DOCTOR McFARLAND IS WITH DEPARTMENT OF SURGERY, UNIVERSITY OF LIVERPOOL, ENGLAND, AND RESIDES AT ONE REBO WILWOOD PARK, LIVERPOOL ONE SEVEN, ENGLAND. ARRANGE FOR INTERVIEW OF DOCTOR AND MRS.

McFARLAND FOR ALL INFORMATION THEIR POSSESSION CONCERNING REPORTED TRIP OF OSWALD FROM NUEVO LAREDO, TO MEXICO CITY ON BUS IN QUESTION.

HAVE PHOTOGRAPH OF SUBJECT DISPLAYED TO McFARLANDS AND IF SUBJECT RECOGNIZED, ASCERTAIN IF HE WAS ALONE OR IN COMPANY OF OTHERS.

DETAILED DESCRIPTION OF BAGGAGE AND ANY INFORMATION AS TO HOW SUBJECT ARRIVED AT NUEVO LAREDO, AND NATURE OF HIS TRAVEL FROM NEW ORLEANS TO THAT POINT IS NOT KNOWN.

Warden K. B. Bailey, Central Prison, Raleigh, N. C., advised the FBI on 12/4/63, that he received an undated, unsigned letter from [redacted] inmate of the Blanch Prison Camp, Vanceville, N. C. In this letter, [redacted] stated that while in prison in Tallahassee, Florida, he was in a cell with seven men including Jack or Tom Freeman, aged 23. [redacted] claims Freeman was a communist and a lover of Castro. [redacted] letter also said that when he read about Oswald having been picked up in New Orleans, he recalled that Freeman talked about that and said Freeman made statements that he belonged to "that outfit." [redacted] advised that Freeman stated President Kennedy would be killed before his term was up and that it would be in Texas. [redacted] mentioned other prisoners at Tallahassee who could furnish information concerning Freeman.

The FBI is attempting to locate and interview these other individuals. The FBI will interview [redacted] for complete details.

On November 25, 1963, the Director instructed that a complete analysis be made of any investigative deficiencies in the Oswald case and also an analysis made concerning any necessary changes in our procedures re handling cases of this type.

Most of my inquiry concerning the Seat of Government and New Orleans facets of this matter is nearly completed. However, a considerable number of aspects of this matter still remain to be resolved with the Dallas Office. These will involve obtaining detailed explanations from a number of Agents and supervisory personnel which will be time-consuming. Inasmuch as the Dallas Office has been working day and night on the report on the assassination and various other aspects of this case, and in order not to interfere with their making the deadlines on these matters, they have not yet been contacted.

Unless advised to the contrary, close contact will be maintained with Mr. Belmont in order to determine the earliest possible time when it will be feasible to get these explanations from Dallas.

AUGUST THIRTEEN SIXTY THREE LETTER TO ARNOLD JOHNSON EXPRESSED THANKS FOR LITERATURE SENT TO HIM FOR FPCC BRANCH "OF WHICH I AM THE SECRETARY- PRESIDENT". HE CLAIMED TO BE DOING HIS BEST TO HELP CUBA, A CAUSE WHICH HE BELIEVED HE KNEW JOHNSON APPROVED.

AUGUST TWENTY EIGHT SIXTY THREE LETTER ADDRESSED "COMRADES" ASKED ADVICE ON "PROBLEM OF PERSONAL TACTICS", OSWALD EXPLAINING HIS HAVING LIVED IN USSR FROM FIFTY EIGHT TO SIXTY TWO AND NOTING HIS UNSUCCESSFUL ATTEMPT TO RELINQUISH U. S. CITIZENSHIP. HE WENT ON TO NOTE HIS PARTICIPATION IN "STRUGGLE FOR PROGRESS AND FREEDOM" IN U. S. IN NINETEEN SIXTY TWO AND ASKED ADVICE AS TO CONTINUING FIGHT DESPITE HIS STATED HANDICAP. HE BELIEVED OPPONENTS COULD USE HIS RESIDENCE IN USSR IN OPPOSING ANY CAUSE HE JOINED INASMUCH AS CLAIM MIGHT BE MADE OF CONTROL BY RUSSIA. FURTHER IN LETTER HE EXPLAINED HE WAS THEN SECRETARY OF LOCAL BRANCH OF FPCC IN WHICH POSITION "FRANKLY I HAVE USED TO FOSTER COMMUNIST IDEALS". HE THEN NOTED AN ATTACK ON HIM ON LOCAL RADIO SHOW BY CUBAN EXILES BASED ON HIS RESIDENCE IN USSR.

