WILLIAM J. WALDMAN, Vice-President, Klein's Sporting Goods, Incorporated, 4540 West Madison Street, Chicago, Illinois, was contacted by SA ROBERT J. DOLAN on 4/15/64 regarding records furnished by Mr. WALDMAN on 3/12/64.

Mr. WALDMAN produced copies of records submitted by Chicago airtel to Bureau dated 3/13/64 and such were re-examined in detail. Specific reference was made to a Purchase Order of Klein's Sporting Goods referred to in referenced communication as "Item 1" in Chicago airtel of 3/13/64.

Regarding Purchase Order, Klein's Sporting Goods, Incorporated, 4540 West Madison Street, Chicago 24, Illinois, the following is noted:

This Purchase Order (Item #1 of Chicago airtel 3/13/64) is one sheet of a multi-page document containing data from various purchases. Mr. WALDMAN explained that this Purchase Order sheet is the bottom page of this multi-page document, all pages of which are concerned in the purchase of, as in this case, Italian Mannlicher-Carcano Rifles. He noted in the center of this page a series of

vertical columns each bearing the designation at its head "A/R". He noted that on an unused Purchase Order blank in addition to a bottom page similar to this would be contained other pages with their leading edges extending to the vertical lines of each of these center columns. Each subsequent page, he noted, would be narrower in width than the succeeding page and as a result would make reference only to a specific vertical column and the data contained thereon.

In the case in question, Mr. WALDMAN stated, the Purchase Order was addressed to Crescent Firearms, 2 West 37 Street, New York 18, New York, and bears an "Effective date" of 1/15/62. This date, Mr. WALDMAN explained, is utilized for administrative purposes only by their firm and indicates when the Purchase Order was first initiated by someone of their firm. This date does not indicate in any way the date order was placed, the date of shipment, billing date, date of invoice, etc. In actuality, Mr. WALDMAN stated, this date has no bearing whatever on the shipment in question but is rather an administrative device utilized by his firm. He stated the date 1/15/62 is correct.

Mr. WALDMAN noted that the Purchase Order in question makes various references to quantities of described rifles showing such figures as 200, 100 and 400, however, the column headed by Order Number 1243 dated 1/24/63 and bearing a vertical line drawn through the column makes reference only to a shipment of 100 of described rifles which, he noted, is the shipment in question containing Rifle #C2766.

Mr. WALDMAN stated that the figures in adjoining columns, namely "200" and "400" do not have direct reference to the shipment in question and have no reference whatever to the shipment of 100 rifles containing the specific weapon in question.

Mr. WALDMAN reiterated that this Purchase Order as shown makes reference only to an order and subsequent shipment

of 100 Italian Mannlicher-Carcano Rifles, Klein's catalogue #C20-T749. He noted that at the bottom of the Purchase Order is noted a receiving record bearing date 2/21/63 showing that ten packages which comprised this shipment of 100 rifles was received on that date via Lifschultz Freight weighing 750 pounds and utilizing bill of lading #3041342. Freight charges are shown as \$39.53. Further, he noted that this form under column "Accounting Department" and "Extension" bears Klein's extension #85000 and shows that the receipt of the 100 rifles was recorded for accounting purposes on 2/22/63.] Continuing, Mr. WALDMAN stated that all entries contained on this Purchase Order were made by Klein's personnel.

Continuing, Mr. WALDMAN stated that this purchase of 100 rifles is further recorded on ten "Customers Invoices" of Crescent Firearms, Incorporated, 2 West 37 Street, New York 18, New York. Each of these invoices, he stated, makes reference to a specific carton in the shipment in question, each of which contains ten of the described rifles. The rifles contained in each carton are itemized by serial number on this customers invoice. The ten customers invoices show an accounting for the 100 rifles in the shipment and specifically to receipt of rifle, serial number C2766, which is recorded on Crescent Firearms, Incorporated, Customers Invoice #3620, which bears carton #3376 and lists this specific rifle as item #3 under caption "Serial Number".

Mr. WALDMAN stated that all ten of the customers invoices were prepared by Crescent Firearms, Incorporated, and all entries made thereon were apparently made by employees of Crescent Firearms, Incorporated. Mr. WALDMAN noted that this is an assumption on his part, however, he can state emphatically that these invoices are received by Klein's as shown and that the entries made thereon are not made by Klein's employees.

