ONE ROBERT RAIZBECK, EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR, THE AMERICAN FORUM,
HOLLYWOOD, CALIFORNIA, RECENTLY TOLD BRIMMER OF CONSIDERING
PRODUCTION OF TV DOCUMENTARY ON ASSASSINATION OF KENNEDY.

RAIZBECK REPORTEDLY LEARNED FROM AN UNDISCLOSED SOURCE
THAT ONE MRS. FNU PAINE, PHONETIC, OF IRVING, TEXAS, A GRADUATE
OF ANTIOCH COLLEGE AND REPORTEDLY A PRO-RUSSIAN, HAD TAKEN
OSWALD AND HIS FAMILY FROM TEXAS TO NEW ORLEANS ON SEVERAL
OCCASIONS.

BRIMMER HAS NO PERSONAL KNOWLEDGE OR RUBY, OSWALD OR
THEIR ASSOCIATES, FRIENDS OR ACTIVITIES AND NO FURTHER
PERTINENT INFO REGARDING CASE.

ON DEC. FOUR INSTANT, ELKE AND NORMAN FREDERIKSEN, NOW GRADUATE STUDENTS, UNIVERSITY OF WIS., MADISON, WIS., ADVISED SA ARTHUR F. BAIER THEY RECALLED ATTENDING MEETING AT THE HOME OF EVERETT GLOVER NEAR DALLAS, TEXAS DURING SUMMER OF SIXTYTHREE, FEATURING SUBJECT AS SPEAKER BEFORE GROUP OF PEOPLE INTERESTED IN RUSSIA AND THERE TO HEAR OSWALD-S ACCOUNT OF HIS EXPERIENCES IN RUSSIA. OSWALD SPOKE OF HIS FACTORY JOB AND LIVING CONDITIONS IN RUSSIA, BUT STAYED AWAY FROM POLITICAL TALK AND IN HIS TALK HE INTIMATED HE WAS DISILLUSIONED WITH RUSSIA, BUT ELKE GAINED IMPRESSION THAT OSWALD STILL SYMPATHIC TOWARD RUSSIA AND LIKED RUSSIA BETTER THAN U. S. FREDERIKSENS DID NOT RECALL THAT HE SAID HE WAS A COMMUNIST OR A MEMBER OF
