QUOTE THE EVENING BULLETIN END QUOTE, PROVIDENCE, R.I., DECEMBER FOUR SIXTYTHREE, SET OUT IN AN ARTICLE THE FOLLOWING INFORMATION RE THE SUBJECT-

LEE HARVEY OSWALD APPLIED THROUGH A PROVIDENCE UNITARIAN MINISTER IN NINETEEN FIFTYNINE FOR ADMISSION TO THE ALBERT SCHWEITZER COLLEGE IN CHURWALDEN, SWITZERLAND, AND WAS ACCEPTED BUT NEVER QUOTE SHOWED UP END QUOTE. THIS INFO WAS CONFIRMED BY DR. ROBERT H. SCHACT, MINISTER OF THE FIRST UNITARIAN CHURCH OF PROVIDENCE, WHO IS CHAIRMAN OF THE AMERICAN ADMISSIONS COMMITTEE FOR THE SWISS SCHOOL. OSWALD APPLIED IN THE SPRING OF NINETEEN FIFTYNINE WHILE IN THE MARINE CORPS FOR ADMISSION TO THE NINETEEN SIXTY SPRING TERM, RUNNING BETWEEN MID-APRIL TO THE END OF JUNE. OSWALD/S APPLICATION WAS QUOTE CLEARED END QUOTE BY THE AMERICAN COMMITTEE AND SENT TO SWITZERLAND.

IN THE SPRING OF NINETEEN SIXTY, THE COLLEGE QUOTE SENT WORD THAT HE PAREN OSWALD END PAREN HADN/T ARRIVED AND DID WE KNOW WHAT HAD HAPPENED TO HIM. WE DIDN/T. THEY SAID HIS MOTHER HAD WRITTEN THEM ASKING ABOUT HIM. SO FAR AS WE KNEW, HE SIMPLY DISAPPEARED END QUOTE.

DR. SCHACHT SAID ALL DOCUMENTS RELATING TO OSWALD/S APPLICATION WERE SENT TO SWITZERLAND AND NO RECORDS WERE KEPT QUOTE HERE END QUOTE. ALL PROCESSING WAS DONE BY MAIL. THE APPLICATION WAS ACCOMPANIED BY THREE REFERENCES, ONE A CLERGYMAN, BUT DR. SCHACHT DID NOT RECALL WHO THEY WERE, SAYING HE HAD A VAGUE RECOLLECTION ONE OF THE REFERENCES MAY HAVE BEEN A MARINE CORPS OFFICER AND POSSIBLY A SECOND WAS A MARINE CORPS CHAPLAIN. HE FURTHER SAID THE SCHOOL WAS FOUNDED TEN YEARS AGO BY UNITARIANS IN SWITZERLAND, IS NON-SECTARIAN AND ACCOMMODATES THIRTY STUDENTS FROM ALL OVER THE WORLD, ABOUT ONE DOZEN BEING AMERICANS. HE SAID IT WAS THE THIRD SEMESTER OF THE NINETEEN FIFTYNINE DASH SIXTY COLLEGE YEAR FOR WHICH OSWALD WAS ACCEPTED.

On 12/4/63 [redacted] who desired his identity kept confidential, advised SA JOSEPH E. JONES that there was a "Peanut Festival" in Floresville, 9/27-28/63. A Republican organization had been invited to participate in the parade and after the invitation was given it was canceled. This gave rise to numerous people protesting the cancellation.

[redacted] said that on the Wednesday after the Peanut Festival, that is 10/2/63, he was talking with either HUDDLE WRIGHT, who runs the Eschenburg Hardware Store or CARL ESCHENBURG, who runs an implement store next door. One or the other said that that morning a man was in the store collecting funds to "shoot or kill President KENNEDY."

[redacted] said on the same day 10/2/63, he remembers seeing a man walking out of either the hardware store or the implement store and now recalls the man looked similar to LEE HARVEY OSWALD. He said the man had a fuller face than pictures he saw of OSWALD on television, but looked similar to a photograph of OSWALD shown him.

[redacted] also stated that on 12/2/63, he talked with HILDA DUNN, who operates Walt's Cafe, where the bus station is located. Mrs. DUNN told [redacted] she

remembered selling a bus ticket to Corpus Christi, Texas, to a man who looked like OSWALD. She was indefinite about the time, first saying it was sometime in September and later saying "about three weeks ago."

