Re Radiogram from Bureau, instructing that Assistant District Attorney WILLIAM ALEXANDER be interviewed.

I called the Bureau and talked to Assistant Director WM. C. SULLIVAN and pointed out to him that ALEXANDER is presently assisting District Attorney HENRY WADE in opposing the motion for a change of venue in the trial of RUBY; that this hearing started yesterday; that the defense has some 175 witnesses subpoenaed, and that there are newspaper reporters here from all over the country and ALEXANDER has had several clashes so far with the attorneys for the defense, and that I strongly recommended against contacting ALEXANDER until after this hearing was concluded. I pointed out that he is the type of individual who would probably either get up in court and say he was being harrassed by the FBI or make the same statement to the reporters, and I believed it would be better to wait. Mr. SULLIVAN stated that unless he instructed otherwise, we could hold off on this interview at this time.

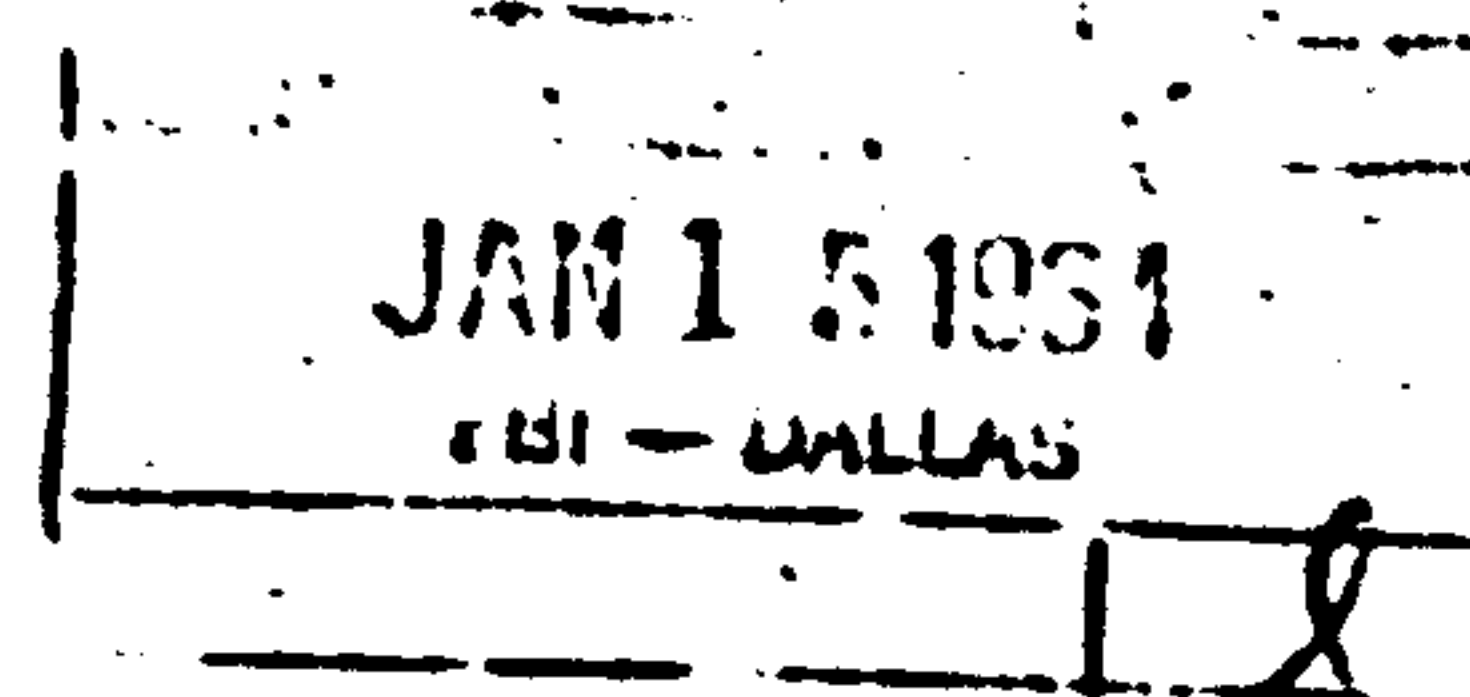
Following your instructions I telephonically contacted Mr. HUGH AINSWORTH of the "Dallas Morning News" and inquired as to the purpose of his telephone call. Mr. AINSWORTH asked if I might answer questions concerning my interview of Mrs. RUTH PAINE re LEE HARVEY OSWALD at Irving, Texas. I advised him "no, I would not discuss the matter" and that he knew that such inquiry should be directed to the SAC. AINSWORTH stated that I didn't have to tell him how to conduct his affairs, and I told him that he should direct any inquiry to the SAC.

