During conversation with Assistant Director SULLIVAN at 4:35 PM, today, he was advised that during the interview with MARINA, today, her attorney, WILLIAM A. MC KENZIE, was present and during this time, he was in telephonic contact with LEE RANKIN of the WARREN Commission and informed him of the news release made by MARTIN in Houston concerning the fact that OSWALD had intended to shoot Vice President NIXON. Mr. SULLIVAN asked what Mr. RANKIN's reply had been and he was informed that MC KENZIE did not repeat the reply.

Mr. SULLIVAN was also advised that with regard to the NIXON story, MARINA stated during the interview that the info that she had previously furnished was just as she had told it and she was "sorry if we didn't believe her".

Mr. SULLIVAN was further advised that during MC KENZIE's telephone call to RANKIN, he advised RANKIN that the movie, "Trial of LEE HARVEY OSWALD", which was made by HAROLD HOFFMAN (ph) and LARRY BUCHANAN (ph), processed by Pathe Studios, Los Angeles, and narrated by CHARLES TESSEMER, with a final summation by TESSEMER, was due to be released. He informed RANKIN that he was taking steps to enjoin the movie to prevent the showing, as he felt it was detrimental to his client and in addition, he felt the movie should not be released prior to completion of the inquiry by the WARREN Commission.

At 4:45 PM, Section Chief WILLIAM A. BRANIGAN advised that Dallas submitted an airtel dated 2/20/64, referring to SA GEMBERLING's report of 2/11/64. In this airtel, we advised that rerep contained 2 pages numbered 116 and we furnished instructions that the 2nd page should be made #116a.

