This question has arisen in connection with a newspaper article indicating that OSWALD could not have worked for the State of Texas if he had not been an informant. He asked to be called back today.

At 9:15 AM today, on information received from SA ROBERT P. GEMBERLING, I advised Mr. BRANNIGAN that JACK CHARLES CASON is President of the Texas School Book Depository and that he advised that this was a private corporation; that we had not checked it any further. Mr. BRANNIGAN stated that is all he needed.

Inspector JAMES R. MALLEY called at 9:10 AM today and referred to Dallas teletype to Bureau, 3/20/64 re ROY S. TRULY's statement that President's Commission is now taking taped interviews with TSBD employees. Mr. MALLEY inquired as to whether they did actually take any recordings.

I advised that they did take one of him and one or two others.

Mr. MALLEY said per Director's instructions, he went to RANKIN of the President's Commission, and they insist that they didn't take any actual depositions or statements as such yesterday. They claim they are only talking to those individuals they plan on bringing to Washington and that all the other work they were leaving to us, and there was no duplication in this. The requests they made of us covered specific information they wanted.

Mr. MALLEY inquired as to how soon we would submit report and requested it as soon as possible. I advised that we would send in extra copies (five each) of the signed statements and that we think we can get all of the signed statements out tomorrow.

On March 20, 1964, a transcript of all radio transmissions emanating from the Dallas County Sheriff's Office during the period from 12:20 P.M., November 22, 1963, to 6:00 P.M., November 24, 1963, relating to the assassination of President JOHN FITZGERALD KENNEDY, murder of Dallas Police officer J. D. TIPPIT, investigation of said assassination and murder, and the security and movement of LEE HARVEY OSWALD to the Dallas County Jail reflected that between 1:54 P.M. and 2:11 P.M. on November 22, 1963, a radio message was given out to the effect that the Carrollton, Texas, Police Department had telephonically advised the Sheriff's Office that someone had reported a 1963 red Chevrolet Impala bearing Georgia 1963 License 52 J 1033 had been parked for three or four days near Harry Hines Circle and had reported that the vehicle had just left the location traveling north on Harry Hines at a high rate of speed.

ATLANTA at Atlanta, Georgia, will ascertain the registration data on 1963 Georgia License 52 J 1033. Thereafter, interview the registrant to determine complete details as to his presence in Dallas, Texas, on November 22, 1963; whether he knew LEE HARVEY OSWALD; and, whether he can furnish any information bearing on the assassination. The results of this particular investigation should be furnished Dallas in appropriate FD-302 or insert form; 25 copies each.

At 8:50 AM today, Mr. BURT GRIFFIN of the WARREN Commission telephonically advised that he had interviewed Sgt. P. T. DEAN of the Dallas PD last night and DEAN informed him that he had received a call approximately 2:00 AM, Tuesday morning, 3/17/64 from one RALPH SIMPSON, Victoria British Columbia. After the call, Sgt. DEAN and the PD switchboard operator PATRICIA (last name unknown) determined that the call was placed from phone number 3843780. This phone number is reportedly registered to R. H. W. SMELE, 1141 Caldonia, Victoria, British Columbia.

DEAN also advised that the switchboard operator at the PD had overheard part of the call and that contact had been made with BERNICE WILLIAMS of the Victoria, British Columbia Phone Co. to obtain the above information. In substance, Mr. GRIFFIN advised that DEAN said SIMPSON informed him he had a moving picture photographs of the assassination and wanted to know what to do with them. DEAN reportedly instructed SIMPSON to forward the film to the Commission and SIMPSON stated he did not desire to do that, and that he was sending the film directly to DEAN in Dallas. *Simpson adv he is represented by attorney Ralph Sadler (PK)*

Mr. GRIFFIN requested that if the Bureau does not have this film, that immediate contact be made with SIMPSON for interview and circumstances surrounding his taking the film.

(3) See Page 6, Item B3-32. These persons are identified as follows:

From left, (a) MARINA OSWALD (b) VALENTIN, last name unknown (cousin of PETRUSEVICH, above-mentioned) and (c) PETRUSEVICH.

