On 2/5/64, Mr. J. PAUL McCULLOUGH, Claims Examiner, III, Insurance Department, Texas Employment Commission, TEC Building, Austin, Texas, advised SA GEORGE W. H. CARLSON that sometime in November, 1963, he recalls receiving a letter from an individual who apparently was attempting to file a false claim. He stated that he has been unable to locate the letter, that he will continue to look for the letter; however, he doubts that he will ever find it, inasmuch as there are some 400,000 claims in the TEC office. He exhibited work papers reflecting his efforts to date to locate the letter which he recalled receiving.

Mr. McCULLOUGH stated that in substance the two-paragraph letter related that this individual who was making the claim indicated he probably would not receive due consideration just as "that person who appealed to Governor CONNALLY about resending a discharge from the Marine Corps and did not receive satisfaction."

Mr. McCULLOUGH said that the writer of the letter indicated he, the writer, might also have to take matters in his own hand. Mr. McCULLOUGH said the writer of the letter did not mention OSWALD by name and only described his appeal in a way that suggested to McCULLOUGH that the writer was referring to OSWALD.



SA LYNDAL L. SHANEYFELT, FBI Laboratory, called at 1:40 PM, this date, with reference to evidence item # 379 on the original inventory, which is the Ansco Flash Attachment for a camera. This item was delivered to the FBI Laboratory by SA DRAIN, and the inventory states it was obtained from the residence of Mrs. PAINE and Mrs. OSWALD.

Inspection by the Laboratory reveals the Ansco Flash Attachment does not fit either of the cameras belonging to OSWALD.

Assistant to the Director BELMONT has raised the question, "Who does the flash attachment belong to, and where is the camera that the flash attachment fits?" SA SHANEYFELT requested the reply today.

SA SHANEYFELT also advised that the camera furnished by Mr. NIXS is still being held temporarily by the Laboratory for comparison and study. He advised that the Commission has requested additional study which will take approximately 10 more days. requested that contact be made with Mr. NICKS to determine if he desires immediate return of his camera or if he is agreeable to the camera's being retained for an additional 10 days.

REQUESTED INTERVIEW OF LONNIE HUDKINS, REPORTER. HOUSTON POST

At 7:30 PM, 2/7/64, SAC ROBERT RIGHTMYER, Houston, advised that he had been instructed late in the afternoon by Mr. WILLIAM BRANNIGAN of the Bureau to locate and interview LONNIE HUDKINS, specific instructions being made to pin him down as to reported statements or information by HUDKINS to the effect that OSWALD had been paid \$200.00 per month from about September, 1962 as an informant for the FBI and he had symbol number 179. The Bureau wants him pinned down, have him put up, or shut up. They desire to get a signed statement if he is willing to give same.

RIGHTMYER stated that he had checked and found that HUDKINS had supposedly left Houston late in the afternoon or early evening, presumably driving to Dallas, Texas. He said supposedly HUDKINS had a home in Dallas and was listed in the telephone book and could be reached there.

A check of the telephone directory reflects ALONZO H. HUDKINS, III, address 117 Tuscany Way, telephone DA 7-2600. Telephone calls were made to this number up until approximately 11:00 PM and no answer was received.

At approximately 9:00 PM, I talked to Section Chief WILLIAM BRANNIGAN and he stated that the Commission was interested in what HUDKINS had to say; that apparently it was reported that he had alleged that LEE HARVEW OSWALD had been an informant of the FBI since September, 1962 and that he was being paid \$200.00 per month under symbol number 179. They wanted him very thoroughly interviewed, with particular reference to this statement. At the time of the interview, he should also be questioned concerning his article appearing in the Houston Post on Jan. 1, 1964

Mrs. BYRON advised me that when they did come from Houston up there, HUDKINS and his wife usually stayed, as far as she knew, at the house, since it had not been sold, but that she has heard nothing regarding their being here this weekend.

SAC RIGHTMYER was advised at approximately 7:30 AM, 2/8/64 that they had apparently not arrived here. He checked again, and had Agents go out there, and neighbors in Houston said they definitely left last night and were apparently planning on going to Dallas.

