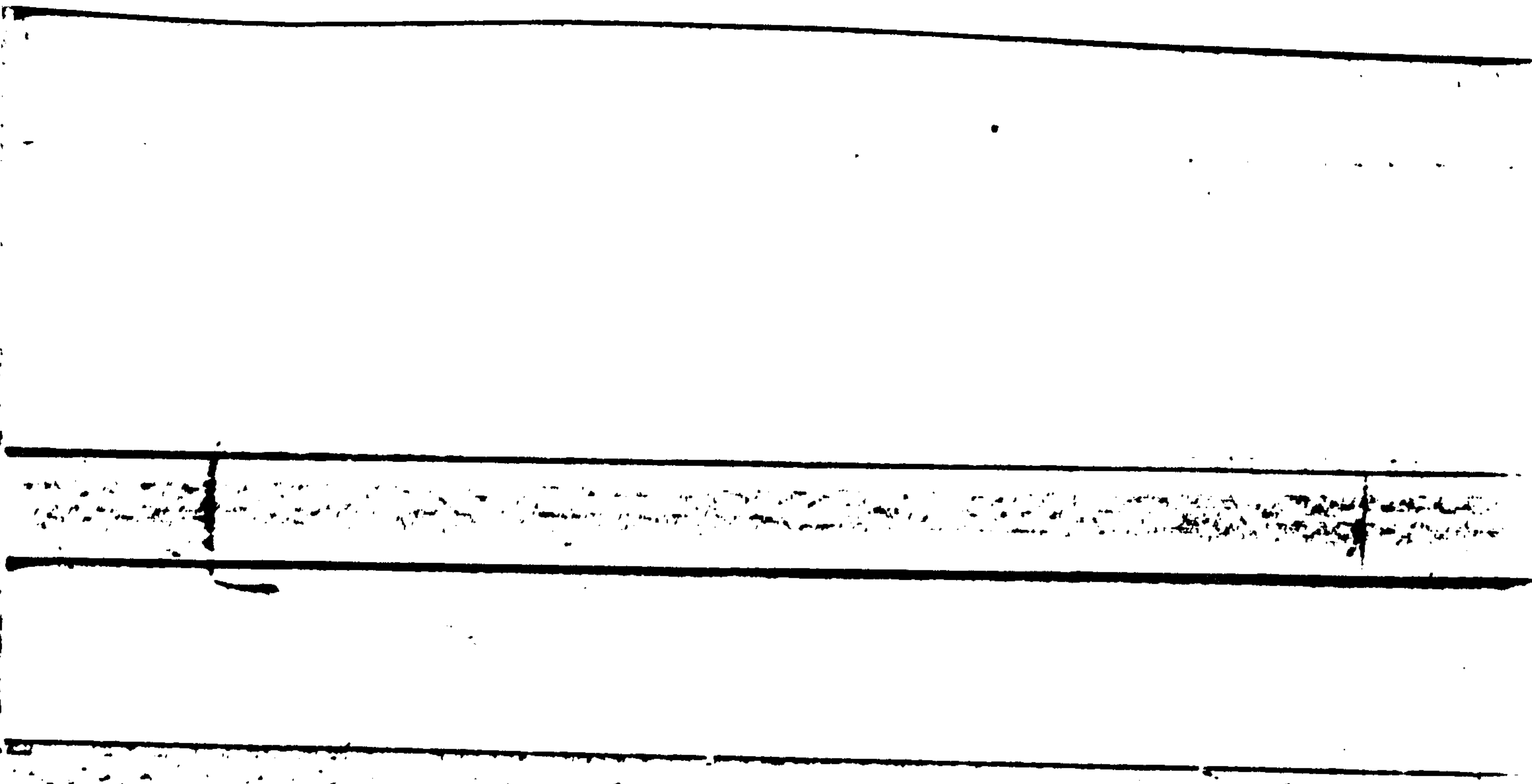

Inspector James R. Malley referred to an item in the Dallas Times Herald dated December 6, 1963, wherein reference is made to OSWALD, the accused assassin, practicing thoroughly with a 6.5 Italian carbine. The article continued: "The mail order house which sold Oswald the rifle also sold boxes of 108 rounds of 6.5 ammunition for about \$7. It also sold four-power telescopic sights that could be fitted to the rifle. However, in disclosing Oswald bought the rifle from the firm, investigators omitted reference to the scope and ammunition."