[REDACTED] stated HUDELL WRIGHT is a cousin of Governor JOHN CONNALLY.

WRIGHT, ESCHENBURG and Mrs. DUNN will be interviewed after which letterhead memo and FD 302s will be submitted.

Dear Mr. Hoover,

Disbelief and grief have shrouded our Country since the inhuman assassination of President Kennedy. I am no different from the millions of Americans who are mourning.

Several pertinent questions have been raised by others and myself in regard to the part the FBI should have played in the arrest and questioning of the alleged assassin, Lee Oswald-- perhaps overting the double tragedy of Oswald's murder.

These are the questions that deserve an answer:

1. Was the assassination's investigation in the jurisdiction of the FBI as an act of treason?
2. Why was the Dallas police allowed to conduct the investigation of Oswald's guilt with no direction by the FBI and apparently without the benefit of the excellently trained FBI men.
3. Why was evidence released to the public? (re Oswald's guilt)
4. Why was the time and place of Oswald's change of jails announced publicly; and further why was someone like Ruby, not a member of the press and known not to be so by the Dallas police, allowed in the jail basement?

This is a grave situation and I seriously wonder if the FBI, under your direction assumed it's proper responsibility and duty.

Dear Mrs. Granof:

I have received your letter of November 24th and understand your concern over the brutal assassination of President Kennedy.

Immediately following the assassination the full resources of the FBI were made available to the Secret Service and local law enforcement agencies. The President has instructed the FBI to conduct a full investigation into the assassination of President Kennedy and the murder of Lee Harvey Oswald. I can assure you that this Bureau will discharge its responsibilities in this regard with the same thoroughness and dispatch that have characterized our investigations in the past.

Since we do not disclose developments in connection with pending investigations, I will not be able to answer your questions.

Kennedy?" which was issued by "The Communist Party of Illinois, Room 806, 36 W. Randolph St., Chicago, Illinois." Source informs that this document was being distributed by personnel of the Illinois CP on 12/1/63 in the Chicago area. Urging that "only the Ultra-Right and the Southern Racists" had something to gain by killing "a president pledged to Negro equality," this document stresses that "Dallas is a stronghold of the Ultra-Right" and the "John Birch Society" and raises questions as to whether the murder of the alleged assassin LEE OSWALD was not brought about by local Texas authorities to silence him. In this connection emphasis is laid on the point that "Oswald (was) kept for two days without the right to see counsel."

Concerning OSWALD's background, the document continues: "The police say he was a member of the Fair Play for Cuba Committee and of the American Civil Liberties Union. Yet both of these organizations deny such membership. The police say he was pro-Communist, yet the anti-Castro Cubans in this country say that he offered to work for them. The police say that he applied sometime back for Soviet citizenship, and been denied. Who really was he? An adventurer who was made the 'fall guy' by higher ups? A dupe? Or an innocent victim? What is the truth?"

In concluding, it urged that the recipient demand a full and impartial investigation by an independent citizens committee in order that the truth may be ascertained.

You will find the mail box in the post office which is located 4 blocks from the drug store on that street. I paid for the box last month so don't worry about it.

2. Send the information as to what has happened to me to the Embassy and include newspaper clippings (should there be anything about me in the newspapers). I believe that the Embassy will come quickly to your assistance on learning everything.

3. I paid the house rent on the 2nd so don't worry about it.

4. Recently I also paid for water and gas.

5. The money from work will possibly be coming. The money will be sent to our post office box. Go to the bank and cash the check.

6. You can either throw out or give my clothing etc. away. Do not keep these. However, I prefer that you hold on to my personal papers (military, civil etc.).