Bureau has gone to CIA and they stated they gave the photo to the FBI. Mrs. OSWALD is claiming she was shown a picture of RUBY.

The story in the Star Telegram indicated that an informed source claimed that a witness was being held in protective custody and that he could identify LEE HARVEY OSWALD as the slayer of President KENNEDY. This was brought to my attention about 8:30 PM, 2/9/64 by SA C. RAY HALL, who had heard something about it on channel 5 TV.

I immediately contacted SA B. TOM CARTER, who called JACK BUTLER, Managing Editor. Mr. BUTLER did not know anything about the story, but had one of the employees call CARTER back, and it appears that the story was one by THAYER WALPO, a reporter, who was not available at the time. At the time CARTER called the paper had changed their original story and stated that it would be somewhat watered down for the later morning edition.

SA VINCENT E. DRAIN called Sheriff DECKER and Chief CURREY, and I called FORREST SORRELS. Secret Service, none of whom knew anything about any witness being held in protective custody.

At approximately 10:00 PM, I furnished this information to W. H. FLOYD at the Bureau.

WILLIAM D. GRIFFIN of the FBI Laboratory called at 8:30 AM today and advised as follows:

The Laboratory will send to the Dallas Office four photographs of each item of evidence that is referred to in each Laboratory report. One of these is for our files. Three of them will be attached to as many copies of investigative reports that we prepare. (One of the three is to be attached to the copy of report that SAC initials and two will be attached to two copies of the report which will be designated for the Commission.) Mr. GRIFFIN instructed that we place a 3" % 5" card to the Commission's copies, stating "Commission Copies". This will be attached to the two copies of reports that have the exhibits attached and will serve as a double flag to the Supervisor that these two and no other two should go over to the Commission.

The above instructions apply to all three cases and the same procedure is to be used in all three cases.

Mr. GRIFFIN stated in getting photographs over to the Commission, they don't want Bureau to send any photographs of evidence that hasn't been previously covered in investigative report. He said in most instances, they can pretty well assume it has been handled in investigative reports, but there are going to be some items not handled. He stated Bureau isnot going to send Dallas photographs just because they are in the Laboratory, but will check with the Lab. Supv. and the other two Divisions, and if they can handle it in headquarters, they will do so. They will just send a letter to the Commission and send it on over.

In connection with my interview of Colonel J. WILLETH of Fort Worth on January 13, 1964, the results of Thick are set forth on an FD 302 as page 217 of the report of SA ROBERT P. GENBERLING dated January 22, 1964, the following information is set forth with respect to the fact that line 5, paragraph 3, first word is reflected as Mexico whereas it should have been reflected as Moscow:

I recall dictating this FD 302 on the telephone from the Fort Worth residence agency where I am assigned. It is my recollection that it was dictated as lioscow. This dictation was performed on January 15. 1964. I did not review the typed FD 302 prior to its inclusion in a report in view of the expeditious nature of the investigation and the fact that same was being included in a report dated January 22, 1964.

... Upon receiving the original FD 302 for approval and initialling, I noticed that the word Mexico should have been Ecscow and called this to the attention of SA ROBERT P. GEMBERLING in order that the Bureau could be advised and appropriate corrections made.

Worth Star Telegram," on 2/11/64 stated that in connection with the story that he put in the "Star Telegram: on 2/10/64, he did not wish to divulge his source. He stated that anybody in his business would accept his source as "pure gold." He stated he asked the source the name of the witness and the source replied, "I don't know," and later changed that to, "I don't remember." The source stated "When I saw this boy he was the scaredest nigger I ever saw. All you could see were the whites of his eyes." The witness stated that when he fled from the building he surrendered to the Special Services because that branch of the police department had picked him up on crap shooting charges in the past. The source stated that the witness made the statement, "Man, you don't know how fast is fast unless you saw me running." He referred to his trip from the building.

Mr. Waldo stated that after he received this information from his source, he went directly to his newspaper and wrote up the story, explaining that he did not take notes during the time the source gave him the story. He stated that after the story was originally written, the source called him on the phone and the only change in the story was the fact that the witness was not on the sixth floor but on the fifth floor of the building.