JOHNSON-S REPLY THERETO, DATED SEPTEMBER NINETEEN SIXTY SEVEN, INDICATED THAT OSWALD-S RIGHT TO PARTICIPATE AS AMERICAN IN ORGANIZATIONS AS HE WISHED BUT LETTER ALSO CONVEYED SUGGESTION THAT HE REMAIN IN BACKGROUND.

AUGUST THIRTY ONE SIXTY THREE LETTER ADDRESSED TO ERIC BERTALAN THE WORKER AND CLAIMED OSWALD WAS COMMERCIAL PHOTOGRAPHER WHO HAD DONE BLOW-UPS, ETC., AND OTHER PHOTO WORK FOR THE WORKER. HE WENT ON TO EXPRESS DESIRE TO BE EMPLOYED BY THE WORKER. HE ALSO MENTIONED THAT HE AND FAMILY WAS TO BE RELOCATED IN AREA, PRESUMABLY IN ARIZONA, IN NEXT FEW WEEKS. HE ASKED THAT APPLICATION BE GIVEN FIRST CONSIDERATION.

SEPTEMBER ONE SIXTY THREE LETTER ADDRESSED ONLY TO DEAR SIR-S ASKED ADVICE ON CONTACTING CP IN BALTIMORE WASHINGTON AREA, IN WHICH HE EXPECTED TO RELOCATE IN OCTOBER SIXTY THREE.

THIS LETTER NOTED A PRIOR LETTER TO JOHNSON, TO WHOM LETTER ADDRESSED, NOTING HE HAD EXPECTED TO MOVE FROM NEW ORLEANS TO PHILADELPHIA-BALTIMORE AREA AND FURTHER NOTED JOHNSON'S ADVICE TO EFFECT HE COULD BE CONTACTED UPON SETTLING THERE AS WELL AS STATEMENT THAT CP WOULD CONTACT OSWALD. HE WENT ON "SINCE THEN MY PERSONAL PLANS HAVE CHANGED AND I HAVE SETTLED IN DALLAS, TEXAS, FOR THE TIME". HE CONTINUED THAT HE HAD BEEN INTRODUCED TO LOCAL CHAPTER OF AMERICAN CIVIL LIBERTIES UNION WHICH WAS MEETING MONTHLY ON SOUTHERN METHODIST UNIVERSITY CAMPUS. AT FIRST SUCH MEETING ON OCTOBER TWENTY FIVE SIXTY THREE, EXHIBITION WAS FOLLOWED BY CRITICAL DISCUSSION ON ULTRA RIGHT IN DALLAS. ALSO, ON OCTOBER TWENTY THREE, HE ATTENDED ULTRA RIGHT MEETING HEADED BY EDWIN WALKER, DALLAS RESIDENT. OSWALD NOTED SUCH MEETING HAD PRECEDED BY ONE DAY ATTACK ON UN AMBASSADOR ADLAI STEVENSON IN DALLAS. OSWALD NOTED POLITICAL FRICTION BETWEEN LEFT AND RIGHT WAS VERY GREAT THERE. HE THEN ASKED ADVICE ON GENERAL VIEW WE HAVE ON ACLU AND TO WHAT DEGREE HE SHOULD ATTEMPT TO HEIGHTEN ITS PROGRESSIVE TENDENCIES.

Gentlemen:

Because of the deep public concern, and because of at least the possibility of a connection or "clue", in addition to the fact that the matter would be quite simple to check without a lot of needles and probably extravagant expense, I am writing to make a suggestion.

Enclosed you will find a picture of a small private airplane that landed and, I assume, took on a load of fuel here at the Big Piney Airport 25 September 1963. We were at the Airport that day because we (that is, three school boys and I) chartered another plane to fly up to Jackson, Wyoming to see President Kennedy when he visited.

You will note that the identification for the plane pictured is **(CFNSC)** not that used in the United States ordinarily, (and since we were "Security-minded" that day, a couple of us took pictures of the "foreign" plane,) which we were told simply indicated that it was from Canada. (However, some one had at first said that the numbers indicated Mexican licensure.)