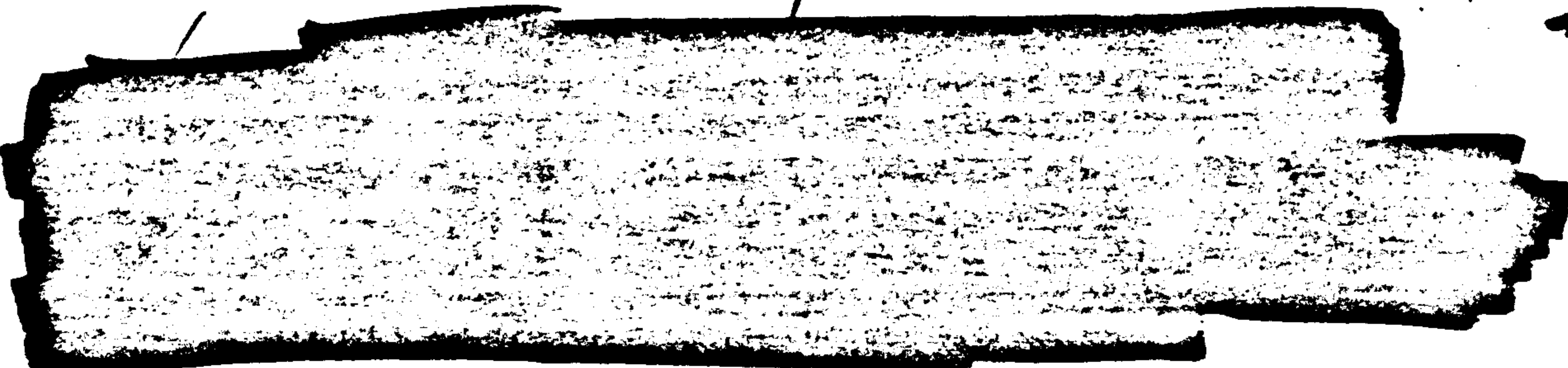

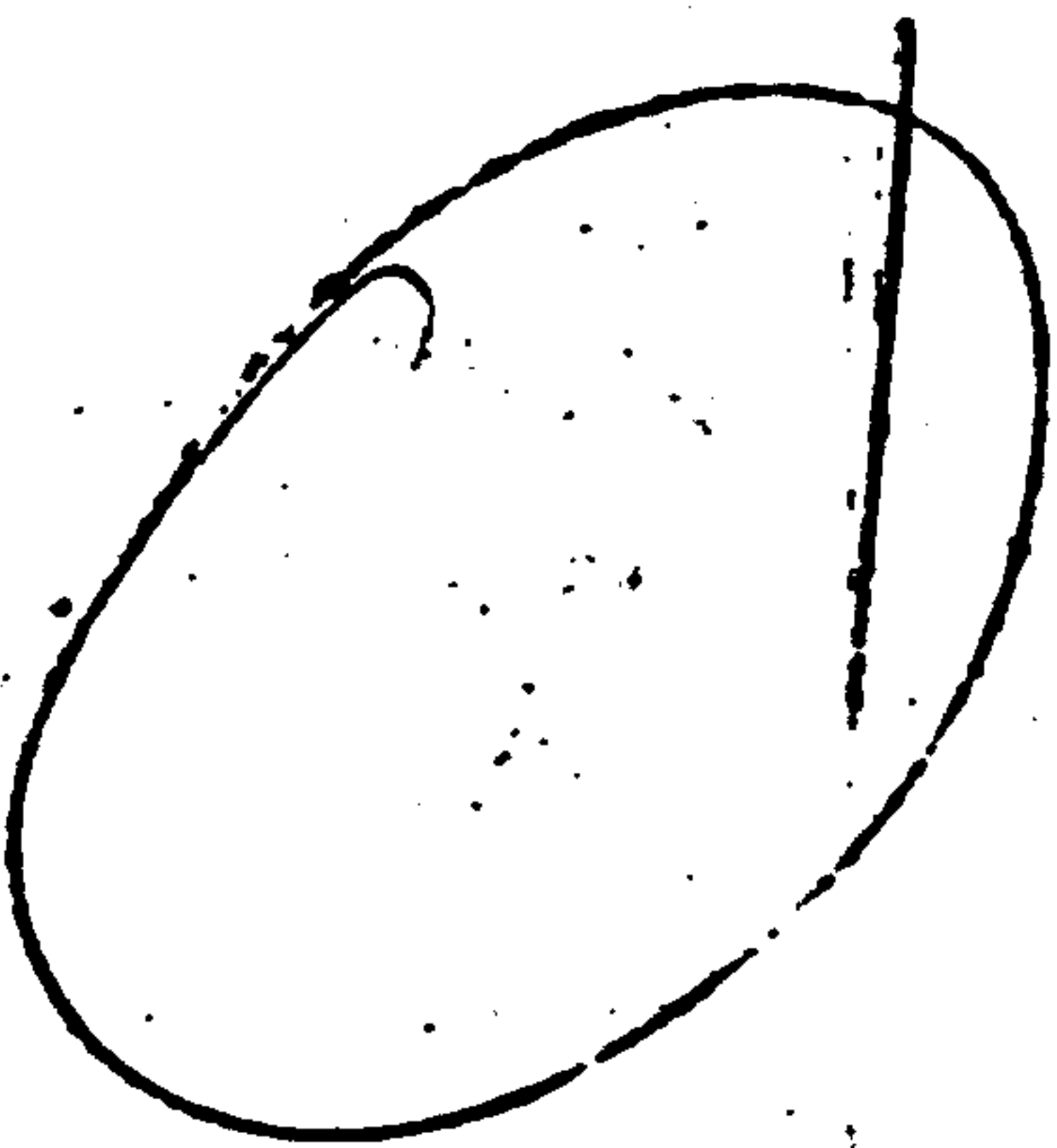
Assistant Director W. C. SULLIVAN called at 8:50 AM today to inquire how the surveillance was running and he was advised that nothing was happening.

A. J. DECKER, Domestic Intelligence Division, telephoned the Dallas Office at 7:10 PM today. He stated with regard to the NIXON incident, the Bureau was primarily concerned with what date NIXON was to visit Dallas and was any publicity given to this visit. DECKER stated the Bureau had been previously advised that NIXON's visit was to occur in April, 1963. I advised that a teletype was presently being transmitted to Bureau answering these questions, captioned "NIXON INCIDENT". Briefly DECKER was told the contents of this teletype.

