Re memorandum of SA BARDWELL D. ODUM dated 12/8/63, relative to a student named DIRK at Dallas University.

On 12/10/63, Sister MARY MARGARET, Registrar, Dallas University, Post Office Box 1330, Dallas, Texas, advised that a student named DIRK is actually DIRK THOMAS KUMERT. Sister MARY MARGARET stated that KUMERT is a German exchange student who is attending Dallas University on a scholarship. She described him as a student who is very egotistical. Sister MARY MARGARET made available her file on DIRK THOMAS KUMERT which revealed the following information:

Record reflects that KUMERT was admitted to the Dallas University on 9/16/63, and he indicated that his major would be in Liberal Arts and science.

The U. S. Department of Justice Immigration and Naturalization Form "Notice and Report Concerning Non-Immigrant 'F-1' Student" reflects KUMERT was admitted at New York on 9/11/63. His student file is No. A13530112. The file reflects that KUMERT is studying jurisprudence and is interested in learning as much as he can about the American legal field. In his writing to Professor KUBECK, he describes himself as an "Important Revisionist Historian." He also indicated he is a student of history as well as law. No further information appears concerning KUMERT.

Mrs. GLORIA MUSSELWHITE, 6912 Gaston Avenue, Dallas, on 12/9/63, telephonically contacted this office and asked to speak to SAC SHANKLIN. After speaking briefly to Mr. SHANKLIN, she was interviewed telephonically by SA EDWIN D. KUYKENDALL.

Mrs. MUSSELWHITE stated that on about 11/21/63, she mailed a pamphlet containing President KENNEDY's photograph to this office and received a reply therefrom acknowledging receipt of same (correspondence shown in 157-304-5,4). She wanted to report also that on 11/16/63, at about noon, she was at Crawford's Cafeteria, next door to the Goodwill store, Hawkins and Elm, Dallas, and noticed a male individual walk into that establishment carrying two guns, believed rifles. She thought one may have had a telescopic sight on it. The man looked directly at her and she was somewhat frightened because he had with him two guns. She does not know that person's identity, but after viewing LEE HARVEY OSWALD's photographs, she believes it may have been OSWALD.

She described the person seen by her as follows:

Re memorandum of SA MILTON L. NEWSOM dated 12/7/63 relative to telephone call from Mr. CLYDE E. BRAYTON, 215 American Bank Building, Zangs Boulevard, Dallas, Texas.

On 12/10/63, Mr. C. E. BRAYTON, Realtor, Oil and Gas Broker, 215 American Bank Building, 415 Zangs Boulevard, Dallas, Texas, was interviewed, at which time he exhibited a memorandum as follows:

"The press secretary to the President has instructed us to advise you that all working press will take direction from Asst. Press Secretary KILDUFF at the President's luncheon.

"KILDUFF will use visual signals to tell photographers and reporters when they can approach an area, how long they can work, and when they must leave the area. His signals will be directed to the White House press, but they are to apply to all working press. Mr. KILDUFF insists on compliance. Thank you."

Mr. BRAYTON stated that on 12/4/63 he was attending a meeting of the Dallas Real Estate Board at the Dallas Trade Mart and found the above memorandum which had attached to it a rough sketch of the President's route in downtown Dallas toward the Dallas Trade Mart Building. Mr. BRAYTON said he found the above memorandum with the rough sketch map in a stack of papers on a desk on the fourth floor between 5:45 p.m. and 6:15 p.m. on

12/4/63. It apparently had been discarded by some member of the press and apparently contains instructions given by either the Secret Service or Assistant Press Secretary KILDUFF in connection with the President's scheduled luncheon. No significance is attached to the above.

The following is in regard to investigation to determine the origin of a piece of adding machine tape turned in by MARTIN ROSS of the Big State Construction Company on 12/3/63 which paper had the name LEO H. OSWALD on one side and the name REDDING, 2122 Wood Oak, on the other. Its purpose is to record additional investigation conducted prior to receiving a suggestion from SA JOSEPH ABERNATHY that the inquiry be cut off following the interview with Mr. J. R. REDDING.