Mr. WALDMAN stated that further documentation of this shipment is shown by Crescent Firearms, Incorporated, invoice #3178 dated 2/7/63 made to Klein's Sporting Goods,

CG 62-6115

Incorporated, 4540 West Madison Street, Chicago, Illinois, which is concerned directly with the shipment of previously described weapons including rifles bearing serial number C2766.

Completing the documentation, Mr. WALDMAN stated, is Klein's voucher and attached check, both bearing number 28966. The check is dated 3/1/63 in the amount of \$850 made payable to Crescent Firearms, Incorporated, and the voucher attached thereto bears date "2-7" for invoice #3178 in the amount of \$850.

It is suggested the FD-302 be rewritten possibly in the form of an insert.

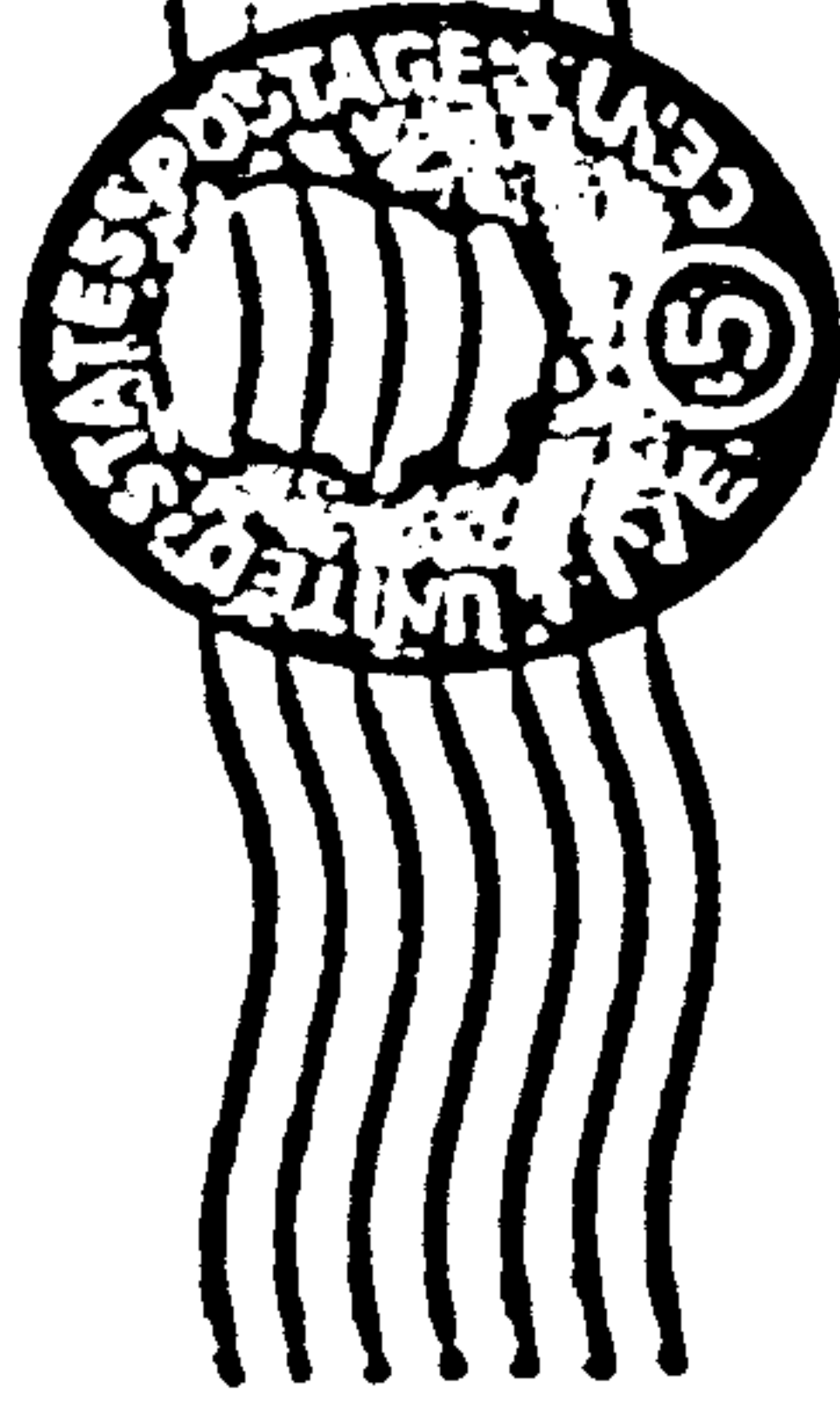

On March 11, 1964, between three and four hundred people attended a meeting sponsored by the Friends of the National Guardian and held at the Philadelphia Ethical Society auditorium, 1906 Rittenhouse Square, Philadelphia, Pa. The auditorium was overcrowded and people were standing in the vestibule.

