This application was furnished to our FBI headquarters shortly after it was obtained from you on November 27, 1963. Our headquarters worked closely with the President's Commission on the Assassination of President Kennedy and numerous documents obtained by this bureau were made available to the President's Commission.

At the present time the Department of Justice has under study the disposition to be made of various documents obtained by this bureau, as well as other agencies, during the course of the extensive investigation conducted.

I am making it known to my headquarters that you have made inquiry concerning the return of this application and requesting that they endeavor to obtain, as soon as possible, a decision from the Department of Justice concerning this matter.

Upon the receipt of any information that would indicate when you may expect to receive the questioned application will be immediately made available to you, and I want you to know how much I appreciate the cooperation

b7d [REDACTED] Civil Service Commission, Dallas, personally contacted me today, at which time he furnished a book entitled "The Day HUEY LONG was Shot". On the inside cover of this book there appears the following:

"To Derek - My Chief  
H. L. Oswald".

b7d [REDACTED] LEON WILSON, at Lubbock, was contacted by J. E. PLATZ, Associate Librarian, Texas Technological College, Lubbock, Texas. PLATZ obtained this book in a shipment of books obtained from a book store in Pelham, New York.

Upon receiving this shipment and during the process of cataloguing these books, the above mentioned book was discovered.

b7d [REDACTED] indicated that PLATZ has necessary information as to the exact name and address of the book store in Pelham, and possibly other background information if needed. [REDACTED] stated he was doing this unofficially in order to preclude notifying his superiors in Washington concerning this matter and therefore, requested that receipt of this book by him be held in a circumspect manner.

b7d [REDACTED] voluntarily furnished this book for whatever significance it may have and he indicated its return to him was not necessary; however, he would like to be advised as to the possible outcome of any inquiry made by the Bureau.

