Re report of SA EMORY E. HORTON dated 3/11/64 at Dallas.

For info of Dallas, on 9/1/66, Rev. LYMAN ERICKSON, Christian Servicemen's Center (CSC), 212 N. Alamo, San Antonio, Texas, appeared at the San Antonio FBI office and furnished the following information to SA WILLIAM F. HOOD.

An elderly man he knew as JOHN HOWARD BOWEN, who had previously visited the CSC from time to time since April, 1966, advised ERICKSON on the night of 8/29/66, that he, BOWEN, was very ill as the result of uremic poisoning. ERICKSON immediately placed BOWEN in the Medical Arts Hospital, San Antonio, where he died on the night of 8/31/66.

In going through BOWEN's personal effects to locate relatives or friends to notify, ERICKSON discovered BOWEN appeared to be using two identities.

There were various credit cards, photographs, receipts and identification cards showing JOHN HOWARD BOWEN, Social Security Card #449-36-9745, was born 1/14/80, Chester, Pa.

There was a Canadian Passport #5-605377, issued 10/10/63, at New Orleans, La., and other documents showing his name as ALBERT VICTOR EMANUEL OSBORNE, born 11/12/88, Grimsby, England. OSBORNE was described as a white male, 5'10", blue eyes, and brown-grey hair. His occupation was shown as clergyman. According to ERICKSON, the passport photo of OSBORNE is the same man he knew as BOWEN. His income was derived from importing bibles, religious books, Christian literature and material from England.

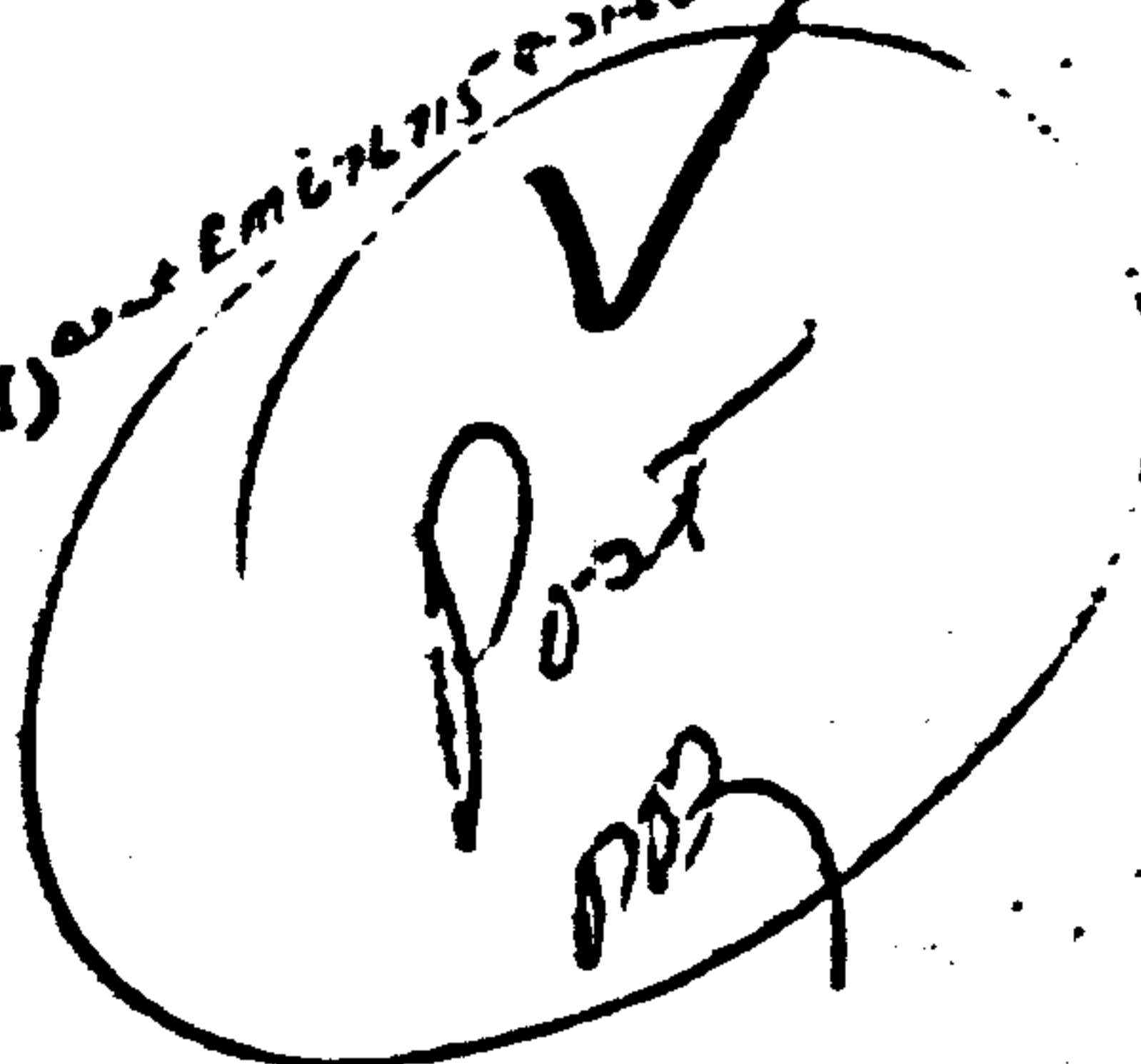