Mr. AINSWORTH stated that he understood that LEE HARVEY OSWALD had my name in his possession. I advised him that he should contact the SAC.

At this point the telephone conversation terminated.

The above should be made a matter of record.





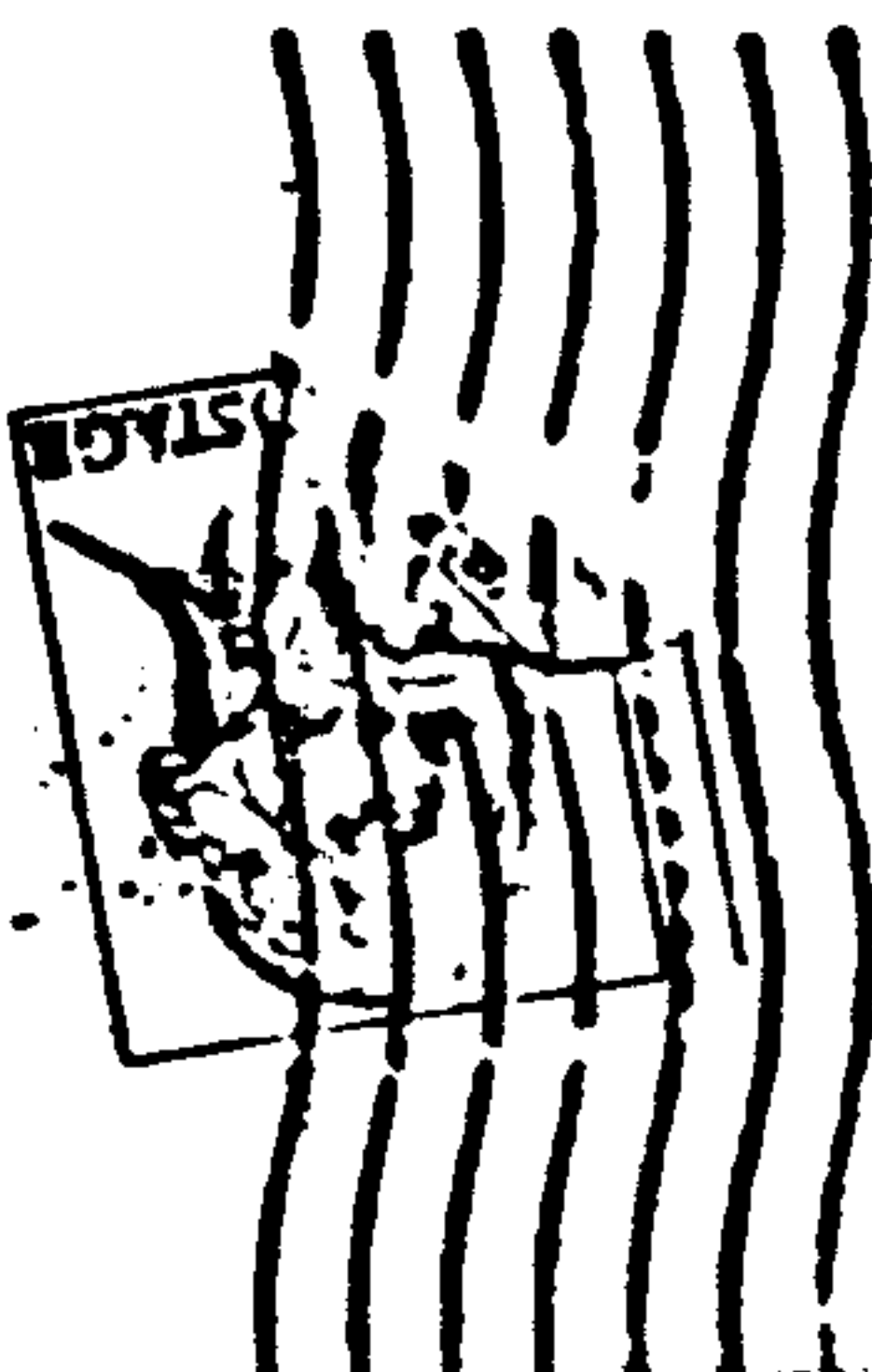

The following investigation was conducted by SAs ALBERT SAYERS and ALFRED D. NEELEY:

On 2-1-64, Mrs. VIOLET GARDENOUR, Information Desk, Records Bureau, Dallas PD, advised she could find no arrest record or other reference to BILLY LEE JONES, aka in her indices.

Acquaintance

On 2-1-64, Brother BILLY W. BOYD and Brother CURTIS ANDERSON BALLARD, Dallas City Mission, 314 South Ervay, Dallas, advised they are in charge of the mission, ~~in the absence of Brother JESS DUNCAN.~~

They advised that Brother IVAN KERR is known to them as the pastor of the Bethel Bible Church, Lewisville, Texas. KERR left the early part of this past week to attend a revival in Mississippi and is expected back in Lewisville, Texas, sometime on the afternoon or evening of 2-1-64. They advised that BILLY LEE JONES accompanied KERR and three or four others on the trip to Mississippi.

