MRS. BIRDIE E. BELCHER, Retail Merchants Credit Association, Dallas, on 1/15/63, advised SA EDWIN D. KUYKENDALL that FRED WARD HUDSPETH, wife MILLIE born 7/13/09, formerly resided at 4215 Eycliff, Dallas, but as of 9/62 resided at 3863 Walnut Hill Lane, Dallas, and continued to be employed by Southwest Novelty Company, Dallas, telephone AH 6-2944. He had a son, age 19, in 1957. No derogatory data appeared.

The current Dallas telephone directory and the 1962 Dallas City Directory reflect subject resides at 3863 Walnut Hill Lane, Dallas. City Directory indicates he is employed by Southwest Novelty Company and his wife's name is MILLIE. The Crisscross Telephone Directory for 1962 does not list AH 6-2944, alleged number of Southwest Novelty Company.

A review of instant file and of the Dallas indices provides no indication subject has engaged in activities of any subversive organization subsequent to the last report submitted in this case. It appears, however, he continues friendly with NATALIE and ELWOOD ROSS, CP members.

Dallas report of SA JAMES P. HOSTY, JR., 11/30/60, reflects subject then was being placed on the Reserve Index, Section B, because of his reported past CP membership and his continued association with CP members in Dallas. There appears to be no change between then and now regarding his sympathies and, therefore, it is recommended subject be continued on the Reserve Index, Section B.

It does not appear that subject has potential for development as an informant or source of information. Also it does not appear he qualifies for the Security Index.

Interview of subject at this time is not warranted. He is retired, lives in a rural area, and presents no potential as an informant or source. Past interview unproductive.

On 12/14/62, Mrs. FREDIE SUE EELCHER, 2112 Jackson Street, Dallas, Texas, Retail Merchants Credit Association, advised that WALTER CASE was formerly employed by the AFL-CIO, but as of 8/16/62, was employed as a dealer by the Fuller Brush Co., Hilline Drive, Dallas, Texas. The files reflected that WALTER CASE and his wife, ROSE, came to Dallas from Louisville, Ky., where they resided at 2345 Alexander Avenue. He was born 8/25/04 at Canadian, Texas and has previously been divorced. His parents are deceased and he has one child 10 years of age.

The Records Bureau at the Dallas Police Department and the Identification Bureau of the same department were checked by GEORGE KEMP and RERT H. SIMS, respectively on 12/13/62 and no record could be found on WALTER CASE.

On 12/14/62, Mrs. EVELYN KEETON, Postal Inspector's Office, Terminal Annex Building, Dallas, Texas, advised that on 10/17/62, WALTER CASE had given a change of address to 10426 Desdemona, Dallas, Texas.

On 1/9/63, [redacted] advised that WALTER CASE had never been a member of the Communist Party in Dallas, nor was he known to associate with Communist Party members in this city. 72

In view of the above, it is suggested that CASE'S name be retained on the reserve index, inasmuch as he offers no potential for development as an informant, or any potential for development by the Soviets as a source, and it is suggested that this case be closed.

On 1/31/63, EDNA MAE CARTER, Records Bureau, Dallas PD, and J. G. VICKERY, Identification Bureau, Dallas PD, advised their respective records reflect no information on BRIMM.

On 3/18/63, [redacted] 7d
"The Texas Catholic," the official publication of the Dallas-Fort Worth Catholic Diocese, 2122 Kidwell, Dallas, advised SA JAMES P. HOSTY, JR., that BRIMM had been employed by the paper for approximately three years. He described him as being an employee who sold advertising, was a proof reader, and "a general flunky." [redacted] 7d
[redacted] was of the opinion that BRIMM came from a pretty good family but that the family considers him to be a social misfit. Personally, [redacted] said, he felt BRIMM was a "little off," 7d and did not have enough sense to be mixed up in any sort of subversive activity.

In view of subject's not meeting the criteria established for inclusion in the Security Index or the Reserve Index, it is suggested that this case be closed, subject to being reopened in the event he is contacted by PHIL BARKER, a CP member of Fort Worth, who has recently returned from Missouri.

On 1/9/63, [redacted] who has furnished reliable information in the past, advised that subject is not now active in the Communist Party and is not a member of the Communist Party. It was informant's recollection that L'HOSTE had not been a member of the Communist Party in Dallas, but may have participated in front activity several years ago.

In view of the above, it would seem that subject offers no potential for development as an informant, has no qualifications as a contact of the Soviets; therefore, it is suggested that her name be retained on the reserve index and that this case be closed.