Inspector J. A. SIZOO telephonically furnished the following instructions 11:45 AM this date.

By way of background, Inspector SIZOO advised the Director has been in conference with Mr. RANKIN of the Commission, and the following action is desired:

1. An immediate 24-hour physical surveillance should be instituted on MARINA OSWALD to determine (1) each person contacted by her and their full identity; (2) to be able to furnish information on everything she does when she leaves her place of residence. This surveillance is to be conducted "as a discreet physical surveillance."

2. With regard to the interview of MARINA today concerning the NIXON matter, the Director and Mr. RANKIN feel that the NIXON affair does not sound right as such activity on the part of OSWALD is not in keeping with his character. This should be thoroughly explored to determine what he did while he was locked in the bathroom, if he attempted to break down the door, and what action he took after he was released; that is, did he beat up on MARINA, etc.

The information concerning the NIXON affair, plus recommendations and results of physical surveillance must be included in the telephone-teletype today, and a daily teletype submitted concerning result of surveillance must be submitted.

It is RANKIN'S intention to immediately re-subpoena MARINA after receipt of the results of our interviews, etc.

With regard to the need for additional personnel, consideration should be given concerning such request, and agents will be flown in; however, it is contemplated that the physical surveillance of MARINA will be discontinued after she is recalled before the Commission.