They said BILLY LEE JONES has been staying for the past month in Lewisville with Brother A. M. JOHNSON, who operates a garage in Lewisville. JONES has a cot in a room at the garage and works as a handyman around the garage. JONES allegedly has a wife by the name of MARY in Dallas but is separated from her.

KERR has telephone KE 9-4369 in Lewisville and A. M. JOHNSON has telephone KE 9-4935 in Lewisville.

Brothers BOYD and BALLARD exhibited a registration card for the Dallas City Mission which is dated 12-30-64. It bears the name BILLY LEE JONES, 511 Circle Road, Del Rio, Texas. It shows his Social Security Number as 462-26-3166. It bears reference to Mrs. A. J. McCULLIS, same address as JONES in Del Rio, Texas. It shows JONES was coming from Plainview, Texas and was going to Del Rio, Texas. It shows JONES's occupation as laborer and his religious preference as Baptist.

Brother IVAN KERR is scheduled to make the noon sermon at the Dallas City Mission on 2-3-64 and JONES will probably accompany him.

On the morning of 2-1-64, efforts were made at KE 9-4369 and KE 9-4935, Lewisville, Texas, to contact Brother KERR, with negative results; however, information was elicited to the effect that he is expected home DALLAS 2:00 PM or 3:00 PM, 2-1-64