Inspector Malley anticipates questions will be asked concerning the possible purchase of ammunition by OSWALD from the same mail order house from which the rifle was purchased.

Accordingly, a check should be made of our files and a memorandum prepared, attention Inspector Malley, with reference to any ammunition purchased by OSWALD.

Investigation at Chicago has established that the 6.5 millimeter Mannlicher-Carcano rifle, Serial No. C-2766, was purchased from Klein's Sporting Goods, Incorporated, 4540 West Madison St., Chicago, Illinois, and that it was shipped to OSWALD's Post Office Box in Dallas, Texas by parcel post, "not broken down with the bolt and scope intact." It has been further reported by the Chicago Office that "The scope would have been wrapped in corrugated paper and then brown wrapping paper or newspaper would be used in wrapping to prevent shifting within the carton."

Investigation at Chicago does not specifically indicate that inquiry was made at Klein's Sporting Goods to determine if OSWALD under any of his known aliases ordered any ammunition for this rifle.

Investigation by the Los Angeles Office has established that the Smith and Wesson .38 caliber revolver, Serial No. V 510210, used by OSWALD in killing Dallas Police Officer J. D. TIPPIT, was purchased from the George Rose and Company, Inc., 1225 South Grand Ave., Los Angeles, California. Inquiry at this company in connection with the purchase of this revolver indicated that written in ink on the order form for the revolver, was an order for one box of ammunition and one holster, but that a line was drawn through these items cancelling that portion of the order.

On 12/7/63, Mr. BANNIGAN of the Bureau talked to Insp. HEITMAN and wanted to know if the following four points had been covered in the interviews with MARINA:

1. Why did the Soviets permit MARINA to leave Russia?
2. The normal procedure followed by Soviets in handling defectors. What happened when OSWALD arrived in Moscow? All details.
3. What the OSWALD say about being interrogated, etc.?
4. Did OSWALD have difficulty in leaving Russia?

A review of the FD 302's concerning the interviews with MARINA and a review of WFO airtel to Bureau, 11/22/63, setting forth details of State Department file concerning OSWALD, indicates that the following points are of interest in connection and that further questioning of MARINA OSWALD along these lines might be productive.

On 12/7/63, MARINA advised she had applied to Russian authorities in May, 1961 for permission to depart Russia and that she had received a Russian permit to depart about New Year's, 1962. She said she received exit permit in May, 1962.

- 7: What is difference between a permit to depart and exit permit, if any? Try to clarify this point with MARINA.
- 8: When did she apply for documentation to leave Russia?

On 12/3/61, she stated OSWALD had been granted permission to leave Russia by Russian authorities much sooner than had she.

Q: Why was OSWALD granted permission before she was granted such permission?

In interview of 12/3/63, she stated she and OSWALD had saved enough rubles to obtain \$100 U.S., which Russian authorities allowed them to change into dollars and which was used by OSWALD to pay rail passage from Russia to Amsterdam.

Q: Is it an ordinary thing for Russian authorities to allow such transactions? Does she remember the rate of exchange? Why were U. S. dollars necessary to pay rail fare?

In interview, 12/3/63, MARINA said that in February and March, 1963, she had requested permission of Russian authorities to return to Russia. She stated that this was because of family reasons.

Q: Refrase question to MARINA concerning this and attempt to determine why she desired to return to Russia at this time.

State Department records reflect OSWALD's mother said she received a letter from OSWALD in December, 1959, at which time OSWALD was staying in Moscow at the Metropol Hotel. State Department records show OSWALD entered Russia from Finland, 10/15/59. Official records reflect OSWALD was missing from Metropol Hotel on 12/1/59. These records reflect he told American Embassy in Moscow in interview of 7/8/61 that he had been employed at Belorussian Radio and TV factory at Minsk on 1/15/59.

In interview 12/4/63, MARINA stated OSWALD did not speak much of his stay in Moscow when he first entered Russia. She recalls that later when they were in Moscow together and staying at the Hotel Berlin, he had made the remark he had stayed at this hotel when he first arrived in Moscow. She believes the Hotel Berlin is now called by another name.

In interview, 12/4/63, MARINA said she did not know how long OSWALD had stayed in Moscow.

