**Train Sniper
Possibility
In Slaying**

NEW YORK (AP) — Police are investigating the possibility that a sniper aboard a passing train fired the shot that killed a young secretary as she sat at a vanity table in her furnished room Sunday night.

Glenda Unterreiner, 26, a native of St. Louis, Mo., who came to New York six weeks ago, apparently was setting her hair when the shot crashed through her closed window, which faces the Long Island Railroad tracks, about 50 feet away.

The bullet penetrated her heart. She staggered into the hallway and collapsed.

The landlady, Mrs. Ilse Norton, told police she heard a loud crack, then a scream, and found Miss Unterreiner's pajama-clad body on the floor.

Detectives are trying to determine whether the slaying was calculated or accidental. The window blind was up and the curtain was not drawn.

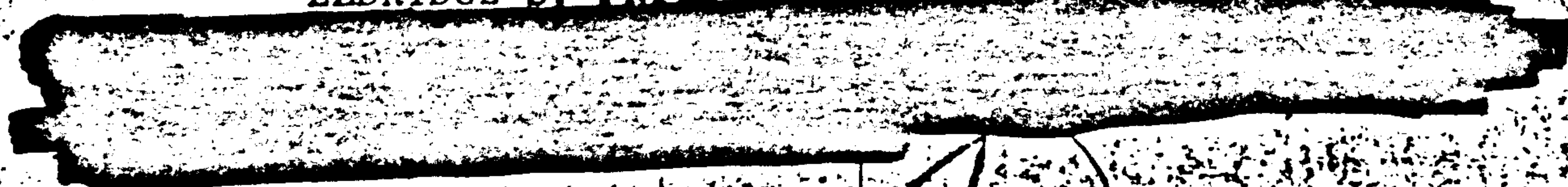

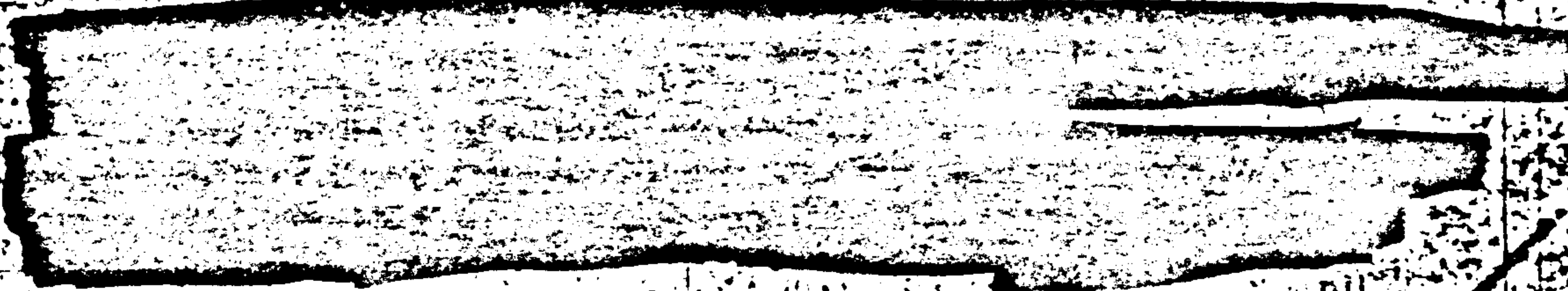

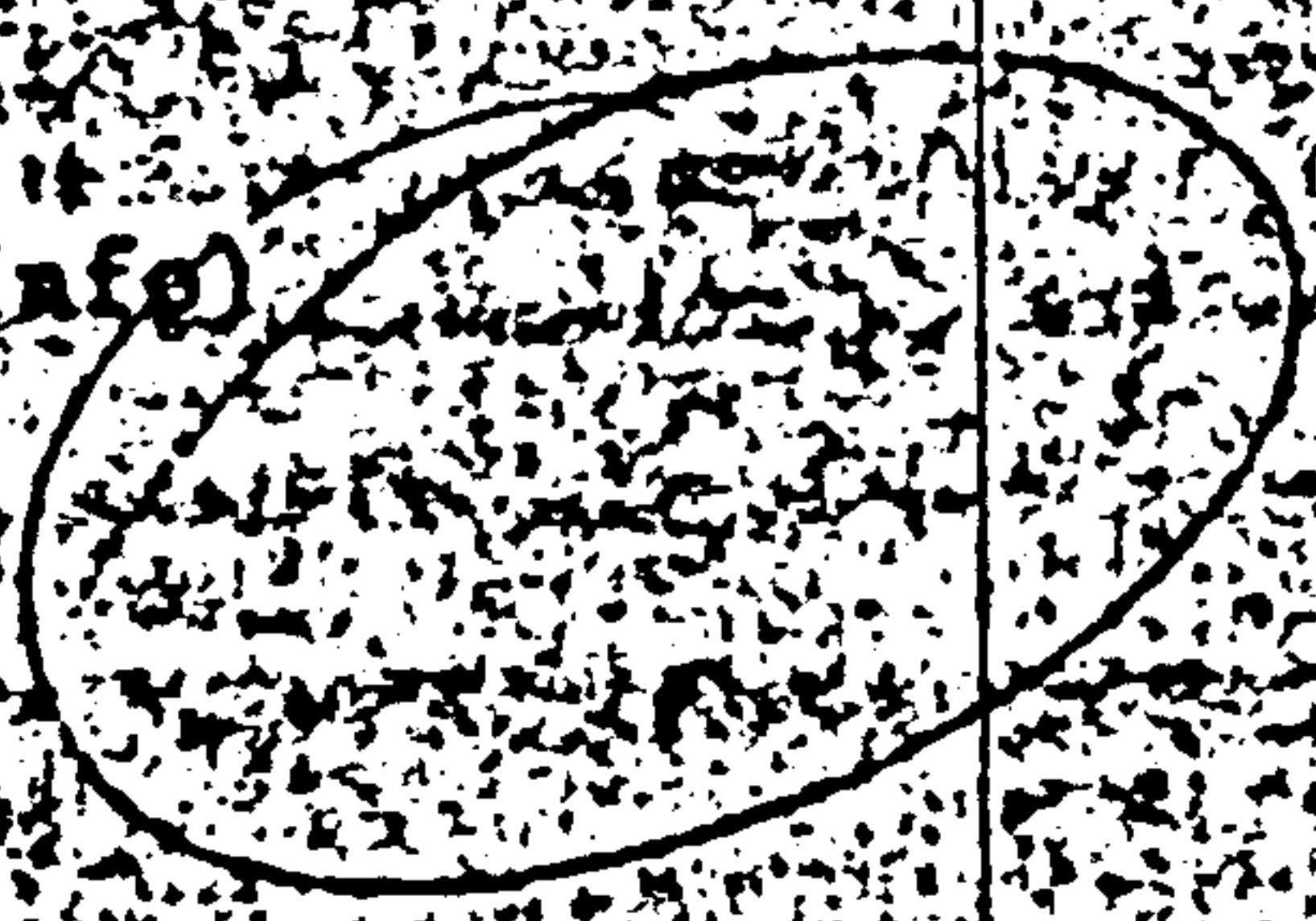

Mrs. HATTIE STEIN, age 71, 3721 Colonial, Dallas, Texas, appeared at the Dallas Office, on 1/10/64, and advised that several days ago she noticed an article in the Dallas newspaper, which stated that OSWALD had a map in his possession on the date of his arrest.

Mrs. STEIN stated that on 10/22/63, she was at the intersection of Metropolitan and Central Expressway, Dallas, Texas, and an individual grabbed her "tote bag", which contained a map which she had purchased at Enoch's Drug Store several years ago. She said that she had placed marks and dots on this map--a dot indicating downtown Dallas, another dot for Love Field, and other marks. She said that she thought the map which OSWALD had in his possession may possibly belong to her.

Mrs. STEIN stated that on the night before the assassination of President JOHN FITZGERALD KENNEDY, she had a dream that the assassination of the President would occur on the following day in the same manner in which the assassination actually did occur. She said that she was invited to watch the motorcade by her neighbors, but had refused to travel to downtown Dallas inasmuch as she had had the above dream on the previous night.