7. Certain of my documents are in the small blue valise.

8. The address book can be found on my table in the study should you need same.

9. We have friends here. The Red Cross also will help you. (Red Cross in English)

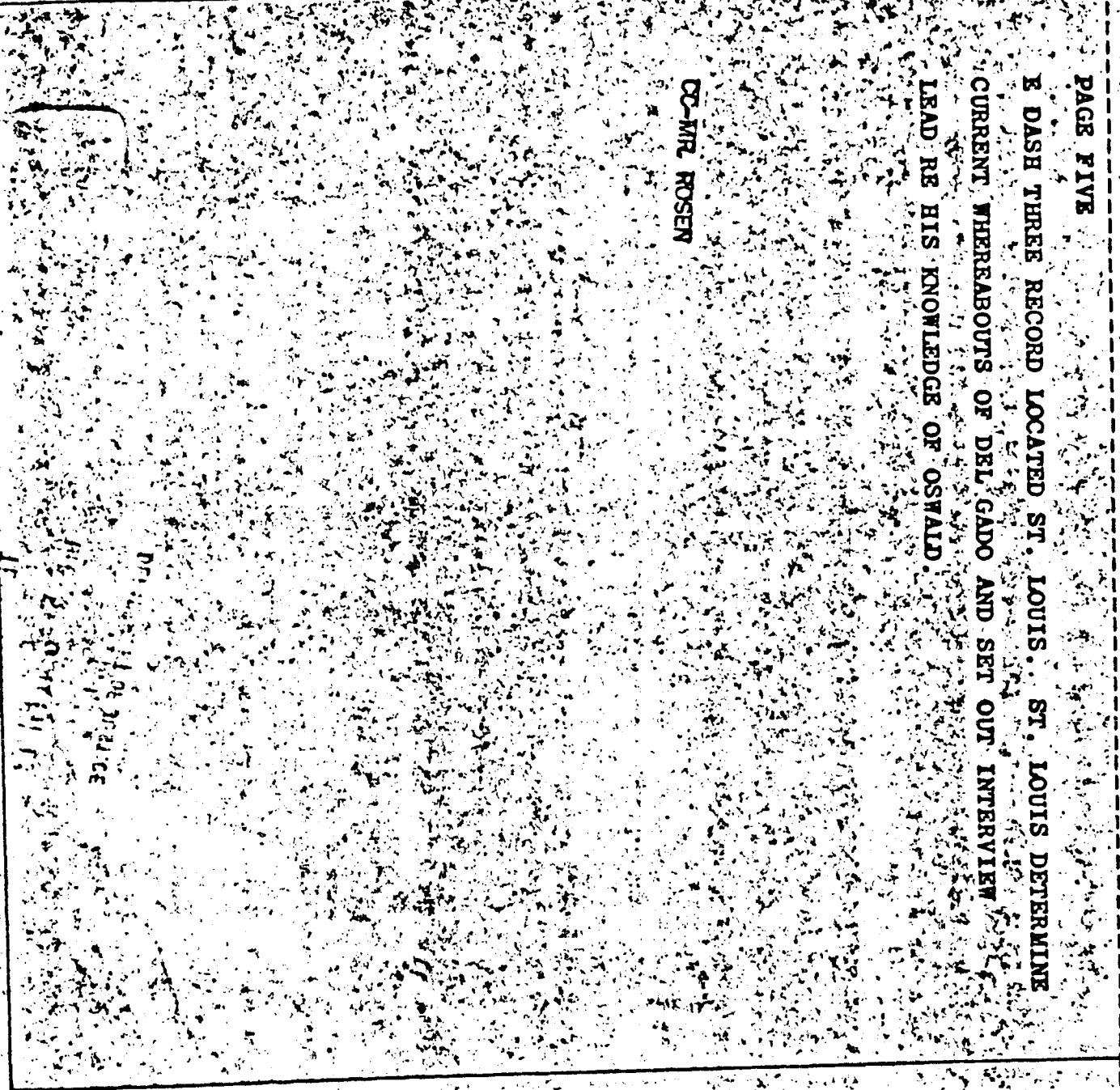

Is there a possibility that Peking was involved at least indirectly in the assassination of President Kennedy?

The question is raised on the assumption that Oswald was in fact linked with the Fair Play for Cuba Committee, some members of which have had associations with China as well as Cuba and some of which are anti-Moscow Marxists. Coupled with the intensity of the Mao-Khrushchev conflict, the assassination of Kennedy might have appeared to some at least to advance the interests of Peking.

Oswald is said to have returned to the U.S. from the USSR in the summer of 1962, alleging disillusionment there but still holding Marxist ideas. He was allowed an exit visa and to take his Russian wife with him. On June 25 ¹⁹⁶³ EZ he applied for a passport to visit the USSR and other countries. In July he apparently tried to infiltrate an anti-Castro group. In August, he was arrested for trying to break up an anti-Castro demonstration in New Orleans; on Aug. 21 on a radio program he identified himself as secretary of the New Orleans Chapter of the Fair Play for Cuba Committee. He then transferred to Dallas where he soon was employed in a building on the announced route of the Kennedy procession. Such ~~are~~ are the facts as reported on the wires.

