On 11/28/63 the distance from the front door of the Texas School Book Depository building at 411 Elm Street to the bus stop at Murphy and Elm Street was walked and timed by SA LEE. By going directly east on Elm Street from this building it is a distance of five blocks and the time required to walk this was five minutes.

To cover the possibility that LEE HARVEY OSWALD attempted to avoid being seen on Elm Street a route was also walked and timed from the front door of the Texas School Book Depository building one block east on Elm then one block north to Pacific Street then east on Pacific to Lamar Street, south on Lamar to Elm and then east to the bus stop at Murphy and Elm. This is a distance of seven blocks and required seven minutes.



MARINA OSWALD was read in Russian, the letter and she said that the letter had been shown to her today in the original Russian, by the Secret Service. She said this letter she had found in LEE's room where he kept his things at the Neeley Street address sometime last spring, the date she cannot remember. She said she remembered it was one night, and OSWALD did not arrive home when he should have. She became worried about 10:00 PM and went into his room and saw this letter. Later OSWALD came rushing in, very agitated and excited. He turned on the radio immediately and lay down on the bed very pale. She asked him what was wrong and he confessed that he had taken a shot at General WALKER but did not know whether or not he had hit him and wanted to hear on the radio whether or not he had hit him. She blamed him for trying to take a life. He told her that General WALKER was leading the Fascist organization here and it was best to remove him. She was quite relieved when she found out he had missed General WALKER. She did not see him take the rifle from the house that day nor did she remember him bringing it back that day. She believes that the rifle he used to shoot at General WALKER was the same she had seen in his possession at the Neeley address and the PAINE house. She said she kept this note so that she could use it to threaten him in the event he thought up some other crazy scheme. She told him that she would go to the police with it if he thought up anything else like this again.

On 12/3/63, MR. TOM KELLEY, Inspector, Secret Service, furnished the following note, which was left in a cookbook in Russian. Presumably used by MRS. MARINA OSWALD, and which was given to the Police Department, Irving, Texas, by MRS. WYTH IAIN.

"This key for a Post Office Box in the Post Office located in the city on Ervay Street on the same street toward the Drug store where you always stood. Four blocks from drug store on the same street toward Post Office, you will find our box. I paid for the box last month so don't worry about it. Send the consulate information what happened to me, and also clippings from the newspapers (if the newspapers will write about me). I think that the consulate immediately will help you if they learn all. I have paid for the latter on the second so don't worry about it. I also paid for the water and gas. Possibly the money from the work will be coming. They will send our checks by mail. You will go to the bank and change the check for cash. My clothing, etc. you can throw away or give away. Do not keep them but my personal papers (military and civil, etc) I prefer that you hold. Several of my documents are located in a small blue suitcase. Address book on night cabinet table if you need it. Here we have friends and Red Cross who would help you. (Red Cross in English). I am leaving you as much money as I could, (\$60 on the second of the month) and you can live on \$10 per week, two more months. If I am alive and taken as prisoner, Municipal Building is located at the end of the bridge through which we always travel when I went toward the city, right in the beginning of the city after you pass the bridge."

It has come to my attention that an article appeared in the Houston newspapers in recent days which quoted Mrs. RUTH PAINE as stating the purpose of my visit to her house on November 1, 1963, was for the purpose of arranging an interview with LEE HARVEY OSWALD.

It should be noted that, as I have previously stated, one of the purposes of the visit was to arrange an interview for MARINA OSWALD. It would appear that either Mrs. PAINE has been misquoted by the newspapers or she may have been confused on November 1, 1963, and thought I desired an interview with LEE OSWALD rather than MARINA OSWALD. This could explain the subject's having my name and the office telephone number in his possession. It should be noted that at the time of this interview, Mrs. PAINE was speaking in Russian and in English to this writer and to MARINA OSWALD and may have confused my request.

This should be made a matter of record in view of the allegations in this case.