Mrs. STEIN stated that during the past several months, unknown individuals had stolen all of the furniture from her apartment building at 3721 Colonial, and that approximately one week previous someone had attempted to kill her. She stated she had reported the above information to the police, and that they had told her this was the work of her "neighbors". She said that the police refused to make any type of investigation.

Mrs. STEIN thereafter rambled from one subject to another and the interview was terminated.

The following investigation was conducted by SA JAMES P. HOSTY, Jr., at Irving, Texas:

On 1-9-64 [REDACTED] Irving, Texas, an established source, advised after reading the above-noted letter, that it was written in German and it concerns a tourist in Dallas, Texas who described the scene of the assassination of President KENNEDY as he was seeing it. The letter described the fact that the flags were at half-mast and that he was staying at a motel near the Parkland Hospital where President KENNEDY died. [REDACTED] said that there was no indication in this letter that this person knew anything personally concerning the assassination of President KENNEDY, and it contained no information of value.

In view of the above, no further action is recommended and this letter is being made a part of the 1-A exhibit of this file.

The following individuals were contacted on the dates indicated in an effort to locate WILLIAM McEWAN DUFF, who was allegedly seen with LEE HARVEY OSWALD about seven or eight months ago on one occasion:

On 1-10-64, Mr. CHARLES H. HOLLOWAY, Apartment 123, 5420 Lewis Street, was reinterviewed at his place of employment, Skillern's Drug Store, 5605 East Grand Avenue, Dallas. Mr. HOLLOWAY advised that he recalls after talking to the FBI, that he met WILLIAM McEWAN DUFF during May, 1963. He said that he was able to verify this fact since he bought a new automobile on 5-9-63 and DUFF was with him when he picked up the car.

Mr. HOLLOWAY said that he believes that a woman by the name of PAULINE M. MINTON, a real estate broker who resides at 4216 Lomo Alto, Dallas, was known to DUFF since he recalls taking DUFF over to this address or some address very close to this address to pick up some clothes. HOLLOWAY said that it is possible DUFF was "bumming off" PAULINE MINTON as he has done with almost everyone else that he has had any contact with.

HOLLOWAY said that DUFF also claimed to have worked for GEORGE BIRNIE, 3834 Casa Ridge, the owner of "Birnie Bows, 12429 North Central Expressway, Dallas. HOLLOWAY said that he does not know whether this was true, however, DUFF had a "Birnie Bow" which is a hunting or target bow made by GEORGE BIRNIE.

HOLLOWAY said that he also believes that DUFF knew the man who runs "DEE's Lounge", 3220 North Fitzhugh, Dallas. HOLLOWAY said that DUFF has been in this place and acted as if he were friendly with the manager.

HOLLOWAY said that it is possible that DUFF may have also known two girls by the name INGRID and VERA, both last names unknown, who are employed by the Merchants State Bank on Ross Avenue in the vicinity of Sears-Roebuck. HOLLOWAY said that these girls also live in the apartment building at his address, 5420 Lewis Street.

It should be noted that the Dallas Police Department record for DUFF indicated that he lived at 4919 San Jacinto, Dallas, Texas.

On 1-12-64, Mrs. OLIVE SABRACE, manager of 4919 San Jacinto, said that there was no record of anyone by the name of WILLIAM DUFF or WILLIAM McDUFF having resided at 4919 San Jacinto. She said it is possible that this man may have stayed with some other tenant and gave this as an address. Mrs. SABRACE said that she has only been the manager of this apartment building since August, 1963; however, the owner, Mr. J. A. BOZEMAN, address unknown, telephone DA. 1-9003, may be able to furnish some information concerning DUFF, since he would have more complete records.

Sirs,

I am attaching a map of Dallas that I happen to pick up at the Dallas Hotel on the night of December 10, 1963. I was at a District Meeting called for by my Manager December 10th and 11th (employed by Western Weighing and Inspection Bureau, 202 Union Station, Dallas) and spent the night of the 10th at the Dallas Hotel, I'm sure it was room 735.