(FFCC Acting Director Vincent Theodore ~~Lee~~ denies that there is any FFCC chapter in New Orleans or Dallas.) NY

Following are possible indications of links between the FFCC and Peking, in addition to the recent indications that Castro has been playing up ~~XXX~~ to Peking.

1) Vincent Theodore Lee of FFCC reportedly has become a distributor of the Peking-financed, new propaganda magazine Revolution, published in Lausanne.

He visited Cuba at least once this year.

2) Richard Gibson, once CBS in Cuba, was the ^{President and one of the} organizer of the FFCC with offices at 799 Broadway, in March 1960.

In 1961, he was accredited as UN representative for the Cuban paper Revolution

3) Conrad Lynn, NY lawyer:

 1958 when he was sent by the Young Socialist Alliance (or Socialist Workers'
 Party) to investigate facts in "Kissing Incident" in Monroe, North Carolina
 which Robert Williams was agitating. Williams became chairman, Committee
 used Lynn's office.

Visited Cuba with Williams in 1960 (and 61?) describing self as counsel for
 Williams. Has ^foken at meetings of FPCC, addressed at least one Black Muslim
 meeting, served as moderator of the Sept 1963 Student Travel Committee meeting
 in NY (see below under Rosen)

An organizer of the "Freedom Now" political party, he visited J. Edgar Hoover
 interviewed his group.

4) Robert F Williams described as schizophrenic and dangerous in a poster
 issued by FBI as a fugitive from an indictment in Monroe, NC, for alleged
 kidnaping of a white couple during a racial disturbance there in August
 1961.

Given "refuge" in Cuba where he had visited twice before and been utilized in
 anti-American propaganda, Williams has conducted a violently emotional anti-

US and anti-Kennedy program on the Cuban radio aimed at the US and Central
 America

Mao's August 8, 1963 attack on US "racism" was keyed to alleged requests that he had received from Williams. This opened a major propaganda gambit against the US and to a less marked degree against the deviators (Moscow) for associating with the US. On Sept 25 Williams and his wife arrived in China to be featured in a series of anti-American and pro-Chinese speeches and demonstrations continuing into November.

Author of Negroes with Guns (Marzani & Munsell, NY. 1962), Williams is publicized as a former NAACP leader although he was suspended by Convention action for advocating meeting violence with violence. Book contains a 20 page article by Truman Nelson in which he is compared with Martin Luther King and praised as if he might replace the latter as a leader of American Negroes.

5) ~~William Worthy~~ In addition to his publicized visits to China and Cuba he has been a speaker in California before FCC and Committee to Aid the Mr. Monroe Defendants. Claims he had in October 1960 exposed CIA preparations for Cuban invasion. Also claims he conceived idea for Freedom Now Party.

Has contributed to Revolution (Lausanne-Feking)

6) ~~Milton Rosen~~ Together with Nort Scheer edits Progressive Labor. Both were expelled by CP NY State in Jan. 1962 for disruptive activities ...for "Chinese Communist ideology". Organizer of the "security force" at the meeting of the Student Committee for Travel to Cuba in September 1963, which Conrad Lynn moderated and which was addressed by Truman Nelson, Albert Maher of Texas and several members of the Progressive Labor Movement. NY Times quoted Rosen as saying that he had been assisting the racial integration measures in Monroe, NC. The Monroe defense groups have been publicized in the WCPKP and have been manipulated in various cities as a front group, attacking the Administration as well as the NC authorities.

As some indication of the possible ~~XXXXXXXXXX~~ connections ~~XXX~~ among the Marxist elements listed above with Castro and Mao and the common element of anti-Kennedy and possible anti-Khrushchev factors, the following may be mentioned:

Williams has been used by both Castro and Mac for violently emotional attacks and Williams has been associated with these local Marxists in either the FPCC or Monroe committees. Presumably Castro must have consented to have Williams go to China in September when the Peking-Moscow feuding was well advanced.