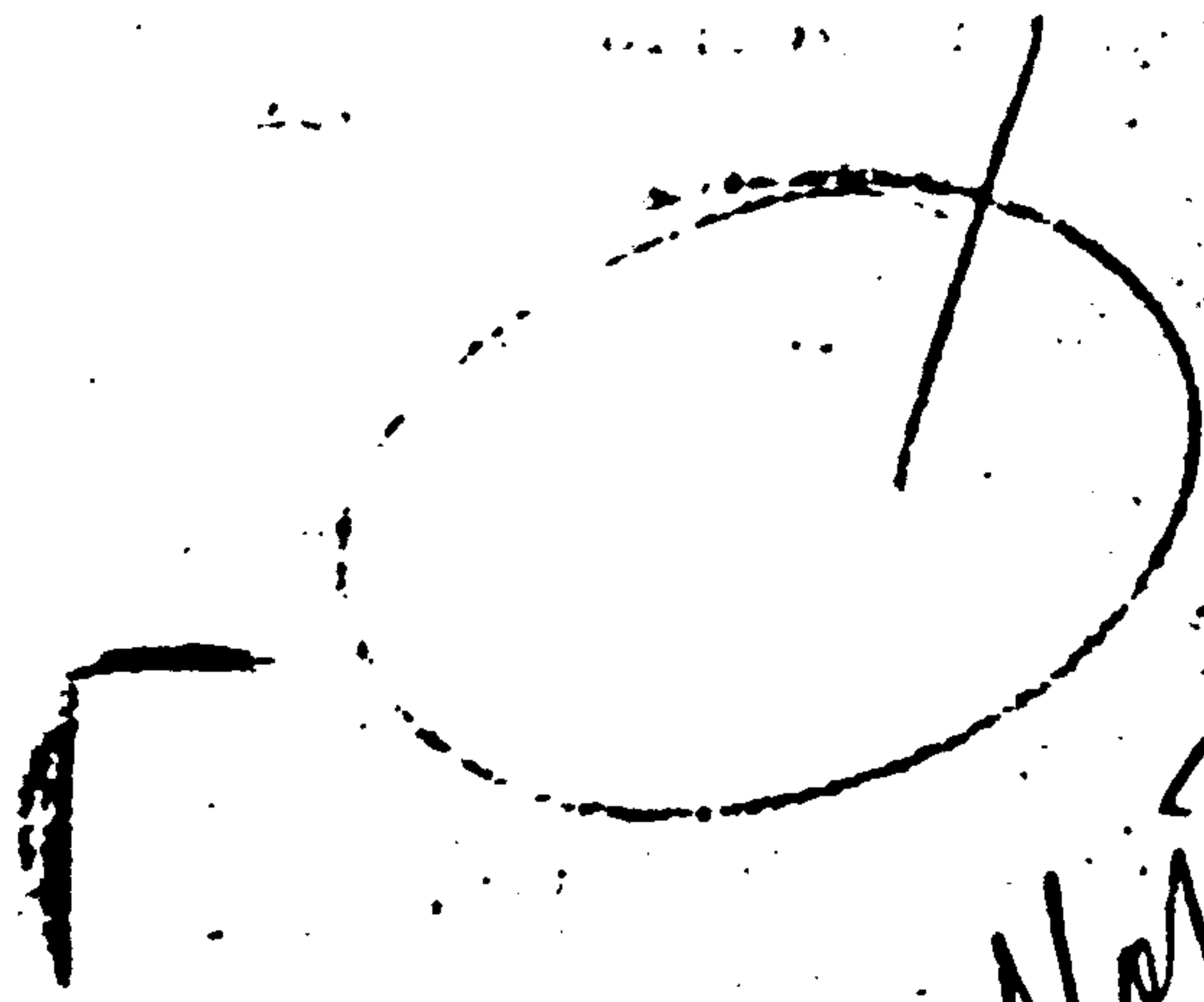

The following investigation was conducted by SA MARTIN L. CROAK:

AT MADISON, WISCONSIN

On February 26, 1964 NANCY BENSON, Clerk, Bureau of Vital Statistics for the State of Wisconsin searched records of that office and advised she could find no birth record for a HERBERT ROBERT VORRHEES, born Beloit, Wisconsin. She advised that she did locate a record for a HERBERT FRANCIS VOORHEES, born July 8, 1889 at Beloit, Wisconsin. His father was listed as JOHN VOORHEES, a carpenter and mother, KATIE MONAHAN, both born in the United States.

On February 26, 1964 JUNE ACKERMAN, Clerk, Bureau of Vital Statistics advised that she had been unable to locate a death record for JOHN VOORHEES checking the dates through the years of 1932 through 1936.

AT BELOIT, WISCONSIN

A search of City Directories for the City of Beloit was made by SA CROAK on February 26, 1964 and there was located no records of a family in the Beloit City Directories under the spelling of VORRHEES. One record of one HERBERT VOORHEES was located for the year 1907 and this is the only directory for the City of Beloit reflecting this name, HERBERT VOORHEES. JOHN VOORHEES appears in City Directories from 1900 to 1933 but does not appear subsequent to that date, and no family by the name of VOORHEES appears in the City Directory later than 1937 in the City of Beloit, Wisconsin.

On February 26, 1964 MARIE BUNKER, Clerk, Beloit Credit Bureau, advised that the files of that Bureau contain no record of a person by the name of VORRHEES and no record of a HERBERT or JOHN VOORHEES.

On February 26, 1964 ALICE NORDIER, Clerk, Beloit Police Department, advised that there was no record in the files of that department of anyone with the name of VORRHEES or VOORHEES.

At 2:15 PM today, Mr. ROSEN, Assistant Director, called and stated that they want Attorney MELVIN BELLI interviewed tonight if at all possible. Mr. ROSEN advised as follows:

On 2/25/64, Mr. DICK BERLIN and KINGSBURY SMITH, General Manager and Editor respectively, *Hurst* Publications, advised the Bureau that an unnamed *Hurst* reporter, described by BERLIN as very reliable, had been told by MELVIN BELLI, Attorney for JACK RUBY, that OSWALD was an FBI informant. BELLI also told this reporter that although he would not care to comment so much regarding RUBY's connection with the FBI, he knew from reliable sources that RUBY had been an informant for eight weeks, and OSWALD an informant of the FBI for thirteen weeks. BELLI also told this reporter that RUBY informed on gamblers and people of low character, and that OSWALD was a security type informant. SMITH advised that this *Hurst* reporter has a tape recording of BELLI making these allegations. *Hon*

Mr. ROSEN instructed that I should immediately arrange to personally interview BELLI concerning these allegations. When he is interviewed, he should be advised that we want to get all the facts the first time in this matter, and tell him to either put up or shut up. Sutel results immediately. If anything unusual comes up, give Mr. ROSEN or Mr. SULLIVAN a call on this.