Since Mr. REDDING mentioned several visits to his home by General Electric servicemen, Mr. M. R. MC CARTY, Manager of Operations, General Electric Appliances Center, 8401 John W. Carpenter Parkway, Dallas, Tex., was contacted by SA HAROLD R. DOBSON on 12/10/63 and after contacting Mr. BERT KLOSTER, General Counsel for the company in Louisville, Kentucky, Mr. MC CARTY made available the records of service calls to the REDDING residence, 2122 Wood Oak, Irving, Tex. Three calls were made, one on 11/14/63 by serviceman E. H. HOUSDEN, one on 11/21/63 by serviceman BILL TIROFF, and the third made in December which was not deemed pertinent as it was after the slip of paper in question was found. With the assistance of Mr. CLIFFORD PRICE, GE Retail Service Supervisor, the servicemen were contacted by radio and thereafter telephoned the office and were interviewed by telephone.

E. H. HOUSDEN stated that he sometimes uses scratch pads provided by the company on which to jot down the names and addresses of customers received over the radio prior to entering the names properly in his service book. He has never used adding machine tape. He never knew LEE HARVEY OSWALD prior to the

President's assassination and has never written his name.

Serviceman WILLIAM TIROFF stated that he sometimes uses adding machine tape for notes but could never recall having written OSWALD's name. He was unable to recall whether or not he had jotted Mr. REDDING's name and address on such a piece of paper prior to calling at his residence. He stated he would like to see the piece of paper as he could undoubtedly identify the handwriting immediately if it had been made by him. He was at that time in Houston, Texas, a considerable distance from the company headquarters, and was not asked to return. He stated he resides at 409 Nancy in the North Richland Hills section of Fort Worth, Tex., and is home after 5:30 p.m.

Should it be determined advisable in the future to continue efforts in this matter, it is suggested that the tape found be exhibited to Mr. TIROFF either at his residence in Fort Worth, Tex., or at some other place arranged through the GE Company.

Colonel E. E. BOYD, INTC, Dallas, on 12/6/63, came to the Dallas Office and furnished information to SA EDWIN D. KUYKENDALL, as follows:

An individual, whom he did not desire to identify, reported to him that ILLYA MANITOV (correct spelling unknown to him), of Sun Oil Company Laboratories, Dallas, a Russian Translator who was utilized on 11/22/63 by unidentified authorities at the Dallas PD as a translator in interviewing Mrs. MARINA OSWALD, or some relative of LEE HARVEY OSWALD, had some information that may be pertinent.

MANITOV allegedly had recalled a social function in February, 1963, at which one Mrs. PAINE and the OSWALDS attended at the home of someone in Dallas, exact name unknown, but may have been JENKINS. GEORGE DE MOHRENSCHILDT, of Dallas, was also at that party. Persons around Dallas, of white Russian descent and various geologists, names unknown, are supposed to be presently suspicious of DE MOHRENSCHILDT, as he has in the past been a Geologist's Advisor in Yugoslavia, and is supposed to be an admitted atheist. Also, DE MOHRENSCHILDT apparently has made a number of trips to South America and Central America. The source of DE MOHRENSCHILDT's money allegedly is unknown, although, he is believed to have previously been married to a former wife who was "fairly well fixed financially" and he might have gotten some kind of a settlement from that marriage. Two children allegedly were born to that previous marriage, names of children unknown.

Also, in about 1962, after OSWALD came to Fort Worth, he was supposed to have met a man named BUHAY (phonetic), who was an employee of DeGolyer and MacNaughton, geologists. BUHAY (phonetic) allegedly put the OSWALDS in contact with one THEOFIL MELLER (which information appeared in an article in the Dallas Times Herald, 11/28/63). Later, OSWALD was supposed to have stayed some with another geologist (name unknown) but name may have been something like DECKFORD (phonetic), who also was married to a Russian.