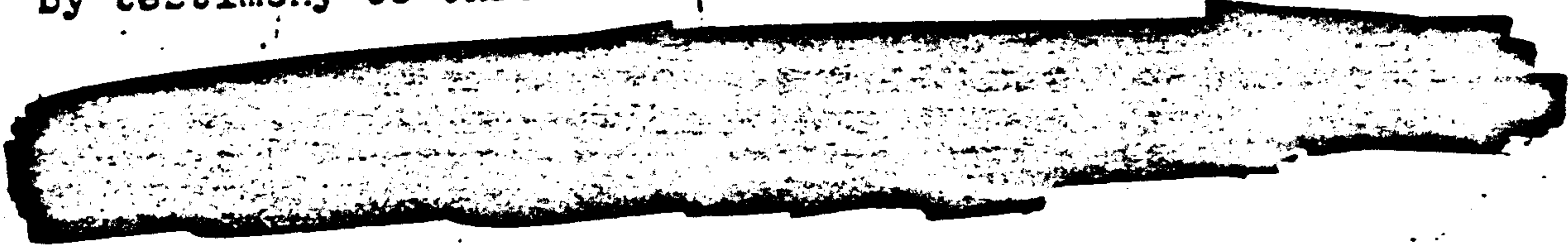

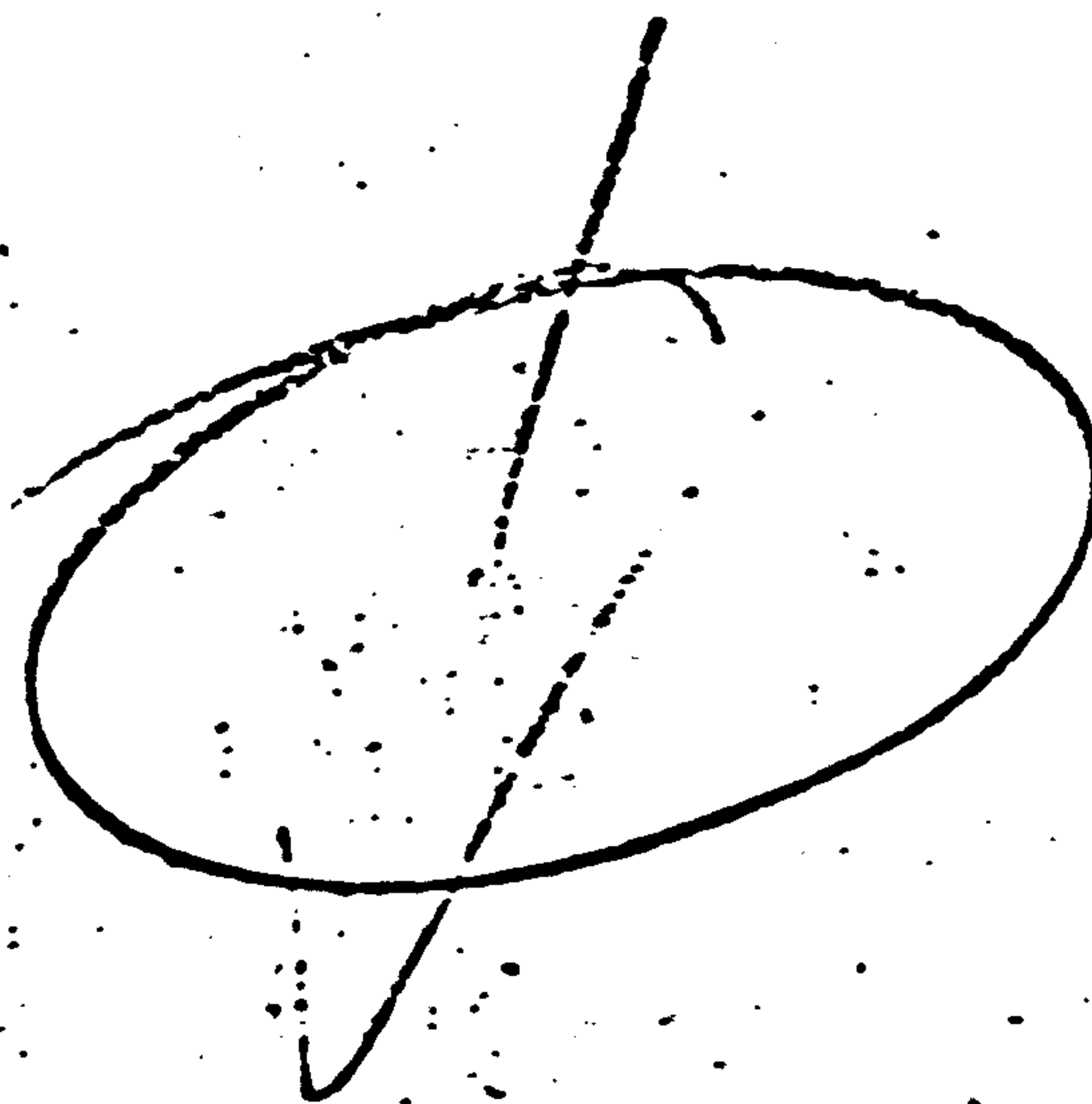