On leaving the next morning I pick up this map from the dresser drawer of Room 735 as it was of interest to me. I lived in Dallas from 1943 to 1948 and again in 1952 for a very short time. By coincidence I lived in the same house xx(1026 S. Beckly) as Lee Oswald. This was back in 1943 and first months of 1944. The landlady's name then was Mrs. Gladys Arrant (or similiar), she having married Mr. Johnson in later years.

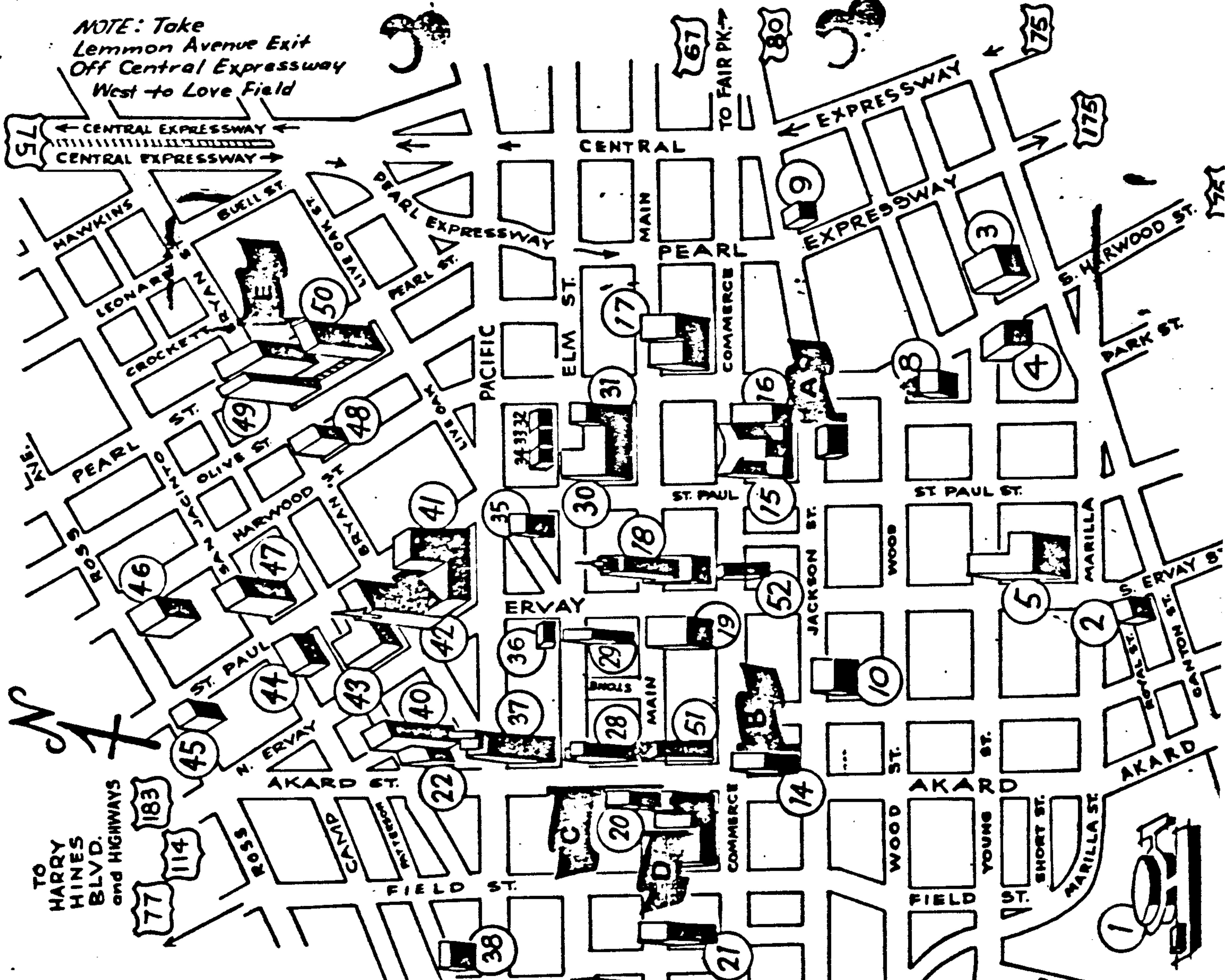
I checked into the Lawrence Hotel the next night and it was here I noticed the markings on the map (Downtown Dallas side). I thought at first the motel people might have done this just for the information to their customers. However I have since observed the little round circle mark entered in Ferris Park and this hasn't made sense to me as I kept up with the news pretty closely after President's Kennedys death. Its probably nothing to this but the map is yours for what ever you can make of it. Having lived in the same house as Oswald and then picking up this map with the markings on it just naturally bothers me and will do so unless I do get rid of the map.