Colonel BOYD furnished the above information for whatever it may be worth as leads. He said this information may all be already known to the Dallas Office. It came to him from the individual whom he did not identify who received it from MANITOV (phonetic).

A review of the Dallas file reflects the above pertains to ILYA A. MAMANTOV (who has already been interviewed by this office) (100-10461-1768, page 731).

A lead is presently outstanding through the Bureau to have GEORGE DE MOHRENSCHILDT interviewed in Haiti, where he now resides. (89-43-2474, a memo dated 12/3/63, which gives a summary of information pertaining to GEORGE DE MOHRENSCHILDT.) (GEORGE DE MOHRENSCHILDT is the subject of two closed files, 105-92 and 105-632.)

_____ BUHAY (phonetic) appears identical with GEORGE A. BOUHE, 4740 Homer Street, Apartment O, Dallas, who has been interviewed on two occasions in connection with this case on 11/23 and 11/27/63, shown in 89-43-1768, pages 275 and 280.

THEOFIL MELLER has been interviewed in connection with instant case on 11/23/63, shown in 89-43-1768, page 254.

Attached envelope and stuffer was given to me by COP M.C. Roebuck Nacogoches, Texas. He advised this was given to him by Mr. Vernis J. Stanlund of the Appleby, Texas Community which is near Nacogdoches. According to Roebuck there is no Mayor of Appleby and he stated there is no radical, conservative or other type of political activity to warrant sending of this literature to Appleby. It is not known if literature is significant or could fit into subject's investigation, but it bears postmark and date at Ft Worth 11/22/63.

Re Newark airtel to Bureau 12/3/63 (Lead #140).

On 12/5/63, it was determined through inquiry at 3312 Shorecrest Drive that RON WILLIAMS had resided there and also resides at 4138 Parkside Drive; was the Field Correspondent for Fairchild Publications and wrote for "Home Furnishings Daily." He was not home at the time and it was learned he had just taken his very ill baby to the hospital, the baby possibly not expected to live.

In view of this circumstance and considering the nature of the information in reairtel, it is not considered practical or in good taste to interview Mr. WILLIAMS at this time.

Further, in view of the type information in reairtel, it might be considered unnecessary to interview Mr. WILLIAMS concerning possible implications involved between the newspaper article and the death of President KENNEDY.

Unless advised to the contrary, Mr. WILLIAMS will not be interviewed in this connection.

On 12/11/63 SA JAMES W. BOOKHOUT advised that items set forth in referenced communication were forwarded to the Bureau on 12/10/63. SA BOOKHOUT advised that the initials "RMS" on back of Dallas Transit Company Shoppers Transfer dated Friday, 11/22/63 are those of Detective RICHARD M. SIMS, Homicide Division, Dallas Police Department.

A review of the report of SA ROBERT P. GEMBERLING dated 11/30/63 at Dallas, reflects that on 11/22/63 SAs BARDWELL D. ODUM and ALFRED C. ELLINGTON interviewed Cecil J. MC WATTERS, 2523 Blyth Street, Dallas, bus driver, Dallas Transit Company, who advised that "while he was at the Dallas Police Department on 11/22/63 he was shown a Dallas Transit Transfer which he identified as having been issued by him on 11/22/63, on the run which he has described as being at St. Paul and Elm at 12:36 P.M. He stated that all transfers issued on this run from north to south showed a time of 1:00 P.M. and 1:00 P.M. was shown on the transfer exhibited to him at the police department. He further stated that he recognized the marks of his ticket punch on this transfer he examined in the 'P.M.' box and in the 'Lakewood' box. He stated this transfer was dated 11/22/63."

In view of the above no further investigation is being conducted as pertains to lead #1.