Mr. ROSEN suggested that in contacting BELLI, we ought not to say "put up or shut up", but to ask him for the facts upon which he bases his conclusion; that we won't get anywhere with BELLI by trying to scare him. The Bureau wants to get the facts, and we would like to put him up or keep him quiet, but that doesn't mean we should approach him on that basis.

We should not attempt to contact BELLI while he is in court or in connection with the presentation of the case, and therefore what we should do is when he is away from there, so there will be no connection between the two, contact him on the side and tell him this information has come to us. We want to approach him directly on it. Don't disclose the source. Merely state information has come to our attention that he has said so and so, and we have been reliably informed.

As far as RUBY is concerned, we don't have to tell him that RUBY has never been an informant of FBI. Find out what he knows. Find out what he knows about OSWALD. That is the strongest case first. After you make a flat denial, he may say on the RUBY case, this man has told him ^{you} have been in touch with him, and we can say, "Yes, we have", but we can tell him he has never been an informant. The question is going to be how to talk to him.

It was agreed that I should not go to BELLI's hotel room and that he should not be invited to the Dallas office, but that I should try to arrange a meeting elsewhere with BELLI on neutral territory. Mr. ROSEN suggested that I get word to BELLI through an Agent that Mr. SHANKLIN would like to talk to him on a matter of interest to him, if he could at his convenience and he would like to do this aside from the FBI and aside from interference with the proceedings which are presently going on.

I advised that I would send someone over to try to set up a meeting tonight if convenient to BELLI and if at all possible, and if not, sometime tomorrow.

Mr. WILLIAM BRANNIGAN called at 10:45 AM today regarding Bureau's request (which they had received from the Commission) to establish exactly where MARINA OSWALD and Mrs. PAINE stayed on the night of 9/23/63. He stated they had received Dallas airtel and letterhead memorandum of 2/26/64 in which we reported the results of contact with a Mr. MIKE CARRIER, of the motel where they stayed and also furnished the original registration card in the name of RUTH PAINE. Mr. BRANNIGAN stated this is not complete enough to go to the Commission. He said we will still have to talk to RUTH PAINE and have her tell us "Yes, we stopped at the Rambler Motel at Waskom, Texas", and get her to describe this motel. Show her a photograph of the registration card, if one was made by Dallas Office, and ask her if this is her signature. BRANNIGAN stated they were also going to have the Laboratory try to compare the registration card with her handwriting.

BRANNIGAN also stated the letterhead memo doesn't say what the license number was, and it should have. Check on this.

Interview Mrs. PAINE; pin her down that this is the motel where they stayed. See if she can identify the writing on the registration as hers, and get descriptive details about the motel so that we can definitely establish her staying at this motel in Waskom, Texas.

On 1/30/64, Mrs. HELEN SHIRAH, 5530 Santa Monica Blvd. South, Jacksonville, Fla., was contacted regarding letter she wrote to the U. S. Secret Service, Washington, D. C. Mrs. SHIRAH exhibited the magazine, "Four Dark Days in History" and pointed out an individual in the photograph on page 4 which showed the Presidential motorcade passing by the Texas School Book Depository (TSBD), 411 Elm St., Dallas, Texas, as being that of an individual she believed to be LEE HARVEY OSWALD. Mrs. SHIRAH based her identification of OSWALD solely from having seen previous photographs of him.

On 2/19/64, Mrs. SHIRAH was again shown the photograph of the Presidential motorcade appearing on pages 4 and 5 in the magazine "Four Dark Days in History" submitted with Dallas airtel dated 1/31/64. Mrs. SHIRAH pointed out the same individual as was identified by the Dallas Office as being a TSBD employee, BILLY N. LOVELADY, as being the individual she had thought to be LEE HARVEY OSWALD.

In view of the above, no further action is being taken by the Jacksonville Office in this matter.

