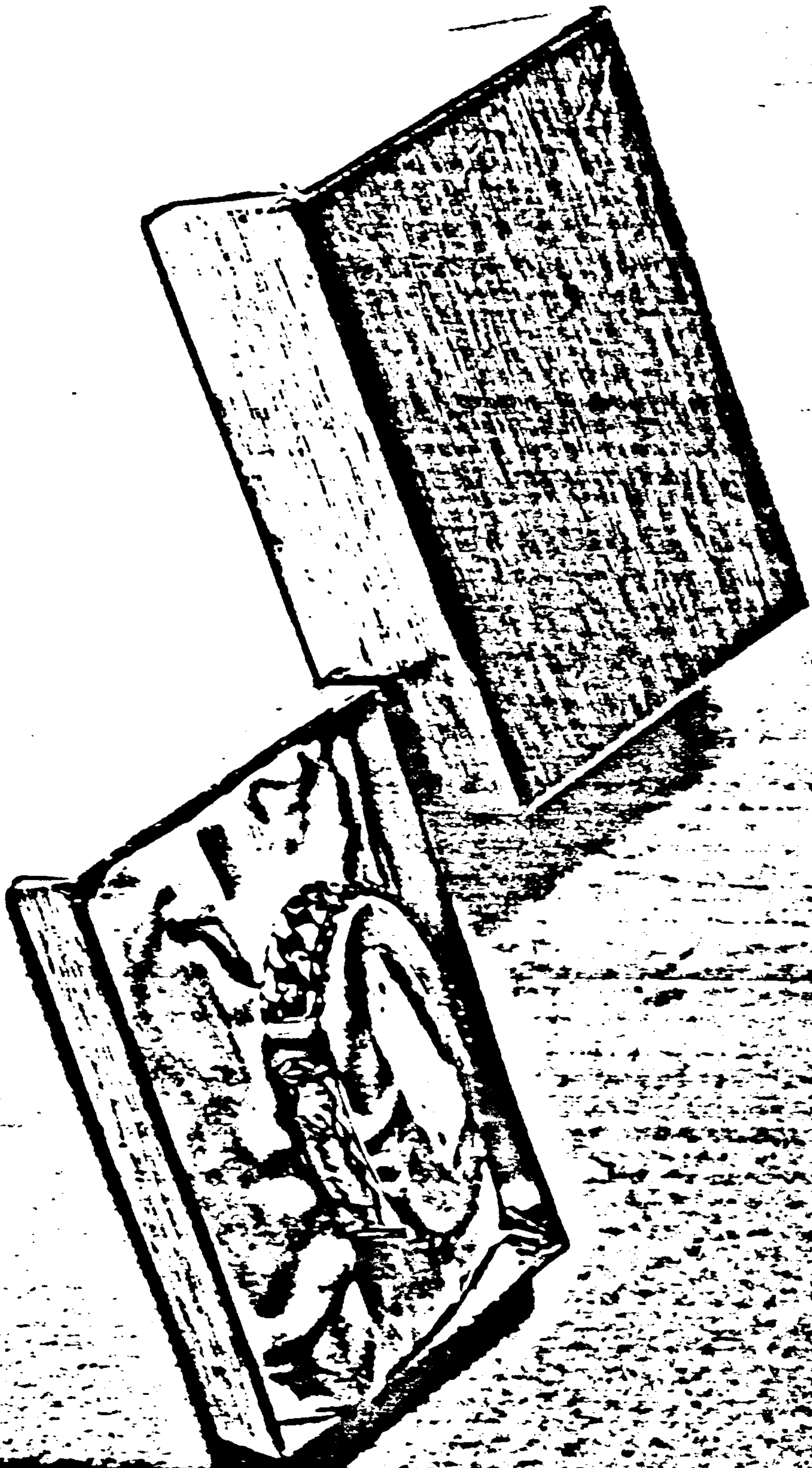