4. Paycheck stub from American Bakeries Company dated August 22, 1960, or August 27, 1960, reflecting amount of pay as \$66.17, less Federal income tax \$7.40, less Social Security \$1.99, reflecting net amount of check as \$56.78;
5. One narrow, black belt with buckle;
6. Small box top bearing the name "Cox's, Fort Worth;"
7. Brass key marked, "P. O. Dept. Do Not Dup.", Number 1126;
8. Silver color Marine Corps emblem ring;
9. Chrome ID bracelet with expansion band with inscription "Lee."

On 12/10/63, PHILLIP COUNTS, OSI, Wright-Patterson Air Force Base, Ohio, advised that Base employee LEONARD C. DICKEY, employed Building 18, Area B, Extension 216, advised him that a [REDACTED] who lives in the Mac and Mac Trailer Court, Route No. 7, Paducah, Kentucky, had recently sent some blueprints to Wright-Patterson AFB and on 12/5 or 12/6 sent an additional letter claiming that Communists had something to do with the assassination of President KENNEDY. [REDACTED] in his letter to DICKEY, stated that he had contacted the Paducah FBI Office, as well as sending the same information to Dallas, Texas, Police.

On 12/10/63, LEONARD DICKEY advised the Dayton RA that the blueprints received appeared to be made by a person with the intelligence equal to a fourteen or fifteen year old individual. DICKEY also felt that from the blueprints and the rambling portions of the letter, he was of the opinion that the writer was "not right" mentally.

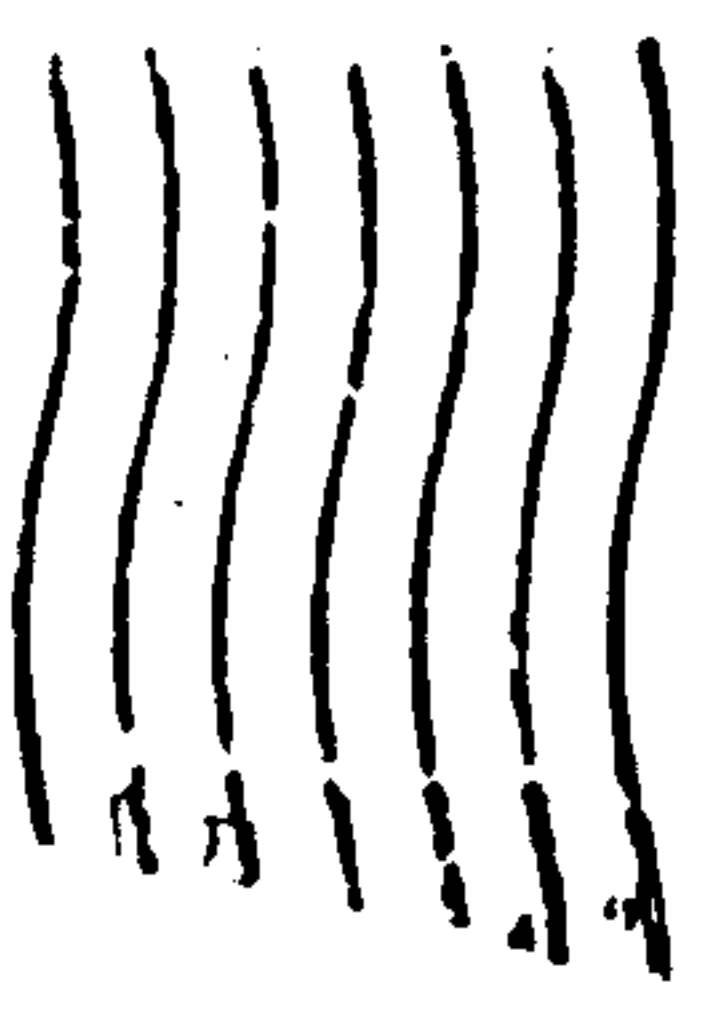
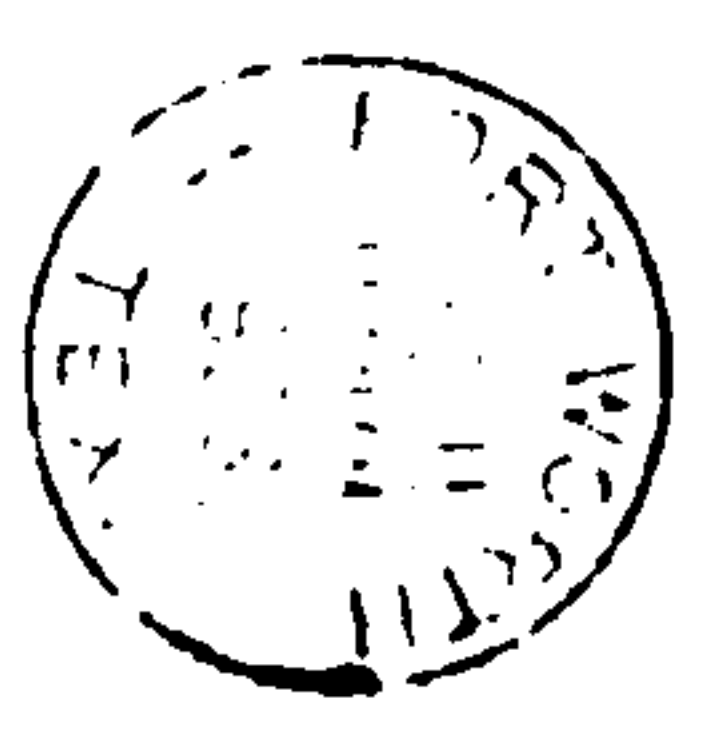



