1. Oklahoma City teletype to Bureau and Houston dated 12/23/63 captioned "LLOYD JOHN WILSON, aka., RACIAL MATTERS, OO San Francisco" was handled in Houston File 157-356 under that caption. It is noted LLOYD JOHN WILSON was reportedly discharged from the U. S. Air Force.

The Houston Office, in the above Oklahoma City teletype, was requested to interview Mrs. A. L. investigation in October, 1963, in which San Francisco was Office of Origin. Houston pointed out that San Francisco had previously interviewed Mrs. EDITH SEITSINGER who had confirmed that in July, 1963, she and WILSON had driven to Houston, Texas, where they visited her sister, Mrs. ESTHER METZ, and that WILSON became angry with Mrs. METZ and left. Houston made numerous efforts to locate Mrs. METZ for interview without success, and inasmuch as the information desired from Mrs. METZ had previously been confirmed from other sources the WILSON case was placed in an RUC status on 12/24/63.

His time on this holiday and Saturdays and Sundays has been accounted for to such an extent that it would appear almost impossible for OSWALD to have been at Beaufort, South Carolina.

On 1/23/64, [REDACTED] of the Dallas PD advised SA GEMBERLING confidentially, stating that under no circumstances should his name be revealed, that a source of his on 1/22/64 had advised that District Attorney HENRY WADE had supposedly received a call from the President's Commission to appear immediately in Washington, D.C. concerning information that WADE supposedly had that OSWALD was on the pay roll of the FBI at \$200.00 per month, and had a code name and number assigned to him and that SA HOSTY was supposedly a non existent person and that that was just a code name used by the FBI. b7D

I called Inspector MALLEY and advised him of this information, plus the fact that a reporter had called me, indicating that an article had appeared in the Nation Magazine just off the press, which he had not seen but he understood it indicated that OSWALD was an informant of the FBI and that he thought that this article was supposed to have claimed the source of their information was District Attorney HENRY WADE.

Mr. MALLEY stated that there had been numerous articles such as this appearing in the "Daily Worker" and "The Peoples Word", and that possibly this article was a rehash of that. I told him I planned to call WADE concerning another matter and would bring this up.

WADE called me at approximately 10:15 AM and during the course of the conversation, I mentioned to him that I had received information that possibly he had indicated that OSWALD was on our pay roll and was an informant for supposedly \$200.00 per month. He stated that he had never received any such information, had never given out any such information, and knew nothing about it. He did state that back sometime in late December, LONNIE HUDKINS, a reporter for The Houston Post, came over to him and posed some leading questions about whether OSWALD was in informant of the FBI or some Government agency.

