On 12/19/63, at 8:15 AM, the writer telephonically contacted Mrs. MARGUERITE OSWALD per her request. Mrs. OSWALD stated she telephonically contacted Postal Inspector STEPHENS on 12/18/63 and advised him of her receipt of obscene letters. Although STEPHENS was not indignant over the phone, she could tell from his voice that he had personal animosity for her and was not sympathetic with her personal problems. Mrs. OSWALD stated she told STEPHENS that she knew her rights as an American citizen, and that he, as a Federal employee, should keep his personal animosity to himself, and that necessary steps should be taken to stop the obscene letters. Mrs. OSWALD stated STEPHENS told her he would send a man out to pick up the letters.

Mrs. OSWALD went on to say that the people of Fort Worth "hate" her and are not sympathetic with her personal problems. She stated that if STEPHENS has not picked up the obscene letters by 11:00 AM, this date, she would send them to the Postmaster at Arlington, Virginia, where the letters originated, for appropriate action.

Mrs. OSWALD further indicated that she would make a trip to Washington, D. C., if she does not get satisfaction soon. She also stated that if action is not taken, she is sure the New York Press would be sympathetic to her problems, even though the Fort Worth Press would not be.

Mrs. OSWALD stated she had no complaint to file with the FBI but only wanted to let off a little steam to the writer.

A confidential source advised at about 4:25 P.M. that he was married with a family and that he was employed as a safety engineer for an insurance firm. He said that he had admitted his wife to the hospital that day so that this, coupled with recent events in Dallas, Texas, has caused him to call the FBI to relate the following incident:

He stated he was working in Dallas, Texas, for two weeks in early June, 1963. His wife and family were residing at the time in Kingsville, Texas.

He stopped into the Patio Lounge, a bar located on a one-way main street in Dallas, Texas, one evening where he eventually struck up a conversation with a stranger. He stated that he believes that the Patio Lounge was within a couple of blocks of the area of strip-joints said to be owned by JACK RUBY. He claimed that this individual was in the export-import business and that he had an office in the same block as the Patio Lounge. This individual, name unknown, had just returned from overseas.

The source recalled that this individual was well dressed and seemed well educated. He stated that he thought the man might have been a "queer" at first but that this individual "picked up" two women at the bar in the Patio Lounge, and the four of them spent the evening together. He described this man as being white, male, American, about 44-46 years of age, 6 feet tall, 180 pounds, black hair, and that he resembled Texas Governor CONNALLY in a way, though it certainly was not him.

He advised that they spent a couple of hours at the Patio Lounge prior to "picking up" the two women and moved on to another bar. He recalled that both of the women were employed in the advertising department of one of the Dallas newspapers. He said that they accepted ads over the telephone and that they usually assumed a code name in their work, selecting the name of some Texas city. He recalled that one of the women used the name, "Mrs. AUSTIN" in her work. He added that the unknown male, who was his companion that night, was not drunk at the time but that he continued to make angry and,

as he recalls it now, highly inflammatory statements against President KENNEDY.

He advised that this man claimed to him to have made several trips to Washington, D.C., to see President KENNEDY, but that he was always unsuccessful in these attempts. He recalled that this individual claimed that he "had enough on President KENNEDY to impeach him." He also recalled that this individual gave him his personal calling card and that he carried it for some time but that he later discarded it. He recalled that this individual mentioned to him that one night they were together in early June, 1963, in the Patio Lounge in Dallas, Texas, to the effect that "you can count on one thing for sure. If President KENNEDY ever comes to Dallas, he will be assassinated."

[redacted] advised that the management and executive officers of Jaggars - Chiles - Stovall, Inc., are extremely "right wing" in political outlook and in opinion are fanatically "right wing".

[redacted] made available a proof of a prospectus which had been printed at the Jaggars - Chiles - Stovall, Inc., entitled "FACT, INC., Free American Committee of Texas, Inc." This prospectus appears to be a description of common stock, par value \$1.00, and the stock is described as being securities that had not been approved or disapproved by the Securities and Exchange Commission or passed upon by the Securities and Exchange Commission as to accuracy or adequacy of the prospectus. The prospectus described FACT, Inc., as a company organized in June, 1962, pursuant to the laws of Texas, under the name Free American Committee of Texas, Inc. The prospectus pointed out that the company was organized to launch an attack on Communism, Socialism, and American Apathy.