In interview, 12/4/59, she said she does <sup>not</sup> know why OSWALD was sent to Minsk. She mentioned Minsk has the TV-radio factory in which OSWALD worked. She also mentioned Minsk has a large foreign population, particularly Argentines.

Q: Did OSWALD ever mention the Metropol Hotel?

Apparently OSWALD was in Moscow from at least 10/15/59 to 12/1/59 and perhaps longer. Refrase questions in an effort to obtain more information concerning OSWALD's stay in Moscow this period.

Was OSWALD given a choice as to where he would be sent?

Does she know why, particularly, there is such a large foreign population in Minsk?

The American Embassy in Moscow received an undated letter from OSWALD on 2/13/61, postmarked at Minsk on 2/5/61, postmarked at Moscow 2/11/61, in which he stated he had received no reply to his letter of 12/60, in which he had requested consideration of return of his passport and of his desired return to the United States if it would be agreed that any legal proceedings against him would be dropped.

Q: Did OSWALD ever mention the missing letter of December, 1960?

Note the long period of time for delivery of above letter. Is such a long delay usual in mail service of Russia?

How long would it take her letters from Minsk to Leningrad, etc., to arrive?

OSWALD's letter to the American Embassy, mentioned directly above, indicates he was thinking of returning to the United States at least as early as December, 1960, which was three to four months before his marriage to MARINA on 1/30/61.

MARINA, in interview of 12/2/63, said OSWALD mentioned to her about three months after they were married that he desired to return to the United States, implying this was the first expression of any such desire on his part.

Q: Since it would appear that OSWALD was thinking of returning to the United States even before he married MARINA, and had made overt efforts to accomplish this, question MARINA more closely about this point.

In his letter received at the American Embassy, 2/13/61, OSWALD stated that the Russians at no time insisted he take Russian citizenship.

MARINA said in interview that OSWALD had told her the Russians had offered him citizenship but he had refused.

Q: What else did he say about this offer of Russian citizenship. When was it made?

Why did he refuse the offer of Russian citizenship?

Did he say the Russians had not insisted that he accept citizenship?

How did the Russians react when he refused this offer of citizenship?



OSWALD appeared at the American Embassy on July 8, 1961, according to State Department records at which time he told of his marriage on April 30, 1961, and said he was arranging for his wife to join him in Moscow for a visa interview.

MARINA said in interview of December 2, 1963, she and OSWALD had flown together to Moscow in the late summer of 1961 for the purpose of interviews at the American Embassy.

Q: Can she fix the date better?

Q: From State Department records it appears OSWALD was at Moscow alone on July 8, 1961, when he was interviewed at the American Embassy yet MARINA says they went together in the late summer. Clarify this point.

Q: Did OSWALD go to Moscow alone one time to make such arrangements? Did she join him in Moscow or did they go together on another occasion?

The American Embassy at Moscow received a letter on March 20, 1961, which was postmarked at Minsk on March 5, 1961, and postmarked Moscow March 17, 1963, in which he stated it was inconvenient for him to come to Moscow for the sole purpose of an interview.

Q: Notice the time lag in delivery of letter. Is this usual?

The Embassy received a letter postmarked at Minsk on May 16, 1961, in which he said he was married to a Russian woman who would accompany him to the United States and that he desired full guarantees of no prosecution in the United States. He appeared at the Embassy on July 8, 1961, and was interviewed at length.

The American Embassy furnished to the State Department on October 12, 1961, text of four letters detailing OSWALD's difficulties in obtaining exit visas for himself and wife and noting they were subjected to increasing harassment in Minsk. He requested the Embassy make official inquiry of Russian authorities concerning these exit visa requests. The Embassy informed him about October, 1961, that MARINA's exit visa had not been approved.

Q: What was this harassment in Minsk. Did she feel like she was being harassed? Get all possible details.

Other possible questions in the next interview with MARINA are the following:

Q: Did he look particularly for a position as a photographer in the United States? If so, why?

Q: Did he attend photographic or other specialized school in Russia?

Q: Did he go hunting in Russia?

Q: Did he own a rifle there and was he a member of a rifle club? If so, how often did he attend?

Q: Does she believe OSWALD was given an assignment in the United States as a condition to leave the USSR?

Q: As apartments are scarce in Russia, does she believe he obtained one so easily? Why does she believe he obtained one so easily?

Q: Was MARINA permitted to leave Russia on the condition that she and OSWALD would accept assignments in the United States?