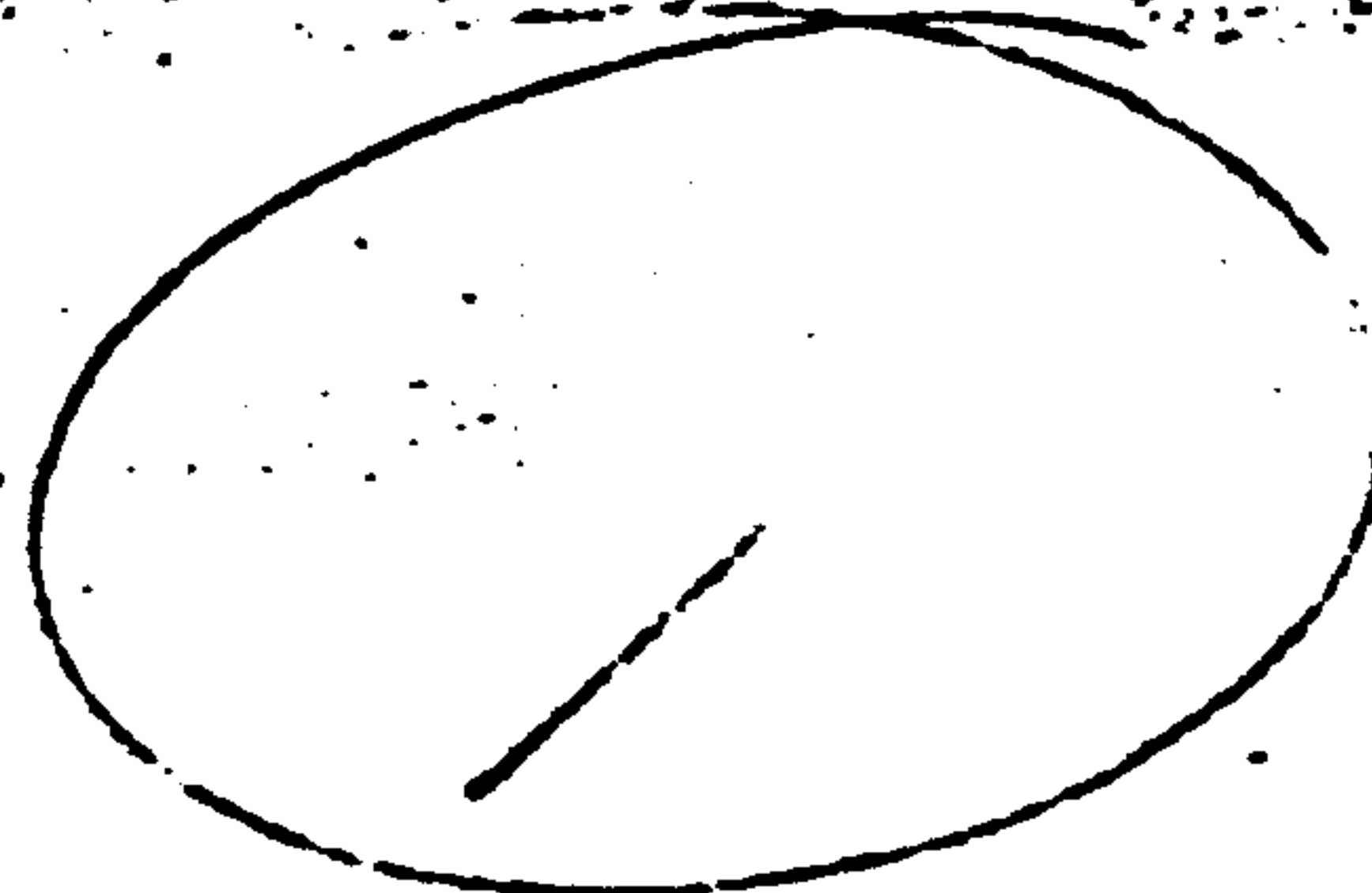

On November 23, 1963, Mr. LLOYD W. HILBERT, residence 1440 West Gambrell, employment 100 University Drive, Fort Worth, Texas, advised that on November 18, 1963, he was in a meeting with GEORGE SAULTANIAN and JOHN ADGER in the lobby of the Blackstone Hotel.

HILBERT stated he overheard an individual making a telephone call to North Manchester, Indiana. He stated that he was standing close by and introduced himself to this individual and asked the individual if he was from North Manchester, Indiana. This individual had said, "I have been there". HILBERT stated that the individual apparently was making a person-to-person call to someone at the Indiana - Lawrence Bank and Trust Company, North Manchester, Indiana. HILBERT stated that he did not hear any conversation that this individual had with the party on the other end of the line. He stated that the man gave his name as OSWALD. HILBERT stated he is sure that the individual stated his first name, but HILBERT did not recall it. HILBERT stated that this individual was somewhat aloof, and they did not actually engage in any conversation because about the time he spoke to this individual, the connection was made on the other end of the line. He stated that the individual was dressed in a blue military type of uniform and was holding his hat.

HILBERT stated that this individual had the same general physical appearance of LEE OSWALD, but he could not identify the pictures of OSWALD that he has seen in the newspapers and on television as being the individual with whom he spoke in the lobby of the Blackstone Hotel. HILBERT stated it was his recollection that the conversation with OSWALD occurred at approximately 4:30 to 4:45 PM on November 18, 1963.

On November 26, 1963, Mr. GEORGE SAULTANIAN, residence 4351 East Line Road, Fort Worth, Texas, employment 100 University Drive, advised that he recalled that LLOYD HILBERT had spoken to an individual in the lobby of the Blackstone Hotel on November 18, 1963, and this individual was in a military uniform. SAULTANIAN believed the individual was a Second Lieutenant in the U. S. Air Force.

SAULTANIAN advised that it was his recollection that this individual identified himself by name as LEE OSWALD. He stated this immediately came to his mind when he heard the news broadcast that LEE OSWALD had been arrested and subsequently charged with the assassination of President KENNEDY.

SAULTANIAN stated as he recalled when Mr. HILBERT spoke to the individual who stated his name was OSWALD, that it was approximately 2:00 PM. SAULTANIAN was questioned further about the time of the occurrence, and he stated that he could not recall just what time the conversation took place. SAULTANIAN insisted that this individual introduced himself as LEE OSWALD.

