Re telephone call from Inspector JAMES R. MALLEY today concerning photographs and manifest of the cab driver, WILLIAM WAYNE WHALEY.

At approximately 11:00 A.M. this date, the writer telephonically contacted Special Agent in Charge FORREST V. SORRELS, U. S. Secret Service, at which time SORRELS stated that he was contacted by both WILLIAM WAYNE WHALEY, the cab driver, and CECIL J. MC WATERS, the bus driver, after they had appeared at his office and inquired of him what documents they should take with them to appear before the President's Commission since the Commission had requested that they bring all documents relating to instant matter. SORRELS stated he advised them that they should take the original of any documents pertaining to instant matter, together with a possible photograph of same and that their companies would probably want to retain a photographic copy in their files.

Mr. SORRELS stated he had not received any request from the Commission to obtain the documents and that he himself did not call either the bus company or the cab company. He said he received a call shortly after the cab driver left his office and that the cab driver (WILLIAM WAYNE WHALEY) stated he was at the cab company and that the FBI was there obtaining the documents.

Mr. SORRELS stated that he advised the cab driver that if this was the case, it was perfectly all right just as long as the Commission got the documents they desired.

Mr. SORRELS stated that he, too, was as anxious to avoid duplication in this matter.

At 10:15 AM today Inspector JAMES R. MALLEY called and referred to Dallas teletype of 3/10/64 re obtaining of desired photographs and manifest of WILLIAM WAYNE WHALEY.

MALLEY stated they had been in touch with Secret Service in Washington and find out that Secret Service in Washington received no request of any kind. Inspector TOM KELLEY said that he knew that letters had been sent to both the bus driver and the cab driver, names not readily available to MALLEY at time of his call. MALLEY said he understood the cab driver has been asked to bring in a manifest of the day's fares and that the bus driver has been asked to bring in a route map, as well as his punch. He said that Secret Service has been arranging for transportation of all the witnesses, and in so doing they do not know whether SORRELLS had been asked by either the cab driver or the bus driver to render assistance by getting information desired from the company, or whether SORRELLS is just trying to be helpful and took it upon himself to make these inquiries. MALLEY said there is also the possibility that somebody in the Commission called SORRELLS direct and requested this.

MALLEY instructed that we find out from SORRELLS whether or not he received any calls from the Commission on this, or just what did happen in regard to the bus driver and cab driver being requested to bring manifests, etc. MALLEY requested that when information obtained, he be called back so Bureau can put all the information in one memo. SORRELLS needs to be pinned down because it looks like a duplication. Unless SORRELLS got a direct call from the Commission, it is silly to ask Bureau to get what they have already asked for.

It was announced that next year STAUNTON LIND would be teaching at Yale University.

STAUNTON spoke from his article "Seeds of Doubt" printed in the New Republic and gave the reasons why LEE HARVEY OSWALD could not be guilty. STAUNTON compared the OSWALD case to the Drefus Case.

Mrs. OSWALD said that what MARINA OSWALD was saying now is completely different from what she said from Nov. 22 to Nov. 28 when she was with her all the time. She said the Warren Commission could not know what MARINA was saying and thinking then and they could not find out the truth without cross examination. MARK LANE had photostats of affidavits that he said came from District Attorney WADE's office that no nitrates was found on OSWALD's cheeks and nitrates typical of revolver shots was found on his hands.

LANE also said he had information that he was not at liberty to discuss at this time but said in about 2 weeks he hoped to be able to do so.

JAMES ARONSON said that everything had been done to prevent the meeting at Town Hall and that at the last minute on Monday they had put up the \$25,000 through the help of friends because if they had gone to court it would have taken beyond the date of the meeting.

Mrs. OSWALD said that letters from her son led her to believe her son worked for a government agency. She said these letters would be published in her book.

About 1500 persons were present at the meeting.

After the meeting a group of friends met backstage to talk to STAUNTON. These people had worked with him in N.Y.C. in Housing. STAUNTON was the first Chairman of the Cooper Square Committee according to ESTHER RAND.