Q: Does she know whether OSWALD was in direct or indirect contact with the Soviet Embassy?

Q: Did OSWALD know how to operate a short wave radio or did he have such equipment in Russia or United States?

Q: Did OSWALD have any other unusual equipment in Russia or United States such as secret ink, etc.?

In the material received from the FBI Laboratory which is copies of correspondence found at the PAINE house there is a letter from PAVEL GOLOVACHOV, 11 Zakharov Street, Apartment 72, Minsk, written to MARINA on September 29, 1963. It appears that MARINA and PAVEL GOLOVACHOV are quite close friends.

MARINA has mentioned PAVEL before as a friend of OSWALD.

Q: Question her more closely concerning this relationship between herself and OSWALD and PAVEL GOLOVACHOV.

On 12/9/63, DONALD CARROLL, attorney, Tyler, Texas, telephone LY 2-7351, was telephonically contacted in an effort to obtain the present address of RAMON BUENOSTRO CORTEZ, whom CARROLL had previously represented in a trial at Dallas involving an impersonation violation.

Mr. CARROLL was advised this office was interested in contacting CORTEZ in connection with the assassination of President KENNEDY, but no further details were furnished to him.

CARROLL stated he was sure he could determine the present location of CORTEZ; however, it may take a day or two to do so. He stated either he or CORTEZ would then telephonically contact the Dallas Office.

He stated in conclusion that he preferred no matter not related to the assassination he discussed with CORTEZ, as he is presently representing CORTEZ in another matter involving the Federal Government.

SA ROBERT C. LISH advised that he was at the County Jail and had learned that subject DAVID LOUIS GOLDREYER had been removed from Memphis, Tennessee and had arrived at the Dallas County Jail at approximately 5:30 AM, Dec. 7th. The Deputy Marshals from Memphis who brought GOLDREYER to Dallas advised JOHN E. LOWELL, Deputy Marshal to the effect that GOLDREYER had received a telegram from OSWALD and had such a telegram in his possession when arrested in Memphis. SA LISH stated he had been unable to obtain any information indicating that anyone had seen such a telegram.

The report of SA PAUL N. CONRAD, Memphis, dated 12/4/63 reflects that GOLDREYER when interviewed by Agents of the Memphis Office, stated that while he was en route by plane from Dallas, Texas to Memphis, Tenn., he met a news reporter who asked him if he, GORDREYER, would send the following telegram, since he would be getting off the plane at Memphis:

"To Mr. BURT RHEINHARDT, United Press, Statler-Hilton Hotel, Dallas, Texas. Suggest obtaining telescopic rifle sights housing on a cross hair zooming a spot where tragedy took place. Perhaps you can use convertible and simulate incident. Fifth will help doorman. Local sports shop Cullum and Boron may rent you outfit. Director of Public Safety or Mayor should clear for entry, signed Fred and Jack. Sender United Press, Washington."

GOLDREYER advised that he did send this telegram from Memphis for the news reporter.

In view of the allegation that GOLDREYER allegedly had something in his possession that was from OSWALD, the Memphis Office was called.

SAC KARL W. DISSLY, Memphis, subsequently advised that there was no foundation to this comment of any kind; that the true facts are as set forth in the report of SA PAUL N. CONRAD. He stated, however, that he had talked to the Deputy Marshals who had brought subject GOLDREYER to Dallas, and that one of the Marshals admitted having made the statement that he thought perhaps the reason GOLDREYER had been returned to Dallas so quickly was because he was connected in some way with OSWALD. He denied, however, ~~making the Deputy Marshal at Memphis deny~~ having made a statement that GOLDREYER had a telegram from OSWALD.

DISSLY stated that the individuals in Memphis seemed to be somewhat upset over the fact that they were questioned and he wouldn't be at all surprised if the statement as quoted in the Dallas area was actually made.

SAC SHANKLIN telephonically contacted JOHN E. LOWELL and advised him concerning the above statements and the fact that it was understood GOLDREYER was being held in maximum custody of the Dallas County Sheriff, and that this was being passed on to him for his information inasmuch as there was no foundation to this story that GOLDREYER had received a telegram from OSWALD.

I furnished the same information to ROBERT I. NASH, U. S. Marshal, and the Marshal assured me GOLDREYER would be treated now as any other prisoner.
