When this information was received in the Norfolk Office, it was furnished to Special Agent L. N. FARMER, U.S. Secret Service, on 12/5/63.

The Bureau may desire to disseminate both memoranda on SANDS to the Secret Service.

Inasmuch as no information has been developed linking SANDS to OSWALD, no lead is being set forth for the Memphis Division to interview SANDS, SACB. This appears to be a matter of primary interest to the Secret Service at this time inasmuch as SANDS had remarked that he was acquainted with President and Mrs. JOHNSON.

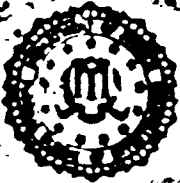

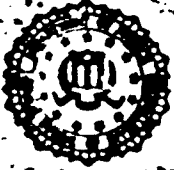

VERNON H. WILSON, 3609 Potter Street, Eugene, Oregon contacted SA JOHN R. McCULLOCH on 12/5/63 at Eugene, Oregon to ask how he could obtain the address of OSWALD's widow. It was learned from him that he was extremely shocked by President KENNEDY's assassination and then when OSWALD was killed he became even more upset. He said he cannot sleep because of constant worry over what will happen to OSWALD's widow and children; that he can think of nothing else and had finally decided to write to Mrs. OSWALD and offer her the hospitality of his home, financial assistance, or the adoption of her children. He said that he was embarrassed to advise of these plans because they are so foreign to anything he has ever before contemplated; that he is not in good financial condition and has never been particularly generous or public spirited, but he is completely unable to shake the overpowering feeling that he must help the OSWALDS, with whom he has never had any contact whatsoever.

WILSON said he is a house builder and has been in Eugene since 1946. He is married and has two children. He was noted to be in his mid thirties, 5' 6", thin build, curly brown hair, large red nose with pitted scars. He admitted having been under great nervous tension recently because of business problems and to have consulted a physician in that regard prior to the assassination. He said he might not write to Mrs. OSWALD until after he again consults his doctor.

Sgt. DAVID WALLACE RANSBERGER, MSN 1064516, Repair Battalion, Yermo Annex, USMC Supply Center, Barstow, California, furnished the following information to SA HAROLD E. NEWPHER on 12/5/63:

In 1956, RANSBERGER was assigned to Marine Corps Air Facility, Santa Ana and Marine Air Base, El Toro, California. In August, 1957, he was transferred to Marine Air Base Squadron, Atsuga, Japan. He returned to El Toro on 11/15/58.

During the initial tour of duty at El Toro in 1956, RANSBERGER was acquainted with an individual with the last name of OSWALD who possibly is identical to LEE HARVEY OSWALD. The degree of association was not close. RANSBERGER recalled that one of his duties was to furnish repair parts for vehicles and generators to a unit to which OSWALD was assigned.

RANSBERGER recalled that OSWALD was either a private or a PFC, who was "always alone." RANSBERGER said that OSWALD was constantly critical of the Marine Corps. RANSBERGER is unable to furnish any additional information.

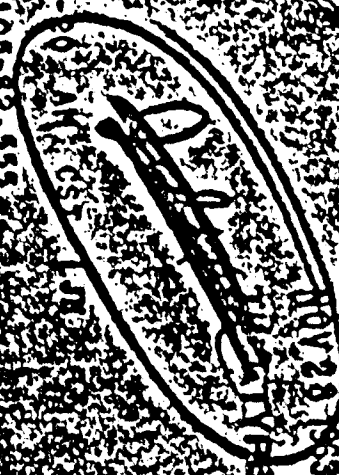