ESTHER said that STAUNTON had had a rather serious accident recently.

She also said that STAUNTON's mother taught at Sarah Lawerance College in Bronxville and that was how they got the students from Sarah Lawerance to help with the Cooper Square surveys.

ESTHER said that she didn't see how MARK was living but perhaps his brother who is a teacher is supporting him.

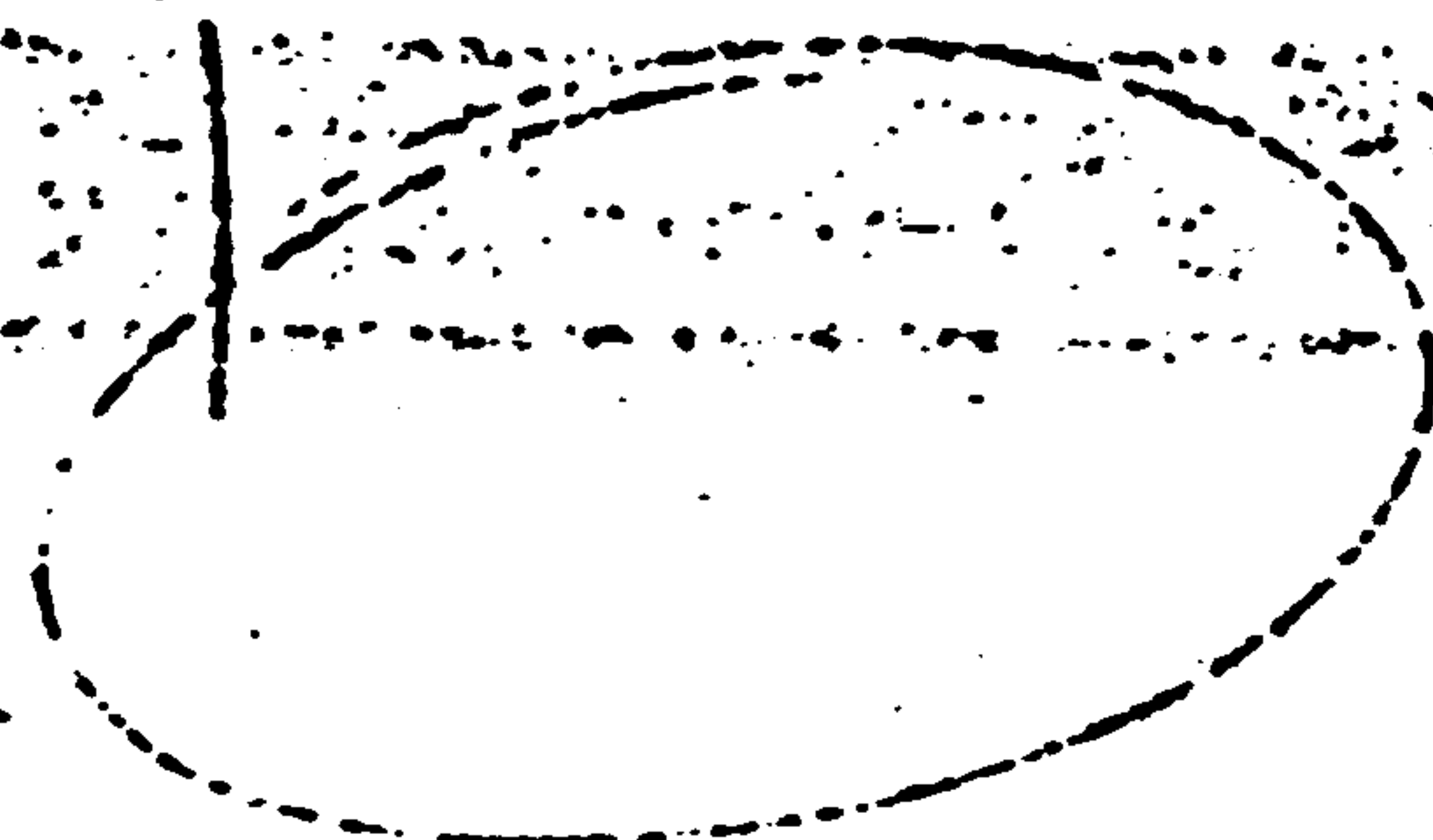

Section Chief WILLIAM BRANNIGAN called at 5:10 PM today and referred to Dallas teletype of 3/10/64 wherein it was stated it is presumed the Bureau has made available to the President's Commission as warranted copies of reports on GEORGE LYMAN PAINE, JR. & SYLVIA LUDLOW HOKE. The Bureau is disseminating its reports to the Commission so Dallas can disregard any of that information in reports. It will be handled by Bureau at SOG.

Regarding the RUTH PAINE, case, Buded of 3/23/64. Mr. BRANNIGAN was advised that she is testifying on March 18th, and he stated that this being the case, Bureau would like to have report by March 16, and in the cover letter, set out those areas that have not been covered, so Bureau can advise the Commission. It is noted Dallas was to submit final closing report by 23rd, after auxiliary offices submitted their reports by 3/16/64. In view of Mrs. PAINE testifying on 18th, Dallas is to submit pending report on whatever Dallas has done by the 16th.

Mr. BRANNIGAN also requested information on the FORDS immediately as they are scheduled to appear on or about March 18th. He was told that a letterhead memo was in dictation and that it would be sent on 3/12/64 AMSD to his attention.