The writing on the greater Dallas side (as far as I can tell) is all mine. The long numbers were cars I was looking at out at Mockingbird Rambler and the Box 3907, Curtis Cotton, is one of my fellow workers.

Sorry to bother you with this but I realize sometimes that even the smallest clue can be of big help in your business.

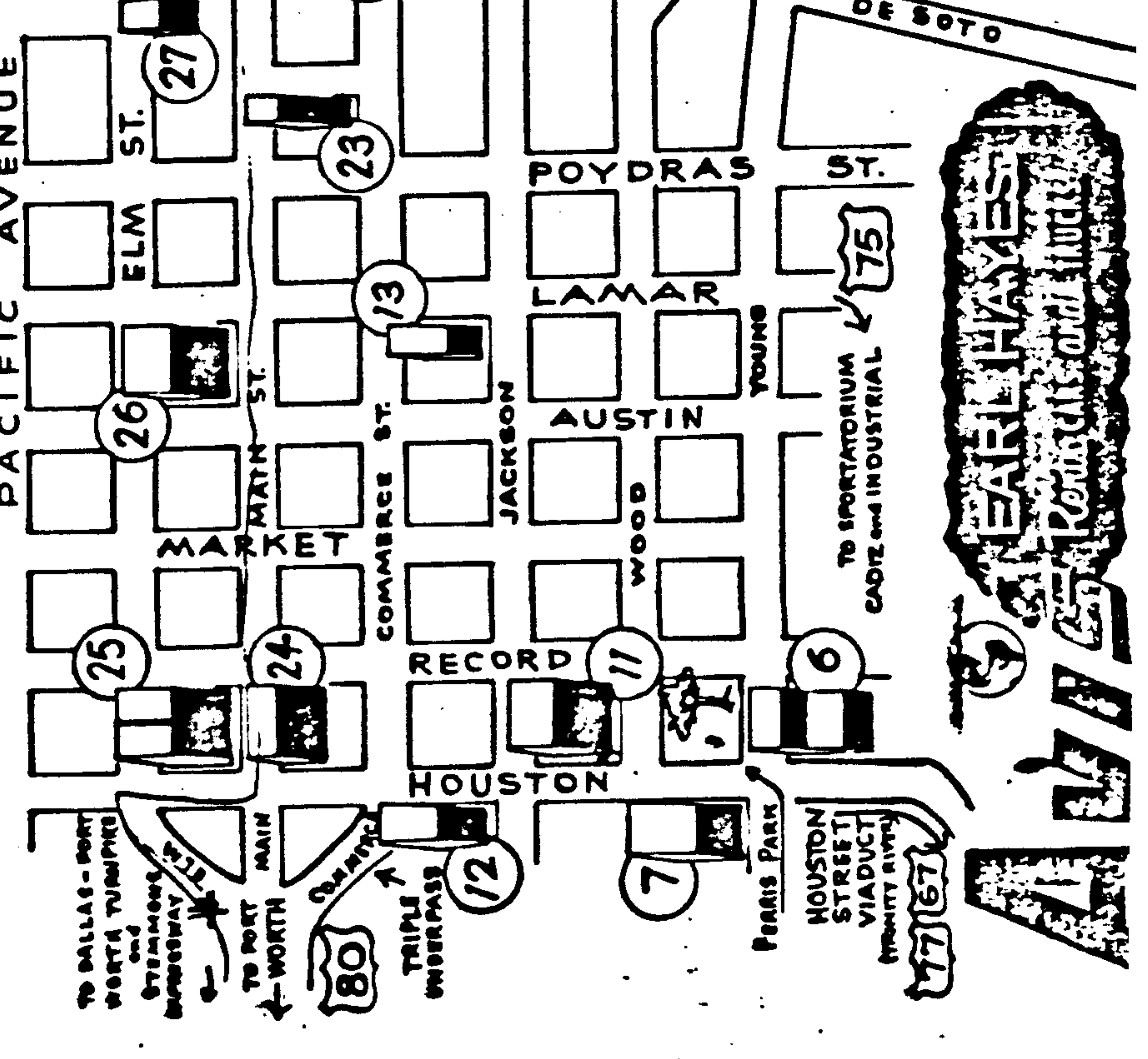

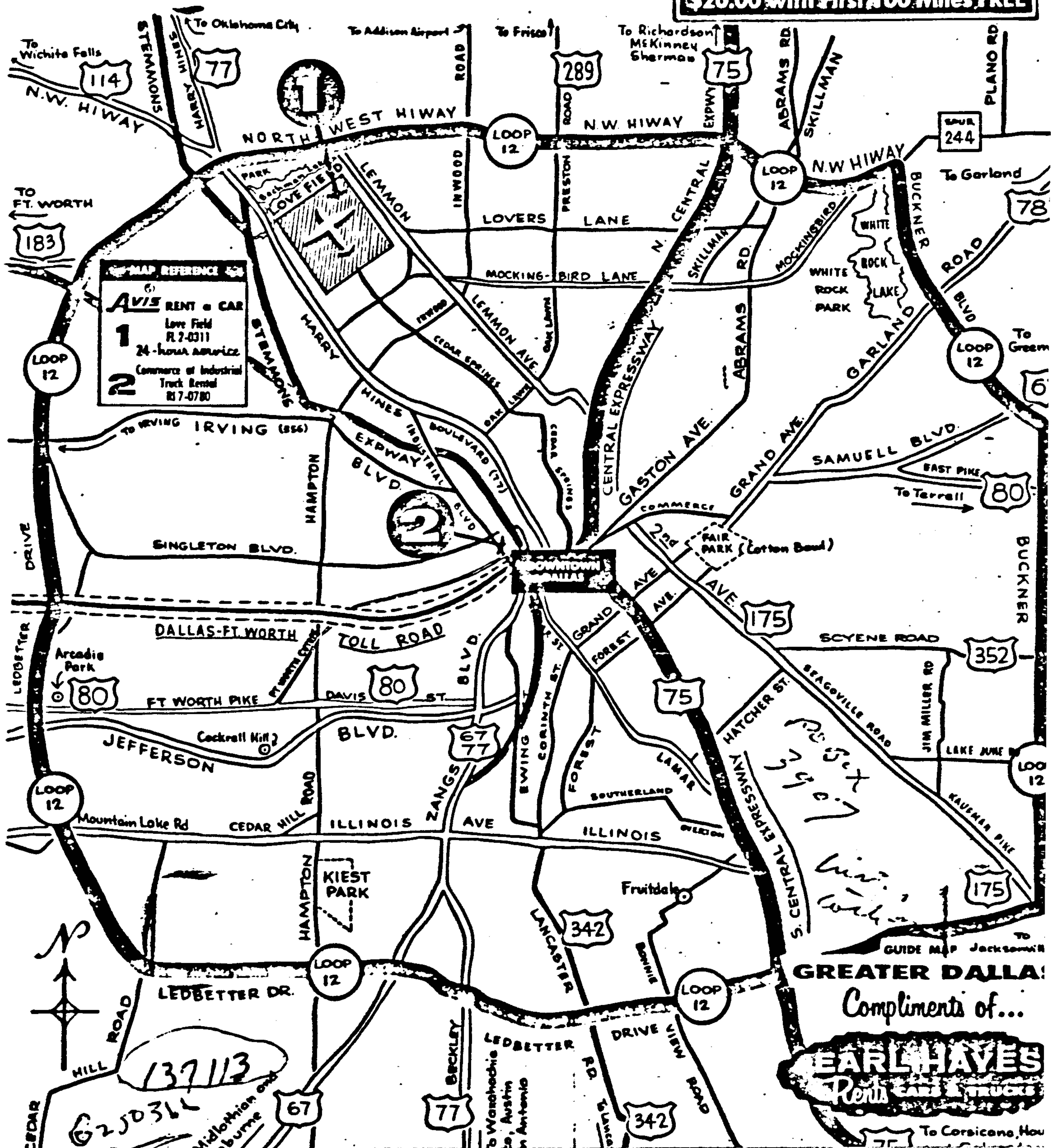

On 1/14/64, Mr. WILLIAM R. MORSE, retired electronics manufacturer from College Park, Maryland, presently at 306 Wailupe Circle, Honolulu, Hawaii, appeared at the office and introduced himself by giving to me the enclosed two letters from KENDALL J. FIELDER (retired General, U. S. Army). The attached letters are self explanatory and Mr. MORSE was particularly interested in knowing how to get in touch with Mrs. MARINA OSWALD. He stated he had in mind the plan of possibly trying to get Mrs. OSWALD and her two children to move to Honolulu and he was attempting to get Rotary Clubs in Honolulu to put up sufficient money to provide her a home there. He was doing this as a philanthropist, with the idea that Honolulu, being a mixture of all races, would be an ideal place for her to be rehabilitated and raise her children. He stated, of course, the Rotary there would not want to do this in the event she was not deserving.

