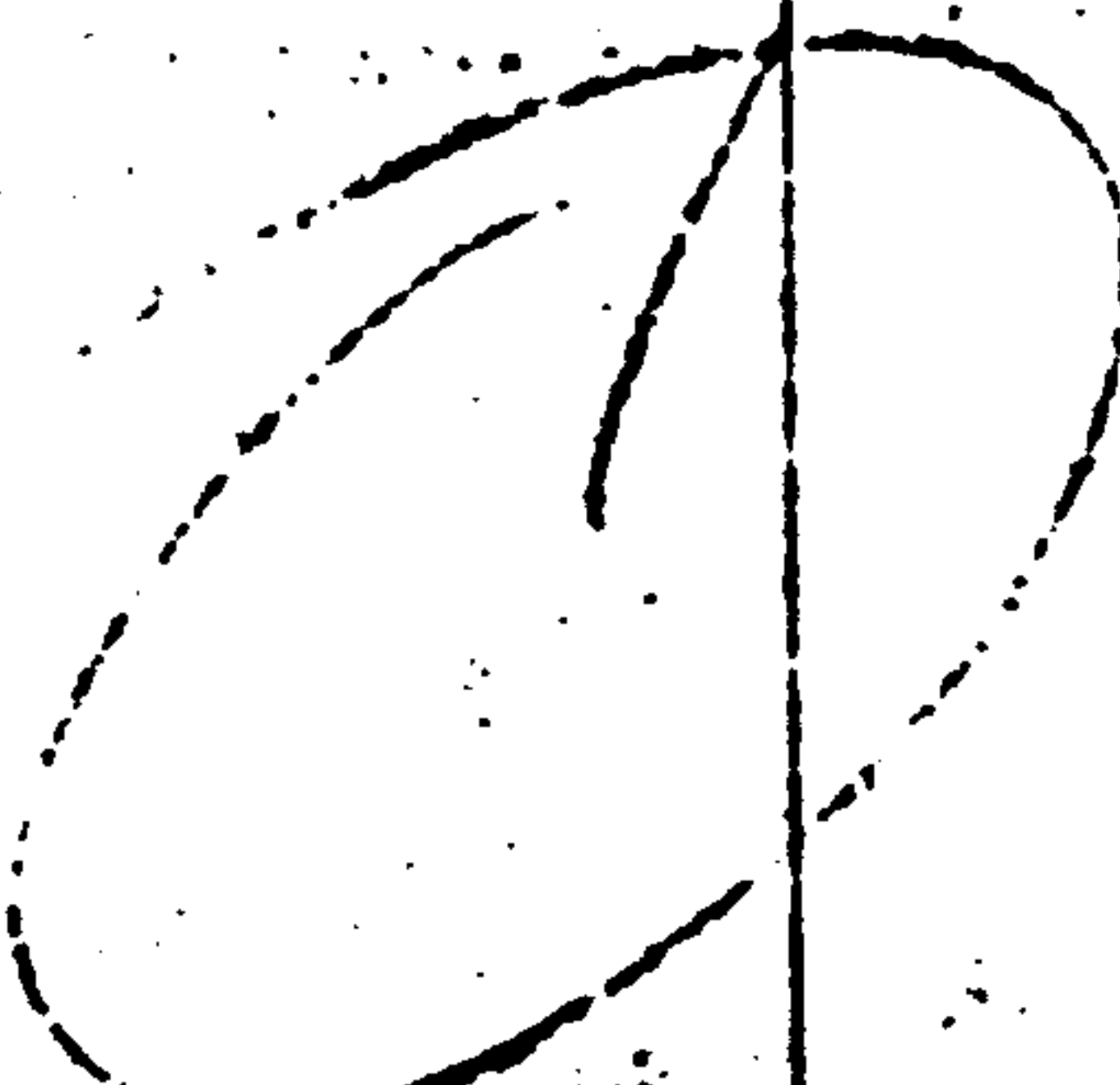

Assistant Director W. C. SULLIVAN called at 10:50 AM today and stated that the Bureau keeps getting indications that WILLIAM ALEXANDER is the source of the rumor that OSWALD was an FBI informant. Mr. SULLIVAN instructed that WADE be contacted and told that in effect "ALEXANDER should either put up or shut up;" that we insist upon it." Qualify your statement to WADE to effect that if it is so that ALEXANDER is the source of it, he must either come up with the evidence or stop making these statements. SULLIVAN instructed that the Bureau be advised as to what WADE says, etc., and to use best judgment as to best time to contact WADE.

Regarding the interview of former SA JOHN W. FAIN, Houston, in which he states he had no recollection of ever having contacted GEORGE MOHRENSCHILDT and had no recollection of this individual, Mr. SULLIVAN requested that a teletype be sent to Bureau regarding same. SULLIVAN stated he will put in a memorandum that FAIN was interviewed and ^{had} never talked to MOHRENSCHILDT.

Sullivan called Bureau and advised we had sent circ - tel 3/2/64 as he said we Teletype necessary

For the information of the file, it is noted that MARINA OSWALD was taken in a Bureau car by SAs WALLACE R. HEITMAN and ANATOLE A. BOGUSLAV on 3/2/64 from her residence at 629 Beltline Road, Richardson, to the Oak Cliff Section of Dallas where she was shown the house in which LEE HARVEY OSWALD had last resided at 1026 North Berkley. MARINA traced the route of her and OSWALD on the night in March, 1963, when OSWALD took from the Neely address his rifle wrapped in a raincoat and boarded a bus for the purpose of going somewhere to practice with the rifle.

WILLIAM A. MC KENZIE, attorney for MARINA, was present during part of this tour. He was picked up when the Agents and MARINA arrived in downtown Dallas from Richardson and he was let out of the car in downtown Dallas near his office en route back to MARINA's home in Richardson.

Interviewing Agents arrived at MARINA's home at approximately 2:00 PM and the Agent and MARINA left the house at about 2:35 PM and MARINA was delivered back to the house at approximately 5:10 PM and the Agents left it about 5:20 PM.

JUNE accompanied her mother and RACHAEL was taken care of by Mrs. DECLAN FORD in the latter's home during MARINA's absence.

We are attempting to check out his credibility and the truth of his story in order to fairly represent him in Dallas, Texas.

Your cooperation in furnishing us with a brief history of [redacted] would be greatly appreciated. Any and all information will aid us in determining whether or not he is legally responsible, and whether or not he is a dangerous person. Your cooperation would be greatly appreciated.
