Immigration and Naturalization Service (USINS), Tueson, Arizona. CHOATE advised that the story told by EAYE would indicate that KAYE is not a naturalized citizen of the United States. CHOATE stated that he would send for KAYE's file and intended to review it before taking any action.

ROBERT 3. KAYE was interviewed at the office of the Tucson Resident Agency. He was advised that he had the right to consult an attorney, that he did not have to make any statement unless he desired to do so and that anything he said could be used against him in a court of law.

KAYE advised that he is still residing in Apartment 9, 2116 East 17th Street, Tucson, Arizons, and that his telephone number is 624-2102. He is still employed as a vending machine service mechanic by Paleon Automatic, Inc., 727 South Campbell Avenue, Tucson, Arizona.

MAYE inelets that he met the man known to him only as LEE (LNU) at Denver, Colorado. When he saw the picture of LEE HARVEY OSWALD on TV, he was of the opinion that OSWALD was identical with LEE (LNU). He now admits that he is not certain of this identification and that he very well could have been mistaken. Maye was still unable to furnish the exact date of his meeting with LEE (LNU) at Denver, Colorado.

When quastioned as to the identity of description of the man whom he was to meet in Mexico City, KAYE could not recall any details other than that LEE (LNU) told him that the man he was to meet had black hair, and a mustiche, and would be wearing a treast cost and dark glasses. He denied that he had ever told the Secret Service Agent in El Paso that the man's take was "francis," that he was six feet, four inches tall, skinny and had a long rose. He was unable to explain thy he had furnished no description of this man at the time of his previous interview at Tusson, Arizona.

HAYE stated that he had forgotten to mention that he had appeared on TV and radio while in Denver, Colorado. He advised that these appearances were based on his experiences during the war. A few years ago, about the year 1950 or 1961, he had been interviewed on the "STARLY (Phonetic) ALLEN" show on Channel Seven in Denver, Colorado. Around the same time he was interviewed on two occasions on the LEE BURMAN show on Channel Two, also Denver, Colorado. KAYE also stated that about the same time he was interviewed by a BILL BARKER on NBC radio in Denver, Colorado. KAYE was unable to be more specific regarding these appearances.

On April 6, 1964, the below listed individuals were contacted and they advised that they had no information in the files of their respective offices identifiable with ROBERT J. KAYE, also known as ROBERT KLONOWSKI, ROMAN BOBBY SOKOLOWSKI:

On April 6, 1964, Miss CONSUELO MALDONADO, Mexican Custors Service, Juarez, was furnished the information that one ROBERT J. KAYE had in his possession as of November 24, 1963 a 15 day Mexicar Tourist permit, number 662282, which was supposed to have been issued to him at Juarez on October 28, 1963. Miss MALDONADO stated that she would check the records of her office is as effort to locate additional information regarding this matter.

On April 29, 1964, Miss CONSUELD MALDONADO, mentioned above, stated that she had checked the records of her office and had been unable to locate any 15 day Mexican Tourist permit issued to ROBERT J. KAYE.

Om May 8, 1964, Miss CONSULLO MALDONADO, mentioned above, was shown a copy of a 15 day Mexican Tourist permit, number 662282, issued by the Secretaria de Gobernacion of the Mexican Government at Juarez, Chihuahua, Mexico, on October 28, 1963, to ROBERT J. KAYE. KAYE's occupation was listed as mechanic. He was described as 28 years of age, single, a North American. This document contained the entrance date of October 29, 1963, and was stamped to indicate that the bearer of the document traveled by automobile. No return date was stamped on the document.

After viewing the above mentioned document, Miss MAIDONADO rechacked the records of her office and ascertained than the above mentioned document was issued to KAYE on October 29, 1963. She said that travelers receive only one copy of a Mexican Tourist permit and that this copy must be turned into the Mexican Immigration authorities at Kilometer 28, south of Juarez, when the traveler returns to the horder area. In addition, she pointed out that the traveler must display the Mexican Tourist permit when passing the Mexican Immigration station located at Kilometer 2d, erroute to the interior of Mexico. She said that the same procedure was followed

by persons boarding an airplane at the Juarez airport for the interior of Mexico and upon returning to the Juarez airport. Likewise, documents of individuals traveling on Mexican Tourist permits are checked by the railroad authorities and bus limes upon their entry into Mexico and their return to the border area.