(4) See Page 9, Item 33-30. These persons are depicted as follows:

From left, (a) LEE HARVEY OSWALD (b) person with back to camera unidentified by MARINA (c) Mrs. ZIEGER, standing, and (d) ANITA ZIEGER (lying on ground).

At approximately 9 AM, this date, Supv. WILLIAM A. BRANIGAN called in regard to Dallas letterhead memorandum dated 3/20/64, on OSWALD. This is the letterhead memorandum which identifies the various photographs that were shown to MARINA OSWALD.

1. Page 4 of the letterhead memorandum, item # B3-1, shows from left, LEE HARVEY OSWALD, MARINA OSWALD, MARINA's aunt and LUBOVA's husband. In other words, this letterhead memorandum shows that MARINA identified four persons in item # B3-1. A review of this particular photograph shows only three persons.

2. Page 5, item # B3-7. This letterhead memorandum identifies one of the persons as being Mrs. ZIEGER. A review of the photograph itself shows three male persons. MR. ZIEGER

3. Page 6, item B3-32, of the letterhead memorandum shows that MARINA identified two persons depicted in the photograph. A review of the photograph itself shows that there are three persons. AND Petrusovich

4. Page 9 of the letterhead memorandum, item # D33-30 - The letterhead memorandum identifies only three persons in the photograph. A review of the photograph itself shows four persons. The fourth person has his back to the camera. *4th person unidentified by Marina.*

Bureau requests that Dallas review the letterhead memorandum and furnish the correct identification of the persons in these four items.

It is requested that Dallas call this info to the Bureau and Bureau will make changes in the pages up there, that being the faster way to handle.