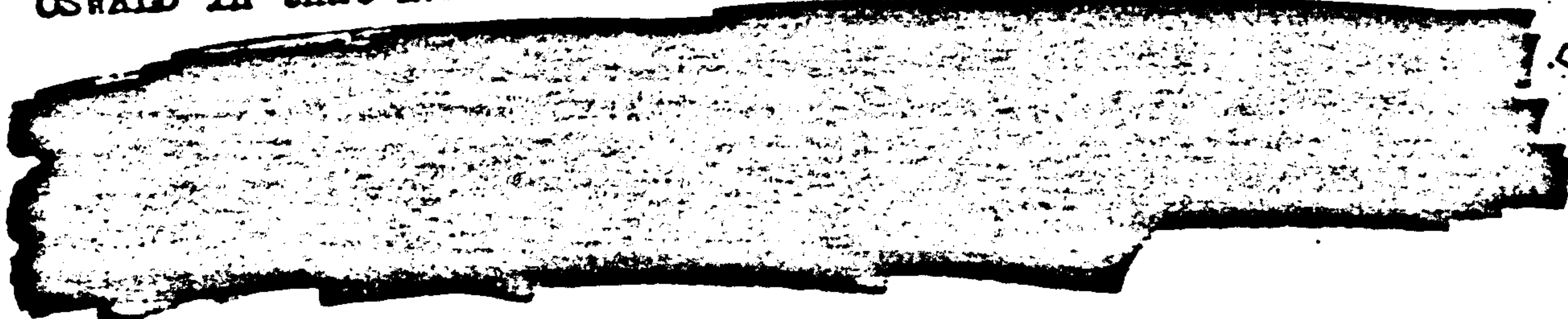

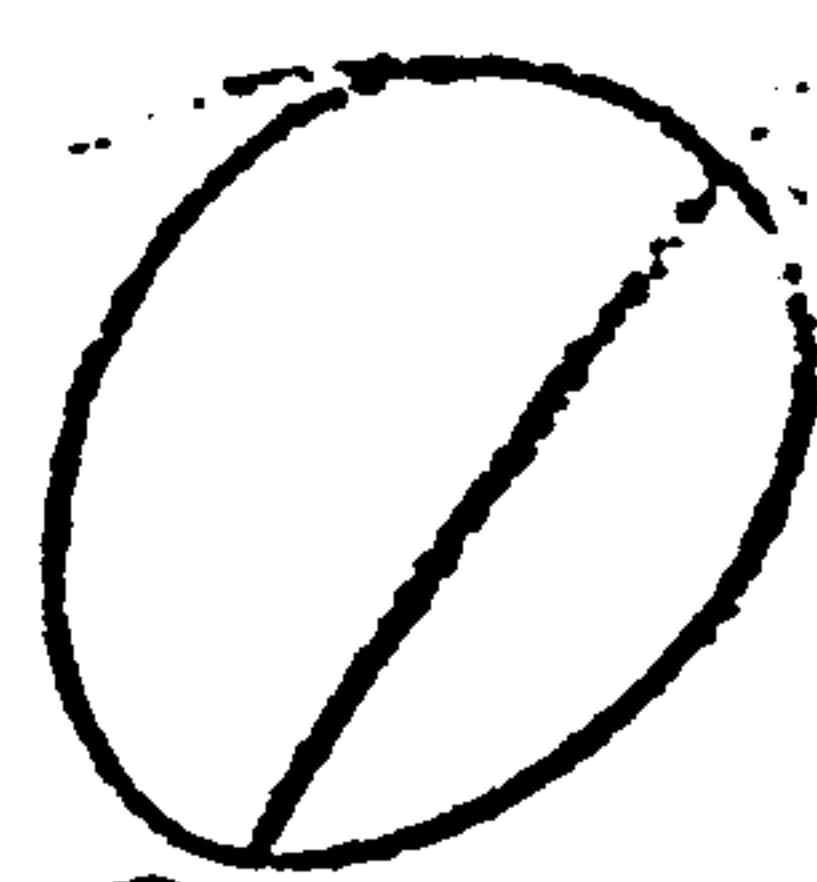

For the information of Los Angeles, VEREEN ALEXANDER advised Atlanta Office 11/25/63, that while a student at Sophie Newcomb College, she and ROBERT HOFFMAN, a Tulane University student, published a newspaper, "The Reed", which she described as a very liberal paper. She said that ROBERT HOFFMAN's brother DAVID HOFFMAN, held a party during the summer in his apartment and identified a number of individuals who attended this party. She had a strong belief that OSWALD may have possibly been present.

All of the individuals named by ALEXANDER as having attended this party, have been interviewed in an effort to determine whether OSWALD attended. It is noted that in Mrs. ALEXANDER's letter, she stated that she received a letter from one of her friends who indicated that he had been interviewed and mentioned that "a mutual friend in New Orleans had written him saying that he had known OSWALD".

The New Orleans Office has been attempting to learn the identities of all acquaintances of OSWALD in New Orleans and to interview these individuals.