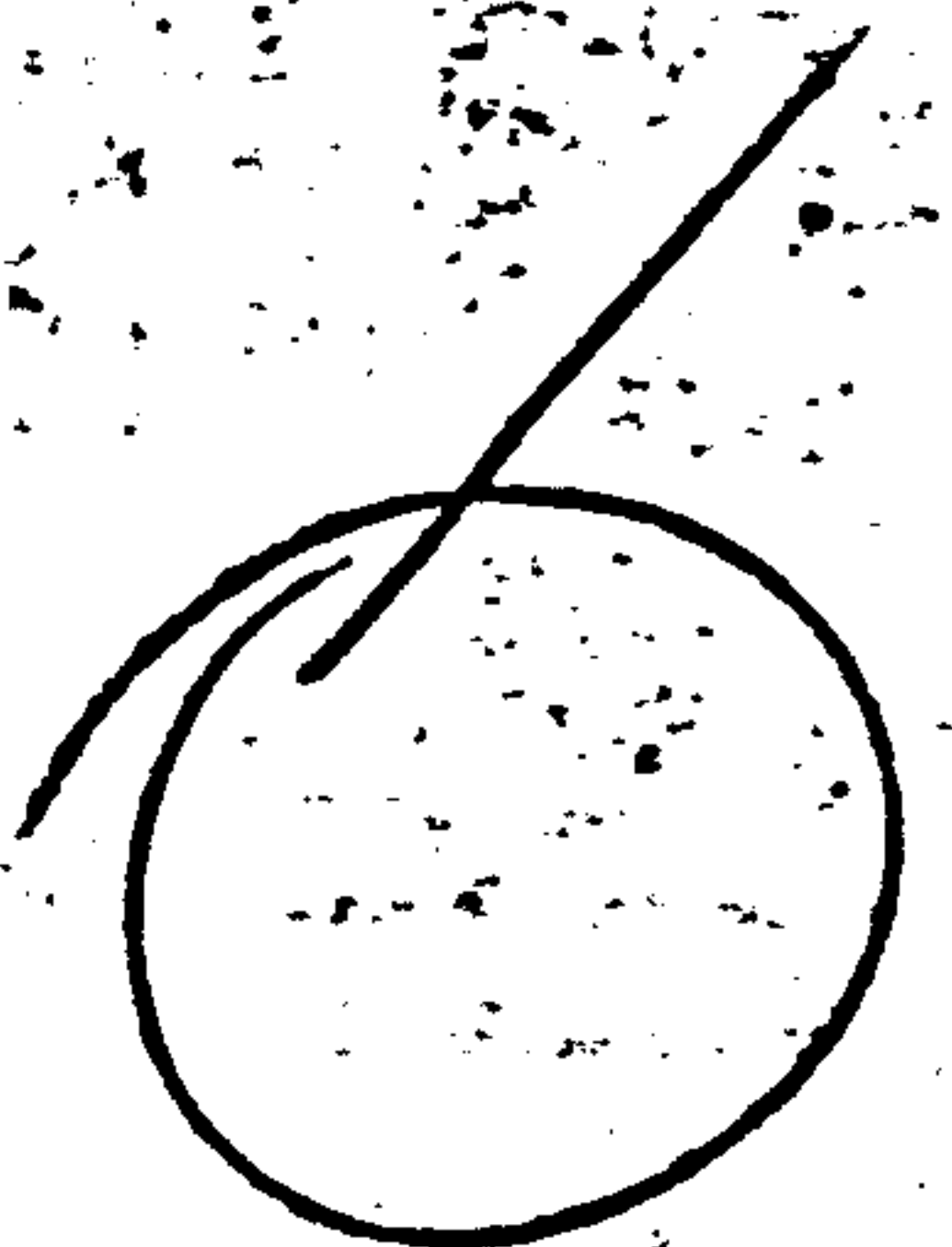

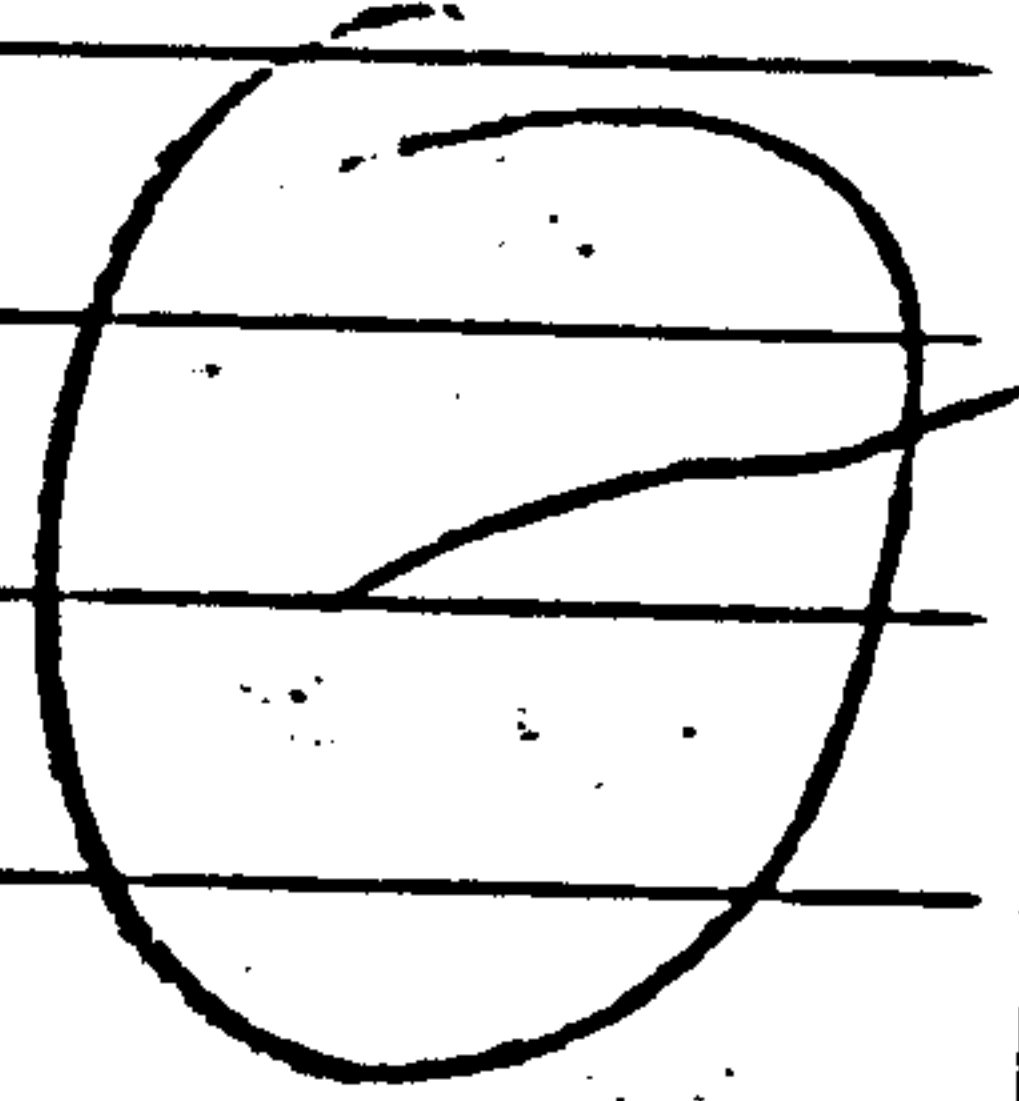

In 1962 I was in Washington D. C. and took a picture in front of the White House. I examined the photograph in early 1964 and noticed that one of the people in the picture, who were demonstrating in front of the White House, looked like pictures I had seen of Lee Harvey Oswald. I notified the FBI and they sent the resident agent from Abilene, Texas, to see me. I was stationed at Webb Air Force Base, Big Springs, Texas, at the time. To the best of my recollection this was in February or March of 1964.

I gave my 35mm color slide to the agent with the understanding that it would be returned to me. Also I asked that any information pertaining to the picture might be sent me, as I was interested in whether or not the person in the picture really was Oswald.

I have heard nothing from the FBI and I would like to have the picture back if it has not been lost.

I would appreciate any assistance you might give me on this matter.