The meeting was billed as a public inquiry into the OSWALD case and took place about 8:30 p.m., featuring MARK LANE, described as a civil libertarian, a leader in the New York Reform Democrats, a former member of the New York State Legislature, and the attorney retained by Mrs. MARGUERITE OSWALD, LEE OSWALD's mother. Over three hundred people paid \$1.00 each for admission and approximately \$200 additional was collected.

A. HARRY LEVITAN was Chairman of the affair and DAVID DAVIS appeared to be in charge. MARK LANE spoke and gave various information to cause a great deal of doubt as to whether LEE HARVEY OSWALD was guilty of the assassination of President KENNEDY. He accused the FBI and Dallas Police of withholding evidence and accused the Secret Service of not doing a real thorough job of protecting the President. He

had photographs of testimony of OSWALD taken while he was in prison. He pointed out discrepancies in this testimony. He said that the Dallas Police said the rifle was one make and the FBI said it was another make. Also, that the doctor who examined the President after he was shot changed his story as to the direction from which the bullet entered the President's body.

He said also there were questions he could not answer now. One applied to JACK RUBY, which he could not answer due to RUBY's trial. The other information was given to the Warren Commission and had to do with the meeting of three men after the President was shot and before OSWALD was shot. The information in general was the same as that furnished by LANE on radio and was effective in convincing the people present that there was doubt as to the guilt of OSWALD. There was a standing ovation and the audience applauded for approximately ten minutes at the conclusion of his talk.

WFIL TV was there but no cameras were in the auditorium. Also, MARK LANE spoke on Radio Station WPKN from about 12:10 to 12:50 a.m., March 12, 1964.

All the faithful were there. That is to say many people known to me as pro-Communist or active in Communist front groups. Those recognized were those who have attended

meetings of the Philadelphia Social Science Forum, the JACK FONER Forum, members of the Sholem Aleichem Club, Emergency Civil Liberties Committee, and also Communist Party and Socialist Workers Party membership was in evidence at the meeting. A large group of Woman Strike for Peace people were present and active in getting people to sign a peace petition after the meeting.

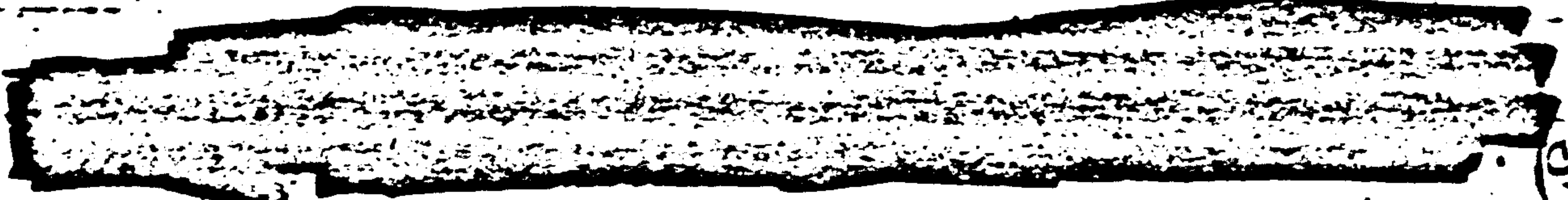

Re Bureau radiogram 4/17/64, requesting photographs of records of Mrs. BERTHA CHEEK, and Dallas airtel to Bureau, 4/21/64.

On 4/22/64 I called the Bureau and talked to Supv. RICHARD ROGGE and pointed out to him that there were approximately 1,000 names; that we had not made a list of these names; that we had sent in the film and that we were taking no further action.

I inquired as to whether he knew what the Commission wanted this for and whether there was going to be additional investigation. He stated he had no information except what was in the radiogram, but that we should take no further action unless requested to do so. He stated they would have copies made of the film for us and for the Bureau prior to sending it to the Commission.