At 2:05 PM, 12/16/63, Mrs. MARGUERITE OSWALD telephonically advised she had received two letters on 12/13/63 and two letters on 12/16/63, all postmarked Arlington, Virginia. The letters were described as "nasty and obscene" but not of a threatening nature.

On 12/18/63, at 9:05 AM, Mrs. OSWALD was telephonically contacted, at which time she stated she had received four more obscene letters.

Mrs. OSWALD was advised that the FBI has no jurisdiction in reference to the obscene letters, and that she should contact LLOYD STEVENS, Postal Inspector, Fort Worth, Texas. Mr. STEVENS' telephone number was furnished to Mrs. OSWALD.

During the course of the conversation, Mrs. OSWALD stated she was getting sick of the constant "run around", and that she was getting no action on her complaints. She stated she had previously contacted Postal Inspector STEVENS about her mail being opened by the Fort-Worth Police Department.

She stated she probably would not contact STEVENS about the obscene letters, because he gave her no satisfaction previously. Mrs. OSWALD indicated she would probably contact the Postmaster in Arlington, Virginia, in regard to the obscene letters.

Mrs. OSWALD advised she contacted Mr. SORRELS of the Secret Service in Dallas about the obscene letters, and he also advised her of the jurisdiction of the Postal Inspectors.

Mrs. OSWALD stated she is very disgusted about the lack of action and is considering hiring an attorney of taking any other action that might get results for her.

Inspector J. R. MALLEY telephonically advised that the New York Times had contacted the Department and were trying to cause some trouble concerning the fact that apparently the FBI, Secret Service, and the Department of Justice would not let MARINA OSWALD be available for interview. He stated that Mr. BELMONT was going to have to make some report today to the Department, and BELMONT had asked whether the Agents who were regularly contacting her knew whether she was amenable to being interviewed by the press, or wanted to be, or did she possibly say she didn't want to be interviewed at this time.

I talked to Agents HEITMAN and BOGUSLAV and called Mr. MALLEY back and pointed out to him that MARINA OSWALD has a Mr. JAMES MARTIN in whose home she is presently living. She also has an Attorney by the name of THORNE from Grand Prairie and that quite some time ago, they were very interested in having her interviewed by representatives of the press and have the material copyrighted. I pointed out that she had received one offer from a German newspaper in the amount of \$12,500.00 and that there was no doubt but that Mr. MARTIN was very interested in securing as much money as possible; in fact, he had told the Agents that he wanted to expose her enough to get all the money she could. I also pointed out to him that from the inception of this thing, we had consistently insisted that it was Secret Service's responsibility to keep her from the press if they so desired, but that we would not make any recommendation.

I also noted that while the Agents felt that they could get her to say she did not care to be interviewed at this time, we certainly had no control over her once we left, and if MARTIN learned this information, he could well use it. I also pointed out to him that while she has been cooperating, and at the present time, BOGUSLAV is the only Russian speaking

and SCHELL were sponsored by the hotel for such employment and immigrated. After a term of employment, the Buffalo Club of the Townhouse Hotel Chain, Houston, employed GUNTHER and SCHELL. [redacted] who is 40 years of age, described GUNTHER and SCHELL as 20 years old and sexual perverts, who eat and drink their earnings away and give no thought to the future. They look upon the U. S. as a land of easy money. [redacted] seriously doubted if either ever had a serious thought regarding the political situation in the U. S. or is capable of such thought.

[redacted] who had no social contact with these individuals, resigned his position at the Buffalo Club on 11/15/63, and left there for his present address in Florida. When he departed, GUNTHER was still working as a bartender and he has had no contact with him since. However, a few days before [redacted] departure, SCHELL resigned and headed for California. [redacted] supplied him with the name of a friend in the restaurant business who might assist him in gaining employment. This person is OTTO THIELEMAN, 5721 Carlton Way, Hollywood, Calif. [redacted] speculated that GUNTHER may have joined SCHELL in California after leaving the Buffalo Club.

[redacted] recalled that SCHELL had an old brown convertible with Texas license. The canvas top was ripped. It was his impression that the car was a low-priced popular make, such as a Ford or Chevrolet.
