Mexican Immigration, and ROBERTO NODALES, Chief of Mexican Customs, had the list prepared and have advised that it is a complete list of persons entering Mexico at Nuevo Laredo on 9/10/52. This list is being set forth by State. The address of the person entering is available only on the entry card of the person entered by automobile and was the name of person entering the automobile into Mexico. (Example: four or five persons could enter in the same automobile but only the owner or person driving or entering the automobile would be recorded in the Customs records with the complete name and address.) All the others, however, would appear in the Mexican Immigration records. FM-5 records are available for 6 months. FM-8 are valid for 15 days.

TO ALL OFFICES RECEIVING COPIES OF THIS COMMUNICATION:

Offices receiving copies of this communication are requested to immediately locate individuals mentioned in their area and to interview these persons regarding their mode of travel to Mexico, port of entry, approximate hour and date of entry into Mexico, and final destination. Ascertain if any person interviewed recalls seeing an individual fitting the description of the subject LEE HARVEY OSWALD and, if so, interview them regarding any details they may have concerning this person. Will also exhibit photograph of subject.

It is to be noted that the first list is composed of the individuals registered as having entered Mexico at Nuevo Laredo, Tamaulipas, the same date OSWALD entered, 9/26/63. The second list is composed of individuals who departed Mexico at the same port on 10/3/63, which is the day OSWALD left Mexico at this port.

During the course of the interview, each office should bear in mind that if the person being interviewed has any information regarding subject or a person fitting his description, every effort should be made to elicit information as to the means of transportation used by OSWALD when they knew or saw him, or any of his activities.

If, during the course of the investigation, information is developed reflecting that the person who entered Mexico on 9/26/63 is still in Mexico, every effort should be made to ascertain this person's exact whereabouts in Mexico and an appropriate lead should be expeditiously sent to the Bureau for forwarding to Legat, Mexico, to have this person immediately interviewed.

All offices receiving this airtel refer to Butels to all SACs 11/30/63 (4:53 p.m.) and 12/1/63 (5:52 p.m.). One copy of reports written should be furnished to San Antonio Division.

Two extra copies of this communication are being forwarded to the Bureau for transmittal to Legat, Mexico, in case information is developed reflecting that one of the persons mentioned on this list may still be residing in Mexico and will have to be interviewed at that point.

Dear Dick:

The purpose for this letter is two fold. First off I need a small favor, and secondly I have some information for you which may bring to light some very important facts concerning a connection between Oswald the subject who assassinated President Kennedy and Captain David ~~W. Ferrie~~. Lo

Secondly, in reference to Ferrie. Don't your case records on Ferrie show that this guy Oswald was a member of Ferrie's so-called phony C-1 Squadron?


Furthermore... Was not this the person (Oswald) that Ferris helped to get into the Marine Corps...

Dear Sirs:

Leo Oswald

I have been informed that a person named Virginia (no last name known), employed at the Equitable Equipment Company here in New Orleans as a relief telephone switchboard operator is running about acknowledging the fact that she is working for the F.B.I. as an anti-communist agent.

The reason I have personal knowledge of this, is that a few weeks or months ago your agents questioned many persons about the city and else where about my wife (Paula Mae Martin), as well as myself.

Frankly the result of this has nearly ruined my reputation...what little I have...and has almost cost my wife her job...and it may yet cost her this position...She had been due a promotion at her place of employment, and this INQUISITION has killed that it seems.

As well known as I am...it seems to me that such a statement from a known mental case as Virginia, should have been taken as a grain of salt in the first place.

However, because of the prejudicial conduct upon the part of your local office, and/or agents here, I withdrew from candidacy for office in the December 7th, Democratic primary Election here in Louisiana, and my wife may lose her job.

Because of this, we demand that this person who made these statements be exposed as a fraud, and that your Agent In Charge here personally apologize to my wife, her working associates, and above all her employer, Captain Neville Levy president of Equitable Equipment Company.

I am certain, that neither Mr. Hoover, nor those in top authority condone such activities as these, and I sincerely hope you shall bring us both remedy and relief to this situation at once before matters get worse at my wife's place of employment.

Supervisor Warren Marchessault, NYO, called at 5:05 PM today to advise that John Abt, attorney for the Communist Party, had contacted the New York Office to advise that Arnold Johnson (Legislative Secretary of the Communist Party) who is his client, had located copies of correspondence Johnson had sent to Oswald. Abt stated that Johnson wanted to make these copies available to the FBI if we wanted them.

Abt also advised that in addition, Johnson had received a letter today (12-2) from Oswald which was dated 11-1-63 and which he also wants to make available. Abt said that he would be tied up until 3 PM on 12-3, but that he would be glad to make them available at his office at 3 PM on 12-3-63.

While we have copies of some letters sent by Johnson to Oswald, it is believed that the Bureau should accept these letters.

ACTION:

Supervisor Marchessault was advised that unless advised to the contrary, New York should accept these letters from Abt, make no comment other than to thank him for the letters, determine if he wanted them returned and, if necessary, sign a receipt for them. New York will advise as to the contents.

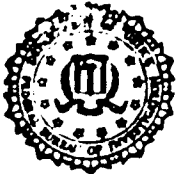

At approximately 6:30 P.M., November 23, 1963, three boys and one girl entered the store of Mr. CECIL BALES, Kyle, Texas, and asked if they could watch Mr. BALES' television as they had been hunting near New Braunfels, Texas, and had just heard about the assassination. As they were watching television, the girl asked if the person who had done the shooting had been caught and Mr. BALES said that the police were holding a person from Fort Worth who was supposed to be a member of the Fair Play for Cuba Organization. The girl then remarked that this sounded like a person she knew by the name of OSWALD. Then Mr. BALES told her that was the name of the person who was being held and the girl remarked that she did not think OSWALD had the guts to do a thing like this. Another boy then mentioned that he has seen OSWALD in Fort Worth passing out literature for the Fair Play for Cuba Organization. Another boy said he was the grandson of former Vice President JOHN NANCE GARNER. All four said they were presently students at the University of Texas.