I definitely at this point pointed out to Mr. MORSE that the FBI certainly could make no comment whatsoever in this regard. He was advised that Mrs. OSWALD is apparently represented by Mr. JOHN M. THORNE of the law firm of THORNE & LEACH, 302 West College Street, Grand Prairie, Texas, telephone AN 2-2608. He advised that he would get in touch with Mr. THORNE.

Houston has interviewed employees of Continental Trailways Bus Station who sell tickets and were on duty during pertinent period of 9/25 - 26/63, and no one has been located who could recall selling ticket to OSWALD.

On 1/9/64, ANN LINDSEY, Report Clerk, Continental Trailways, Houston, Texas, advised that during period 9/24/63 through 9/26/63 only one bus ticket was sold at the Houston terminal for passage from Houston to Laredo, Texas. No tickets were sold during this period for travel from Houston through to Mexico City. The ticket sold for Laredo, Texas, carried number 112230 and was valued at \$10.60. Miss LINDSEY explained that portion of this ticket retained by Continental Trailways was forwarded to the Dallas office of that company for permanent filing. This ticket stub should contain rubber stamp impression showing date, but not hour, on which ticket sold. Ticket stub will also bear "die number" which will identify specific Continental employee selling ticket. Miss LINDSEY believes this ticket was sold by ROBERT STEVENSON, who has been assigned die number 5, but she could not be sure. She stated above ticket stub should be available at Continental Trailways Bus Company, 2805 Logan, Dallas, Texas, and suggested that initial inquiry be directed to Mr. CONNIE WALTERS, in charge of that office.



While stationed at this base, he resided in a six-man quonset hut for several weeks with DONALD OSBOURNE, BOB ALLEN and three other Marines he could not recall. He does not recall LEE HARVEY OSWALD as one of the three other Marines living in this hut. TESSEM does not recall ever meeting OSWALD and is sure he would remember such a meeting in light of recent events.

Dear Captain Fritz:

I write representing Mrs. Marina N. Oswald, widow of Lee Harvey Oswald, deceased. In telephone conversations with you, Mr. Paul W. Leech was advised that the property taken from the person of Lee Harvey Oswald and that confiscated from his rooming house and home was subsequently delivered to the Federal Bureau of Investigation. The property I speak of includes such items as clothing, pictures, letters, discharge papers, his rifle, pistol and other personal items.

In a subsequent telephone conversation with the officer in charge of the local Federal Bureau of Investigation Office, I am advised that the property may be re-delivered to you after it has been reviewed and examined by the President's Commission.

It is the desire of my client that all items held by either your office or the Justice Department, or that which may be delivered back to your office shall be turned over to me in her behalf.

Kindly advise me when you have received any such property and are prepared to deliver same.