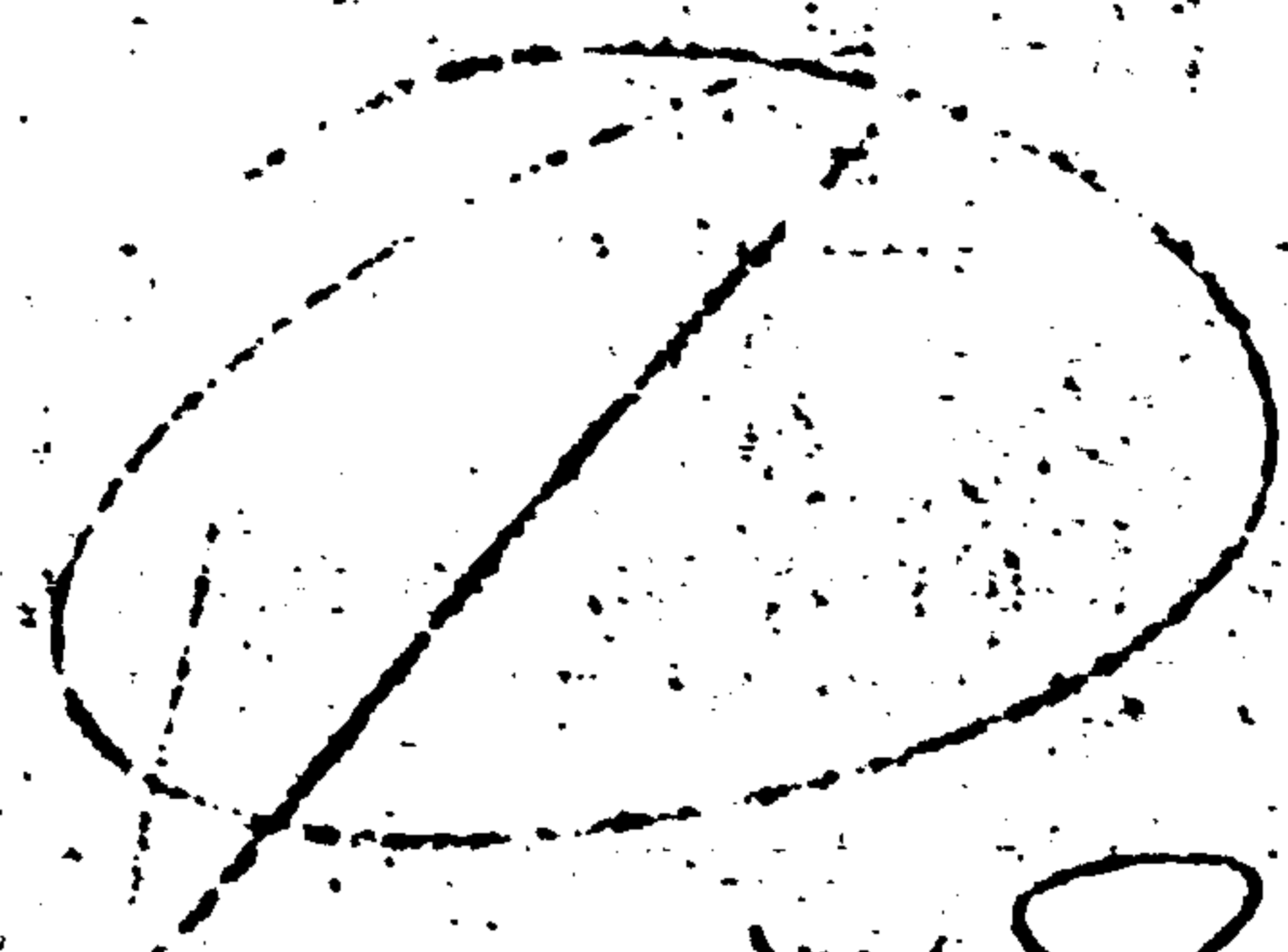

On the morning of 2/17/64 WILLIAM GRIFFITH of the FBI Laboratory was telephonically contacted and requested to furnish the "Q" or "K" numbers for each item given an arbitrary number by the Laboratory, such as D- or J- in order to facilitate the Dallas Office locating where the FBI Laboratory report on such items was included in an investigative report. He stated that the Laboratory would do this and submit same to Dallas.

At the same time, Mr. GRIFFITH was advised that Dallas had noted that Exhibits No. J-8 and D-106 were identical and were both photographs of Laboratory item Q332, a manifest of the Transportes Frontera Bus Company covering the trip from Mexico City to Laredo, Texas on which OSWALD was a passenger.

Reference is made to inventory list of items submitted in this investigation, which inventory is Serial 1B15 of this file. Item D53 of this inventory is a 2-page handwritten letter, unsigned, on letterhead "Jack Ruby Associates, Dallas, Texas," addressed "Dear Jail," and bearing name C. L. On the evening of February 17, 1964 MR. ORVILLE O. NIX telephonically contacted SA ROBERT P. GEMBERLING. NIX has previously furnished his movie camera for examination by the Laboratory, and he has previously been interviewed as a witness to the assassination.

NIX stated that he has been contacted by an individual whose name he does not at this time know who has requested that NIX consider telling him what he saw in connection with the assassination in order that the unknown individual may write a story about same. NIX stated that since he is an employee of the U. S. Government (GSA) he wondered if he should consent to be interviewed for such a story.

MR. NIX was advised that the FBI could not tell him that he should or should not consent to such interview but was cautioned that any information he gave to anybody should be truthful and that this office would be interested in knowing to whom he furnished such information.

NIX stated that in the event he did consent to be interviewed by anyone he would furnish this office a copy of the story prior to its being printed and would at the same time furnish the FBI the identity of the person interviewing him and writing the story.

It is suggested this be filed for reference purposes in the event NIX does furnish a story.

ROY H. JEVONS, Supervisor of the FBI Laboratory, called at 11:15 AM and stated that in the "Washington Post" this AM, there was a news article referring to a Police ballistics test report, which indicated the rifle believed to have been used in killing President KENNEDY was the same one used in the attempted assassination of General EDWIN WALKER. It indicates the report was made public by Chief CURRY and M. W. STEVENSON, Deputy Chief of the Criminal Investigative Division, Dallas PD. He said that points of comparison of the slug that was fired at WALKER matched the fragmentations of the bullets which took the President's life. He pointed out that the FBI made a report to Chief CURRY on the examination of the slug fired at General WALKER with the rifle, and he sent him a report, which did not say anything like this.

LEADS

(1) Find out what report they are referring to. We do not have any indication that they have any fragmentations of bullets to compare. Find out about that.

(2) Tell them certainly our report did not reflect any such findings.

They desired to be called back after Chief CURRY and STEVENSON are contacted. He suggested that Mr. CONRAD be called and given this information as the Director wants a memorandum re these ballistic tests. There was also a picture of OSWALD holding the rifle, etc., which has appeared in numerous papers, and the Director wanted to know the source of this.

Chief JESSE E. CURRY (NA) and M. W. STEVENSON, Deputy Chief of the Criminal Investigative Division, Dallas Police Department, were contacted 2/19/64 by SA VINCENT E. DRAIN and they stated they positively did not make any statement that there had been any conclusive evidence developed by Laboratory examination reflecting that the fragments of the bullet that was shot at General WALKER were identical with the bullet that took the President's life. CURRY related that GEORGE CARTER of the Dallas Times Herald was given the results of the FBI Laboratory report and that only one ballistics test had been made and that was by the FBI Laboratory. CARTER asked him if he was going to close this case and he said technically, "I guess so in view of MARINA OSWALD's testimony to the effect that OSWALD has been identified by her as the one who had shot at General WALKER in the Spring of 1963"

DUNCAN that on that date inmate [redacted] appeared before a parole judge at the above reformatory.