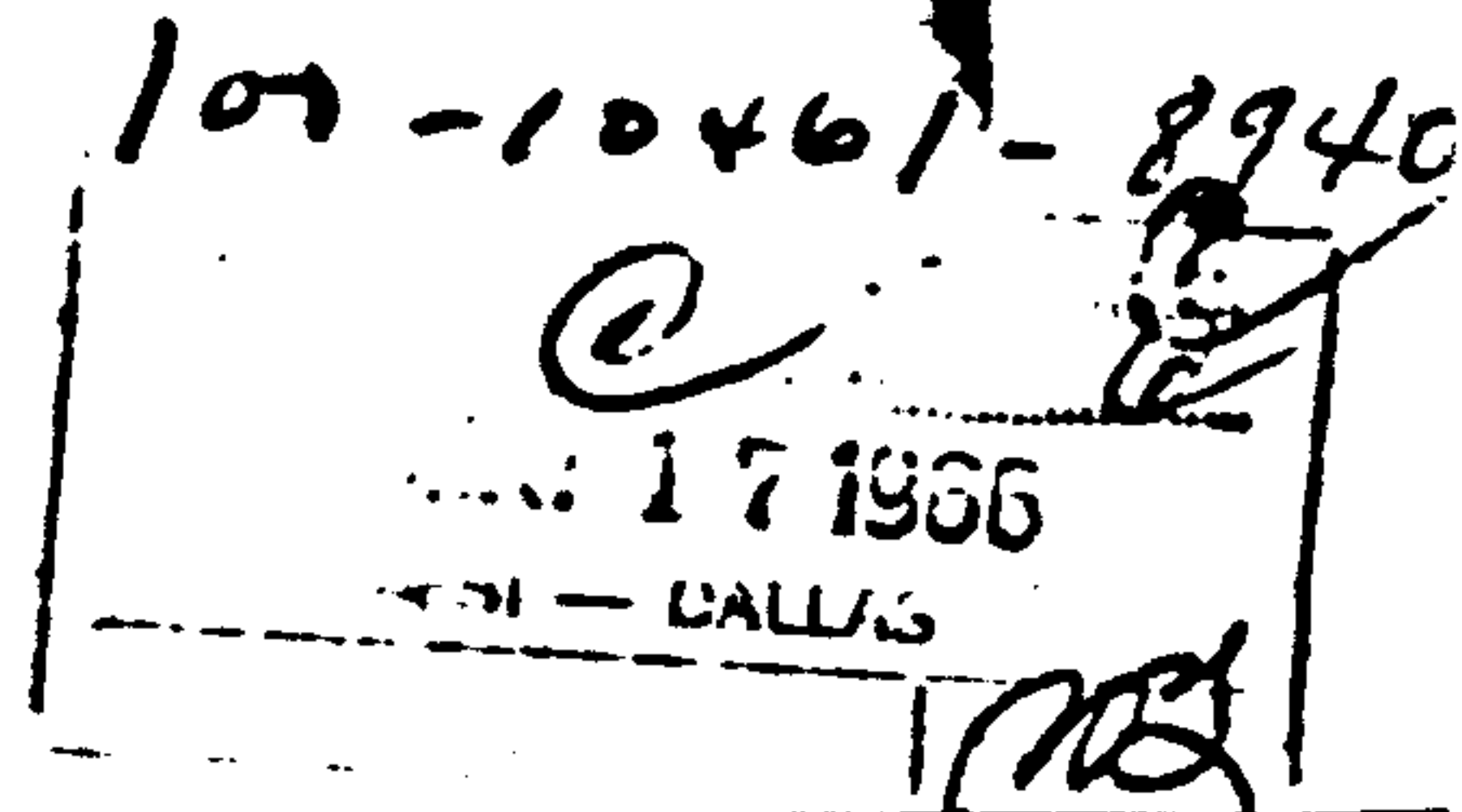

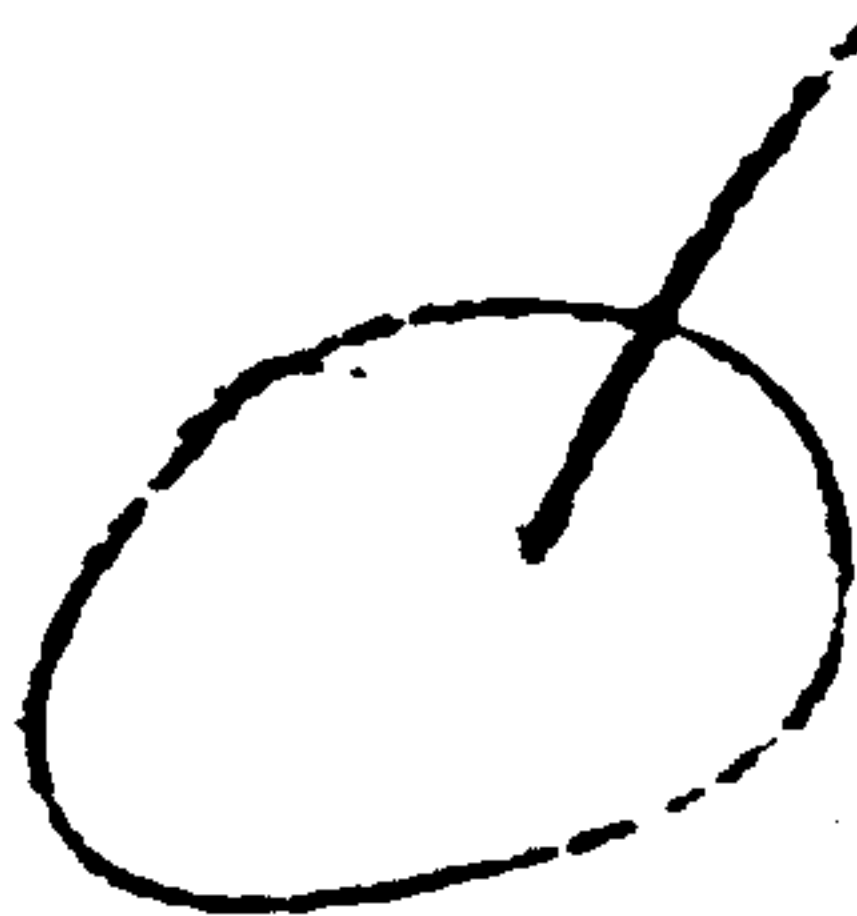

On 5/31/66, Inspector REX SCHRODER, SOG, telephonically called the attention of the Dallas Office to article appearing in the Washington Post newspaper on 5/29/66 and requested that in the event Dallas could locate any information which would assist the Bureau in a rebuttal of the allegation contained in the article, it would be appreciated.

On 6/2/66, telephonic contact with Inspector SCHRODER indicated that the Bureau was desirous of any information Dallas had in its files with respect to a subsequent official autopsy report reflecting that the bullet which entered the shoulder of President KENNEDY had exited through his throat. He indicated further that in the event the Dallas Office had any such information to also determine if there was any indication that a member of the KENNEDY family had requested that the subsequent autopsy report be held in the strictest confidence.

Inspector SCHRODER was advised that such information was never received by Dallas.