Williams contributed to the latter. On Nov. 1 NCNA-English he said "We hear people who should be supporting us complaining before the world, not about the savage deeds against Negroes but attacking Chairman Mao who is appealing to the people of the world, of all colors, of all races, to support us in our just struggle". On Oct 4, Peking Domestic in Mandarin quoted him as

saying "Only those who remain undaunted before the military and wealthy power of the racists and the US imperialists have the courage to raise high a flag of revolution and leadership."

Mao on Aug 8 pointed out that "the racial problem is actually a class problem"; and expressed belief that the Negroes would join the proletariat and overcome their common class enemy, the US monopoly capitalist group. He has been calling upon Marxist-Leninist groups to support the national liberation movements whereas the "modern revisionists are pictured as siding with the imperialists and colonialists.

CFUSA has been criticised recently as having been so dominated by whites that it has failed to win the Negro Americans or to ~~xxxx~~ support the correct elements. Hence perhaps the connection with among the Progressive Labor Movement with Castro at least.

CRYSTINIK STATED THAT ON THE DAY AFTER ADLAI STEVENSON, AMBASSADOR TO THE UN, SPOLE IN DALLAS, CRYSTINIK AND HIS WIFE ACOMPANIED MICHAEL PAINÉ TO SMU IN DALLAS WHERE THEY ATTENDED A MEETING OF THE AMERICAN CIVIL LIBERTIES UNION IN A CAMPUS BUILDING. THE GREATER PORTION OF THIS MEETING WAS DEVOTED TO THE SHOWING OF A DOCUMENTARY FILM WHICH PORTRAYED A QUOTE SMEAR UNQUOTE CAMPAIGN REPORTEDLY WAGED AGAINST A POLITICAL CANDIDATE IN A RECENT ELECTION IN THE PACIFIC NORTHWEST.

CRYSTINIK DOES NOT RECALL THE NAME OF THE CANDIDATE OR THE OFFICE HE WAS SEEKING. AFTER THE FILM THERE WAS A QUESTION AND ANSWER PERIOD AND THE PRESIDING OFFICER MADE REFERENCE TO THE FACT THAT AMBASSADOR STEVENSON HAD BEEN STRUCK ON THE HEAD BY A SIGN POSTER ON THE PREVIOUS DAY. LEE OSWALD THEN JUMPED TO HIS FEET AND INJECTED HIMSELF INTO THE DISCUSSION BY STATING THAT GENERAL EDWIN WALKER WAS RESPONSIBLE FOR THE TROUBLE AT THE STEVENSON MEETING AND STATED EMPHATICALLY THAT

CRYSTINIK, A MEMBER OF THE ROMAN CATHOLIC FAITH, FOLLOWED OSWALD FROM THE ROOM AFTER THE MEETING AND BEGAN QUESTIONING HIM ABOUT THE ANTICATHOLIC ALLEGATION AGAINST GENERAL WALKER. THE DISCUSSION BECAME RATHER HEATED AND OSWALD TOLD CRYSTINIK THAT CRYSTINIK WAS A QUOTE PETTY CAPITALIST UNQUOTE. THIS APPARENTLY AROSE BECAUSE OSWALD HAD LEARNED THAT CRYSTINIK HAD A HOME WOODWORKING SHOP WHERE HE MANUFACTURES BIRDHOUSES AND OCCASIONALLY EMPLOYS THREE MEN. CRYSTINIK ASKED OSWALD ABOUT HIS POLITICAL BELIEF AND OSWALD STATED THAT HE WAS A QUOTE MARXIST UNQUOTE. CRYSTINIK THEN ASKED QUOTE DOES THAT MEAN YOU ARE A COMMUNIST UNQUOTE. OSWALD THEN SAID QUOTE ALL RIGHT, IF YOU WANT TO CALL ME THAT, THAT IS WHAT I AM, I/M A COMMUNIST UNQUOTE.

CRYSTINIK THEN ASKED WHAT OSWALD THOUGHT OF THE ADMINISTRATION OF PRESIDENT KENNEDY AND OSWALD STATED, QUOTE THEY ARE DOING A PRETTY GOOD JOB AS FAR AND CIVIL RIGHTS ARE CONCERNED UNQUOTE. SHORTLY AFTER THIS STATEMENT, CRYSTINIK AND HIS WIFE DEPARTED THE CAMPUS. CRYSTINIK SAID THAT HE,