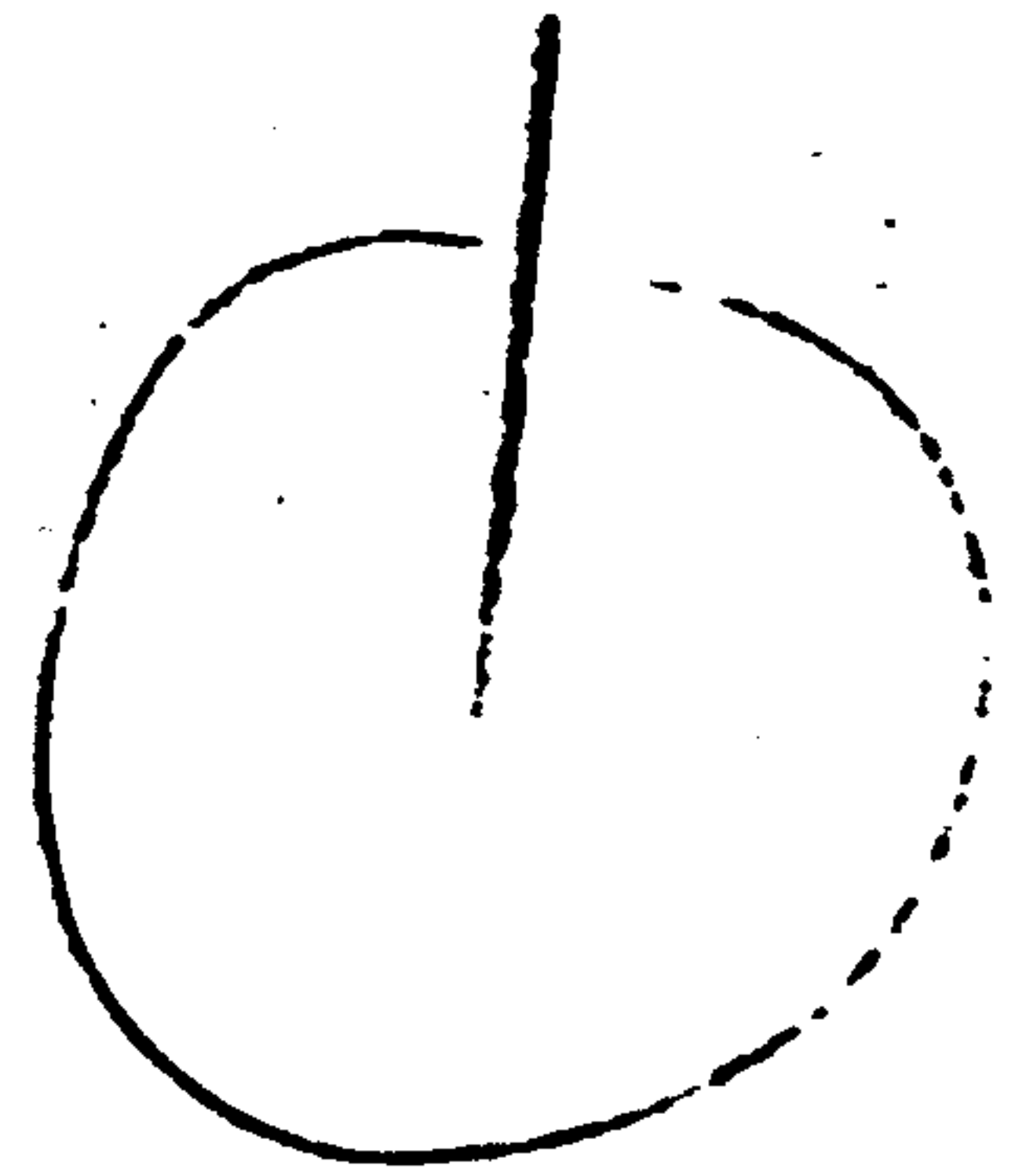

Dear Sirs:

I have been retained to represent [redacted] who is being held in the Dallas County, Texas, jail. He informs me that he has spoken with F.B.I. agents of your office. [redacted] tells us that his discussion involved the assassination of President Kennedy and the assassination of Lee Harvey Oswald. We are attempting to check out his credibility and the truth of his story in order to fairly represent him in Dallas, Texas.