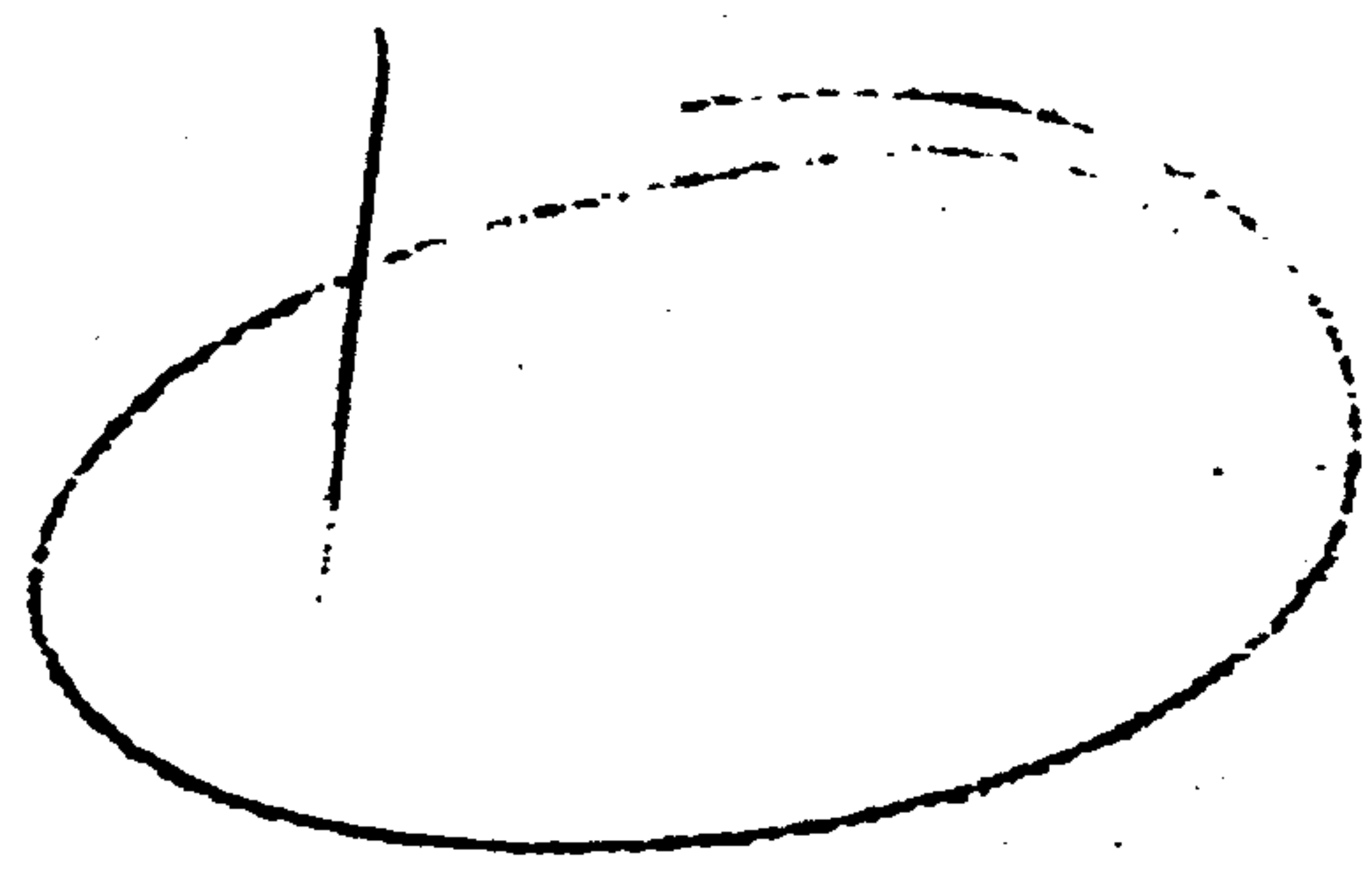

Mrs RUSSELL R. PUGH, 3502 Wichita Street, Vernon, Texas, on 3/19/64 advised SA JARRELL H. DAVIS that Post Office Box 782, Vernon, Texas is their box and has been their post office box since March, 1958 when they moved to Vernon. She added she, her husband and children are the only ones that have been receiving mail in this post office box since 1958 so far as she knows. She added that over the last few years they have received ~~XXXXXXXXXXXXXXXXXXXX~~ a few letter addressed to someone else and giving their box number but they turned these letter over to the post office clerks with the notation that these parties were not known to them. She added that she does not recall ~~XXXXXXXXXXXXXXXXXXXX~~ any of the names appearing on these letters but thought someone had made a mistake in the box number or that the box was formerly issued to them.

Mrs PUGH further advised that she and her husband had never known LEE HARVEY OSWALD or his mother, Mrs MARGERITE OSWALD and had never heard of either of them until ~~XXXXXXXXXXXX~~ they saw their names in the papers ~~XXXXXXXXXXXX~~ and heard their names on TV. She added that since November 1963 she had heard that Mrs OSWALD had formerly lived and worked in Vernon but she had never known her and so far as they knew Mrs OSWALD had never received ~~XX~~ mail in their post office box.

He added their records would not reflect all of the names of persons that had received mail in this box since 3/8/58. Section Chief W. A. BRANNIGAN telephonically advised 3:05 PM this date that the Bureau had forwarded by routing slip a copy of 30 groups of questions submitted by the Commission. He stated these questions dealt with Bureau policy, and would necessitate interviews of the Agents handling the OSWALD case, "SA HOSTY and ex SA FAIN, and it is possible there will be required additional affidavits."

Mr. BRANNIGAN stated some of these questions will be answered by the Bureau and some will be answered by other offices; therefore, Dallas should take no action regarding the questions until an airtel setting out specific instructions is furnished by the Bureau.

During the above call, Mr. BRANNIGAN inquired as to the status of the inquiry concerning the history books and the investigation involving the Love Field vicinity and the purchase of ammunition. This was the request submitted by the Bureau on 3/18/64 and then returned by the Bureau for additional investigation. Mr. BRANNIGAN was advised that the investigation was completed, the letterhead memoranda being correlated, and it would be furnished to the Bureau during the first part of next week.