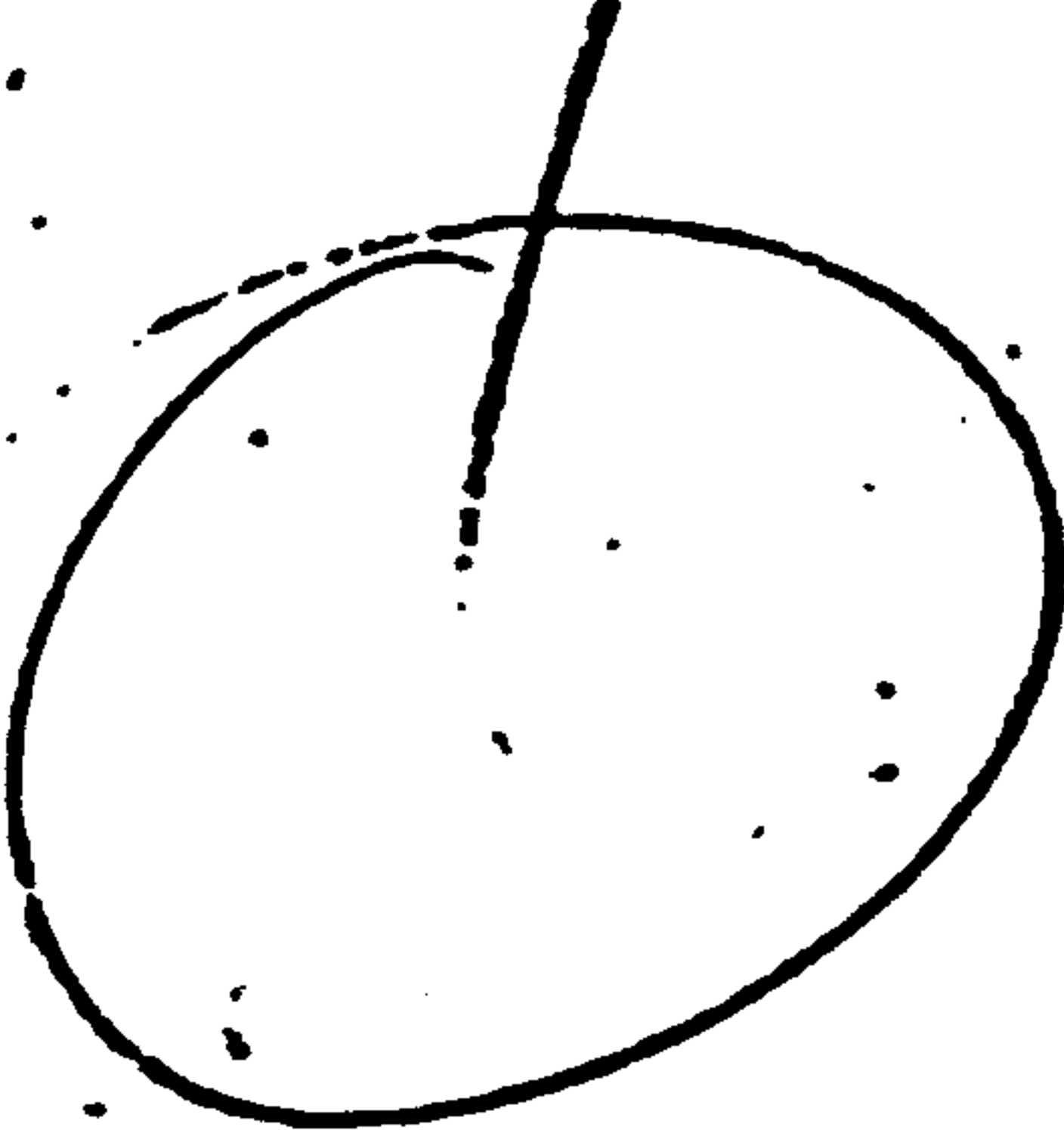

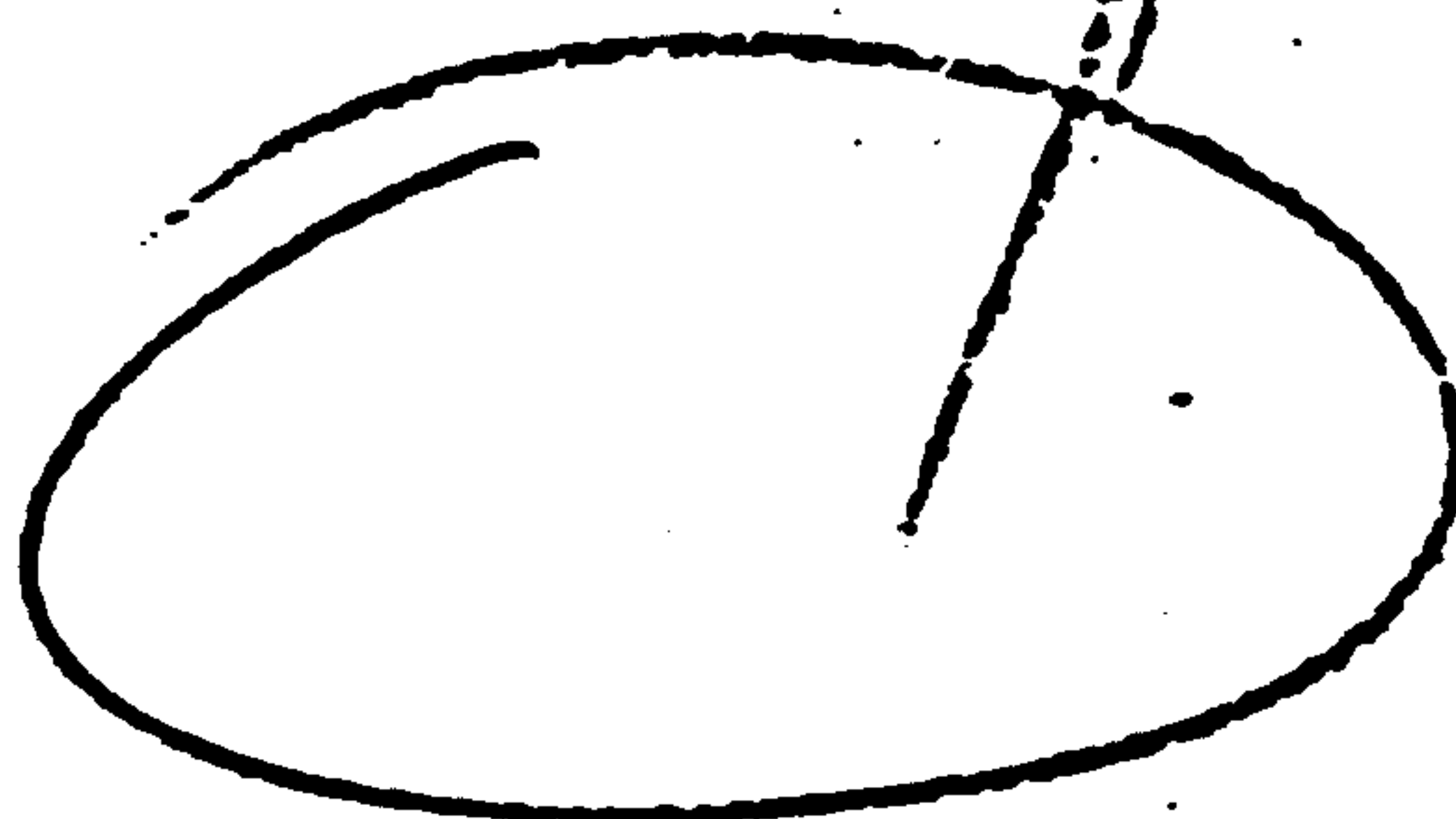

On 3/7/64, [redacted] Dallas, telephone [redacted] telephonically communicated with this office to furnish the following information:

[redacted] requested her name not be used in any way in connection with this information, stating she would probably lose her job if the source of this information became known.

[redacted] is employed at the [redacted] Company, Dallas, under the supervision of [redacted]. [redacted] has a friend who recently visited at the home of a person residing next door to the Beckley Street address where OSWALD resided just prior to the assassination. The lady who lives in the house next door to the house in which OSWALD lived reportedly made a complaint that she had trouble with JACK RUBY several times about parking his car in her driveway when he would visit with OSWALD.

[redacted] stated she is unable to furnish any further information regarding the above. She stated someone asked the lady who lived next door to OSWALD why she did not report the information to the FBI or the police at which time she allegedly stated she did not want to become involved in the matter.

ACTION: Review Dallas files to determine whether occupants of houses on either side of Beckley Street address at which OSWALD lived have been interviewed. [redacted] said she believed the house in question was the house on the south side of the OSWALD's house. If occupants of these houses have not previously been interviewed, interview immediately re any persons observed by them to have possibly visited with OSWALD when he resided on Beckley.

