Preliminary Special Dallas Report #1. Assassination of the President (Assassination Scone)

At approximately 12:30 FM on November 22, 1963, a car bearing the Precident, Mrs. Kennedy, Governor John Connally of Texas and Mrs. Connally, was proceeding west enroute to the Trade Mart Building, 2100 Stemmons Franciay, to a Lunchoon sponsored by the Dallas Citizens Council scheduled for 12:30 PM. The car cuned and operated by the Secret Service was driven by Special Agent William R. Greer. The right front seat was occupied by ASMIC Roy H. Kellerman. At the foot of Elm Street, at a point approximately 200 feet east of the Houston Street Triple Underpass, on the approach to the Stemmons Freeway, President Kennedy, who was seated on the right rear seat, was shot. Immediately thereafter Governor Connally, seated in the right jump seat, was shot once. The President was then shot the second time. The car carrying the wounded President and the Governor proceeded immediately to the Parkland Remorial Hospital at 5201 Harry Hines Boulevard where the Fresident was pronounced dead by Dr. Kemp Clark, Chief of Dallss Hourocurgery at 1 pm. Governor Connally, critically wounded, survived.

Witnesses identified the source of the shots as the sixth floor of the Texas School Ecok Depository Building at hill Elm Straat. A search of the building disclosed a number of open windows on the south side of the building. Officers Capt. J. W. Fritz and Detectives R. M. Sirs and E. L. Doyd of the Dallas Homicide Division of the Police Department found, in an area on the sixth floor near an open window on the southeast corner of the building, three expended shells of 6.5 lm caliber rifle amunition. An immediate search of the room disclosed on Italian Mainlicher-Carcano rifle 6.5 lm with a lm Scope, hidden among the boxes on opposite side of this room near the staircase. One leaded shell was found in the chamber of the rifle.

I looked up at the window and I noticed that he seemed to be laying down there or in a funny position anyway, because all I could see was his head. I noticed that he was light-headed and that he had on an open-neck shirt, and that was before the motorcade rounded the corner. I noticed his complexion seemed to be clear, and that he was in his twenty's, appeared to be in his twenty's.

I turned away and by that time the motorcade rounded the corner. And then I heard what I thought was three shots, and the motorcade was about where that Stemmons Freeway sign is there.

I do recember one peculair thing happened just at the time I saw the man up there. There was a girl walked in the Texas School Book Depository Building, a rather tall girl, and looked to me like she might be an employed in that building. She was walking in while everyone else had been coming out.

The motorcade rounded the corner about this time, and then I thought I heard four shots, but it never occurred to us what it was. The shots seemed to come from that building there.

I am a student at Edemson High School in Dallas, Texas. I am employed on trockends at the Pizza Inn located on West Davis Avenue in Dallas. At approx instely 12:10PM today, my wife Barbara and I arrived in downtown Dallas and took position to see the President's motorcade. We took position at the west entrance of the Shoriff's Office on Houston Street. We stood there for a time talking about various things and were talking about the occurity measures that were being made for the president's visit in view of the recent trouble when Mr. Adalai Stevenson had been a recent visitor to Dallas. It must have been 5 or 10 minutes later when we were just looking at the curroudding buildings when I looked up at the Texas Book Supposition building and noticed that the second floor from the top had two adjoining windows which wore wide open, and upon locking I saw what I thought was a man standin back about 15 feet from the windows and was holding in his arms what appeared to be a hi powored rifle because it looked as though it had a scope on it. He appeared to be holding this at a parade rest sort of position. I mentioned this to my wife and morely made the remark that it must be the secret service mon. This wan appeared to be a white man and appeared to have a light_colored shirt on, open at the neck. He appeared to be of slender build and appeared to have dark hair. In about 15 minutes President Kennedy passed the special spot where we were standing and the metercade had just turned west on Elm heading down the hill when I heard a noise which I thought to be a back fire. In fact some of the people around laughed and then in about 8 seconds I heard another report and in about 3 accords a third report. My wife, who had ahold, of my hand, started running and dragging we carees the street and I never did look up again at this window.

This statument is true and correct to the best of my impuledge and belief.