Miss MAIDONADO indicated that it did not appear as though the above mentioned document was actually ever used by ROBERT J. KAYE. She said that she checked the records of her office and that there is no record to indicate that KAYE had turned in his Mexican Tourist indicate that KAYE had turned in his Mexican Tourist permit upon his return to the border area of Mexico from permit upon his return to the border area of Mexico were made regarding all persons who travel into Mexico were made regarding all persons who travel into Mexico and then subsequently raturn to the border area. She stated that the only way that KAYE could have maintained his Mexican Tourist permit in his possession after returning to the border area from the interior of Mexico was for the Mexican Immigration officer to inadvertently fail to pick up the document from KAYE, unless KAYE was able to illegally depart from Mexico.

Miss MALDONADO checked the records for entries and departures for the periods October 1, 1963 through October 15, 1963 and October 28, 1963 through November 15, 1963 and no record was located regarding NAYE, except for the record mentioned above. She added that the above mentioned permit issued to KAYE listed KAYE's destination in Mexico as Chibushua, Chibushua, Mexico.

On April 16, 1964 an individual who requested that his identity not be divulged, but who has furnished reliable information in the past, advised that he was not acquainted with an exertic dancer by the name of GLORIA; who was supposed to have been employed in a small club in Juarez during the fell of 1963 and with whom KAYE had Juarez during his stay in Juarez. The records of his office reflect that ROBERT J. KAYE, 95 South Ogden Street, Denver, Colorado, traded in a 1957 Ford, Fairlane, crange over white, 1963 Texas license CF 941, motor number D7DT224947, to El Paso Ford on September 27, 1963 and purchased at the same time from El Pase Ford a 1956 Oldsmobile 93, black, motor number 569A4713. KAYE was allowed \$295.00 on the 1957 Ford and . purchased the 1956 Didsmobile for \$495.00 paying the difference in cash.

On October 23, 1963, KAYE sold the 1956 Oldsmobile back to Fl Pago Ford for \$75.00. KAYE told Mr. FRAZIER that he needed the money in order to return to Denver, Colorado. In connection with the resale of the 1956 Oldsmobile to El Paso Ford, KAYE listed his name as ROBERT JOSEPH KAYE.

KAYE was in Denver on September 29, 1963 and talked with CARLSON on that date. Shortly after October 1, 1963, KAYE laft Denver and abandoned his family. Mrs. KAYE did not hear from KAYE for several weeks and then moved to Las Vegas, Nevada where she could be contacted in care of Mrs. SUZ KLUKAS, 3815 Nellis Boulevard, Las Vegas, Navada.

After Mrs. KAYE left Denver, the mambers of the JENKINS family recalled that a letter or statement was delivered to KAYE's former residence, 95 South Ogden, which apparently had been sent by an optometrist in Fort Worth, Texas. This communication was forwarded to Mrs. KAYE in Las Vegas.

No further information had dome to the attention of CARUSON or Mr. and Mrs. JENKINS regarding KAYE.

ROBERT J. KAYE was interviewed at the Tucson Resident Agency. He was advised that he did not have to make a statement, that he could consult an attorney prior to making any statement and that any statement he did make could be used against him in a court of law.

KAYE stated that it was impossible for him to furnish any additional information relative to the identity of GLORIA (LNU), an exotic dancer he met at a small club in Juarez. Mexico or/MIGUEL (LNU), the individual who accompanied him from Juarez to Mexico City. In addition, KAYE stated that it was impossible for him to furnish any additional information relative to/RAOUL (LNU) or RAIL (LNU), the individual he stayed with for several days in Chibuahua, Mexico.