DICK ROBERTSON, news reporter with WFAA, telephonically contacted me today and advised that he had received information that two American law enforcement officers had been killed in a plane accident on Tuesday, 12/10/63, in Mexico. He advised the plane had been en route from Mazatlan to Sinaloa and hit a guy wire on making approach to the landing. ROBERTSON further related that he had received information that the two individuals who were killed, one STANLEY HOFFMAN and WALLACE SMITH, were in the company of two Secret Service Agents. He stated that the only information he could obtain from the Mexican authorities was that the two individuals killed were American law enforcement officers. In addition, he had determined that Mexican authorities had contacted Sheriff DECKER with regard to HOFFMAN requesting that he notify the next of kin and determine the disposition to be made of the body and personal effects, although Mexican authorities had reported to the news that HOFFMAN was from New York.

ROBERTSON stated he felt that this incident was connected in some manner with the investigation of OSWALD and requested clarification.

ROBERTSON was advised that no comment could be made with regard to the above.

A search of the Dallas indices revealed no information concerning these individuals. In addition, Inspector TOM KELLEY, Secret Service, was telephonically advised of the above at 3:40 PM, this date. Inspector KELLEY advised the individuals who were killed were not Secret Service Agents, and they had no Secret Service Agents in Mexico City in such an accident.

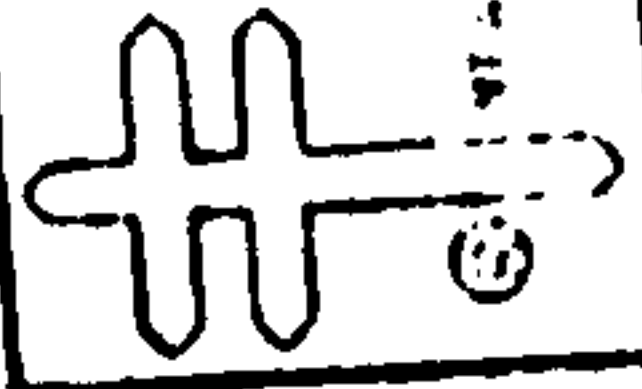