On Friday, November 22, 1963, I was at work at Bell Helicopter, when I heard of the President's being shot. A short time later, I heard that the President was shot from the Texas School <u>Book Depositor</u>y Building. I knew that Lee Oswald worked there, and I immediately thought of him and wondered if he might have shot the President and Wondered if I should call the F. B. I. I thought it unlikely that he shot the President, and that the F. B. I. was fully aware of his presence there, and I did not want to contribute to his harassment which would be likely to occur due to his knowmMarxist views.

through the crowd and go into our building. I realized he did not know anything
about the building, so I ran in with him. The officer and I went through the shippi department to the freight elevator. He then started up the stairway. We hit the
second floor landing, the officer stuck his head into the lunch room area where there
are coke and candy machines. Lee Oswald was in there. The officer had his gun on Oswald and asked me if he was an employee. I answered yes. We then went up the
stairs to the 5th floor where we found the elevator open. We took the elevator to
the 7th floor and out on the roof. We searched the roof and a small room, also
checked the landings. We could look out over the tracks and street below. We did not find anything. We started down on the elevator. The officer took a
hurried look on a couple floors on the way down. We then met some other officers
on the 1th floor searching the building. I overheard someone say that the shot
came from the window of our building. By that time there was several people in the building. Some fifteen minutes later I was checking our employees, and I did not
find Lee. I asked Mr. Shelley if he had seen Lee. He said no. I then contacted
Chief Lumpkin and XI told him Lee was missing. Then both of us went up on the sixth floor where Captain Fritz was and I told Captain Fritz about Lee being missing and

Who, after being by me duly sworn, on oath deposes and says: I work at Texas School Book Depository, Corner Elm and Houston. I have worked there since September 13, 1963. I fill orders. About a month ago, I met Lee Harvey Oswald at work. I saw that he was a new man, and I walked up to him and asked him if he was Lee. I figured he must be Lee as my sister had told me about him. I asked him if he would like to ride back and forth with me as I knew his wife lived with Ruth Paine near my house, and he said he would, But only on week ends as he had an apartment of his own in Oak Cliff. After that every Friday evening Lee would ride home with me and then ride back to work with me on Monday morning. He has only rode home from work with me on Fridays, but yesterday morning, Thursday, November 21, 1963, Lee told me that he wanted to ride home with me that evening. I was surprised, and I asked him if he was going home with me Friday also, and he said, "No". He told me that he was going home to get some curtain rods. Thursday afternoon Lee rode to Irving with me to Ruth Paine's house, where his wife is staying. I let him out of my car in front of Ruth's house, then I went on. This morning, Friday, November 22, 1963, I got up between 6:00 - 6:30 AM, and got ready to go to work, and then sit down to eat breakfast, about 7:15 AM, me, my mother, and my two little neices were at the table, and my sister was at the sink. My mother looked up and said, "Who is that looking in the window?" I looked up and said, "That's Lee." I got up and finished getting ready and got my lunch and went to the door and met Lee on the car port. We then walked to my car, it was parked backed up at the side of the car port. Before I got in the car, I glanced in the back seat, and saw a big sack. It must have been about 2' long, and the top of the sack was sort of folded up, and the rest of the sack had been kind of folded under. I asked Lee what was in the ask, and he said "curtain " rods", and I remembered that he had told me the day before that he was going to bring some curtain rods. We drove to work the same way that I usually go. We came into town on Stemmons Freeway to Main and Main to Record, and then on across to Mc Kinney and by the warehouse to the parking lot. I parked the car and sit there awhile and run the motor to charge the battery, and while I was doing that, Lee got out and opened the back door and got the package out of the back seat and walked behind the car, then I got out of the car and started walking toward the building where I work. Reference Dallas teletype 12-5-63 in above-captioned matter advising that on 11-24-63 the U.S. Secret Service interviewed subject's widow and that the interview was recorded on tape. The tape was forwarded to Secret Service headquarters in Washington and is in the Russian language. Idaison was requested to obtain information concerning this tape.

Enclosed is a translation of the Russian-language tape consisting of 45 pages showing questions and answers of the interview of Mrs. Lee Harvey Oswald. This was furnished to Liaison on 12-6-63.

Mr. Robert I. Bouck, U. S. Secret Service, who furnished this to Liaison Agent Bartlett, advised that the Russian-language tape is in his possession and that if the Bureau feels it should have a copy of this tape he will have a copy made and will furnish it. Mr. Bouck was told that if this was necessary we would make a separate request for the actual tape.

- 4: My wife showed the theme to Mrs. They were in a quandry as to what to do realizing this wasta sensitive matter that if reported could have implications of a police state with children reporting on their parents. The issuing uprear from PTA, etc., could cause considerable repercussions disrupting the school and its relationship to the community.