KAYE stated that he had carefully reviewed the information he had previously furnished to the FoI and that he was certain he arrived in El Paso, Texas, the end of October, 1963. KAYE insisted that he had worked for the Colorado Vending Company and for GLENN A. JENKINS during the period January or February, 1963 to the end of October, 1963, and that during that period he had resided at 95 S. Ogden, Denver, Colorado. KAYE stated that he was positive that he arrived in El Paso the end of October, 1963. KAYE stated that during the period January, 1963, to October, 1963, he had not made any trips whatsoever outside of Denver.

KAYE was queried relative to his mode of transportation to El Paso and he stated that he was driving a 1961 Thunderbird, which he had purchased in Denver for \$2,700.00. Upon questioning as to where the 1961 Thunderbird was purchased in Denver, KAYE stated that actually he had made one trip. outside of Denver during the period January, 1963, to October, 1963, that being a trip to Tulsa, Oklahoma, where he purchased the 1961 Thunderbird. KAYE stated at that time he owned a 1956 Ford station wagon and he drove that car to Tulsa, and traded it in for the 1961 Thunderbird. KAYE stated that he received a credit of approximately \$900.00 for his vehicle and that he borrowed \$700.00 from another party in Tulsa to complete the down payment on the purchase of the vehicle, the total price of the vehicle being \$2,700.00. KAYE refused to identify the party who loaned him the \$700.00 but added that

KAYE stated that the information previously furnished to the FBI was as factually correct as possible and that he could only reaffirm his previous statements to the effect that he had left benver during the latter part of October, 1963.

WONG's father is Chinese and his mother, whose maiden name is RODRIGUEZ, is a Mexican. WONG is one of five children. WONG's family is well known in Chihuahua, Chihuahua, Mckico. WONG's wife is EMELIA GONZALES. She believes that WONG has about four children.

During the time that she has known RAUL WONG, he has made a number of trips from Los Angeles to Chihuahua. He normally enters and leaves the United States through El Paso. She believes that he has some friends in El Paso. She could not recall that he has any relatives in El Paso.

In May, 1964, RAUL WONG visited her and stated that he had quit his job at the Beverly Hills Hotel and was going to return home and live with his family in Chinuanua, Chinuanua.

WONG always represented himself to her as a waiter and did not mention that he was merely a bus boy. To the best of her, knowledge, WONG is still residing in Chihuahua, Chihuahua, Mexico. She has not heard from him during the month of June, 1964.

It should be noted that RAUL WONG terminated his Beverly Hilton employment on 8/29/63 and left to visit his mother. His next employment in this area was when he was rehired on 12/13/63 by the Beverly Rodeo Hotel. From these records it would appear that it was possible for him to have been in Chihuahua, Chihuahua, in November, 1963.

Bureau believes it advisable to attempt to locate the Eacul with whom he claimed residence in Chihuahua and Gloria, the exotic dancer who resides in Juarez. Note that Raoul, according to Los Angeles 6/26/64 airtel, is apparently identical with Raul Rodriguez Wong, a Mexican Chinese who was born 2/2/32 of a Chinese lather and a Mexican mother. Rodriguez Wong is said to be a member of a well-known family in Chihuahua.

Legat, Mexico City, endeavor to locate Rodriguez Weng and interrogate him concerning the claims of Kaye. Endeaver through Wong to identify Gloria and Miguel. Ascertain if Rodriguez Wong can furnish any information concerning Kaye's claimed reason for his visit to Mexico. Display Kaye's photograph to him. Places handle expeditiously.

NOTE:

Kaye has told a wild story of having met a min he believes to be Oswald in early 10/63 in Denver who hired him to go to Mexico City early 10/63 to pick up unidentified papers from one Francis which were to be delivered to an unnamed individual in Amarillo for which he was to be paid \$3000. The man he mit in Denver, according to Kaye, introduced himself only as "lee." We apparently did enter Mexico at Juarez in 10/63. We have been attempting to identify Gloria and Raoul and Los Angeles has now apparently identified him. Hence, advisable to interview him.
