On 6/4/64, WILLIAM F. ALEXANDER, Assistant District Attorney, Dallas County, Texas, appeared at the office for the purpose of obtaining photographs of all property obtained by the Dallas Police Department which had been turned over to the Dallas Office of the FBI on 11/26/63. These photographs were desired, inasmuch as District Attorney HENRY WADE was to appear before the President's Commission. (A list of the property is contained in 1B1, of 100-10461).

ALEXANDER was advised a complete set of photographs ^{had} ~~have~~ been previously furnished to the Dallas Police Department and that such photographs could be obtained at that department.

On 6/5/64, Inspector J. R. MALLEY advised that he had received information from the legal counsel, J. LEE RANKIN of the President's Commission that he and Chief Justice EARL WARREN, along with representatives of Secret Service, and possibly another attorney or two, would very probably come to Dallas on Sunday, June 7th. Tentative plans are that they will leave Washington by military jet at 6:00 AM Washington time, scheduled arrival in Dallas area at about 7:00 AM Dallas time. All arrangements have been made by Secret Service, and no requests are being made of the Bureau.


As far as Mr. RANKIN knows, there will probably not be any requests, but he has advised MALLEY that in the event they need anything from the FBI, he will get in touch with this office immediately.

It is anticipated that they will drive around to the various points of interest, such as the School Book Depository Bldg., OSWALD's address, both in Dallas and in Irving, and possibly go to the Police Department basement. Again, all arrangements are being made for these tours by Secret Service.

Inspector MALLEY is not coming along. His only suggestion was, of course, that we have an Agent on duty throughout the day Sunday to make certain that any requests were given immediate and prompt attention.

Inspector J. R. MALLEY called at 4:00 PM today and quoted the following UPI news release captioned "Assassination - Dallas"

A Dallas auto salesman told the Dallas Times Herald today that one of the three bullets fired during the assassination of President KENNEDY went wild, crashed into a curb and apparently hit him. Last week, KRLD TV said in a copyright story that the third shot went wild. The television station quoted a source close to the Warren Commission as saying the first bullet apparently struck both President KENNEDY and Texas Governor JOHN CONNALLY, and the second hit the President in the head.

The 27 year old salesman, who asked that his name not be used, said either the bullet or concrete chip grazed his face. In the interview, he said he was by a concrete abutment on the east side of the triple underpass watching the motorcade as it turned on Elm at Houston. It was that first shot -- then the second and the third, he said sometimes I think it was with the second, a bullet -- I am sure it was a bullet -- hit the curb in front of me and I felt a sting on my cheek. In the confusion that followed, I did not think any more about it until a policeman told me his face was bloody. I went back to where I was standing and saw the crease mark, obviously fresh on the curb. Apparently what hit me was the bullet ricocheting off the curb, or possibly even a part of the concrete, tho I doubt it. He said he was almost in a direct line from the Texas School Book Depository Bldg. on a downward angle in front of the KENNEDY car. He said he told his story that day to a Dallas detective and was interviewed by FBI Agents in mid December. He said the FBI talked to him about 15 minutes and seemed more concerned "about whether I knew JACK RUBY." He said the Warren Commission has not contacted him.