I am sure by now you have guessed what is in my mind, in view of rumors and stories about Lee Harvey Oswald and his attempts to establish a get-away route perhaps through Mexico, after having shot President Kennedy. If Mr. Oswald had any sort of following in connection with his "Fair Play for Cuba" group, I just wondered if perhaps any subversive activity were brewing for a get-away plan as long ago as September 1963 using just maybe other people and the plane pictured.

I should think that a licensure designation of this sort could be easily checked without arousing any suspicion and without causing any embarrassment if it all proves groundless suspicion.

At least one of the boys who had the privilege of shaking the President's hand that day, and I are curious about this plane whether Canadian or Mexican, and I hope that my raising the question and suggesting that a "check-out" be made is in order.

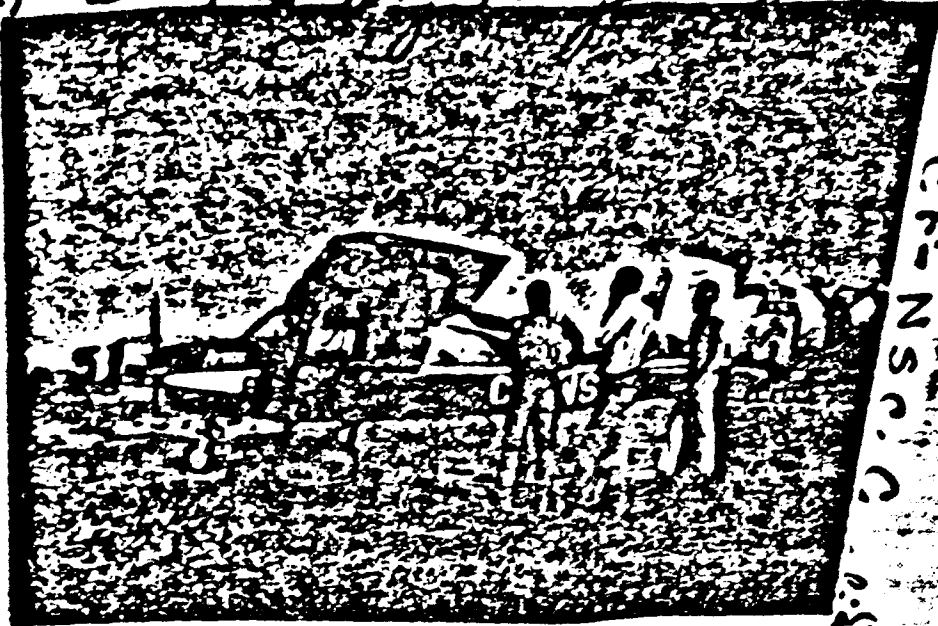

I wish to ask you for information concerning Lee Harvey Oswald, the accused assassin of our late and beloved president of our United States.

Is it possible that this man could have been in the Louisville, Kentucky area on September 6th, 1963 or September 7th, 1963?

I was in Louisville, Kentucky from September 6, 1963 to September 20, 1963 at the Sheraton Seelbach Hotel, and have reason to think that after looking at two or three of his pictures in the Courier Journal, a Louisville, Kentucky paper, that I saw a person at night time on a street in Louisville, Kentucky, who looked like this man Lee Harvey Oswald. I believe it was the night of September 7th, 1963.

This man was with two more fellows, approximately the same age, maybe younger. One was carrying three books. The one who looked like Lee Harvey Oswald was carrying a trumpet or cornet musical instrument, and held it with his left hand. He held the instrument with a dignity of pride. He conversed in a foreign language. He was sort of dark complected with black hair, and had on a brown coat or suit identical to the material and weave in one of his pictures, after being captured.

He conversed with a party I was walking with, and I was told that these boys were "Pick Pockets" but there was something about this fellow that stuck in my mind. His tight pressed lips for one reason and of course the musical instrument. I just thought it strange at the time and still do.

Therefore it would please me if the following information I seek, may be given.

- No. 1- Was Lee Harvey Oswald on September 6, or September 7, 1963?
- No. 2- Was he ever known to carry a trumpet or cornet musical instrument, out of the case, on the streets?
- No. 3- Was he left or right handed?
- No. 4- Was he ever known at any time to pledge or salute in any fashion such as, the right hand, fist closed on the left shoulder above the heart?

I feel it my patriotic duty to clear my mind of this feeling of identification, and the all due respect for our slain president.