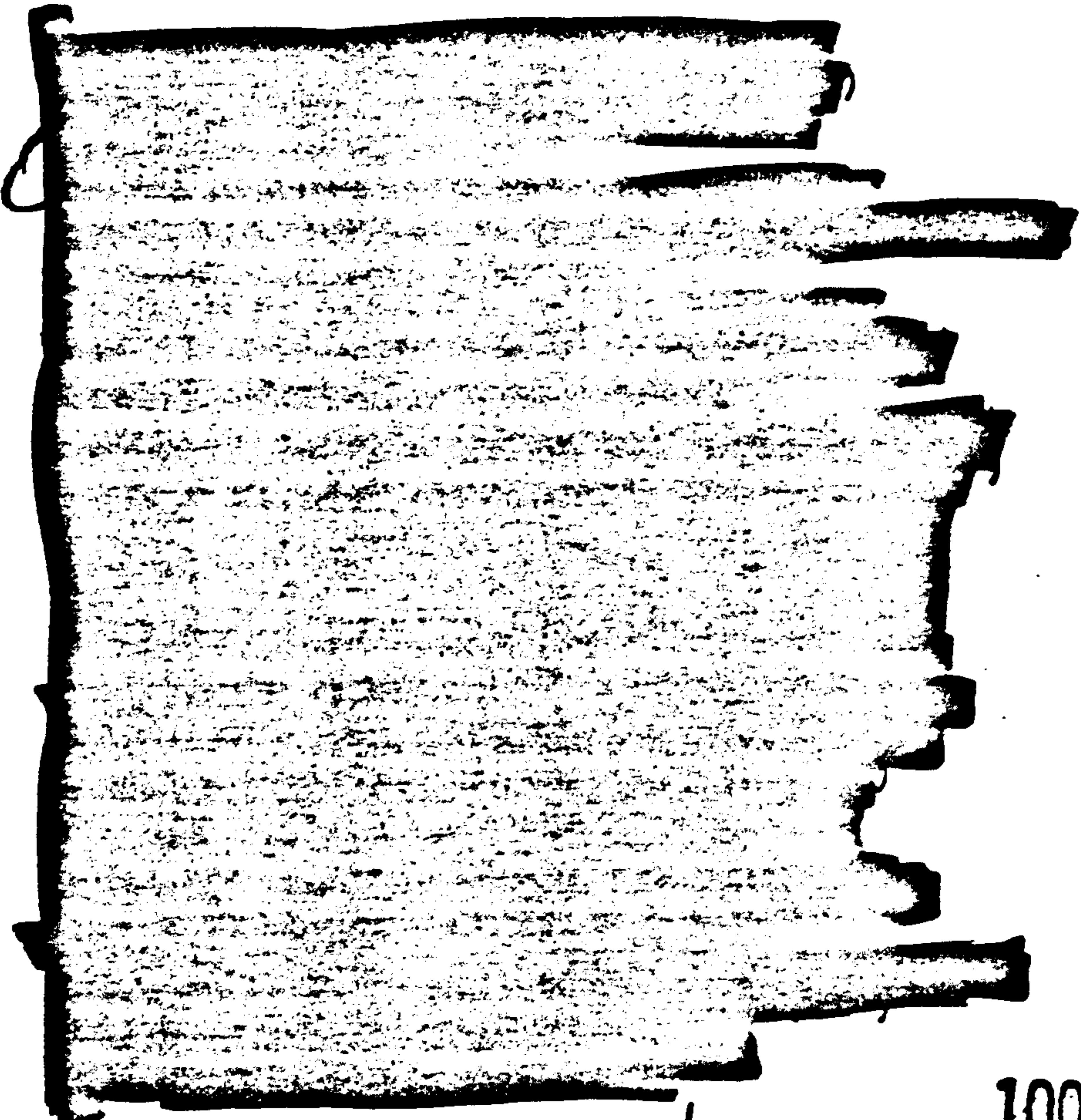

"We would like a photograph of the Irving, Texas, area which would show the RANDLE-FRAZIER house and carport with windows and also have shots taken from the viewpoint of a person looking out of these windows or coming out of the door along the path or route followed by OSWALD on the morning of November 22nd. According to the interview with Mrs. RANDLE appearing on pages 288-289 of GEMBERLING's report dated 12/10/63, she saw OSWALD walking diagonally from 5th Street in a northeasterly direction, across Westbrook Street toward the back of the house while she was standing at her sink looking out the window. She says she opened the back door a slight bit to see what OSWALD was doing, and saw him go to the far side of her brother's car which was parked just north of the carport and heading in an easterly direction toward Westbrook Street and saw OSWALD open the right rear door of the car. Upon completion of dictation of above letter, Inspector MALLEY advised that he had informed the Department that their request was of such magnitude that it would be physically impossible to obtain the desired plats and photos in the prescribed time.

He stated they then requested that if at all possible that they be furnished the info requested for 3/9/64, no later than 3/10/64.

Inspector MALLEY was advised that this project would take a minimum of 2 weeks with qualified draftsmen. He stated that we should review the matter, determine the amount of work and also determine if a local contractor could compile the desired plats and then submit our recommendations as to whether a local contractor should be employed or if Inspector GAUTHIER and his assistants should come to Dallas to compile the desired info. 