District Attorney HENRY WADE telephonically advised at 11:30 AM today that he had received a telephone call from HUGH AINSWORTH of The Dallas Morning News, inquiring if he was acquainted with former SA WILLIAM W. TURNER. Mr. WADE advised that he did not know this individual and had checked records available to him and found no record of such a former Special Agent.

AINS WORTH then read portions of an article which he stated had been written by WILLIAM W. TURNER, and it is reportedly being published in the Saga Magazine to be released 1/28/64. In essence, Mr. WADE advised that the article made very disparaging remarks concerning the FBI's handling of OSWALD with respect to the assassination of President KENNEDY and rendered the opinion of former Agent TURNER that the FBI could have prevented the assassination had they furnished information concerning OSWALD to the Secret Service and the local police.

ADDENDUM

SAC J. GORDON SHANKLIN

I called the Bureau and talked to Inspector ROBERT WICK. He stated he was well aware of the fact TURNER had written an article and was attempting to get it published. He didn't know whether it was going to be published or not. He thought probably instead of it actually being published in the Saga, that he might have just submitted the proposed article to The Dallas Morning News.

WICK stated that of course TURNER was well known to the Bureau as he is suing the Department, the Director, Civil Service Commission, etc. in an attempt to get back as an Agent, and he has previously with one JACK LEVINE, submitted various articles and this is just a rehash of what has been

told. Inspector WICK also stated he had received a call from The New York Times representative here in Dallas concerning whether OSWALD had been employed by the FBI, and he had unequivocally told him that OSWALD had never been employed by the FBI and that I was authorized in connection with any such inquiries to make that flat statement. He suggested, however, there would be no need to contact AINSWORTH as they were handling this matter in Washington.

Mr. HUGH AINSWORTH telephonically advised that he has allegedly an advance copy of the Saga Magazine, wherein one WILLIAM W. TURNER alleges that he was an Agent of the FBI for about 10½ years. Apparently this has been sent out with the idea that the local newspaper here will highlight his allegations, in addition to having the article printed in Saga.

I told Mr. AINSWORTH that I thought that some individual by that name had been an Agent, but that he had gotten into considerable difficulty and had either resigned or been dismissed, and that he had fought the matter through Civil Service and was now suing the FBI and the Department in an attempt to get reinstated. I advised him this was in strictest confidence. He stated he would like to know whether this type of information could be verified and that he would call me back in a short period of time.

I talked to Inspector ROBERT WICK. He stated that I could tell Mr. AINSWORTH confidentially and not to be quoted as far as anything from the FBI, that TURNER did work for the FBI for approximately ten years and that about one year ago, he was dismissed with prejudice for violation of rules. He subsequently took this matter up with the Civil Service Commission and that the Civil Service Commission had a hearing where both the FBI and TURNER were present, and the Civil Service Commission upheld the dismissal with prejudice. He has filed a suit in Washington in the Appeals Court there. WICK stated that if the paper wanted to verify the thing and they have a representative in Washington, they could go to the Civil Service Commission with his name, and he felt that the matter could be verified as this hearing was a matter of public record. He stressed that he didn't want AINSWORTH to be quoting us, but that if he wanted to verify it, he could do so in that manner.

At 4:30 PM HUGH AINSWORTH called and he was advised per instructions of Inspector WICK. He stated he would have his Washington representative check with Civil Service Commission.

Re your telephone call with Mr. WILLIAM BRANNIGAN, of the Bureau, wherein he asks the following questions:

(1) Why did I leave my name and telephone number with Mrs. RUTH PAINE?

(2) Do I have any idea as to how OSWALD could have secured license number of my car.

At the time I interviewed Mrs. RUTH PAINE on 11/1/63, she was very cooperative and furnished OSWALD's place of employment, and stated she did not have his residence address; however, she would attempt to obtain it for me and would furnish it to me as soon as she could. She asked for my name and a manner in which she could get in contact with me. I then gave her my name and the office telephone number. I do not recall whether she wrote it down or if I wrote it down for her.

I believe MARINA OSWALD in all likelihood copied down the license number of Dallas car DL 22 on either November 1 or November 5, 1963. It should be noted that Mrs. PAINE's house is located on a very small lot and is close to the street. Any person with normal 20/20 eye sight should be able to readily get an auto license number from an automobile parked in front of Mrs. PAINE's residence; therefore MARINA OSWALD could have easily obtained this license number.

SAC SHANKLIN: I telephonically furnished the substance of the above to Mr. WILLIAM BRANNIGAN while he was on the phone, and SA HOSTY thereafter prepared me the memorandum.

(3) In the Nation Magazine article by HAROLD FELDMAN, it is indicated that "after the murder of the President, the police find in his room in addition to the wad of money, several expensive cameras and rolls of film. BRANNIGAN wants the answer to the following question in the same teletype. Was there any expensive cameras or rolls of film found?"
